God's provided way of escape.

Now, when God makes His ways,
just wonder wh—how He
feels when He makes a way for us,
for our healing, for our salvation,
for our comfort, for our peace, and
all these things, and we just walk
away and leave them. It must make
Him feel terribly bad.

no fault in Him, how can there be
fault? How can He find fault, when
you are dead and your life is hid in
Christ through God, sealed by the
Holy Ghost?

“They that are born of God does not commit sin, for he cannot sin.” How can he sin when a perfect sacrifice is laying in his place? God never looks at me, He looks at Christ, because we’re in Christ.

112 We've got to take the entire,
full Gospel. We must. And now,

invited to be molded in His Image,
that we might reflect His
Presence.

“And the works that I do, shall you do also. The Life that I live, so shall you.” We’re invited, by God, to take Him as an Example, and let our character be molded like His. What a thing! My!

113 Then, when we let His
character be in us, then we have
become sons, by having the mind
of Christ, mind, which is His
character. Your mind makes your
character.

“Let the mind,” Paul said, “of Christ, this mind that was in Christ, be in you.” Let that mind of Christ be in you. It molds the character of a son of God. Now, how.....

79 When you receive Eternal Life, there is only one form of Eternal Life. That's the Greek word, Zoe. Is that right, brother? [The brother says, "Yes."—Ed.] Zoe, "God's Own Life." So you, being a son, you become part of that Life.

So the Life that's in you never did begin and It never can end. Think of it. It can't end, because anything that's Eternal never began. The Life that's in you never did begin, that is, if you've got Eternal Life.

80 Notice, “created.” God, God flowed through Him just like the—the wind would flow through a—a building, or like the water flow down a stream, even He had...Him and the Word being One.

No other character could do it, for He was the only One that was born without carnal. All the rest of them was sexual desire, by carnal. He was born without sex desire. He was the virgin born.

81 God identified Himself as we are. He took—He took His strain, what He was, His strain as God, and stretched His tent down here and become human. He made Himself a tent, a body to live in, and that body is known as Jesus.

God lived in Christ. See, He become human, in order to save us. And He took our upon Him, our form, that He might mold in us His character.

82 And His character was, that, He
did everything that pleased God,
and He stayed with the
Word. That's what He wanted us
for, we'd stay with God's Word,
find our place, and then know
where we were at.

Stay with His Word! And, think of
it, we are invited to shape our
own character to His. Now we're
going to find out what we've
done. Shape our character to His
Own, by His Own Spirit.

Then we, by Him, are sons of God,
just what I've expressed, by having
His mind in us, to shape
our character to His, His
mind. "Let the mind that was in
Christ be in you." If that mind is in
you, then, you see...

It brings you right back where you
were predestinated. Amen. (Never
saw that before.) Brings you
right...

What—what makes you believe
the Word of God, and turn down
these other things? Is because you
were...There is something in you.
Way back yonder, you're
suppo-...What? You are made to
live here forever.

Perfect Because Of
The Name In The
Lamb's Book Of Life

65-1125 - The Invisible Union Of The
Bride Of Christ

205 Here it brings into view, the two books that's going to be mysterious to you when you read the book of *The Seven Church Ages*.

The two books: Book of Life, said, one says you can put your name on, you never comes off; other one says you take his name out of the Book of Life.

This brings it perfectly in view, right here. I'm going to stop a few minutes, maybe, on a few notes here, and catch this before we close.

206 Life is a sacred thing, to God, and it's recorded in a book. God is the Author of life. Do you believe that? [Congregation says, "Amen."—Ed.]

207 Our natural life here, we have, is just a perversion. It really should be the right life, to begin with, but it's perverted by the natural birth. The first life, or your first union, you were joined in at birth, by nature, a natural act.

A natural human being associated, man and woman together, associated together in sexual affair, which brought your first life here, and that's associated with sin and death. How can you miss seeing the serpent's seed?

214 Your name of your first nature, was born, and put in a book of life. And all your deeds was wrote in it, too. Everything you done under that nature was put in a book, called the book of life.

215 You notice, in Daniel, when he come to “the Ancient of Days, Whose hair was as white as wool. Ten thousand times ten thousands came with Him, to minister to Him; the—the Bride. And then the books were opened.”

“And another Book was opened, which was the Book of Life.” See? There is saints already there, the Church, the Bride. “Another Book was opened, which was the Book of Life.”

216 Now, you, but when you were separated from that union, by spiritual death: Your natural desire is to cut your hair. Your natural desire is to wear shorts, paint your face.

Your natural desire is to be intellectual, smart man, know something better than the other. That's what Eve wanted. That's the very thing she wanted.

222 Well, you separated from your first union, by spiritual death. Now you are born again, or remarried again, to the new spiritual union; of not your natural life of the things of the world, but of Eternal Life. That germ that was in you at the beginning, found you.

223 Now, your old book is gone, with your old union. Now, your name in your old, in your...has been transferred. Now, you say, “Do you mean to tell me that my old book...” God put it in the Sea of His Forgetfulness. You stand perfectly before God.

224 Now, your name is now in the new Book; not the book of life, but the Lamb's Book of Life, what the Lamb redeemed. Not the old book of your natural union, but your new, Bride.

Hallelujah! Your new life is in the Lamb's Book of Life, your marriage certificate, hallelujah, where your true Eternal germ, from the beginning, takes hold.

Now you're not only forgiven, but you're justified. Glory! "Justified," Romans 5:1 said. Yeah. Romans 5:1 said, "Therefore being justified by faith."

225 Look up the word. The word don't mean "forgiven." The word means "justified." It don't mean you're forgiven.

226 For instance, you heard I got drunk and—and done some evil things, and everything. Then you come around, say to me. You found out I didn't do them, then you come around, say, "Brother Branham, I forgive you." Forgive me? I didn't do it, at the first place. See?

227 Now, if I did do it, I'm guilty.
But you could forgive me, and I
wouldn't be guilty. But yet I'm not
justified, because I actually done it.

228 But the word, *justified*, is though you never done it. Amen. It's not even regarded, at all. How is it done? In God's Book of the Sea of Forgetfulness, your old book and marriage is divorced and dead, and it's not even in the memories of God. Amen. You are justified.

“Therefore being justified.” It was accused. You was accused. You never done it, in the first place. The old union is in the Sea of God’s Forgetfulness. You wasn’t married to it, to begin with.

He, the Bridegroom, bore your shame, Himself, for you, in your place. He took your place, for you were predestinated for Him, to be in His Bride, before the foundation of the world. The Bible said so. You are the predestinated Seed.

229 How did you come to do this? You were deceived into it by your first marriage, to your adulterous parent, Eve. It's no fault of your own. By your natural birth, you come after Eve, who committed adultery.

That's the reason you was born an adulteress. You're a sinner, to begin with. That's right. You was deceived into it. You had no...No, you, it ain't your fault.

230 You never did it. Because, that little germ that was in you, was to be you, before the foundation of the world. God put your name in the Lamb's Book of Life.

93 Just like, in the beginning, it was not God's perfect will for children to be born on the earth through sex. No, sir. God created man out of the dust of the earth, breathed the breath of life into him,

and he become a living soul. He took from that man a helpmate, and made a wife to him. That was God's first and original will.

But when sin come in and did the thing that it did, then He permitted man to marry a wife, legally, and have children by her. “Multiply and replenish the earth, then, if that’s the way you’re going to do it.” But, you see, it never was His perfect will.

94 Therefore, all these things that²¹⁰

but God like He did in the beginning will call man from the dust of the earth, and his helpmate with him. That's right. That's the way He did it at the beginning.

95 So therefore, God never
changes His mind about anything,
but He will permit you to go
on. Now, this is a long ways around
to get to what I want to say here
about this. But, and, but, it's,
you'll...

I want you to understand it. See?
God will permit you to do
something, and even bless you in
doing it, but still it isn't His perfect
will.

96 God permitted Israel to take a law, in Exodus the 19th chapter. When grace had already give them a prophet, Pillar of Fire, a sacrifice lamb, a delivering power, but they cried out for a Law.

It wasn't God's will, but it was
injected because man wanted
it. And he was cursed by the very
law that he wanted.

97 It's best to have God's will.
That's what He taught us. "Thy will
be done. Thy Kingdom come. Thine
will be done." We must submit
ourselves to His will and His Word.
Don't question It. Believe It. Don't
try to find a way around It. Just
take It the way It is.

So many wants to go around, get
some other way. And when you do,
you find yourself going on, you
find God blessing you, but you're
working in His permissive will and
not in His perfect, Divine will.

98 He permits it, as I said, but He will not—He will not let it be His perfect will; but He'll make it work to honor and bless His perfect will. And childbearing, by sex, is one of that.

76 Then they wanted a law. And God always gives you the desire of your heart; He promised to. But we find out, when they turned one step from the side of what God originally promised them,

then that was a thorn in the flesh
until the law was taken away, until
Jesus Christ came and was
crucified to take away the law. It
was a thorn in the flesh.

77 And anything that you try to do within yourself, it'll always work to your dishonor. It'll work to your disadvantage. Just simply believe God, and that settles it.

forms causing death,” was the
right words. That’s actually what
Paul wrote. See what he’s trying to

270 Now, all these things, like baptisms: one is baptized backward, one forward, one in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Ghost, one Jesus name, one *this way*, and *that way*, and all these different little things of baptisms.

271 And of laying on of hands:
“Bless God, I got the gift of laying
