1. The Acceptable Year Is The Year Of Our Homecoming-The Year Of Jubilee

52-0716 - Thou Knowest All Things 37 Now is the hour. Now is the time. Now is the accepted hour. This is the acceptable year of the Lord.

Now is when healing is supposed to be. Now is when miracles take place. Now is when Christ is revealing Himself. Here we are now, not in the future. The devil keeps pushing it off; that's Catholicism. Now is the day. This is the hour. This is the time. This is the place, right now. This is the day.

38 When Jesus Christ the same yesterday, today, and forever is revealing Himself, making Himself manifested to the people,

showing signs and wonders, the same thing that happened in the Bible. Search It out, try It out, It's infallible. Oh, my. Here we

are.

63-0319 - The Second Seal 214 In the Old Testament, when a man had been sold to slavery. There come a year of jubilee, every fifty years.

Forty-ninth year, and then the year of jubilee. And when a slave heard this, and he wanted to go free,

there is—there isn't nothing that can keep him from going free. He can throw down his hoe, and say, "so-long," go back home. The trumpet sounded. That's right.

215 But if he don't want to go, and he is satisfied with his slave master, then he is taken into the-the-the temple, and they take an awl...

You know what an awl is. And they press his ear, and put a hole in his ear. And it's a mark, that he can never go back. Is that right?

He has to serve this master for all time. I don't care how many more times the jubilee sounds, whatever happens. He absolutely has—has sold out his birthrights, of being free.

216 And when a man turns down the Gospel Truth, Satan marks him (where?) at his ear. He deafens him so he can't hear the Truth no more, and he's finished.

He stays with the group that he's with, if he won't hear the Truth. No.

217 "You shall know the Truth, and the Truth shall make you free." See, the Truth makes free. 218 God marks His when they come. God marks His by vindicating His promised Word through them. That's exactly, Saint John 14:12.

And another thing, you want to put down, Mark 16. Jesus said, "These signs shall follow them that believe."

<u>62-1122 - Return And Jubilee</u> But, brother...Oh, I could hold on this a long time. But let's not do it. Let me give you one good

news.

<u>This is the year of jubilee. If</u> <u>you've got mixed up in that kind</u> <u>of stuff, let's return. We got an</u> <u>inheritance.</u>

67 The fathers of Pentecost fought to win the prize and sailed through bloody seas. Let's not walk this flower bed of ease by joining some organization, and settling down, and saying, "Bless God, I'm Pentecost."

24

Let's get the experience. Let's go back to God. Let's go back to the eagle food. Let's go back to the leadership of the Holy Spirit.

Let's go back to the Word of God. Let's go back to the fast and pray. Why, the church forgot the street meetings long

ago.

The church forgot its long nights of prayer. Why, they can't pray fifteen minutes no more. Oh, my, when it does, it's some little formal thing and half of them fall asleep.

Why, it's a—it's a disgrace. Chickens trying to eat eagle food, you can't do it. Won't digest. That's right. You're not built for it.

You're not built for the rugged part. Got to be built rugged. And the only way you can ever get that is to be borned again and change your way and come back. Amen. Yes, sir.

68 Yes, sir, it's time to return. "Return to what, Brother Branham? Return back to the organization I come out of?" No, return back to your inheritance, the inheritance that our Father left us.

"How did He...What kind of an inheritance did He leave?" "Wait ye, in the city of Jerusalem until you're endued with power from on high." That's the inheritance.

Not, "Go, join this one, and go join that one, go join this one." Wait till the power comes from on high. "How long?" Until. "One day? Two days?" Wait until.

Don't take some little emotion, some little flusteration; wait there until you are dead and buried and borned again anew in Christ Jesus, and every pulsation of your life beats out Jesus Christ,

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so you can see the life of Christ reflected right in your—your living, the way you go. Yes, sir, till you can find that power like they had back there in the beginning...

69 Back to a Pentecostal inheritance. Yes, sir. That's your possession. Denomination's not your possession.

Pentecost is your possession. Not a Pentecostal organization, your fathers come out of such a thing. The Pentecostal experience is your possession. Examine ourselves. The sounding of the Trumpet. "What kind of a trumpet?" The Word, God's Trumpet, the Holy Ghost in the Word.

54-1003E - Jubilee Year 64 Now in this great Welsh revival that started, that was a jubilee time for the Welsh people. There started, just a bunch of illiterate people, just preaching the Gospel.

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And the power and the glory of God begin to fall, until businessmen would go to work and sit down at their desk,

and weep like babies, and close their meet-...their business. Farmers in the field would be sitting on their plows or plowing. They would stop their teams and get out in the field, rank sinners,

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and raise up their hands to God, and cry out for mercy. People walking on the roads, and everywhere. Whistles started to blowing, and everything else. There was a revival on.

65 That's what America needs tonight. It doesn't need a Billy Graham, nor it don't need a Oral Roberts. What it needs, tonight, is the Holy Spirit moving amongst the people, claiming the year of freedom.

That's right. Doesn't need a new organization. Doesn't need a new setup. The only thing it needs is the Holy Spirit to come

in convicting power.

You could preach the Gospel till you turn gray; you could work signs and wonders till you turn gray; except God gets out amongst the people and goes to moving.

66 Why, when that revival started, a minister went down to a place where there was a culvert that crossed the road. And he got it...stopped his horse, and got over this culvert, and said, "Almighty God, this city is all polluted down here." Said, "Cause every man, woman, boy or girl, that passes over this culvert, to fall under conviction by Your Spirit."

<u>He went and got a good, faithful</u> <u>warrior, stuck him under that</u> <u>place, to pray. Stay in there, day</u> <u>and night, fasting, praying.</u>

67 <u>He went on into the city, and</u> asked permission to ask the blessing at the table, before the dinner was served. Said, "All

right."

<u>68 And he stood and said, "Lord</u> <u>God, cause every man and every</u> <u>woman that sits at this table, to</u> <u>come under conviction</u>."

69 And it was said, and wrote by papers, that, "Men would pass over that culvert, and stop their horses on the road, and start weeping and crying."

"Men and women would come to the table and sit down and get their food, and push it back, and would weep and cry and repent."

70 That's the kind of revival that we need tonight, where God gets out amongst the people.

71 We can start a meeting, work signs and wonders. I notice it here. I go out, and sometimes, in the meeting, blind see, deaf hear, the people come around and look, say, "That's wonderful."

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When the revival is gone, you don't hear of them no more. They're right back out, "Well, yes, I believe in that."

72 What it needs, tonight, is not a new preacher. What it needs is the Holy Spirit, get out amongst the people, go to stirring them up, hungering and thirsting for righteousness' sake.

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"Blessed are they when they hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be filled." Wherever it is, it takes the Holy Spirit to do it.

73 Now, in these days when these priests...They'd take the man out there, and maybe hoeing in the cornfield;

<u>the master walking down,</u> <u>whipping him with the whip,</u> <u>"Hurry up there! Got to hurry up</u> <u>with this!"</u>

59 74 But just as soon as that trumpet sounded, that man could throw that hoe down, say, "I won't hoe with it no more." And that taskmaster, that slave driver, was forbidden to touch him any more, 'cause he was free.

Why? He had heard the good news. The jubilee was on. The atonement was made, and all the slaves could go free.

75 I remember, myself, oh, my, when I heard that good news come to my heart. As a little old sinner boy laying here on the hospital bed, the doctor said,

"You got three more minutes to live." I heard a sound from Heaven, that told me jubilee

year was on.

76 Laccepted the Lord Jesus, turned loose all the shackles of sin, and said to the devil, "You can't do me any more harm,

because I have give my life to Christ Jesus, and you can't whip me anymore." Since then, he's bluffed me, lots of times. But <u>he's not been able to touch me</u> since, because he's just a bluff.

I can hear his whip cracking and popping, and so forth, but it don't do no good. Because, he <u>can't get me, because I belong</u> to the Lord now. That's right.

65-0219 - This Day This **Scripture Is Fulfilled** 38 And I was on my road home, back down to Tucson, that evening. The kids was crying for a sandwich, and I stopped to get a sandwich at a little stand.

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And my wife said, "Bill, I never was so nervous in all my life, to see you standing up there fumbling through that Bible." Said, "Didn't it make you nervous?"

39 I said, "Nope." I said, "I knowed it was in there somewhere. They just didn't have the page in. It's a misprint."

40 And she said, "To think, that I got you that Bible! Looked like every eye in there was right upon me."

41 And I said, "Well, you couldn't help that. That was a misprint in the Bible." I said, "They just never put the page in."

42 Well, I got down and looked at it again, just perfect as it could be; but the 16th chapter ends, portion, the portion of it just about three inches from the bottom, over at the 17th chapter on the other side, does the same thing.

And, being a new Bible, those two pages had perfectly stuck together, and I was reading from the 17th chapter instead of the 16th. "Well," I said, "that's all fine. It's for some cause."

43 And just as plain as you could hear any voice, a Voice come to me, and said, "He entered into Nazareth, to where He was brought up at; and went into the synagogue, as it was His custom.

73

And the priest gave Him the Scriptures to read, and He read Isaiah 61. And when He had read the Scriptures, He set down; handed the priest back the Bible, the Book, and sat down.

And all the eyes of the congregation was upon Him. And precious Words proceeded from His mouth. And He said, 'This day this Scripture is fulfilled." "This day this Scripture is fulfilled."

44 How accurate is the Scripture! If you'll notice this in Isaiah 61:1 to 2, is where our Lord was reading from, Isaiah 61:1 to 2.

But in the middle of the 2nd verse of Isaiah 61, He stopped. Where it said, "The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me; to preach the acceptable year," then He stopped.

Why? The other part, to bring judgment, didn't apply to His first coming, but His second Coming. See, it didn't apply there. How the Scriptures never make a mistake!

They are always perfect. Jesus stopped just where the Scripture stopped, 'cause that was exactly what was to be vindicated in His day, now, in that first coming.

The second Coming He will bring judgment upon the earth; but not then. He was "to preach the acceptable year."

45 Notice the Messiah standing in the platform, to identify Himself with the Word of promise for that age.

How strange, the Messiah standing up before the church! And look at these precious Words, when He says here, "To preach the acceptable year."

46 "The acceptable year," as we all know, as Bible readers, was "the year of jubilee." That, when all slaves and prisoners, as they were, been taken, prison; and had to give a son, to pay a debt;

or a daughter, to pay a debt, [Blank spot on tape—Ed.] and they were in bondage. No matter how long they had been in bondage, or how long they was supposed to stay there;

when the year come, of the jubilee, when the trumpet sounded, every man could go free if he wanted to go free. [Blank spot on tape.] You're free. You was no more slave.

47 But if you desired to remain a slave, then you had to be taken down to the temple, stood by the temple post, and they took an awl and bored a hole in your ear, and then you had to serve that slave master the rest of your days.

48 What a perfect example it is of the Gospel of Jesus Christ! When It's preached, the acceptable time, and the time of Jubilee; anybody, no matter who you are, what color you are,

what denomination you belong to, how it's far you've stooped in sin, or what's wrong with you; you can go free when you hear the Gospel trumpet sound out. You are free!

49 But if you turn your back upon the Message and refuse to hear It, notice, you were bored in the ear, with an awl. That means, to say, that you have crossed the line between grace and judgment,

and you will never hear the Gospel again. You'll never get any further. You must be a slave to the system you're in, the rest of your days, if you refuse to hear the acceptable year.

50 Now, the other part of it, as I said, didn't need to be answered, because this coming Messiah, a time now, is when He will bring judgment.

51 Now, how could those people ever fail to see Who He was? How did they ever miss it? How could it be, when it was so plainly made known and showed? How could they have ever missed seeing? When He...

92

52 What a Word! Think of it, "This day is this Scripture fulfilled before your eyes." Who said it? God Himself, Who is the interpreter of His Own Word. "This day is this Scripture fulfilled."

93

The Messiah, Himself, standing⁹⁴ in the presence of the congregation and reading a Word out of the Bible, pertaining to Himself, and then saying, "Today this Scripture is fulfilled," and they still failed to see lt.

53 What a tragedy that that would be, but it's happened. It's happened many times. How could it happen? Of course, like it did in other times, by believing man's interpretation of the Word.

95

That's what caused it. Those believers in them days, so-called believers, was taking the interpretation of what the priest had said about the Scripture.

Therefore Jesus, not belonging to any of their ranks or their societies, He was excommunicated from their company.

54 And, therefore, they could not identify Him with them, because He was different from them. The Person of Jesus Christ was so unique that no one should have missed seeing that that was the Son of God, because He was the perfect identification of the Scripture that was wrote of Him.

55 That's the way any Christian is known, when his life identifies the very things that's the Christian is supposed to do.

2. Christ (Anointed) To Preach/Declare The Year; The Bride (Messiahettes) Anointed To Accept The Jubilee

<u>56-0101 - Why Are People So</u> Tossed About?

252 Some people gets the wro ng impression of what the anoi nting is. Did you ever think of t hat?

When was the greatest anointing ever give to anyone, and what did they do when they had the anointing?

104 253 The greatest anointing that was ever give to anyone, was Jesus Christ. We have the Spirit by measure. He had It without measure. And one day He entered into the temple and picked up the scroll and read,

said, "The Spirit of God is upon <u>Me, for He has anointed Me to</u> preach the acceptable year, to bind up the broken hearts, to heal the sick, give sight to the blind."

254 And now we would think, if such anointing was on Him, had been prophesied eight hundred years before, that it would

<u>come,</u>

and here He was with that type of anointing, the full blessing and anointing of the Lord upon Him, we would want to run all over the building, scream and holler.

255 But the Bible said, "He laid down the scroll, and sat down, and precious Words proceeded from His mouth."

That's what He done under the anointing. The anointing is not emotion. The anointing is supreme power in control, knowing exactly what and how. See?

256 And that's what's here. Now, you might not be able to understand it, as you walk here. You might not be able to get it. But I challenge your faith to this: you come and believe what I have told you, and watch what happen.

See? You just—just believe what's been told, and see what happen. The anointing of the Lord is in the temple, the tabernacle, this morning. Amen. 61-0117 - The Messiah 29 You see what Messiah is? Messiah is the Kingdom of God, anointed ones, them anointed with the same Spirit He was anointed with.

<u>One said to him one day, "Will</u> <u>my sons set at the right and left</u> <u>hand?"</u>

He said, "Can you drink the cup that I drink? Can you be baptized with the baptism that I'm baptized with?" She said, "Yea."

And He said, "You will. But the Kingdom, to sit right and left hand is not Mine to give."

So it showed that we could drink the same cup of persecution, be called Beelzebub or whatever it might

be,

and still be baptized with the same Spirit He's baptized with. So if He was called Messiah, which He was, because He was anointed with that Holy Spirit...

And any church that's anointed with the same Holy Spirit is a Messiahette, a littler, smaller, god. And someday when this body is resurrected,

I hope beforehand that God can get a hold of a bunch of people that'll manifest His power in every dimension that it's supposed to be in. Messiah, anointed One, a King to deliver, a King...

You're kings and priests, kings to bring in, priests to minister to, a Messiah. His signs was to follow in all ages, reflecting His Light, His Presence with His Kingdom people.

<u>30 Now, don't-you don't have</u> to die to get this. You have to spiritually die, but you don't have to physically die. The inside is where God gets in to control <u>you.</u>

<u>And He—as He presses Hisself</u> forward in you, don't let any root of bitterness, hatred, malice, strife...That'll-that'll run Him right back again.

Just get all the meanness, and the superstitions, and all the-the unbelief out of you. And every time you move out a little unbelief, God steps right in and takes over. Move out unbelief...

123

31 He told Joshua, "Everywhere the soles of your foot has set, that I give to you." And tonight, as we enter into the Kingdom, God's Kingdom, taking out all the Philistine unbelievers,

and all the Amorites, and the Amalekites, and whatevermore, throw it out of us like that, we take possession. Amen. I like that. Say, "Days of miracles is past."

- <u>"You Amorites, get out of me.</u> <u>I've put a footprint there; I've</u> took over."
- "There's no such a thing as—as
- seeing visions."
- "Get out of there, you
- Amalekite. I'm coming over."

There you are. You're pressing out. From that little button is taking over the fibers of you, spreading out, God working through you, in you, around you.

32 No wonder Elijah laid his body upon that dead baby and it come to life. It was God in that man. God had took over. He was anointed.

Jesus said he was. Every prophet of God in the Old Testament was anointed with the Holy <u>Chost. They were. Then they</u> were lesser Lights.

He was the Fullness of God, being Messiah. They was Messiahettes then, smaller Messiahs, for they were anointed with the same Spirit that He was anointed with, only <u>He had It in the Fullness.</u>

130

And every man today that's received the true baptism of the Holy Ghost is anointed with the same Spirit that Jesus of Nazareth was, that went about doing good and healing the sick.

<u>Oh, my. That makes me feel</u> good to know that He lives today. There's something about a man. He is a god. He was made to be a god.

His purpose here on earth was to be a god, to have a dominion over everything in the earth. Oh, my. Now, don't let that stagger you, 'cause I got some more <u>Scriptures wrote down here.</u> See?

3. The Trumpet Calls The Bride Back To Her Inheritance-Her Position

63-0421 - Victory Day 289 Heavenly Father, we are grateful. And I, Lord, am so in debt to You. There's no way that I could ever pay the debt of my sin. I was in a cell one day, 'cause I was born in that cell.

I knowed what—what freedom meant. And the price was so great, I couldn't pay it. But I am so glad that, the day that You visit my cell, I recognized it, that it was the only One that could pardon.

The only way I could ever be free, and have victory, a complete victory, was to accept the pardon that You had signed for me. And today I am free.

290 l'm so happy, Lord. I visit from prison house to prison house, from those that are got marriage scruples, those who are sick and fevered,

those who are sick and in prison, those who are sinful and in prison, those who flusterations, and doubt, and in prison.

I'm going from cell to cell, telling them, the Governor is coming right along, pardoning every one, taking every one out.

291 Father, You know the heart of the people here today. May this be a V-day, a complete V-day. May this be a day that when every one, Lord, today, will receive the victory. Grant it, Lord.

<u>62-1122 - Return And Jubilee</u> 26 Now, in a type, or a figure, we take Israel because it's the jubilee time and the Church was given a portion,

which was Christ Himself that was poured out by the Holy Spirit into each heart that would receive It and become sons of

God.

Now, Israel was a servant to God, and he...they was given a possession, and this possession was not to be given to anyone else, it was to be to Israel only, Palestine belonged to them.

27 And if we had the time, or, time would permit us, rather, to go back and take the birth of those patriarchs

(When they were born by those women, and, each one when the baby was being borned, and the mother in labor uttered the voice of this patriarch,

positionally placed him, in his place, in Palestine hundreds of years later.) how we can put our confidence in this written Word of God because It's so inspired,

that every phase of It hangs together, and It's drawing a picture for us of what God was, and what God is, and always will be!

28 Now, we find that when Joshua divided the inheritance to the people, each person was placed positionally, exactly the way these Hebrew mothers named those children,

how they were placed in Palestine just at their place: Asher, Gad, and—and Naphtali, and each one, Judah; every one just placed in their position.

29 What a—a wonderful picture it gets us, because it's a type of God placing in the Church, Himself, every member, every stone, every place, every Christian, to itself.

Each one of us in our peculiar way has a place in the House of God, like Solomon's temple when it was cut out all over the world,

but when it was brought in by...to Joppa by, floated in, and took from there by ox-cart, and all these odd rocks had their place when the temple went together.

30 And I think that God, down through this time has cut out some very odd stones that we might not have understood, but they have their place exactly in the temple, in the building of God.

And Joshua, by inspiration, not by just mathematics, he-he by...inspired by God he lotted each one of those patriarchs in their position, just exactly the way their name belongs.

31 What a—a picture it puts before us of God in His masterwork! No one could have ever done it but God, there's no way of doing it, God alone.

It was to be for...was to be their—theirs forever, it was a gift from God.

God, by His marvelous grace, give these people this land in this position and placed them in it according to His Word and the birth of the people, just perfect, how it clucked right together, and I think it was a type.

32 And now, no one else could take that place, that had to be for Israel alone, just them alone was the only ones that could take this place, and still it, the blessings, on the place.

And if somehow-or-other, during these time, if they lost their inheritance by some means, it might been poverty, it might been some other way that theythey lost their inheritance where their fathers...One would leave it to his son, he would leave it to his son, it belonged to that tribe, it belonged to that people forever, it was an inheritance.

60-0522E - Adoption #4 72 Oh, "an inheritance." Somebody has to leave you something, to inherit it. Is that right? An inheritance! What inheritance do we have? What inheritance did I have?

I didn't have any. But God left me an inheritance when He put my name on the Lamb's Book of Life before the foundation of the world.

73 Oh, you say, "Now, wait a minute, brother, Jesus did that when He died for you." No, He never. Jesus come to purchase that inheritance for me. Read the very next ver-...very next line.

In whom we also have obtained apparent...obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own good will:

74 God, before the foundation of the world, as we've took it down through the lesson, you people,

how we seen God was self-existent, how that in Him was love. In Him was to be God; there was nothing to worship Him.

In Him was to be a Father; there was...He was by Himself. In Him was to be a Saviour; nothing lost. In Him was to be a Healer. That's the attributes of Him. There was nothing there.

So His Own Self, His Own good¹⁶⁹ counsel produced these things, that He might through this one Man, Christ Jesus, gather it all together again. Oh! "Eye has not seen, ear has not..." No wonder it's a mysterious thing!

75 Look, "has predestinated us unto this inheritance." If I'm a right inheritance of something, if God is knocking at my heart and saying,

"William Branham, I called you a long time ago, before the foundation of the world, to preach the Gospel," I have an inheritance, an inheritance of Eternal Life. Now, God sent Jesus to make that inheritance real to me, because there was nothing I could do to—to inherit it.

It was blank, it was valid, there's nothing I could do. But in the fulness of time God sent, in His Own good time, Jesus the Lamb, slain from the foundation of the world.

His Blood was shed that I might go to my inheritance. To be what? What inheritance? The sonship, to be a son of God.

54-1003E - Jubilee Year 83 The mark of God is the baptism of the Holy Spirit, without a shadow of doubt. I preached that not long ago, right here.

By the Holy Spirit's help, and the Word of God, proved it, that the seal of God is the baptism of the Holy Ghost. Ephesians 4:30

<u>says,</u>

"Grieve not the Holy Spirit of <u>God, whereby you're sealed until</u> the day of your redemption." Without the Holy Spirit, you are not sealed. But the Holy Spirit is God's Seal.

84 And then, that, all that was not sealed by the Holy Spirit, was took on the mark of the beast. And the mark of the beast is a mark of apostasy, which is, rejecting the Holy Spirit. See what I mean?

178

<u>85 Then when the year of</u> jubilee, or the blast comes, that people are receiving the Holy Spirit; and you deliberately, wilfully turn It down,

180 God has no more, or, not under any more obligation to ever speak to you no more. Then you'll be marked off, all the old types of the Old Testament, only types and shadows of the New.

And to reject Christ, and to turn Him down, that He's knocked at your door, you're on a danger line of being bored to the ear. "Faith cometh by hearing, hearing of the Word of God."

And God will put a blind over your ears, that you'll never be able to understand no more. And you'll do no more than criticize the Gospel as long as <u>you live;</u>

and die, and be lost forever. What a time, while it's jubilee time, while the doors are open! Did you realize that this same baptism of the Holy Spirit...

4. The Trumpet Of Jubilee Is Calling Us Back To Our Father (Like The Prodigal Son, Like Samson-Once More Lord)

<u>65-1126 - Works Is Faith</u>

- **Expressed**
- 24 I had a dream, the other morning. I don't dream very
- often, l'm not a dreamer. But I–I
- dreamed that I seen a man, a young fellow in shackels,

and he was trying to get out, and—and I said...Somebody told me, said, "Those are horrible people, don't have nothing to do with them."

25 And I seen this young fellow getting out of his shackel so I just let him alone. I thought, "I'll just see what he does." So when he got out, he was a nice fellow. And I seen others trying to get out.

26 Now, this is only a dream. And I walked over this way and I seen a-a brother, Roy Borders, a very good friend of mine, lives in California.

Looked like there's something wrong, his eyes was half closed, and great big...maybe cancer or something over his eyes.

And I...someone was trying to pull me away from him. I screamed, "Brother Borders! In the Name of the Lord Jesus, snap out of that!"

27 And he just barely could speak, saying, "Brother Branham, it'll have to take something more than this. I just can't grasp it, Brother Branham. I just can't grasp it."

28 I said, "O Brother Borders." I love him.

29 And someone pulled me away, and I looked, and it was a lady standing over here that I, when I was a little boy, I-I used to haul groceries from the grocery store to the peoples.

And her name was Mrs. Fenton, she lives in Jeffersonville yet, a personal friend to the wife and I.

195 30 And she said, "Brother Branham, deliver us from this." Said, "This is a house of hell." And said, "You've been misunderstood." And said, "These...And you—you misunderstood these people, too."

Said, "These are fine people, but..." And I looked over there, and like a great big cellar, or-or big walls, down beneath a great big cave;

He had to be a servant as long as he lived. He must continue to serve this slave driver, as long as he lived, if he wilfully rejected his calling and opportunity to be free.

43 And we realize that, in the Scriptures, over in Malachi 4, there is to be a one like John, an—an Elijah to whom the Word of God can come to. And he is to reveal, by the Holy Spirit, all the mysteries of God,

and restore the Faith of the children back to the faith of the apostolic fathers, restore back all these mysteries that's been probed at, through these denominational years.

Now, that's what the Word said. I'm just responsible for what It said. See? It's—It's written, is right. That's what It is.

44 Now, we see that this Seven-Seal Book, now, is the mystery of redemption. It's a Book of Redemption, from God.

45 Now, all the mysteries, at this time, should be finished at the sounding of this messenger. Now, here is the angel on earth; and "another" Angel, mighty Messenger, come down.

See, this angel was an earthly angel, messenger; but here comes One down from Heaven, a rainbow covenant, see, only Christ it could be.

46 Just exactly like was in Revelation, 1st chapter, "Standing in the midst of the Seven Golden Candlesticks, with a rainbow, to look upon as jasper and sardius stone."

47 And here He returns back, in the 10th chapter, after the coming time that all the mysteries is to be finished and the Seals are to be broke, and proclaiming that it's, "Time is no more."

And He said, "When the seventh angel has begin to sound, then the mystery should be finished, and time for the Angel to appear." We're close, somewhere. Right. Now notice.

48 The Seven Seals holds the mystery of the Book. Until we can see what those Seven Seals has sealed in, we're only presuming them things.

Because, as I've told you, this morning, upon my little Message this morning, of God hiding in simplicity. You see, we-we are...We are sure to miss the thing unless It is absolutely,

genuinely revealed by the Holy Spirit, and vindicated the same. See? If the prophet rises and tells you that This is just That, and God don't vindicate the same, forget it.

See? But God, in every statement, in everything, has to vindicate It, to make It right. See? So, His children will watch those things, see, and be alert, notice.

244 There was three stages of it, as I said. The martyrs, age of the martyr, for it; and then the stage of the reformers; and now the calling-out time.

245 When finished, at Laodicean Age, according to Revelation 10, the mystery of all the Bible would be knowed to the Bride.

Is that right? Revelation 10. Listen close now. Uh-huh. Bride, called out by the Word; Christ Himself calling out the Bride, making plain Hebrews 13:8,

that He's "the same yesterday, today, and forever," does the same, is the same. "He that believeth on Me, the works that I do shall he do also." See? Luke 22...

Or, Luke 17:30, and also Malachi 4, Hebrews 4:12, all these Scriptures that's promised, this is to be between the Sixth and the Seventh Seal, and the Sixth and the Seventh Trumpet.

65-1126 - Works Is Faith Expressed 24 I had a dream, the other morning. I don't dream very often, l'm not a dreamer. But I-I dreamed that I seen a man, a young fellow in shackels,

and he was trying to get out, and—and I said...Somebody told me, said, "Those are horrible people, don't have nothing to do with them."

25 And I seen this young fellow getting out of his shackel so I just let him alone. I thought, "I'll just see what he does." So when he got out, he was a nice fellow. And I seen others trying to get out.

27 Now, you speak about unworthiness? "Not even worthy to look at It; no man, nowhere."

And one of the elders said unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.

And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts,...in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.

And he came and took the book out of the right hand of him that sat upon the throne.

28 We will pause there for a few moments, from the reading of Revelation 5, down to the including the 7th verse.

29 This Seven-Seal Book is revealed at the time of the Seven Thunders of Revelation 10, now, if you're marking it down.

Let's turn to Revelation 10, just a moment, so you'll get an understanding before we get into it. Now, this is at the end time. For, listen:

...I saw another mighty angel come down from heaven, clothed with a cloud: and a rainbow...upon his head,...

30 If you notice, that's Christ, see. Cause, He, in the Old Testament, was called the Angel of the Covenant.

And He is directly coming to the Jews now, for the Church is finished. See? All right. ...and his face...as it were the sun, and his feet as pillars of fire:

31 You remember that Angel in Revelation 1? Same thing. Angel is a "messenger." And He's the Messenger to Israel. See?

The Church has been raptured, see, now, or fixing to be raptured. He comes for His Church. Now watch. And he had in his hand a little book open:...

32 Now, here, It was closed here and sealed; and here It's open. It's been opened. Since that time of the sealing, we're getting into tonight, now the Book is open.

"A little Book in His hand, in His...It was open. Oh, how the sun, as pillars..." Wait just a minute. Let me start back here and read.....

4b. Gabriel's Instructions Daniel 9:24

<u>61-0730M - Gabriel's</u> Instructions To Daniel 141 Watch, "seventy of weeks." Yeah, there are near two thousand years they been away;

they've been drove now, their people; like it was in hardening Pharaoh's heart, He had to harden Hitler's heart.

Millions of them died. Look at this Eichmann, guilty of killing six million Jews. Six million of them, human souls, babies, children, adults, all put to death;

Eichmann, one man. Look at Russia, how you drove them out of there. They drove them everywhere. They been a despised nation.

142 But because of the love of their money, they came back again. But that little minority is returning into Palestine. Amen, brothers! When you see her begin to come to her homeland!

143 They got enough in there now to make that about a hundred and forty-four thousand. And what's happening?

They'll know their Joseph. Don't you worry. Yes, sir. And they're all standing there waiting for it to happen. And the very hour that...

144 The nations has declared them a nation, this last year. When that hits, we're near the end, the Gentile Church is

gone.

So, most any time, God could say, "Israel is My people." When that is, the Gentiles are finished.

145 "They will trod down," said Jesus, in Matthew 24. "The abomination maketh desolation, they'll trod down the walls of Jerusalem until the Gentile dispensation be finished."

- When that's finished, then the Jews will return back into
- Jerusalem, to re-establish the
- temple and temple worship. We'll
- get it all in these next Messages,
- the seventy of weeks of the sixfold
- purpose.

Now I'll read that before closing, 'cause it'd be just about time then for us to get home, then come back tonight at seven o'clock.

146 First, first, if you're putting it down, "To finish the transgression." Daniel, the 9th chapter, 24th verse.

"To finish the transgression," one. "To make an end of sin," two. "To make reconciliation for iniquity," three. "To bring in everlasting righteousness," four.

"To seal up the vision and prophecy," five. "To anoint the most Holy," six. And that's what we'll speak on tonight. God, bringing to pass!

147 Now wait, let me go over it again, so you get it. First, "finish the transgression."

Second, "make an end of sin." Third, "make reconciliations for iniquity." Fourth, "bring in everlasting righteousness."

Fifth, "seal up the vision and prophecy." Sixth, "to anoint the most Holy."

Here come Luther out, in Reformation, his words, that, his church, won't work today. Wesley's won't. Pentecostal's won't. It worked in their day.

260 But it's another day. This is the opening of the Seven Seals. I know It sounds strange to you, but God has vindicate it so perfectly.

There's no-no question in It. Just perfectly! I ain't scattering that to the local assembly here. I'm speaking to the people out across the nation. See? Do what you wish to.

261 Now notice the anointed Word of his day, of which you are a part, by predestination. You immediately, like, knew.

When you heard That, you knew right quick that you was an eagle. You also realized that you wasn't a denominational chicken, to begin with.

You knowed there is something wrong there. There is something wrong, that's right, for you know that you were trapped into it, at the beginning.

262 He, the Bridegroom, took away your shame, "And put it in the Sea of Forgetfulness, by the washing of the Water of the Word and the Blood of Life."

That's what the Bible said. Your first husband that you were married to, the world...

The anointed Bridegroom, which foreordained you, has washed you by the washing of the Water. By "the church"? [Congregation says, "No."—Ed.]

That don't sound right, does it? ["No."] You might find that in the almanac, but not in God's Bible. "By the washing of the Water by the Word." In the Word! See? By the...

263 You are standing completely justified, as though you never did it at the beginning. This is my Message to the Church now. As you...as we go off the air, just in a minute.

You are standing, if you're standing on God's Word and with God's Word, every amen, every jot, every tittle. Where you standing? I'm trying to tell you, pull away from them shucks.

And get out here in the wheat, where you can get ripe before the Son. I hear the coming of the combine. You're standing complete, justified, like you never did it in the first place. Hallelujah!

264 Talk about a thanksgiving! I feel real good. I'm more thankful for that than anything I know of.

265 You are the pure, virtuous, sinless Bride of the Son of the living God. Every man and woman that's born of the Spirit of God, and washed in the Blood of Jesus Christ,

and believes every Word of God, stands as though you never sinned at the first place. You are perfect. The Blood of Jesus Christ! How can you...If a man...

266 If I was supposed to die in the morning, a man took my place, I cannot die for that sin. Somebody took my place.

267 And Jesus, the Word, took my place. He become me, that a sinner, that I might become Him, the Word. Amen. Let me hold true to It, not the church. The Word! Amen.

268 Oh, that spiritual union of Christ and His Church now, when the flesh is becoming Word, and the Word is becoming flesh, manifested, vindicated.

Just what the Bible said would happen in this day, it's happening, day by day. Why, it's cumulating so fast out there, in those deserts, and things taking place, that I couldn't even keep up with it.

We're near the Coming of Jesus, to be united with His Church, where the Word becomes the Word. Call of the Holy Spirit, searching the hearts!

269 You're standing, completely. You never sinned at the first place. God don't even know. It's in the Sea of Forgetfulness.

You never did it. You were accused of it, by the accuser. But really, from the beginning, you were predestinated to be a son and daughter of God.

You're standing there, washed. And your old book of divorcement is put away, and it's dead, absolutely out of existence, even in the mind of God.

270 You're the virtuous Bride of Christ, washed in the Blood of Christ.

Precious, virtuous, sinless Son of God standing with a pure, unadulterated Bride-Word that He washed by the Water of His Own Blood; that become flesh and manifested,

that He might take you which were predestinated in the bosom of the Father, before the beginning, the same as He was. He was that great attribute of God, called "love."

<u>65-1125 - The Invisible Union Of</u> <u>The Bride Of Christ</u> 272 Your first wedding was annulled. It was.

You never done it, in the first place. Because, there's only one thing could do it, that would be God come down, Himself,

81 I've got some Scriptures and comments and so forth wrote down here. Now, in Ephesians 1:13-14, we...if you wanted to write it down, that,

"We have now the earnest. The Holy Spirit is the earnest of our inheritance." In other words, It is the assurance, the earnest is the "assurance," the "down payment," that we have been received into Christ.

It is the blessed hope and insurance that we do have Eternal Life and are heirs of everything that He purchased for us. Oh, my! Can you see it?

82 Oh, when we have been sealed by the Holy Spirit (I keep quoting it because I don't want you to miss it), it is God's seal of approval that everything that Christ died for belongs to us.

It's God saying, "I have received you now, and I'll give you this Seal that you're just waiting for that time," to our full redemption, and that is that we have been partially already redeemed.

63-0317E - The Breach **Between The Seven Church** Ages And The Seven Seals 137 That's the One met the requirement.

Grace produced the Person of Jesus Christ. And we find, this Book now...God stretched His tent, come from God, to become a Man.

He changed His strain, from the Almighty, to be a Man; to take on the form of man, so He could die, to redeem man. Wait till we see Him, when there's "nobody worthy." See? All right.

138 In the Bible, in the Book of Ruth, as you read it, you'll find out, such a person was called the "goel," g-o-e-l. Was called the goel, or, it was a person that could meet the requirements.

And the goel must be able to do it, must be willing to do it, and must be a kinsman, next to kinsman, to do it. 139 And God, the Creator, of 509 Spirit, became kinfolks to us when He become man, in order that He could take our sin upon Him, and pay the price, and redeem us back to God again. There it is. There is the Redeemer.

140 Christ has redeemed us now. We are now redeemed. But He has not claimed His possession yet. Now, you might differ with that, but just hold on a minute, see.

We'll see. See? He hasn't claimed it. See? If He took the Book of Redemption, everything that Adam had and everything that he lost, Christ redeems back.

And He has already redeemed us. But He hasn't took the possession yet; He cannot until the time appointed. And then will come the resurrection,

and then the earth will be renewed again. And then He'll take possession, His possession which He got when He redeemed us, but will do it at the appointed time. Oh, my!
