# 65-0822M - Christ Is Revealed In His Own Word

17 Now, and my text this morning is: Christ Is Revealed In His Own Word. Now, where I come to the conclusion to talk on this, was because that...

Knowing that what we say we mustn't just say because we're gathered together to just haphazardly speak on anything, but it's something that will help stabilize the people, for we are going to pass through dangerous, treacherous waters.

We're already sailing through them. And sometimes I guess it's with you like it is with me, that seems like that, so much of it, it's such a scary.

## 62-1230M - Absolute

58 Now, I was hearing a man speak, or talk, not long ago, and he used the word: Absolute. And I thought, "That's a very fine word." I hear it used so many times, "Absolutely." That's...

59 I looked up in the dictionary, Webster's. According to Webster's, it's "Perfect in itself; unlimited in its power; primarily an ultimate." And an ultimate is "The amen. That's all."

A Absolute, it is. It's "The unlimited in power," the word absolute. It's—it's, "Perfect in itself. That's all of it. That settles it." I thought, "That's a glorious thing. That's a wonderful word."

### 62-1230M - Absolute

62 <u>But the word absolute is "an</u> <u>ultimate." And, therefore, I think</u> <u>that everybody should have an ultimate.</u>

And every great achievement that's ever been achieved, there has been an absolute behind it. No matter what it was, it's had an absolute behind it. And every person, in order to achieve something, has to first have the absolute.

And that's the final wind back, through this, that, back through the other, till you come to that absolute, or the amen, or the ultimate. Of what you're...You got something you have to tie to, in other words. It's the final tying post, to every achievement.

It's somewhere. It might wind through many different things till it gets to that tie post, but there is the amen to all of it. There must be such a thing. You cannot go on through life without having one.

86 If the traffic signals are not on, then we got a traffic jam. And I think that's what we've got up there in the religious pentagon today; a traffic jam, of make-believers, unbelievers, and everything jammed together.

You just got a traffic jam. Why? They don't have no absolute. One say, "Well, we're...We're the absolute." The other one say, "We're the absolute."

87 God is the Absolute. He said, "Let every absolute, otherwise than Mine, be a lie. Mine is the Truth!" So, there is the absolute to Christianity.

# That's the end of all arguments. The Bible said so, that makes It right. Yes, sir. There must be an absolute in everything.

# 64-0205 - God Is His Own Interpreter

16 When God makes a promise and God says...ln—in the beginning, in Genesis, He lotted His Word to each age as It come down from the beginning to the end.

# And, down through these ages, the church world has got all these things all mixed up by traditions,

and so forth, and God always sends on the scene, down through the Old Testament and New, prophets! And the Word of the Lord comes to the prophet. And how does It do it?

It manifests the Word of God. God's manifestation, that tells whether it's right or wrong. Nobody has to interpret It, the Word interprets Itself. God promised it and there it happens!

17 What good does it do to say anything else about It? Who is the sinful man that would try to say (when God made a promise and God does it) that that interpretation is wrong?

That's God Himself doing His Own interpretation, interpreting. He don't need anybody to interpret Him, He interprets Himself by manifesting what He promised that He would do.

18 Oh, if the church could only see that and see the promises that's lotted for each age! All other ages, God has sent on the scene (even down through the seven church ages) and has manifested everything that He promised to do. Everything, there's not one thing left undone. Exactly! What He said He would do, that He did.

# Prophets Are God's Divine Interpreters Of His Word

## <u>Amos 3:7</u>

<sup>7</sup> Surely the Lord GOD will do nothing, but he revealeth his secret unto his servants the prophets.

63-0627 - Jesus Christ The Same Yesterday, Today, And Forever 98 Now, Israel was always taught to only believe the prophets. You Bible teachers know that.

And a prophet could only be identified, a prophet, that when he prophesied and the thing he said come to pass. The Bible said, "If there be one among you, who is spiritual or a prophet,

I the Lord will speak to him, make Myself known to him, in visions and dreams. And what he says comes to pass, then hear him.

But if it doesn't come to pass, don't fear him." That same, that's what He told Moses to tell the people, and that was their Scripture identification that the Messiah would be the prophet.

99 Now anyone knows that the Word of the Lord comes to the prophet; not to the priest, but to the prophet. The Bible said so. The Word of the Lord came unto the prophet.

And we know, if it's the Word of the Lord, and the prophet is true, then his words are true, then his words comes to pass.

And that's his credentials, that, first, it's the Word. And, first, God is the Word. And then if he speaks a word, and it happens, then that shows that God has Divinely set that man.

## 65-1125 - The Invisible Union Of The Bride Of Christ 65 Now, God, He, every generation, He adds a new part of His Book. It all goes together.

Now, we find in this, that, each generation, God has lotted His Word from the beginning.

70 So has it been in God and His Church. Justification under Luther. Sanct-...That's pulling His Bride out, now. He's creating His Bride. Justification under Luther; sanctification under Wesley; and so forth, you see.

He, the evolution of the Spirit being given more and more, 'cause the Body is building, coming to the Head, which is Christ, the Body of Christ.

## The Prophet's Word Is God's Absolute For That Age

64-0415 - Christ Is Identified The Same In All Generations 127 It's the portion of Word for each age. And how does He make it known? He makes it known by His servants, the prophets.

He all... How is the—how is the prophet understood? When he prophesies anything, and it comes to pass.

128 Now, prophets now, in these days, we got gifts of prophets... gifts of prophesy, rather. You lay hands on, and pray, and you... Gifts comes in, in nine spiritual gifts, in the church.

That's, before the prophecy can be received by the church, it has to be judged by five spiritual judge...or three spiritual judges.

129 But, not a prophet. A prophet is born a prophet. "Gifts and callings are without repentance." It's something that's in you.

## It's something was born in you. God ordained it in you. Why, Moses was born a

prophet.

130 Jeremiah, the Bible said, why, said...God said to Jeremiah, said, "Before you was even formed in your mother's womb, I sanctified you and ordained you a prophet to the nations."

131 John the Baptist, seven hundred and twelve years before he was born, Isaiah saw him, "The voice of one crying in the wilderness." His father was a priest.

64-0214 - The Voice Of The Sign 67 Now, He, that's His way of interpreting His Word. A prophet, in the Scripture, must first be a—a seer that's a vindicated.

It must not be just any fellow come along, say, "I got THUS SAITH THE LORD," and the next one say, "I say THUS SAITH THE LORD." Prophets are not hands laid on them and made prophets.

Prophets are predestinated for the hour. The Bible tells when they'll come, what they'll be. Prophets are—are sent from God. They are offices of God, that's been born.

68 God told Jeremiah, "Before you was even conceived in your mother's womb, I ordained you a prophet to the nations." See? They're just...That must be perfectly in the man. It's a...

It's not him; it's a gift from him. Moses was born a prophet. Jeremiah was born a prophet. Isaiah, a prophet. John the Baptist, a prophet. God had spoke of them.

69 And what they say must be true. And the way that the people is to know whether they are true or not, what He says must be correct, because what he is prophesying about is his credentials of his call from God,

when God vindicates what he says to be the Truth. Now that's why I'm trying to say these things tonight, so that you will understand. See? Now 70 The Bible said over here, "If there be one among you, who is spiritual or a prophet, I the Lord will make Myself known unto Him, in visions, speak to him through dreams."

Then He says, "If this prophet says anything and it doesn't happen, then don't you believe it." Now that's no more than good sense. "But if what he says comes to pass, then hear, then you must fear him," because He is with him.

71 Now we find out, what Moses said come to pass. See? That made him a vindicated seer. That was his credentials, because what he said happened.

He said, "About this time tomorrow there will be fleas all over the ground," and there was. "This time tomorrow there will be so-and-so," and there was. It must hit exactly on the dot, not just a haphazard.

72 So many man today, if you'll excuse this just for a minute. And I'm no judge or...Just passing a personal opinion.

Many man has raised up, good Spirit-filled man, and they try, they go out...Maybe the Lord give them a gift of prophecy.

73 Now, there is a million miles difference between a gift of prophecy and a prophet. See? A gift of prophecy must be judged by three before it can even be passed into the church.

We know it's the same as speaking in tongues, it must go before three judges before it can even be given to the church.

## 50-0405 - Expectation

16 Now, that isn't true. That isn't true. Gifts and callings are without repentance. There is spirits that's in the Church. That's true, such as gifts of prophecy, healing, and so forth.

But they're in the entire body. They may fall upon one person tonight, a prophecy, and It might not never fall on that person again; It might be somewhere else in the body.

And those spirits are supposed to be judged. "Let one speak and two or three judge," said Paul. Now, those are the spirits of the gifts that's in the Church.

But the only person that has a right to say, THUS SAITH THE LORD, is an a vindicated prophet. You never seen anybody judging Isaiah, or Jeremiah, or those people.

They were prophets, foreordained and borned in the world to be prophets. And they foresaw the thing by a vision, and then said, "THUS SAITH THE LORD," for the Lord had already said it.

54-0620E - Divine Healing 45 Oh, there's gifts in the church, like you say, "Gifts of prophecy. What about?" Yes, brother, but there's a vast difference.

That's what they do; latter rain people get off the grounds. You've tried to make a gift of prophecy, a prophet.

It's altogether different. A gift of prophecy is to be judged before two or three judges, but never a prophet's to be judged. His word's true from cradle up.

64-1227 - Who Do You Say This Is? 121 Now, notice, Moses, the anointed Word...or either we call him...I hope you will understand, when I say that he was the Messiah.

He was the anointed Word that had been promised for that day. Moses was! Do you believe that? Sure, the word—the word Messiah means "the anointed." See?

Now, Noah was the anointed of his day. Abraham had spoke that there would...His people would sojourn four hundred years in bondage, and they'd be brought out by a mighty hand, and what he'd show:

his signs and wonders... and—and the generations that was coming on, and what would do. And Moses stood there, that anointed Word of that day.

- 4 - The Smyrnaean Church Age In every age we have exactly the same pattern. That is why the light comes through some God-given messenger in a certain area,

and then from that messenger
there spreads the light through the
ministry of others who have
been faithfully taught.

But of course all those who go out don't always learn how necessary it is to speak ONLY what the messenger has spoken. (Remember, Paul warned the people to say only what he said, I Corinthians 14:37,

"If any man think himself to be a prophet, or spiritual, let him acknowledge that the things that I write unto you are the COMMANDMENTS OF THE LORD." "What? Came the Word of God out from you? or came it unto you only?")

They add here, or take away there, and soon the message is no longer pure, and the revival dies down. How careful we must be to hear ONE voice, for the Spirit has but one voice which is the voice of

Paul warned them to say what he said, even as Peter did likewise. He warned them that EVEN HE (PAUL) could not change one word of what he had given by revelation.

Oh, how important it is to hear the voice of God by way of His messengers, and then say what has been given them to say to the churches.

## 65-0725M - The Anointed Ones At The End Time

209 And when he went and got the old dean of the college, he walked up-and-down a little bit, said, "Son, that don't sound right." He said, "There's only one way." Here it is!

"There's only one way for us to know. Now, we have such a person, an anointed prophet, by the name of Martin. Come, go up before him."

210 And said, "You're going, anyhow." And they grabbed him by the arm, to take him before Martin, and the robe left him.

211 See, "Deceive the Elected if it were possible." See, they know them. Jesus said, "My sheep know My Word."

- "Oh," you say, "hear My "Voice.""
- That's His Word. "Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every Word." See?

The predestinated knows this. "A strange word, or a strange voice, they won't follow." That's the way with those fellows back there; they wouldn't follow.

They knowed that Martin was there, a prophet of that age, identified by God through the Word, knowed the Word. And that man wouldn't stand before It.

# 65-1127B - Trying To Do God A Service Without It Being God's Will

144 Like on my Message of the Antichrist, "There shall rise false christs." Now, He didn't say false Jesuses.

See, nobody would stand still to be called "Jesus," in the term of the Lord. But false *christs* means "the anointed." 145 Oh, they, each one thinks they got anointing, "Glory to God, he can do this and do that!" But put him on the Word test and find what he comes out at, see, the Message of the hour.

# 146 They had anointing in the time of Jesus, but not on Him.

147 They had anointing in time...Even Dathan had anointing in the time of Moses.

He said, "Now, don't you think you're the only holy one among us, God's got plenty. We'll just start an organization here, a group of men."

148 God said to Moses, "Separate yourself from him," and He opened up the earth and swallowed them up. He had give His original Word to Moses, His prophet;

that's the only way He ever did do it, and the only way He ever will do it. He doesn't change His plan, see.

### The Chaos In The World Today Is Because Of People Rejecting God's Absolute

#### 62-1230M - Absolute

237 Each one has their own absolute. Oh, my! It's just like it was in the days of judges, "Every man done what was right in his own sight."

In the days of judges, every man had his own—his own absolute. He did just what he wanted to do. And that's the way it is now.

"Every man done right in his own sight." Now, you know the reason they did that in Judges? This might shock just a little bit.

But the reason they did it in Judges, because they had no prophet in them days, for the Word of the Lord to come to. So every man could do what he wanted to, in his own sight.

238 And that's exactly what's happened today. We don't have the prophet in these days of denominations, but God promised us one.

See? See? And He did. In the last days, He would rise up and send Elijah back on the scene again,

"And he would turn the hearts of the children back to the Faith of the fathers," back to the original pentecost. You know He said that.

### Our Prophet Is The Lord Jesus Christ

63-0318 - The First Seal 192 Notice, this last Message, of the last church age, is not a reformer. He is a prophet, not a reformer. Show me where one prophet ever started a church age. He's not a reformer. He is a prophet.

193 Others was reformers, but not prophets. If they would have been, the Word of the Lord comes to the prophet.

That's the reason they continued on in the baptism in "Father, Son, Holy Ghost," all these other things, because they were reformers, and not prophets.

## But yet they were great men of God, and saw the need of the day that they lived in.

And God anointed them, and they sent out there and tore those things to pieces. But the full Word of God never come to them, because they was not prophets. They were reformers.

194 But in the last days, it'll have to be a prophet, to take up the mysteries of God, to bring it back, because the mysteries was only known by the prophets. So, it has to be this fellow come.

See what I mean now? He can't be a reformer. It's got to be a prophet, because it's got to be somebody that's gifted and set there, that catches the Word.

- 9 - The Laodicean Church Age Revelation 3:14, "These things saith the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the Creation of God."

# My, isn't that the most wonderful description of the attributes of our lovely Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ?

These words just make me want to shout. They bring such a spirit of reality into my heart. Just reading them without even waiting for a thorough revelation of the Spirit upon them thrills me.

Jesus is giving us this description of Himself in relation to the last age. The days of grace are winding up. He has looked from the first century right through to the twentieth,

and told us all things concerning these ages. Before He reveals the characteristics of the last age to us, He gives us one final look at His own gracious and supreme Deity.

### This is the capstone revelation of Himself. Thus saith the "AMEN." Jesus is the Amen of God. Jesus is the "So Let It Be" of God.

Amen stands for finality. It stands for approval. It stands for prevailing promise. It stands for unchanging promise. It stands for the seal of God.

#### 63-1201M - An Absolute

148 It was a paradox, the other day, on March the 15th, or May the 15th, I believe...no, March the 15th, this last year.

When, three or four months beforehand, Sirs, What Time Is It?, said we'd go out there, "And seven Angels would meet, and come back and the—the Book of the Seven Seals would be opened."

And standing right there with Brother Fred Sothmann, that just said "amen" there, standing there by him, why, I told them, "There would be a noise that would shake the country."

And I said, "It'll be there. It's THUS SAITH THE LORD." It's on tapes, tapes, tapes, from Phoenix all the way around. "It's THUS SAITH THE LORD."

## 65-0725M - The Anointed Ones At The End Time 269 Now, I want you to know this is sure, and you that listen to this tape.

You might have thought today that I was trying to say that about myself, being that I was packing this Message. I have no more to do with It than nothing, no more than just a voice.

And, my voice, even against my better judgment; I wanted to be a trapper. But it's the will of my Father that I declare to do, and determined to do.
