#### 59-1220M - Conference With God 222 Lot was the—the one that lives in the city, and has big times. And see how his daughters was, and how his sons was, and everything.

That's just like the world today, Sodom, sin and everything. That's the church, nominal.

### 64-0320 - God Identifying Himself By His Characteristics

136 Now we find out, one day he saw three man come, walking. The Bible said here, "It was in the heat of the day," must have been about noon.

These man walked up and was talking to him. We understand that two of them went down in Sodom. I believe we spoke on it the other night. One of them stayed with him. 137 Watch this Man that he called...that stayed with him, what the Man did. One was identified by His characteristic, that He was Elohim.

138 Elohim, the very first word in the Bible, "In the beginning God..." Now, any of you scholars know that that word God there means, in the Hebrew, is "Elohim," which means, "the Almighty, the all-sufficient, the self-existing,"

needs no help from nobody, needs nobody's interpretation; does His Own. He is the all-sufficient God, omnipresent, omniscient, omnipotent. He is God.

139 There He was. And Abraham now, this patriarch who had a hold of the Word, looked at this Fellow. And when this Fellow had His back turned to the tent,

He said, "Where is your wife, Sarah?"
Said, "She is in the tent, behind You."

140 Said, "I'm going to visit you according to the time of life, and you'll have this baby that I promised you."

141 And Sarah laughed about it. And the One was talking to him, told him what Sarah said in the tent, behind Him. 142 Now, in Genesis, you'll read that. We find out that then, Abraham, after this Man had identified Himself...

143 What was it? Hebrews, 4th chapter, the 12th verse, said, "The Word of God is sharper, more powerful than a two-edged sword, a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart."

144 He knew that this was the Man. He knowed there was no prophets in the land but him, and therefore the Word of the Lord had come to him. And he was the prophet, and here the Word come to the prophet. 145 Same thing with John the Baptist. There had not been a prophet for four hundred years. I remember...

146 Maybe old Doctor Davis is sitting here, tonight, the old Missionary Baptist preacher that baptized me in the Faith. He used to argue with me.

He said, "Billy, you're just a kid now. You got to listen to me."
I said, "All right, Brother Davis, I'm listening."

147 He said, "You see, John was not baptized. So he had been baptizing, but hadn't been baptized; nobody was worthy to baptize him." That's good Baptist theology. "And here come Jesus, and said then...

John said, 'I have need to be baptized of Thee; why comest Thou unto me?' And He said, 'Suffer it to be so." He said, "And then when he 'suffered' Him," said, "you see, then Jesus baptized John.

And when He went out of the water, then the heavens opened and He saw God in the form of a dove, coming down and going on Him, said, 'This is My beloved Son, Whom I'm pleased to dwell in." But, no, not disagreeing with Doctor Davis, but he was wrong.

148 See, John was the prophet, and the Word always comes to the prophet. So if the Word was made flesh, It had to come to the prophet, anyhow; 'cause, he was testifying of the Word, and his very characteristic identified him that.

Here comes the Word, now what happened? As soon as he walked into the face of Jesus, John said, "I have need to be baptized of Thee; why comest Thou unto me?"

149 Jesus said, "Suffer it to be so, for thus it is becoming to us (behooveth us) to fulfill all righteousness." John being the prophet; Him being the Word.

He was the Sacrifice, and He was fixing to enter His earthly ministry, and the Sacrifice had to be washed before it was presented. And John baptized Him, 'cause he knowed.

"Suffer that to be so, for thus it's becoming to us to fulfill all righteousness." The Sacrifice had to be washed before presented, and so John baptized Him. It was not Jesus baptizing John. John baptized Jesus. "Suffer it to be so."

150 Notice, here was Abraham, and he had the Word of the Lord. The Word of the Lord come to him. He was the prophet. And now here comes the Word. He called him, "Abraham," not Abram.

151 A few days before that, his name was Abram—was Abram, now it's Abraham. His wife was Sari, now it's "Sarah," not S-a-r-r-a; S-a-r-a-h. Not (A-b-r-a-h-a-m) A-b-r-a-m, but A-b-r-a-h-a-m, Abraham.

152 And this Man identified Himself, when He said, "Abraham!" Oh, my! Abraham said, "Elohim!"

- 153 There is the Word and the prophet, together, both characters identified.
- 154 Elohim, He said, "Where is your wife, Sarah?"

155 Said, "She is in the tent, behind You." And the...Then the miracle was done. Elohim! Abraham called Him, "the all-sufficient, Almighty, omnipotent God."

156 Jesus said, when He was on earth, He did the same thing that Elohim did. That identified His characteristic as being God.

157 And He said, before, "In the last days, just at the coming of the Son of man, when He is being revealed, this setting will take place again, like it was at Sodom." Elohim among His people, the Almighty God! That's what the Scripture says. Elohim among the people!

158 For forty years He has been baptizing us with the Holy Ghost, Elohim, God! And the church...

159 Look, Abraham seen one sign, another calling; a sign, a calling; a calling, a sign; waiting for that promised son. But the last sign that he saw, the last appearing, the last visit of God before the promised son arrived on the scene, was Elohim in human flesh. Then the promised son come.

160 And Abraham's Seed is waiting for the promised Son, Jesus Christ. And they've seen signs, the pouring out of the Holy Ghost, speaking in tongues, Divine healing, and so forth.

But when the Son of man is being revealed, Elohim will return back to the royal Seed of Abraham and show that same thing that He showed in that day, amen, Elohim, as it was! Why? It will be the characteristic of God.

## 63-0630M - The Third Exodus 111 Get out of that thing. It's cursed. "Cursed?" Tell me where one ever fell and rose again. Tell me one ever raised that didn't fall. So, you can see that the thing is wrong. All right.

112 The iniquity wasn't full yet, of the Amorites, so they had to linger and wait before the exodus.

But when the Amorites got their iniquity filled, then there come a spiritual exodus, or natural exodus, to lead the people to a natural land, where a natural Amorite had once dwelt, called that their land.

113 And the iniquity of the Amorite denomination has called themselves "the Church," so long, till their iniquity is about fulfilled.

114 There's coming an exodus, where God will show who is who; where the Church Itself, the Bride of Jesus Christ, will be exodus-ed out, into the Land that's promised. "In My Father's House are many mansions, in this place."

You don't have to go There and fight like they did. It's already prepared. If this earthly tabernacle dwelling be dissolved, we have one already waiting, "That where I am, there ye will be also." The great exodus at hand!

115 Watch how God did that exodus, what He...what preparations He made, and study just a minute, then look at today. All right. Notice, before this exodus, "There raised up a—a pharaoh who didn't know Joseph."

See? A pharaoh who didn't know Joseph. "Didn't know Joseph." What was Joseph represented? The spiritual part in this spiritual exodus.

116 There raises up now, "We are freedom." ("The woman was nourished for a time, time, and a dividing of time.") But finally there raised up a—a Jos-...

or a pharaoh dictator who knew not the freedom of religion, uniting them together. Don't let it pass you. There come a time where there was a pharaoh, first, had to come.

2. Revelation Concerning The Time Of Deliverance Comes To An Elected Group (Privileged) To Bear The Burden Of Seeking For Deliverance – (There Depression That Comes With This Kind Of Ministry, It's 'The Hard Way')

-4- The Smyrnean Church Age Now the Lord God Almighty says, "I KNOW." There He is walking in the midst of His people. There He is, the Chief Shepherd of the flock. But does He hold back the persecution? Does He stem the tribulation? No, He does not.

He simply says, "I KNOW your tribulation — I am not at all unmindful of your suffering." What a stumbling block this is to so many people. Like Israel they wonder if God really loves them.

How can God be just and loving if He stands by and watches His people suffer? That is what they asked in Malachi 1:1-3, "The burden of the Word of the Lord to Israel by Malachi. I have loved you, saith the Lord.

Yet ye say, Wherein hast Thou loved us? Was not Esau Jacob's brother? saith the Lord: yet I loved Jacob, and I hated Esau, and laid his mountains and his heritage waste for the dragons of the wilderness."

You see, they could not figure out God's love. They thought that love meant no suffering. They thought that love meant a baby with parental care. But God said that His love was "elective" love.

The proof of His love is ELECTION that no matter what happened, His love was proven truly by the fact they were chosen unto salvation (because God hath chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth).

He may commit you to death as He did Paul. He may commit you to suffering as He did Job. That is His prerogative. He is sovereign. But it is all with a purpose.

If He did not have a purpose, then He would be the author of frustration and not of peace. His purpose is that after we have suffered awhile we would be made perfect, be established, strengthened and settled.

As Job said, "He puts strength in us." (Job 23:6b.) You see He, Himself, suffered. He learned obedience by the things that He suffered. He was actually made perfect by the things that He suffered.

Hebrews 5:8-9, "Though He were a Son, yet learned He obedience by the things which He suffered; and being made perfect, He became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey Him."

In plain language, the very character of Jesus was perfected by suffering. And according to Paul He has left His church a measure of suffering that they, too, by their faith in God while suffering for Him, would come to a place of perfection. Why did He want this?

James 1:2-4, "My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations; knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience. But let patience have her perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing."

Why does He stand by? The reason is in Romans 8:17-18, "And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with Him, that we may be also glorified together.

For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us." Unless we suffer with Him we cannot reign with Him. You have to suffer to reign.

The reason for this is that character simply is never made without suffering. Character is a VICTORY, not a gift. A man without character can't reign because power apart from character is Satanic.

But power with character is fit to rule. And since He wants us to share even His throne on the same basis that He overcame and is set down in His Father's throne, then we have to overcome to sit with Him.

And the little temporary suffering we go through now is not worthy to be compared to the tremendous glory that will be revealed in us when He comes. Oh, what treasures are laid up for those who are willing to enter into His kingdom through much tribulation.

41 My text. Be certain, first, before you do anything. Be certain, in your heart, that it's God. And when you've met everything that He said, then you're sure that He's God, that's when faith goes to work, right there. Faith stands steady, for it knows that He is.

42 And you met every requirement. You believe that He is, and faith holds steady. Oh, blessed be His Name! Faith won't move, for it's sure that God is, and a rewarder of those that diligently seek Him.

43 May this go way down deep and never move from you, Branham Tabernacle. If you've met God's requirements, and in your heart you believe that He is, God is only testing your faith, for He loves to do that.

You've confessed your sin and you've met every requirement that God requires, and still He lays silent, remember, faith says that He is.

Then faith holds onto it, not knowing what it's all about, but it knows that He is, and it's certain that He is.

44 Then, remember, if He is, His Words has to be true. And if He required you to meet these circumstances, and you did, He is obligated to take care of His Word. Don't back off, and say, "Well, I never got healed.

45 Wait, when you met His requirement. That brings your faith to a showdown. If you have met...God's requirements has been made, or met, and you have fully considered it,

and you have done everything that God required you to do, then your faith rests right there, that He is. Be certain of God.

46 You know, He loves to test us. He loves to see the reaction of your faith. Did you know that? God likes to see how you'll react. When you say, "O Lord, I believe You. Thou art my Saviour.

I believe that You are the Healer. I believe that You are the One Who gives the Holy Spirit. And the things that I am requiring, You are the God Who gives that."

Your request has to be granted. Oh, I—I hope you don't miss that. If you are sure of God, God is sure of His Word. He's only waiting to test you.

I can show you people that prophesy, and it comes to pass; I can show you those who speak in tongues, and—and run up and down the buildings, and say things that actually interprets, comes to pass;

but where is that person that sighs and cries for the abominations that's did in the city? Where's that burdened soul? You could turn some new leaves on that. See what I mean?

When a car is being loaded, they go through that car, the inspector, and if he finds anything loose, where it would fall and break, or anything that would destroy;

he'll not seal that car until that car is so completely packed, until it's so packed down and so in order, that the shaking of the ride won't bother the product that's on the inside.
