42:6 I the LORD have called thee in righteousness, and will hold thine hand, and will keep thee, and give thee for a covenant of the people, for a light of the Gentiles;

42:7 To open the blind eyes, to bring out the prisoners from the prison, and them that sit in darkness out of the prison house.

<u>St. John 12:20-24</u> 20 And there were certain Greeks among them that came up to worship at the feast:

21 The same came therefore to Philip, which was of Bethsaida of Galilee, and desired him, saying, Sir, we would see Jesus.

22 Philip cometh and telleth Andrew: and again Andrew and Philip tell Jesus.

You don't find Christ there - not at the church, not in a building, not in a creed, not in good works, not in a manger.

Jesus 120 Oh, how different it is! Yes, sir. How different! But your life and His Life find each other, not at the church, not in a building, not in a creed, not in good works, but in the cross where you are crucified with Him. That's where you find Christ.

You don't find Him by doing better, turning a new page. Starting a new life, you don't find Christ. You find Christ only in death; not in a manger, not in a confession. To believe in certain creeds and fables, you don't find Christ there.



Die to yourself, don't maintain your own idea or your way of it.

<u>Jesus</u> 103 Oh, so many try, today, to <u>hold</u> <u>theirself and maintain your own</u>

idea. "I've got my way of it. I

believe this." But you cannot find

<u>Christ until you die to yourself</u>, and <u>accept Him</u>, the Word, then you

find Life. Let's see.

61-1224 - Sirs, We Would See

<u>Jesus</u>

74 Now, here is a great thing, and a text that's unusual. Just as soon as these Greeks was pointed to Jesus, Jesus did not point to Himself.

or He did not make Hisself known to them. Because, you cannot know Jesus in that way. Jesus isn't known in that way.

75 But as soon as, we see here in the Scripture, that when these Greeks brought, was brought up to Jesus, and was in His Presence, it looks like that Jesus would have said,

"Well, this isn't...I—I am the Messiah of the Jewish race, that's been predicted by the prophets, by inspiration, down through the centuries.

And I am here now. And I am the...born of Nazareth. I'm of Jewish mother. My Father is God. And I'm here now to make Myself known to you Greeks." Now that would be more like the 1961 version of it.

76 But, look, as soon as they were brought in His Presence! That's the main thing, get the people in His Presence. And as soon as in His Presence, Jesus said, "Except a corn of wheat falls into the ground and dies, it abides alone."

What an unusual thing! Instead of accepting their introduction, the thing He done was pointed them to a place that they could find Him. "Except a corn of wheat falls into the ground and dies, it abides alone."

77 What did He do here? He pointed them to that great Truth, how to see Him. They could not see <u>Him in the way of Eternal Life, just</u> standing there the way He was. He was a Man.

They try to take you to a cradle but never get you in the Presence of Christ.

61-1224 - Sirs, We Would See

<u>Jesus</u>

106 Disciples today is so much difference, for today. They try to take you to a cradle, or a manger, or to a Santa Claus, or to a bunny rabbit for Easter, or something another, instead of Christ.

<u>They never bring you in the</u> Presence of Christ. Christmas isn't Christ. No. Today, they bring you, some other place, to some statue, some church, some organization, some doctrinal laws, but never get <u>you in the Presence of Christ</u>.

Never one time did Jesus refer them to His birth, but to His death.

135 That's the Message to get to people; not a cradle, not a manger. Christmas is not mentioned in the entire Book of the Bibles. Never one time did Jesus refer them to His birth, but to His death.

He pointed them to a future place, if they wanted to know Him.

<u>61-1224 - Sirs, We Would See</u> <u>Jesus</u> 160 Now, Jesus never said, now, <u>He is going to bring them to</u> <u>Bethlehem</u>. Jesus never said to the

Greeks, when they come up, "Now, just a moment.

If you want to see It, I'll take you back to Bethlehem where I was born. <u>And I'll tell you how it</u> <u>happened back there." It wasn't</u> <u>that.</u>

161 He pointed them to a future place, if they wanted to know Him. "If you want to know Me," in other words, "I won't take you back and tell you when I was born at Bethlehem, and all about that.

I'll point you to a place where I'm going to be crucified for you. And in there, <u>if you'll be crucified with Me</u>, and take up your cross and follow Me, <u>you'll know Who I am</u>.

They can't find any history of Him, because He didn't have any father, He didn't have any mother, He never had any time He began, He never had any time He'd ever die, so ever Who He was is still alive.

He never did have a beginning, so <u>He couldn't have been nobody else</u> <u>but El, Elah, Elohim; self-existence,</u> <u>self-abiding, Almighty God!</u>

50 Jesus had a Father, Jesus had a mother; Jesus had a beginning of days, Jesus had an ending of earthly life. But this Man had neither father nor mother, amen, no father nor mother. Jesus had both Father and mother. This Man had neither father nor mother. Amen.

There is three manifestations of Jesus Christ.

65-0822M - Christ Is Revealed In His Own Word 138 And all the Scripture is Divinely given, Divinely set in order, and the whole thing is the revelation of Jesus Christ. The New and Old Testament, where they foretold of Him coming,

what He would do when He got here, and what He would do in this age to come. <u>So that makes Him</u> <u>the same yesterday, today, and</u> <u>forever</u>. See? Like in Hebrews there, when Paul wrote it. He is God, "Jesus Christ yesterday," of the Old Testament. He is "Jesus Christ today," manifested in the flesh. "And He's Jesus Christ forever," in the Spirit, "to come." See? See? "Same yesterday, today, and forever."

And He ever lives to make His Word live what It said It would do for that age. He is alive.

139 He was alive in the Old Testament, manifested. I just want to let you see a little something here, if you can stand it. Watch, when Jesus was manifested in the Old Testament, as we believe it.

Now, you preachers out there, you can argue with it, do whatever you want to, but I'm talking for my...what I think. See?

140 When Jesus was manifested in the Old Testament, in a theophany, in the person of Melchisedec; not a priesthood, but the Person, the Man. See? For, this Man had yet not been born, but He was in a theophany,

so He had no father, no mother. <u>He</u> was God Himself. He was manifested in the form of a Man, called, "King of Salem, which is King of Peace, and King of Righteousness."

See? He was Melchisedec. "He had neither father nor mother, beginning of days or ending of life." See? It was Jesus in a theophany, in the form of a Man. Could you go that? All right.

141 Then He was made actually human flesh, and dwelled among us, in the Person of Jesus Christ Himself, born of the virgin Mary. He come in that form so He could die, and went back into Heaven.

Now in this last days, He has promised to manifest Himself in the fullness again, of His flesh, in Spirit. See? "For as it was in the days of Sodom, so shall it be in the Coming of the Son of man." Now look at the Sodom, how it set, and what taken place.

65-0221E - Who Is This Melchisedec? 121 Now, notice, now we see Melchisedec and why that Mary wasn't His mother. That's the reason He called her "woman," not mother. "He had no father," for He was the Father, the everlasting Father, the three in the One.

"He had no mother," certainly not. <u>He had no father, for He was the</u> <u>Father.</u> As the poet said one time, speaking a great compliment unto Jesus, he said:

IAM that spoke to Moses in a burning bush of fire, IAM the God of Abraham, the Bright and Morning Star. IAM Alpha, Omega, the beginning from the end. I AM the whole creation, and Jesus is the Name. (That's right.)

Oh, who do you say that I am, and whence do they say that I came, <u>Do you know My Father, or can</u> you tell His Name? (Hallelujah!) 122 <u>That's the Father's Name!</u> Yeah, "I come in My Father's Name, and you receive Me not." See? Sure, <u>He's the same yesterday,</u> today, and forever.

Praise God for these opening Seals, Now the true revelation of Melchisedec comes into view

65-0221E - Who Is This Melchisedec? 94 Now notice. Praise God for these opening Seals, is my prayer, to know these things! 95 Now the true revelation of Melchisedec comes into view. What? He was God, the Word, before He became flesh; God, the Word.

Cause, He had to be; no one else could be immortal like Him. See, I had father and mother; you did, too. Jesus had father and mother. "But this Man had no father, or had no mother."

Jesus had a time He started; this Man didn't. Jesus gave His life; this Man couldn't, because He was Life. And it's the self-same Man all the time. I hope God reveals it to you. <u>The self-same Person</u>, all the time.

Christ was the living Word. He always was the Word. He is still the Word. He always will be the Word. He was only the manifestation of the attributes of God, for He was the Son of God.

63-1229E - Look Away To Jesus 265....Did that catch you right? I wonder if you'll understand. If you'd look for Him, tonight, what would you look for? He would be the same. The Messiah is the Word, the Word!

Where the Word is preached, the Spirit follows it
