Our great evangelists across the <u>countries today, "A revival in our</u> time! A revival in our time! All you Methodists, Baptists, Pentecostals, all get together."

How can you have a revival of fresh Manna on an old, dead, vultured food? How can you have it, revival in our time? The revival will be so small they'll never know it ever happened.

133 Pentecostals said, "Oh, there is going to be a great thing happen." It's happening, and they don't know it. See, that's it. See? Yes,

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sir. "For where the Carcass is,

<u>there the eagles will be gathered,"</u> <u>just as sure as the world. See?</u>

That's what It said. What is the Carcass? The Word. He is the Word, the Carcass, Christ! "Christ in you," the same yesterday, today, and forever. How true It is!

<u>64-0816 - Proving His Word</u> 236 Now, remember, that was not Jesus talking to Abraham there, that could discern the thoughts in Sarah's mind behind Him. That was not Jesus, He had not yet been born.

But it was a Man in human flesh, that Abraham called "Elohim, the great Almighty." Showing...<u>And</u> Jesus said, "As it was in the days of Sodom," now watch close, "in the days of Sodom, so will it be at the <u>coming of the Son of man, when</u> the Son of man is being revealed."

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Not no more as a church, see, not no more; the Bride is called, see. "In that day the Son of man will be revealed." What?

To join the Church to the Head, unite, the marriage of the Bride. The Bridegroom call will come right through this, when the Son of man will come down and <u>come in human flesh to unite the</u> two together.

The Church has to be the Word, He is the Word, and the two unites together, and, to do that, it'll take the manifestation of the revealing of the Son of man. Not a <u>clergyman. I–I don't know, I…Do</u> you see what I mean?

See, it's Son of man, Jesus Christ, will come down in human flesh among us, and will make His Word so real that it'll unite the Church and Him as one, the Bride, and

<u>then She'll go Home to the</u> <u>Wedding Supper. Amen.</u>

She's already united, see, we go to the Wedding Supper, not to the marriage. "...fill your flesh...self, of all the flesh of mighty men, 'cause the marriage of the Lamb has come."

But, the Rapture, is going to the Wedding Supper. When, the Word here unites with the person, and they two become one. And then what does it do then?

It manifests the Son of man again, not the church theologians. The Son of man! The Word and the Church becomes one. Whatever the Son of man done, He was the Word, the Church does the same thing.

64-0705 - The Masterpiece 160 She is smitten from the church, from the church body; smitten with Her Master, for the same purpose. She is the Word. Just the same as Joseph was smitten from his brethren, because he was the Word.

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And Jesus was smitten from His brethren, because He was the Word. The church is smitten...The Bride is smitten from the church, because She is the Word. There is your stages again; one, two, three, see, just exactly.

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161 The Word, living and in action, the Bible Bride, not some man-made bride; the Bible Bride, smitten and afflicted of God. "No beauty we should desire Her, but yet we did esteem Her smitten and afflicted of God." That's right.

She stands alone. She is smitten from all the denominations, according to Revelation 3. She is smitten out of the Laodicean Church Age that She was raised up in. See? This Church was raised up in the Laodicea Church Age; that's the husk. But if them others went...

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162 Can't you Pentecostal men see that, if that other was husk and died? If that other (stalk) had to die, if the tassel had to die, so must the husk die; the three stages of organizations.

163 And remember, you said, "Well, now, there was a lot of tassels hanging on. There's a lot of *this*." Yeah. There had been Methodist, Baptist, Presbyterian, Lutheran, church of Christ, all these other little things that fell onto it, leaves and everything else had hung onto it, but the original was the reformations, now, see.

164 <u>Stands alone, like the</u> Bridegroom, "rejected of men, despised and rejected of the churches." The Bride stands that way. What is it? It's His Masterpiece, see, it's the Word that He can work through, make manifest. Rejecting!

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165 <u>So, the stalk, the tassel, and</u> <u>husk, never become Seed, no, but</u> <u>are all the time becoming more</u> <u>like the Seed.</u>

166 Now at the harvest time, the Seed is back to its original Life, back to the Bible. Malachi 4 said it would be brought that way. Oh, oh, <u>my!</u>

<u>Must have all! To be this way, It</u> <u>must have all of the Word. Is that</u> <u>right?</u> [Congregation says, "Amen."—Ed.]

167 Now what did He say, in Revelation 10, that would take place? Why was the trip to Tucson? To open to the Church. "In the days of the messenger, of the seventh angel, the seventh angel Message, the whole Word of God would be made manifest.

<u>The Seal, that what all the stalk has</u> <u>left off, of why and all about It,</u> <u>would be made manifest in this</u> <u>time."</u>

Is that what the Word said? [Congregation says, "Amen."—Ed.] Then, we see it. Then where are we at, see, where are we at? There is only one thing, the harvest is here. She is dead ripe. She is ready now for the Coming. Notice.

168 No, it'll never be It. <u>At the</u> <u>harvest time, the Seed is back to</u> <u>its original condition, and must</u> <u>have all of the Word, in order to be</u>

<u>the Seed.</u>

Now, you can't have a half a Seed; it won't grow. See? It's got to be the whole Seed. It's got to not manifest...Say, "I believe in the **baptism of the Holy Ghost.** Hallelujah!

I believe in speaking in tongues." That's just part of the Seed, uh-huh, but now there is added to that. Hallelujah! See? The Life, not the gifts; the Life of the gifts. See, see what I mean? We're at the end time, brethren.

169 Stalk, tassel, husk, is dead and dry now. There is only one thing that has to happen to that, is to be gathered in the World Council of Churches for its burning.

170 <u>The Word has become</u> <u>flesh, exactly like He promised in</u> <u>Luke 17, Malachi 4, and all, see,</u> <u>that's right, Revelation.</u>

171 <u>All true Life that was in the st</u> alk, tassel, and husk, is now gathering in the Seed, ready for the resurrection, ready for the harvest. The Alpha has become <u>Omega. Amen.</u>

The first come last, and the last is the first. The Seed, that went in, has come through a process and become the Seed again.

accurate this thought is. In the Dark Ages the Word was almost entirely

lost to the people. But God sent Luther with the WORD.

The Lutherans spoke for God at that time. But they organized, and again the pure Word was lost for organization tends toward dogma and creeds, and not simple Word. They could no longer speak for God.

Then God sent Wesley, and he was the voice with the Word in his day. The people who took his revelation from God became the living epistles read and known of all men for their generation.

When the Methodists failed, God raised up others and so it has gone on through the years until in this last day there is again another people in the land, who under their messenger will be the final voice to the final age.

Yes sir. The church is no longer the "mouthpiece" of God. It is its own mouthpiece. So God is turning on her. <u>He will confound her through</u> the prophet and the bride, for the voice of God will be in her.

Yes it is, for it says in the last chapter of Revelation verse 17, "The Spirit and the bride say, Come." Once more the world will hear direct from God as at Pentecost; but of course that Word Bride will be repudiated as in the first age.

- 9 - The Laodicean Church Age Oh, God still has a voice for the people of the world, even as He has given a voice to the bride. That voice is in the bride as we have said and we will talk more about that later.

Those in the bride do only His will. No one can make them do otherwise. They have "thus saith the Lord" or they keep still.

They know that it has to be God in them doing the works, fulfilling His own Word. He did not complete all His work while in His earthly ministry so now He works in and through the bride.

<u>She knows that, for it was not yet</u> time for Him to do certain things that <u>He must now do. But He will now</u> fulfill through the bride that work which He left for this specific time.
