100 But in Genesis 2, when He made man, He said, "I am," Y-a-h-u, J-u-v-u-h, Yahweh, "Jehovah." What did it mean? "I am the all-existence One Who has created something off of Myself, to be a son of Mine, or a temporary, or an amateur, little one of Mine." Glory!

- Why? He gave man...*Jehovah* means that "He gave man to be an amateur
- god." Because He is Father God, and He made a man an amateur god, so He isn't
- self-existence anymore, He exists with His
- family. Elah, Elah, Elohim. Now, now He is
- Jehovah. *Jehovah*, meaning, the "One Who
- exists with His family."

Now, God made man to be the predominate over all the earth, he had dominion. And the earth was man's dominion. Is that Scripture? Then if that's his domain, he was god over the earth. He could speak, and it would be so. He could speak this, and it would be so. Oh!

There He is, God, Jehovah, the One Who once existed in self-existence, but now exists with His family, and His little ones with Him. There you are.

Just like one great big Diamond, and He could not be nothing else, but inside of this Diamond His attributes was a Saviour. In this attributes, on the inside of Him, was a Healer. Well, there was nothing to save and nothing to heal, but His attributes produced it. So, then before the foundation of the world, when He knowed,

that the great display in here of Him, that He would be a Saviour, that He would come and be made flesh and dwelt among us, and He knowed by His stripes we'd be healed, He slayed the Lamb on His Book before the foundation of the world, and wrote your name on that Book before the foundation of the world. Oh!

106 Listen to This! Predestination looks back to foreknowledge, I mean election. Election looks back to foreknowledge, and predestination looks to destiny. Don't forget that, that election looks back here, here it is, "I was a cocklebur. I was born in sin, shaped in iniquity, come to the world speaking lies, born amongst sinners.

Father and mother and all my whole family, sinners. I was a cocklebur. But, all of a sudden, I become a wheat grain. How did it happen?" That, what is that? Election. God, before the foundation of the world, elected that the cocklebur was to become a grain of wheat. "Now I know I'm a grain of wheat, because I'm saved. How do I do it?"

Look back and see that He predestinated it, long time ago. By foreknowledge He seen that I would love Him, so He made a propitiation through His Own Son, that through Him I might become from a cocklebur to a grain of wheat. "Now, where am I at now?" I'm saved, I'm walking in the grace of God.

"What does predestination look?" To destiny. "Where will He take me to, and where am I going?" Amen. That's got you. There you are. <u>**107</u>** Now let's read just a little farther, and then we'll have to close pretty shortly. According as he...chose us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy...without blame before him in love:</u>

Having predestinated us unto the adoption, predestinated unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will, 108 What did He do? He, by foreknowledge, foresaw us, knowing that He was a Saviour, self-existence. There was no Angels, no nothing; just God, Elah, Elohim, the self-existence One, nothing but Him alone.

But in Him was a Saviour. Well, what's He going to save, there's nothing lost? Knowing that, then He knowed that this great attribute in Him would project something out yonder that He could save. Then when it did that, by foreknowledge He looked down and He saw everyone that would accept It.

And then by doing so, He said, "To save that, the only way I can do it, will be come down Myself and be made flesh and take the sin of a man upon Him, and die for him, that I might be the One that's worshipped," because He is God, the object of worship.

**109** Then He came down and taken upon Himself. And while He did that, He did that that He might save you who wants to be saved. Do you see what I mean? By foreknowledge, the infinite God, Who knowed all things, saw the Lamb, and He slayed the Lamb before the foundation of the world, and He put your name on the Lamb's Book of Life.

And He seen the deceitfulness of Satan, what he would do. So He put your name on there. And He said that the antichrist would be so religious, so good, such a fine fellow, such a smart man, such a religious man, that he would deceive the very Elected if it was possible. But it is an impossible, because their names were foreordained before the foundation of the world

By election He chose them, and by predestination they know where they are going. There you are. 110 Now, who could doubt that? That's what Paul said. That's Paul's Scripture. That's Paul's writing. That's what he taught his church. The church, positionally, before the foundation of the world.

When God, in His labor pain, was bringing  $\frac{25}{25}$ forth, bringing forth you, knowing what you would do, He positionally placed you into His Own Body, to be a housewife, to be a farmer, to be a preacher, to be a prophet, to be this or to be that. He placed you positionally. Then when we have come from the garlic lands of Egypt, through sanctification, and is baptized into the promised land...

For, the promise of God is the Holy Ghost. Ephesians 4:30 says, "Grieve not the Holy Spirit of God whereby you are sealed until the day of your redemption." Then God, having predestinated the church, He said, "And all the peoples, there will be millions times millions that will walk very religious and be deceived."

The only ones that will not be deceived will be those that have come over into the promised land, who before the foundation of the world had their names put on the Lamb's Book of Life, and is come over into the promised land, and enjoying it.

- fellowship, is under the Blood. That's the

Now, when they'll come to the courts, realizing that they're defiled, setting in the congregation, knowing they're wrong, by faith they apply the Blood, believe it, accept it, the water—the washing of the water by the Word, cleanses them then and makes them ready.

<u>23</u> Now, here's where the thing comes, here's where the point comes. Most people says, "When I believe, that's all I have to do." Now there's where the rub comes. The man that's hit the water's of separation could not yet enter into the holiest of holies. He could not yet come into the congregation.



24 ....What does he do? He takes her to his house that he's prepared for her. Now, many people here might disagree with me by this, but you don't live but in a three room house. Oh, you may have many other rooms, but you've really only got three rooms. That is the kitchen, the living room, and the bedroom.

You may have three or four bedrooms and you may have a kitchen and a dining room and so forth, but really a person only lives in a three room house.

You live in a three room house in your body: soul, body, and spirit. God lived in a three room house: Father, Son, and Holy Ghost. Everything is in a three. And a three is a triangle. Take a triangle and shine a light on it, well, where three meets in one place, will produce seven different colors. Seven different colors is a rainbow. The rainbow is a covenant. Oh, it just keeps going on and on and on and on. On, because in that, God made a covenant through these three things: the hyssop, scarlet, and so forth.

#### And the Light of God shining upon this, makes a covenant, a covenant that God made.

<u>44</u>

<u>25</u> Now, when the woman is brought, the young bride (oh, how he loves her), but yet, they're not truly in full fellowship yet. Now the first thing...What is the kitchen to do? Is where you eat. That's like it is in the first courts of the church.

You eat here. Come, set on the back seat, listen to the Word, and the first thing you know you begin to, "O God, that meant me." You accept Him as your personal Saviour; by faith you grasp it. Then you begin to eat the Word. You begin to-to feel that you have accepted Christ as your personal Saviour. You begin to feast upon the Word; you enjoy It.

Where used to you'd get up and walk out of the building if preacher didn't say something just suited you—not right. You'd get up and walk out. But after you once accepted Christ, you've been separated then. The waters by the Word of separation separated you from your evil thinking.

Then the next thing comes is into the—the living room where you take your little bride. She takes her veil off. You're coming a little closer. Then when you do you put your arms around her, talk to her, embrace her...That's how it comes into the fellowship of the Lord Jesus. Before you do, you are separated from your sins. Then you embrace the Lord's Gospel.

You embrace the—the written Word. You believe It with all your heart. "God, it doesn't matter what You want me to do, whatever you have planned in my life, I'm ready now to receive it." That's in the-the living room. Then, still you say, "Isn't this far enough?" No, sir.

26 The next room is the bedroom. Then when you go to this bedroom, then it's-you come into fellowship and relationship. You become into a relationship, then you have complete fellowship, because you cannot have complete fellowship until you become relationship.

- Anyone knows that.
- And listen. So is it with the church today.
- We got too many people; we got too many of them that's ashamed to go into
- complete relationship with God to new life and new birth. If we're the Bride of Christ,
- then why can't we go into relationship,
- then all the shameness and backwardness and all's gone from us?

If we come into complete relationship, been borned again, I don't care...The President of the United States could be standing on the street; you'd shout, "Hallelujah, Praise the Lord. Hallelujah." You don't care, because you're come into a relationship. You're borned again. You're a new child. You're in the Shekinah Glory with God, fellowshipping with Him.

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That's what the ch...What we need today, brother, is a worship under the Blood, a worship in complete relationship, to die out.

30 Oh, don't you never lose that. If you ever lose that, to a place to where you get ashamed to go into relationship with Christ, let Him dwell in you, God in man, making Himself known to the people by His Spirit, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a peculiar people, odd,

different from the world, sanctified by the Blood and set aside from the things of the world...Amen.

<u>**34</u>** But he took the Blood to the mercy</u> seat. And only he, alone, could go in once a year. But when Jesus died, on the day of the atonement, He rent the veil in two. Not only the high priest, but whosoever will may come any time into the Shekinah Glory of God by the

<u>55</u> baptism of the Holy Ghost, into a real Pentecostal fellowship (Amen), into a place in the Presence of God, where the power of God cleanses us from all unrighteousness. We become new creatures in Christ Jesus. The Holy Ghost falls upon us and all of our backwardness and shameness, we become into a relationship with God. Isn't the Church the Bride?

Well, shouldn't the Bride be bringing fort children crying, "Abba, Father"? What's the-the matter? No wonder we can't produce ourselves any more, if we ever get away from that Shekinah Glory, get away from there and don't know Who your papa is, don't know who your mama is, out from under the Blood, "Pentecostal grandchildren" as David duPlessis called it...

God don't have any grandchildren. No, sir, God only has sons. 39 What we need today is a beating, the Gospel, back in the church to straighten the church up to pull it out of the kinks that it's in and come back under the fellowship of the Blood again in this Shekinah Glory, into a Pentecostal experience like it had back many, many years ago,

like we used to have years ago. What we need...Like we did in the days of John Wesley, way back in the days of Calvin, Knox, way back, all the way to Pentecost... What we need is a relationship again, with God, till men are willing to die out to themselves in the secret chamber with God, until new life is produced, until they become a new creature.

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Let a man do that, if he's a little old coward, he will go out and win souls. Because why? He's become in Divine relationship with God in the secret room to himself, with him and God he's anointed, and went in there with tears rolling over his cheeks and saying, "God, give me the Holy Spirit.

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I don't care if it costs my wife, my children, my girlfriend, my—ever what I am, just fill me, Lord, till I can stand in Your Presence and feel the Shekinah Glory moving, surging over me and through me."

[1] Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity! [2] It is like the precious ointment upon the head, that ran down upon the beard, even Aaron's beard: that went down to the skirts of his garments;

<u>31</u>....In the Old Testament, the high priest went in once a year, once a year, and that, bearing the blood before him. He was anointed. Oh, I like to study that, how he was anointed with the—with the anointing oil.

I believe David cried, "How sweet it is for brethren to dwell together in unity. It's like the precious anointing oil that was on the—the beard of Aaron, it run all the way to the hems of his garment."

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Oil makes things run easy, soft. You know, when a man gets really anointed and ready for God, he's just flexible.

# You know when he's not, he sets back real stiff, you know, just—oh, I don't know, just like a...

<u>61-0214 - "The Basis Of Fellowship"</u> 130 Now, then once a year the high priest (Oh, my!) had to be dressed in a certain way. He had to be anointed a certain way. He had to be anointed with the perfume of the Rose of Sharon. They put it upon Aaron's beard, and it run all the way down to the hems of his garment.

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He had to have a certain-made clothes. And another thing, he had to walk a certain way. And on his end of his garment he had a bell and a pomegranate, a bell and a pomegranate. And he had to walk a certain way to make that play "Holy, holy, holy, unto the Lord; Holy, holy, holy, unto the Lord." What's he doing?

He's approaching the Shekinah Glory, the  $\frac{67}{2}$ real fellowship. Hallelujah! 131 Now, you see, he had...and he had to make a noise. The only way the congregation could tell he wasn't dead is because they could hear that noise. I tell you when church lets off its noise there's something happens, right, as sure as the world, 'cause everywhere the Shekinah Glory is, there is a noise.

132 Watch, the man that's anointed, and Aaron went in, packing the blood before him, going in, "Holy, holy, holy, unto the Lord. Holy, holy, holy, unto the Lord," them bells chiming out, anointed, going into the holiest of holies. How the congregation used to admire that man. How he went in there one day and—and left his old staff that he had in his hand, and when he went

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back in again, that staff that was dead, nothing but an old stick, it had come to life, bloomed, and had blossoms on it (Yes, sir.), laying in the Presence of the Shekinah Glory. Whew!

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### 64-0216 - "Identification"

<u>79</u> When you receive Eternal Life, there is only one form of Eternal Life. That's the Greek word, Zoe. Is that right, brother? [The brother says, "Yes."—Ed.] Zoe, "God's Own Life." So you, being a son, you become part of that Life. So the Life that's in you never did begin and It never can end. Think of it. It can't end, because anything that's Eternal never began. The Life that's in you never did begin, that is, if you've got Eternal Life. And that's God, for you was in His thought from the Eternal, and now it's expressed here in a human being, for His glory. Jesus came to redeem that, being the Son, the fulness of God had to come and become that.

The sinless character of God did that, that He might redeem these other thoughts that was to come to Him, to make a Wife. See what I mean? Oh, it's a glorious story! We ain't...oughtn't to get on that, anyhow. Let's go on. All right. 80 Notice, "created." God, God flowed through Him just like the-the wind would flow through a—a building,

or like the water flow down a stream, even He had...Him and the Word being One. No other character could do it, for He was the only One that was born without carnal. All the rest of them was sexual desire, by carnal. He was born without sex desire. He was the virgin born.

81 God identified Himself as we are. He took—He took His strain, what He was, His strain as God, and stretched His tent down here and become human. He made Himself a tent, a body to live in, and that body is known as Jesus. God lived in Christ. See, He become human, in order to save us. And He took our upon Him, our form, that He might mold in us His character.

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# 4. <u>Christians, Oh, You</u> <u>Must Have A Personal</u> <u>Relationship To God.</u>

# <u>63-0630E - Is Your Life Worthy Of The</u> <u>Gospel?</u>

<u>138</u> Christians, oh, you must have a personal relationship to God. In order to be a son of God, you must become relation to God. He must be your Father, in order for you to be His son.

And only His sons and daughters are saved, not the members of a church, but sons and daughters. There's only one thing that will produce that, that's the new Birth. The new Birth is the only thing that will produce relationship to God.

## <u>55-0227A - The Position Of A Believer In</u> <u>Christ</u>

<u>64</u>.... Forget your traditions. Let's come together as God's children. And if you can't love one another like that, then there's something wrong with your experience...?...only saved upon emotion. And you're wondering why all these false things are rising up in your churches. People impersonating things is the very cause of it. The church is hungering for it, but you can't get together. Get yourselves together in Christ Jesus, and God will give you a real genuine faith.

### <u>60-0229 - The Oncoming Storm</u>

143 Brother, sister, that's what the Church ought to do! We don't need the shade of these towering Babylons today, of modernism. We need the blessings of each other, together, our testimony, and our Christian love and brotherhood shed abroad in our heart by the Holy Ghost.

That makes the shadow; when I can take my brother by the hand, my sister by the hand, and know that we are citizens of the <u>Kingdom of God; that we love one another,</u> and we stand together in this one great Cause, the Cause of Christ. Whether you're a Methodist, Baptist, Presbyterian, Oneness, Twoness, Threeness, whatever you are, it makes no difference,

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<u>as long as the Blood of Jesus Christ</u> <u>cleanses us from all sin and we have</u> <u>fellowship one with another. That's what</u> <u>we want, brotherhood, fellowship!</u>

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### <u>60-0304 - Thirsting For Life</u>

**<u>8</u>** I have come among them, as—among the brethren as a...Out of the Baptist Church, and I have seen this great thing, and I have never taken sides with any different one. Just whatever their belief is and everything, I try to stand right in the breach and say, "We're brothers."

We are brothers regardless. If we can discern the spirit of one another, and realize, if a man comes in, I don't care what church he belongs to, if he's got the Spirit of God on him, he's my brother. And I don't care how great he is, and how intellectual he is, and how powerful he can speak, if there's a-if he's trying to achieve the wrong thing, I-I don't believe it's my brother yet. But it's what he trying to do. If he's trying to save souls, or do something for God, that's a brother. If he's a Jehovah Witness, he's still my brother.



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# <u>60-1210 - The Philadelphian Church Age</u> 156 One thing God hates is "sowing discord among brethren." And that's right. And them's the organizations is what does it, sows discord among brethren. We should be standing in the breach and saying,

- "We are brothers!"
- We are not divided,
- All one body we;
- One in hope and doctrine, (The doctrine of the Bible.)
- One in charity.

# 5. ADAM & EVE Were In Perfect Harmony With God: Love Triangle



#### <u>62-0211 – Oneness</u>

14 Now, the first man and first woman in the garden of Eden was in perfect harmony with God, so much that God could come down at any time He desired and talk lip-to-ear with Adam and Eve. Now, that is perfect oneness, God and His creation, God speaking lip-to-ear with Adam and Eve.

And they were so perfect in harmony with God till they were one with God. God and His family was one.

15 Any man and his family, a correct, good, noble, obedient family is one with another, any family. And if there's something in the family that moves them apart, then it's not right, the family's broken somewhere. They should all be one, father with mother, mother with father, children with parent, parent with children, all in agreement. And, when you see that, you'll see one lovely picture.

<u>**16</u>** That's God's purpose. And His purpose as Father, supreme, was to be one with His family, earthly family, Adam and Eve.</u>

And the only way that they could be one with the family, or with God, was because God's nature was in them. So that made them with God's nature in them, then with each other and God, they become all one. Isn't that a beautiful picture, God in His family, Father over all, supreme! No death, no sorrow, no heartaches, no nothing; just joy unspeakable; never to be sick,

never to have a heartache, just one with God! What a picture! Because, the very nature of God was in these people. And therefore, what they did, they followed just in line with God, and God with them made them one.

63-0120E - Just One More Time, Lord 135 Is the Pentecostal church, the General Council, the Assemblies of God, the church of God, all the rest of you, willing to pay the price? Are you willing to say, "Once more, Lord! Here I stand. I didn't have the audacity, the very Christian spirit to shake hands with my oneness brother,

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or my trinitarian brother. I didn't have the audacity to do it. I didn't have the grace to do it, when I see where it's got me to, broke up in organizations and disfellowshipping, with a congregation so poisoned against one another that they hardly speak to each other on the street, when, we're molded into one clay, by the Holy Ghost"?

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<u>98</u> <u>136</u> Are you willing to cry out, "Once more, Lord, let it happen"? If you are, God will sure hear your prayer. Watch when that man, with all that fiber standing there, his great regime, but he was still blind. He knowed the price, he knowed the possibility, and he said, "Once more, Lord! Once more avenge me of my eyesight!" When he made that prayer, God answered it.

Every fiber of his body begin to tighten up, the Spirit begin to come on those muscles. Oh, if we could have the Spirit that come on our Wednesday night prayer meeting, on our Sunday school, feel the fibers of the muscles of God's power tightening up, where the Holy Spirit can come in.

Not in a mockery, but in a genuine Spirit to reveal the secret of the heart and to straighten up the sin that's in there, cast out the evil.

#### 63-0608 - Conferences

102 As long as Satan can keep you firing at one another, he just sits back and said, "Brother, I don't even have to fight." 103 But if we could just get together, and look up to God, as brethren, then step, arming, united. You don't have to change, and one go to one church.

And do the—the way you want to. Them little differences you make is no difference anyhow. God give every one of you the Holy Ghost. So the Bible said, "God gives those the Holy Ghost who obeys Him." So surely somebody has obeyed God.

<u>104</u> But the thing, as long as Satan can keep the little differences, that's what makes the church in such a commotion as is today. Let's forget that thing and come together.

### <u>61-0316 - The Church Choosing Law For</u> <u>Grace</u>

58 People try to wonder why visions and great powerful things isn't happening in the church, and greater healings and so forth. God wants to take the church over, and we're back down here in this mount moving around and around.

What kind of a mountain? An organization mountain. "Oh, wait a minute, Brother Branham, you get..." Oh, no I'm not. Mount Seir, a mount belonged to Esau, his great organization. And Israel formed themself a mountain. They were on a mountain too. But one day God said, "Leave this mountain. I'm going to take you over yonder in the plains.

You can't get nothing on these old stony hills here. You can't do no good. Get over yonder where I can bless you with milk and honey and pour in the good things of God in you, and settle you down."

That's what the church needs tonight, is to leave this mount and turn north. Let's leave this cold formal condition. You Assembly brethren, you Oneness brethren, you Church of God brethren, all you brethren, haven't we been around here long enough? Let's forget our differences. Let's put our hearts together, our arms together, our efforts together, our motives, objectives together, and go on up to Jordan, and be crucified to these things,

and cross over into the promised land where God promised to walk with us and bless us and give us the "exceedingly abundantly."

### <u>62-0211 - Oneness</u>

- <u>177</u> But God said, "Not by power, not by might; by My Spirit, saith the Lord. That's how I'll unite My Church. Not by organization, not by education, not by
- theologians; but by My Spirit, saith the
- Lord, I'll bring My sheep together." Oh, my! And when He does, what happens?

And His signs will bear record of the same. That's how Israel could say, before they got mixed up with Moab. There was a Pillar of Fire over them. Yes, sir. What will He do? He'll bear record, the same kind of a record. But after they got disassociated and so with God, separated their oneness between them and God, and got in with Moab and them, the victory all failed.

They stayed in the wilderness for forty more years, till God raised up another group to go over and complete His plan. That's exactly what they did.

12<u>1</u> And every man and woman hearing me this morning, or will hear me by the tape, your penalty is paid. Don't you disbelieve God's Word again. Come back to the Word! Don't believe it... He was the Word. Glory! I feel like shouting, honest I do. The penalty is paid. It's all over. No wonder Angels screamed and sang, the anthems of

Heaven ring out.

A propitiation was made for him to be restored again, the waters of separation, God's Word that washes him from his iniquity, when the Word died in my place and was resurrected again and become preeminent in my life, in my heart. 
