56-0120 - Fellowship With God Through Reconciliation

21 So we find out that man must come back to his Maker. Then when Adam realized that sin had separated him, he became an alien, a wanderer away from God,

without hope, wandering around in the—the garden, knowing that he was separated from God, knew that he didn't have fellowship no more; it made him a wanderer.

And man to this day, when the sin problem, he still becomes a wanderer. He will go to one church awhile; he longs to have fellowship.

God laid out the welcome mat home to every sinner in the beginning in the garden of Eden, through the shed blood of an innocent beast.

An innocent dying for the guilty, which was in a shadow of the coming of the Lord Jesus in the days that when we would really come back to the real,

pure, Divine fellowship again with Father. What a wonderful plan. That was the welcome mat that laid at the door.

23 And when Adam and Eve realized that they had sinned and could not stand upon their self-made religion, they made themselves aprons of fig leaves, we're told.

That's the way man is today, when he sins, he will join church. he will do something; he will try to cover hisself up, get out in a little better group, or try to belong to a better society.

All those things are man made, and cannot stand. They'll never work; you just might as well forget it. God wouldn't recognize it.

And as Adam and Eve come down to the end of the road, when they had to face God and realize they were naked, so will every man, woman, boy, or girl who trusts in anything less than the shed Blood of Jesus Christ.

At the hour of your death, you'll realize that you're a sinner, dying in the Presence of God. Right. Very strong, but I don't believe we got too much time left here on earth to do what we have to do...

The Christian Church, how it failed, and it's time to take off the gloves and preach the Gospel in the old fashion way. I believe it in the old fashion way.

Like that little—like that little drop of ink this morning, when it struck that bleach, it went all the way back. And when sin has been confessed and fallen into the Blood of Jesus Christ,

oh, my, it gives an abstract, right straight back to the Creator again. You become a son of God. Abstract title deed is held in the hands of the Almighty. Oh, my!

119 Its redemption means all legal possession to all that was lost by Adam and Eve. Oh, my! [Brother Branham claps his hands together once.] What ought that to do to a born-again Christian!

Its legal possession to that abstract deed, title deed of Eternal Life, means that you possess everything that Adam and Eve lost. Whew! What of it, brother? The possession of that deed!

120 Adam could not meet the requirements of redemption. After he found he lost it, he had sinned and he had separated himself from God, was on this side of the chasm, so he could not redeem it.

He just couldn't do it, 'cause he—he needed redemption, hisself, so he could not do it.

121 But the law required a Kinsman Redeemer. The law of God required a Kinsman Redeemer. You want to mark that down, "Kinsman Redeemer," find it in Leviticus 25.

122 We won't have time to thoroughly search this, 'cause, you know, each—each text would make a—a night. See?

123 But God's law received a substitute. Now, what if God had not offered to take a substitute? But love constrained Him to do it.

That, man was without a way back, and there's no way for him to get back. He was gone. But the grace of God met this Kinsman Redeemer in the Person of Jesus Christ.

Law required it. Grace met its requirements. Oh, amazing grace, how sweet the sound! God's law required an innocent substitute.

244 Now He has the title deed to redemption. He has It in His hand. Mediation is done now. He has It in His hand.

He is my God. He is my Kinsman Redeemer. He is all. For what was I without Him, or what could I be without Him? So, see, He is my All. And He is standing There as our kinfolks.

And now He's been interceding for us, up till this time. And now He comes forth and takes the Book of Redemption, to claim His rights, of what He did for us.

2. God Embarked On Restoring The Fallen ManAnd He Sent His Temple **Guards To Protect The** Throne. Wherever The Word Went, They Went! Ezekiel 1:

62-0707 - Jehovah-Jireh #3

58 Remember, all Abraham's Seed that ever come to God, comes the same way. Not nothing you could do!

You could not save yourself no more than you could take your boot straps and jump over the moon. You cannot save yourself. No man ever sought God; it's God seeking man.

"You never chose Me," said Jesus, "I chose you." 59 The first, now, could you go out here and tell a pig that he's wrong, eating slop? He'll tell you to attend to your own business. But it would have to take something that could change his nature, to make him realize that he's wrong. Something has to happen to the pig, first.

60 That's the reason that so-called Christians many times wallow in the mud, back in sin, is because...You could wash a pig, and paint their fingernails, put on lip manicure.

That, that's wrong, ever what it is. Lip rouge, isn't it, or something? I get that, all that stuff, mixed up. You know what it is, though. You put the old sow on some lip rouge andand, you know, do all the other works to it, and she'll go right straight to the wallow, and wallow again. Why? She's a hog, to begin with. The only way you'll ever make her any different, is change her nature.

61 That's the only way that a man or woman can ever line up with God, is change the nature, clean up, die to the old man's sin, and be reborn again by the Spirit of God.

And, that is, Christ is the Spirit of God, and Christ is the Word. Then it witnesses with the Word. That's the only way they'll ever do it.

61-0108 - Revelation, Chapter Four #3 261 Now, when Ezekiel saw the Glory of God, he saw the same thing that John saw. You remember last Sunday how we got "the Glory of God,"

and got the picture where He had It taken with us? You remember that? "The Glory of God," the same thing Ezekiel saw, same thing John saw, here It is today.

Makes Jesus Christ the same in Ezekiel's time, same thing was here on earth, the same God that's here with us today; same yesterday, today, and forever; He that Was, Which Is, and Shall Come;

the entrance to the soul, body, and spirit; the brazen sea (the Word), the Sanctifier of our soul, and the Filler with the Holy Ghost. The same thing, see, just the same!

262 Now, watch this. All right: ...and the spirit...wherever they went;...now...to go, they went; and they turned not when they went.

263 They couldn't turn. If they was going this way, it was going like a man; going this way, was going like an eagle; going this way, was going like an ox; going this way, they was going like a lion.

They couldn't go backward! They had to go forward everywhere they went, each one of the beasts. Now, what does a beast mean in the Bible? Power. All right, means "a power."

264 Now:

As for the likeness of the living creatures, and their appearance was like burning coals of fire, and like...of...the appearance of lamps: it went up and down among the living creatures;

and the fire was bright, and out of the fire went forth light. That's God. From the fire went Light; not cosmic light, now, the Eternal Light.

And the living creatures ran and turned (Let's see.)...the living creatures ran and returned, and as the appearance of a flash of lightning.

Now as I beheld the living creatures, behold one wheel upon the earth by the living creatures, with his four faces.

The appearance of the wheels...their work was like unto...colour of...beryl: and they four had one likeness: and their appearance and their work was...it was a wheel in the middle of a wheel.

265 "What's the symbol here, Brother Branham? What is it?" It means that these guards—these guards was God's ark... They were in journey, rolling on wheels when Ezekiel saw them; but when John saw them, they had already come into their right position in Heaven.

The ark of God was on earth, rolling on wheels, as they took it from place to place, meant it was in travel, they took it all the way up through the wilderness and all the way into the temple and so forth;

but now it's received up 'cause the Church age is over, and it's received up into Glory. See? It's stationary now, in Heaven, with all the Angels and things around it.

We find them after while taking off their crowns and falling on their faces and giving glory to Him. See? It was God's guards of the temple, of the ark.

266 Now, remember God's guards of the ark, or the mercy seat. Now, remember. To how many, John saw, how many?

Four. How many did—did he see? He seen four, too, four living Creatures. Now, watch, they both seen the same vision.

267 And four is the number of earth. Did you know that? How many knows now before we have to go into it, four is an earthly number? Sure! Like the four Hebrew...

It's an earth-...It's a number of earth, of "deliverance, deliverance." Now, keep that in your mind, "deliverance," 'cause I'm going to strike it, just a minute, real hard.

See, "Deliverance!" Now, there was three Hebrew children in the fiery furnace, but the fourth One come, it was deliverance. Lazarus was in the grave three days,

but when the fourth one come he was delivered. Four is God's number of "deliverance," so it showed that these Beings must have been something about the earth.

268 I hope you're not too hungry now. I hope your spiritual appetite is a little—a little above your natural now. See? All right.

269 Now, notice, "They have eyes" (in Ezekiel in here) "in front and in back and within." Let's just read that.

Look here, see. You see in here, I believe they spoke through here, "beasts," four faces, like an eagle, and wings, full of eyes without, within.

Look here:

And the four beasts and each of them had six wings about him;...

270 "And they flew," and so forth, "and had eyes without, within, and behind." It spoke of their intelligence. They knowed what was, which is, and which shall come;

for they was right at the Seat, so close till they wasn't even human. Temple guards, or, not temple guards (The temple guards, the hundred and forty-four thousand.),

but this is the mercy-seat guard, the Throne guards, the Throne, right up next to God, "living Creatures," next thing to God, standing there. Their intelligence, they know what was, which is, what shall come.

They had "eyes without," showing what they could see, what was to come; "eyes within," knows everything now; and "eyes in the back," which knowed what was.

Which was, which is, which shall come, reflecting through the church ages "He that Was, Which Is, and Shall Come; Jesus Christ the same yesterday, today, and forever."

62-1111M - Dedication

26 Now first we will read from Chronicles, First Chronicles 17, beginning at the 1st verse. And then, secondly, we'll read at the Book of the Acts of the apostles,

at the—at the 7th chapter. We'd like to begin to read at the 44th verse of the 7th chapter of the Acts, all in line with the dedication of the temple. And then Hebrews 10:5.

Now it came to pass, as David sat in his house, that David said to Nathan the prophet, Lo, I dwell in a house of cedar, but the ark of the covenant of the Lord remaineth under curtains.

but have gone from tent to tent, and from one tabernacle to another. 27 Now in the Book of the Acts of the apostles, beginning 7th, and 44th verse.

Our fathers had the tabernacle of witness in the wilderness, as he had appointed, speaking unto Moses, that he should make it according to the fashion that he had seen.

Which also our fathers that came after brought in with Jesus into the possession of the Gentiles, whom God drave out before the face of our fathers, unto the days of David;

Who found favour before God, and was desirous to find a tabernacle for the God of Jacob.

But Solomon built him an house.

Howbeit the most High dwelleth not in temples made with hands; as saith the prophet,

Heaven is my throne, and earth is my footstool: what house will you build me? saith the Lord: or what is the place of my rest? Hath not my hands made all these things?

28 And in the Book of Hebrews, the 10th chapter and the 5th verse.

Wherefore when he cometh into the world, he said, Sacrifice and offerings thou wouldest not, but a body has thou prepared me:

29 We are very familiar with the reading of these set Scriptures that we want to speak on for a few moments.

30 Now, David, under desire and revelation, thought in his heart, a very gallant thing. When, David, being a fair man, and well-loved with the people,

32 And that night, the Lord came to this seer, and the prophet Nathan, and said, "Go, tell my servant, David." See? I like that. Oh, in other words, "I admire his courage,

and his thoughts of Me, to build Me a place. But," He said, "I—I haven't dwelt in a house. I haven't had a place to stay when I come down to earth, to look My people over.

I haven't had a place to stay, even since I brought up Israel. I haven't commanded any of the judges to build Me a house of cedar,

but I've went from tent to tent." That isn't just about the form of it today! "I've went from tent to tent, and from place to place, to meet with My people."

Now, the word pitch means "to atone." Over in Leviticus, the same word that was used for pitch in Genesis, in Leviticus is used as an atone, to make an atonement.

Well, now, atone is "to stand between." And the pitch that was in the gopher wood, in the ark, was to "keep out," or to atone the believer from the wrath. You see it?

91 Noah could not get into the wrath, the waters of judgment. Oh, I see it now. You get it? Look.

He could not come into the judgment, because there was an atonement between him and the judgment. And the judgment was the water of the world.

92 And the believer, in Christ, is safely secured. Amen. Not upon the merits of himself, but on his obedience, obedience to walk into the ark.

The only thing Noah had to do was get in the ark. He didn't even have to shut the door, God did that Himself. Walk in!

That's all the believer does, is walk by faith in Christ. God takes care of the rest of it. "He that heareth My Words, and believeth on Him that sent Me, hath everlasting Life,

and shall not come into the Judgment." Passed from death unto Life, in the ark, safe for evermore. Amen. Let the Judgment rock, where, if it wants to.

141 This is described in this Seven-Seal Book that we're talking of now. All right. The Book of Redemption, it's all described in here.

All that what Christ will do at the end will be revealed to us this week, in the Seven Seals, if God will let us. See? All right. It will be revealed.

And revealed, as the Seals break and are released to us, then we can see what this great plan of redemption is, and when and how it's going to be done.

It's all hidden in this Book of mystery here. It's sealed, got up with Seven Seals, and so the Lamb is the only One Who can break them.

79 Now it—now it was used for atonements, and in the atonement for sin, one dove.

He was even decayed out in the graveyard four days, past his seventy-two hours. His nose had probably already begin to drop in. The different parts of his body, skin worms was in it.

But they...Mary, Martha, rather, when she went to meet Jesus, she said, "Lord, if Thou would've been here, my brother would not have died." She knew Who He was.

She knowed He was God's provided Sacrifice for Life. For He said, "I am the bread of Life that come from God out of heaven." And God had provided a Life-giver.

He had provided the fulfillment of what He had promised in Isaac:

Jesus Christ, His own Son that He spared not, to provide a eternal Sacrifice. For every generation that would follow Jesus Christ,

every generation after that would never have to look again for a sacrifice, for God provided everything the human race has need of in Jesus Christ.

All the shadows, all the types were all fulfilled in the Lord Jesus Christ. Jesus was the Rock that was in the wilderness. He was the Lamb that died instead of Isaac. Hallelujah.

There was the lamb that died in Isaac's stead in his place. There was the rock that was in the wilderness. There was the brass serpent that hung on the pole.

There was the—the Angel of the pool of Bethesda. The people was looking on the pool to find the Angel, and here It was going right by them.

26 Every type in the Old Testament was met in Him, and He was and is God's everlasting,

provided Sacrifice for sin and sickness. In Him dwelt the power to omit, or to forgive every sin that was ever committed.

Sin—sickness came, an attribute of sin. And when sin was brought into the world, sickness followed it.

Death followed it. And Jesus come to make a riddance of sin, and when He ridded sin, He ridded every attribute that sin produces.

I hope you see it tonight. When He killed sin, He killed everything that sin produces. He killed worry. He killed temper.

He killed everything that sin produces. Jesus killed it when He died instead at Calvary. He was Jehovah-jireh, God's provided Sacrifice.

27 Here it is: After His going away, He said, "I will not leave you comfortless. I'll give you another Ensign.

If I be lifted from the earth, I'll draw all men unto Me. And the things that I do, shall you do, even greater than this, for I go unto My Father."

And he commissioned human beings to go to all the world, and preach the Gospel, and demonstrate the power of the Holy Ghost until He returns, as a sign.

It's God's provided Sacrifice tonight, is the Person of the Lord Jesus in the Person of the Holy Spirit here tonight, proving Himself to be Jehovah-jireh, the Lord's provided Sacrifice for your healing tonight, the Person of the Holy Spirit, Jesus Christ returning in Spirit form.

He said, "I come from the Father; I go to the Father. A little while and the world will see Me no more. Yet you shall see Me, for I'll be with you, even in you to the end of the world."

There He is, God's provided Sacrifice, that can sway the hearts of true believers from one side of the earth to the other side of the earth,

where they'll gather in hot buildings, on the street corners, bear persecution, die for the very cause that it was made and was created for them.

28 Now, He's Jehovah-jireh. Now, He said, "A little while the world seeth Me no more.

But when the Holy Ghost is come, He will testify of Me. The Holy Ghost will testify of Me, and will take these things that I have done and told you,

and bring them to your remembrance, and will show you things that is to come." God's provided Sacrifice...And tonight, my times past for speaking.

But look friends, Jesus Christ, the Son of God, was God's everlasting, eternal provided Sacrifice. It's provided for your sin. It's provided for your healing. It's provided for your freedom.

It's provided for your joy. It's provided for your peace. It's every attribute that Jesus died for, and He come to rid sin, now, not to cover sin, but rid sin. And when...lf I...

If the serpent had a foot, and it was a pulling me, the foot was pulling me, I don't have to cut the foot off to get rid of the thing.

If I'd hit the serpent in the head, I'd kill the foot also. Is that right? You'd kill every organ of his body, everything, was of the serpent. If you kill its head, then you kill the serpent.

And when Jesus, at Calvary, got rid of the sin question, He got rid of sickness and every attribute that went with it. He freely freed us.

29 The devil put us in the pawn shop, but Jesus redeemed us. He's our kinsman Redeemer, God made flesh, kinfolks to us, in order to redeem us from the curse of sin and sickness,

and tonight, has sent the Holy Spirit to dwell with the church, and show signs and wonders of healing and salvation, until He returns again.

7 Then being the Church of God, God ordained a certain place for these people to meet in where there would be fellowship; because God longs to fellowship with His people, and among His people.

Then God took Moses up into the mountain of fire where the lightnings was flashing and the thunders a roaring. And He showed him what kind of a dwelling place He desired to dwell in on earth. For Moses patterned the earthly tabernacle after what he had seen in heaven, a sanctuary of the Lord.

Oh, I think that's so beautiful, to think that God before He would let a church building be built, that that building had to be a pattern of His heavenly abode. Moses made all things after the pattern of the heavenly.

8 And now, let us take just a little look at this, what Moses must have saw. And he made it first out of earthly material, which was made of skin, sheepskins.

We'd call it a tabernacle or a tent, means "a dwelling place." And in this tabernacle, or tent, there was three separate compartments. That surely is the way it is in glory.

And we notice one was called the court, or the congregational place. The next was called the holy place. And the next was called the holy of holies. All these pointed to Christ.

And even the furniture that was in the—inside its walls; everything spoke of Christ. That's the reason that in Christ dwells the Fullness of God, 'cause all things led to Him.

And Christ was God made flesh, God tabernacling on earth. Therefore, it was said by Stephen, "That Solomon built Him a temple.

But the most High dwelleth not in temples made with hands; but a body has Thou made Me." 9 All the furniture in the building typed Christ.

Such as the laver, where the sacrifice was washed, the brass altar, where it was slain and burned. And the brass even in the altar speaks of judgment, Divine judgment.

Brass, like the brass serpent was made in the wilderness, speaking of the Divine judgment of God upon the serpent, made of brass passed judgment.

6. After The Atonement, The Cherubims Are Guarding Man Back To The Tree Of Life = The Person Of Jesus Christ Personally Revealed To You.

61-0611 - Revelation, Chapter Five #1

74 Now, we find out that they were the guards to the mercy seat. They watched the mercy seat.

Nothing come to it, it crossed over the tribes first before it could get to the mercy seat.

Every man willing to give his life,

every Israelite in camp would die before anything could enter into that camp over there and take that mercy seat. And now we find out that was the Old Testament order.

75 And in the New Testament order we find the same thing, that it was guarded, the mercy seat.

Oh, I hope you get it! The mercy seat is still guarded, still got the guards. We found out that those guards are Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John,

guarding the Book of Acts, the acts of the Holy Spirit done amongst the apostles, which is the—the Book of Acts of the New of the New Testament.

And the four writers of the Gospels, Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John, all guard that mercy seat to show that it is God, the Holy Spirit today.

Each Scripture, Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John, every one of them will back up the true Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ and the acts of the Holy Spirit.

7. The Second Eve Rejected The Word And Fell

62-0318 - The Spoken Word Is The Original Seed 46 Now, Adam did not decei-...was not deceived. But his bride was deceived. Christ, today, is not deceived.

The Word is not deceiving. It's the bride that's doing the deceiving, by the Word. You see it? [Congregation says, "Amen."—Ed.]

47 Now, He gave him a bride, a type of the second Adam. He gave the first Adam a bride; she fell.

He gave the second Adam, Christ, a bride; she fell. That's exactly. Why? She's not an original. She is a by-product. 48 The bride today is a by-product. See? She, she calls herself the bride.

But what she is, she's made up of a material of organization, not of the Word;

so much Word in it, to make it kind of a by-product, to make it hypocritical. Eve believed most of the Word, but she doubted one part of It.

Today, she can't even get Acts 20...or Matthew 28:19 straight with Acts 2:38. See? It confuses her. That's just one little place, of the hundreds of others.

Now, the bride of Adam was a type of the second Adam's bride. Now, Adam's bride... [Blank spot on tape—Ed.] I've cut the tape?

49 Adam's bride could not wait. God had told Adam and Eve, "Multiply and replenish the earth."

It was an oncoming thing, a promise. She was not his wife, as yet, because he had never lived with her.

50 The bride of Christ is not His wife yet. The Wedding Supper is to take place. Get it? Notice, oh, this is rich.

51 She got in a hurry, and what did she do? She crossed her seed. She mingled it with the serpent's seed. And when she did, she brought a—a...

What did she bring? She brought a child of death. A child, that, she perverted every child after that.

52 And when the church of Jesus Christ was perverted in the time of Rome, after her virgin birth, and was given to Christ at Pentecost, she...

What did she do? She crossed herself with Roman dogma. And the Protestant church has done the very same thing. She can't wait.

63-0320 - The Third Seal

126 She was promised, (the bride, Eve), to be a Redeemer. Her Redeemer would be the Word. And when the Word came, made flesh, she rejected lt.

She was given substitutes. Now hold that, "substitute." Given substitutes to go on, until the Redeemer come.

And when the Redeemer come, she wanted to continue with her substitute, and rejected the true Word. See it? [Congregation says, "Amen."—Ed.] And that was the Hebrew bride.

127 So did He, by the second Eve, bride, the mother of all spiritual living. See? Eve means "the mother of all," that's spirit-..."all that's living." Eve, "mother of all that's living."

128 Now, and when He came to the Hebrew bride, she was the mother of all that was living, but she rejected It.

129 Natural Eve fell, in Eden, by listening to Satan's reasoning against God's Word. That's how she fell. All right, sir. She fell because she did that.

130 Spiritual Eve, now, that's the church, Christ's bride. She fell, not in Eden, but in Rome, see, at the Nicaea Council,

when she rejected, that Pentecostal church, that went down to Nicaea, and listening to Roman's reasoning, instead of holding onto the Word, she fell.

And everything away from her, died with her, around her. Now, just as natural Eve fell, spiritual Eve fell. God's bride fell—fell in the garden; Christ's Bride fell in Rome. See?

131 Notice, by the same reasoning, against God's Word, she also forfeited her rights of virtue, to Satan.

Which, we found in the breaking of these Seals, that that was Satan, and still is Satan there. The Bible said it's the very seat of Satan.

And as Eve forfeited her—her virtuous rights, and give them over to Satan, in the garden of Eden; the church, the bride of Christ, did the same thing at Rome,

when they forfeited the Bible for their dogmas and reasonings. See how it types? [Congregation says, "Amen."—Ed.]

132 You just run those types, you're bound to come out right. If my hand looks like...

If I've never seen myself, and I see my shadow coming, I'll know just about what I look like. See? But, that's the way.

If you want to see what's coming, look what has been. "For the...all the old things were shadows of things to come," the Bible said. All right.

133 For, she forfeited her virtuous Word, the Word of God, when she sold the Bible,

and put a man in there that says that the church has rights to change anything they want to change. And they've done it. And the bride of Christ, the pentecostal bride,

sold out her virtue, at Nicaea, just as Eve sold her virtue to Satan in the garden of Eden. Exactly. All right.

8. The End Time Bride- Eve Is Redeemed To Walk Back Into God's Presence for True Worship And Fellowship Again... Beyond Time Into Eternity. She Is Ordained To Not Fall. Not To Miss It.

63-0728 - Christ Is The Mystery Of God Revealed 580 When, we see all these, great threefold revelation: God in Christ; Christ in the Church; the Kingdom coming.

Adam and Eve redeemed back to the garden of Eden, in the representation of Christ and His Bride, and then the Kingdom is going to be restored according to His promise.

Praise be to God! Now, by the revelation of the threefold mystery, the secret, and by the personal vindicated Word by His original Headship!

429 Now remember, He is that Tree of Life, contrary to "the serpent's seed," you see. He's that Seed, "the woman's Seed," the Tree of Life in the garden.

"And lest they put forth their hands and move this Tree, they'd eat that Tree and live forever." And He's the only Tree that can be taken, that you can live forever.

Notice, this Tree, of Christ's Body, in the garden. Making, now making His mystery known to this Bride Tree.

433 Watch, redeemed by Christ, the second Adam. You believe He was? [Congregation says, "Amen."—Ed.] Going back Home, to Eden, with His fallen wife redeemed back Home again.

That's Christ in the Church today, taking His Wife back. See the threefold mystery now? ["Amen."] God manifested in Christ; Christ manifested in the Church;

all together, to bring back the original Adam and Eve again, man and woman, which are one, made out of the same Blood and same Spirit, and everything else.

434 The Church is the Blood of Christ, by the Spirit, because the—the Life is in the Blood.

That's the baptism of the Holy Chost that baptizes us into His Body, that recognizes only His Body, His flesh, His Word. [Brother Branham pats his Bible—Ed.]

435 Denomination won't, never touch that. It's a revelation. She knows it. So did Eve know it, but she fell; but this one knows it, and won't fall.

She is ordained! Hallelujah! Whew! She is ordained to not fall. She won't fail. She is predestinated to it. "Blessed is the man who God will not impute sin."

You ministers know what I'm speaking of, when there's a couple dozen of you sitting here. See? "Blessed is the man who God will not impute sin," David.

436 Notice, redeeming back, with Him, going Home; back to Eternal Life in a human body, eating, drinking, living forever.

63-0728 - Christ Is The Mystery Of God Revealed 145 Now, He could do that in Adam and Eve, but sin separated them,

so now there had to be some way to get it back again. Oh, my! Oh, when I...This, this is rich, to me, just to even think of it. See?

See what God's purpose was? Now why didn't He just keep Adam and Eve like that? Then He would never been able to express His fullness, His full attribute.

Because, He could have been a Father there, that's true, but also He's a Saviour. You say, "How do you know He was?" He is, 'cause I've had the experience. See? See?

You don't come by laws, and rituals, and orders. You come by predestination. Amen! There is a genuine, holy convocation! See?

And we're ending the seventh church age, church age, the Pentecostal age. Do you see it? We're entering that holy convocation.

We are entering into that real, genuine, Eternity, where the Church is called; not to some station, some denomination, but into Eternity with their Eternal King.

See? We don't have it at all, no such a thing as days, and things, and times. You've passed into Eternity, where you come from. You was There, to begin with. See?

237 If you got Eternal Life, there is only one form, that's God, and you are an expressed attribute.

but these Things don't, so it speaks of Eternity. The Holy Ghost is Eternal. Then, you are in Eternity, where you was all the time, but you've just recognized what happened.

238 See, you were made for an Eternal purpose, because you was the—the manifestation of an attribute that was in God, that thought of you and expressed you;

and He made a earth to take you out of, and to make you a human being. And sin come along and perverted His way.

You come, anyhow, but you was lost with the world. So He come and redeemed you, the expressed attribute, and also redeems this earth by the same way.

Then, His purpose rolls on. See? Oh! Hallelujah! Oh, that does me so much good, think of just what lays ahead!

239 Now, in Ephesians 1:10, it's called...Now, if you're putting it down, Ephesians 1:10, is called, not a dispensation, not the seventh day. It's called, "The fullness of time."

And when "the fullness of time" has come, that's when time has been fulfilled. When there is no more time, then you go into Eternity, after the seventh church age is over, and it is;

Luther's age is over, Methodist age is over, Pentecostal age is over. And now you go into (what?) Eternity; no more seven's, no more three's, no more other.

They're in Eternity, where there is no such time as numbers, and times, and things. Amen! Oh, my! You see it now?

240 Or, after time has been fulfilled, all sin is gone, taken away, at the Millennium, at the great White Throne Judgment. (A type, by the Holy Ghost.)

After the world is on fire and baptized, its baptism of holy Fire from Heaven; all sin is gone, all germs is gone, all devils is gone,

all temptations is gone, all evil is gone. (Type now.) Then what does God do? He can sit upon the earth, see, because all sin is gone.

241 That's the same thing He does when He gives you the Holy Chost baptism with Fire.

He can come and dwell with you, and we can sit in Heavenly places in Christ Jesus, because we are already in Him.

Not we "will be." We are now sitting in Christ Jesus. How do we get into it? By one Holy Ghost baptism. "By one Spirit we're all baptized into Christ," which, we are now.

Won't "be" in Christ; we are! He is the great spiritual King over the Spirit that's in us, because we were in Him at the beginning.

242 See, God, in the beginning, when He thought of you and thought of others like that, thought of Himself of being tangible.

That was His thoughts. See? So, He expressed His thoughts by Word. He said, "Let there be." "Let there be," and there was. "Let there be," and there was.

243 Then, after a while, He kept saying "let there be," till the people said, one day, "Don't let God speak!"

244 He said, "Now I'll speak to them through a prophet." See? "From this on, I'll speak to them through a prophet."

245 And the prophet said, "There shall come; there will be," and it was, and it was. And it was, and it was, see, just like that. You get it now?

246 "The fullness of time" has come after time has been fulfilled.

Sin is gone, after the world's baptism, after the world's baptism makes it a fit place; no sickness, no germs; no thorns, no thistles;

no death, no sorrow, no heartaches; no old age, nothing to represent death; nothing wrong; all right; nothing natural. Eternal!

247 Then, His attribute is expressed because it was there, first, to begin with. That's what He thought. [Brother Branham illustrates at the blackboard—Ed.]

248 And then what happened? He set Adam and Eve here on the earth, and said, "Multiply now and replenish the earth."

Their bodies was all laid out here, for you to eat and make your body. That's the way He had of doing it. 249 But sin come along and interrupted His plan. She rolls right on, just the same, time does.

250 But what did Jesus do? God came down and expressed Himself in the form of a Man, a human being;

gave His life, instead of staying here. Which, He was the King, but He gave Hisself to redeem the rest. You get it?

251 And when it's all over, then it's pulled right back, and God's purpose is fulfilled.

There is the Eternal King again with His Eternal subjects, expressed in human flesh, exactly the way He had it; sin is took away; the devil is gone; it's all done now.
