1. This Is The Hour For The Fullness Of The Godhead Bodily In The Church Again- (The Anointed People)

65-1125 - The Invisible Union Of The Bride Of Christ 263 You are standing completely justified, as though you never did it at the beginning. This is my Message to the Church now.

As you...as we go off the air, just in a minute. You are standing, if you're standing on God's Word and with God's Word, every amen, every jot, every tittle.

Where you standing? I'm trying to tell you, pull away from them shucks. And get out here in the wheat, where you can get ripe before the Son.

I hear the coming of the combine. You're standing complete, justified, like you never did it in the first place. Hallelujah!

264 Talk about a thanksgiving! I feel real good. I'm more thankful for that than anything I know of.

265 You are the pure, virtuous, sinless Bride of the Son of the living God. Every man and woman that's born of the Spirit of God,

and washed in the Blood of Jesus Christ, and believes every Word of God, stands as though you never sinned at the first place. You are perfect. The Blood of Jesus Christ! How can you...lf a man...

266 If I was supposed to die in the morning, a man took my place, I cannot die for that sin. Somebody took my place.

267 And Jesus, the Word, took my place. He become me, that a sinner, that I might become Him, the Word. Amen. Let me hold true to It, not the church. The Word! Amen.

268 Oh, that spiritual union of Christ and His Church now, when the flesh is becoming Word, and the Word is becoming flesh, manifested, vindicated.

Just what the Bible said would happen in this day, it's happening, day by day. Why, it's cumulating so fast out there, in those deserts, and things taking place, that I couldn't even keep up with it.

We're near the Coming of Jesus, to be united with His Church, where the Word becomes the Word. Call of the Holy Spirit, searching the hearts!

269 You're standing, completely. You never sinned at the first place. God don't even know nothing.

It's in the Sea of Forgetfulness. You never did it. You were accused of it, by the accuser. But really, from the beginning, you were predestinated to be a son and daughter of God.

You're standing there, washed. And your old book of divorcement is put away, and it's dead, absolutely out of existence, even in the mind of God.

270 You're the virtuous Bride of Christ, washed in the Blood of Christ. Precious, virtuous, sinless Son of God standing with a pure, unadulterated Bride-Word that He washed by the Water of His Own Blood;

that become flesh and manifested, that He might take you which were predestinated in the bosom of the Father, before the beginning, the same as He was. He was that great attribute of God, called "love."

63-0728 - Christ Is The Mystery Of God Revealed

380 And in there, there would be a time come forth when He could express Himself in fullness of His Godhead, Deity, through His Church, have the preeminences in this Church.

Oh, my! What? The anointed Man; now the anointed people; oh, my, to bring back the anointed Bride and the Bridegroom. Anointed by (why?) accepting what Eve turned down,

and Adam; coming back with the anointing of the Word, because He said, "My Word is Spirit." See, anointed with the Word. What Eve turned down, He comes back and we accept. 371 Know! The fullness of Godhead is made known. This secret of mystery is now revealed, that God is manifested. God and man become One, the anointed Man, Christ!

What does Christ mean? "The anointed One," the Anointed that was anointed with the fullness of the Godhead bodily. Oh, my! How can people doubt it?

372 Where once, partly, Moses had Him; partly, David had Him; oh, my, but here He is manifested in the fullness, Deity Himself standing on earth.

God, in His fullness, to die for the sin of the people, that He might bring to His Church a sanctified Life; that He might have the preeminence, in fullness, in His Church, to manifest every promise in these last days, that He promised for the last days. See? What was...

373 Listen now. Are you? Now just pinch yourself a little now. Watch.

374 What was Jesus manifested for? To show God. He was God. He had to be; no man could die, no prophet could die. He was God. He was the God of the prophets. He was the prophets. He was the kings.

He was the history. He was He that was to come. He that was, He that is, and He that's to be in this day; the same yesterday, today, and forever. He was manifested for that purpose.

375 And through that purpose He achieved a Church, that He, the fullness of God, might bring to pass every promised Word of God in these last days;

when He gets the preeminences, preeminence in the Church, the position, His place in the Church.

Jesus said, "He that believeth on Me, the works that I do shall he also; even more than this shall he do, for I go to My Father."

See, that was His purpose. There was the manifestation. And now, today, He wants to get somebody that can so see it, that they can let the Word...

55-0113 - The Fundamental Foundation For Faith 37 When He was here on earth, we...l say this maybe out of repetition. I don't mean it to be that way, but I've said it before.

But let's look at His life just a few moments and see what type of Person He was. Then you can have an idea on what He should be today.

Now, when He was here on earth, He was a perfect example of everything of the Godhead. He was the fullness of the Godhead bodily. In Christ was God. The body of Jesus was only the tabernacle of God.

It's where Almighty God Himself lived and dwelt in a human being. You believe that, don't you? You have to to be saved. You have to believe that.

38 He was Deity Himself made flesh here on earth to manifest His love to the people and to take away sin of the earth.

He came here in order that He could anchor death in His own body, He could anchor sickness in His own body.

The curse that ought to have been on you, He took it upon Himself, and had to die as a man in order to redeem you back to this full fellowship with the Father again. What a marvelous thing.

Our—our hearts can't conceive what a thing that was, what He did. But we're too slow.

Our minds are sluggish. The—the valves have been stopped up. They've been paralyzed by unbelief, and fear, and doubt.

And it can't flow free like it should do it, unless we let the Holy Spirit so dominate our lives till It pushes those valves till life begins to start to operating. See? Then we can see then. Sure, it's the Father.

39 Then unconsciously your faith is there. You don't have to worry about whether you got faith enough to do this, or faith enough to do that. It's just there anyhow.

You just do it because the Father said so. And it's the living Word in you, and God's in you, manifesting Hisself just like He was in Christ. You say, "As He was in Christ?" Yes, sir.

He said, "The works that I do shall you also; even more than this for I go to My Father." Now, that's His Word, Saint John 14:12. He gave that promise. Everyone will believe that was inspired. And...

"So a little while and the world will see Me no more, yet you shall see Me, for I will be with you until the end of the age of the apostles?"

No. "I will be with you, even in you to the end of the world." Hebrews 13:8 said, "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever."

2. Christ Was The Fullness Of The Godhead Bodily —But His Humanity Blinded The People

64-0629 - The Mighty God Unveiled Before Us 64 We see, in Saint John 12:20, the Greeks had heard of Him. Now, there's no man can ever hear of Him except their heart burns to see Him.

Like Job and the prophets of old, they all wanted to see Him. So, this Greek came to see Him. They came to Philip, which was of Bethsaida, said, "Sir, we would see Jesus."

Him, but they were unable to see Him because He was in the temple of His humanity.

"God was in Christ, reconciling the world to Himself." Now we find that, in this, these Greeks could not see Him.

57-0922M - Jesus Christ The Same Yesterday, Today, And Forever 20 Listen, Jesus, 24th verse, 34th verse, Jesus answered them, "Is it not written in your law, I...?" Now here, Hisself, being the Son of God, yet said, "I said."

See the personal pronoun in it? "I said, Ye are gods. Ye yourself are gods. Is it written in your law, that I said, Ye are gods? If He..."

Back to God again. They couldn't understand: one time it was God speaking, next time it was Jesus speaking, and He was a dual personality, as to say.

21 The disciples once said, after, in, I believe, Saint John the 17th chapter, Jesus explaining to them, they said, "Lo, now speakest Thou plainly.

Now, we know that You come from God, and no man don't have to teach You. You come from God, God does Your teaching, You don't need any education or seminary theologies,

God teaches You, and no man tells You what to do: by this we believe that Thou comest from God."

He said, "Do you now believe? After all this time, do you now believe?"

Notice:

Ye are gods.

Now, 35th verse:

If he called them (the prophets) gods, unto whom the Word of the Lor-...of God came,

22 Who do the Word of the Lor-...come to? The prophets. And God called the prophets, "gods" because they had the Word of God.

If a man has the Word of God, it's not the man, it's the Word that the people's listening to; it isn't the man, it's the Word.

And if the prophets, Jeremiah, Isaiah, Elisha, if they had THUS SAITH THE LORD, God said, "As long as that Word was going from them, they were gods."

God said Himself, He was the One done the announcing, because it wasn't a man, He'd took the man out, and put Hisself in there, to speak.

If you call them gods...(Now listen.) If you call them gods, unto—unto whom the word of God came, and the scriptures cannot be broken;

23 Oh, how I'm...Who has more of authority to say that, than Him? "The Scriptures cannot be broken."

If Jesus said, "The works that I do, you shall do also," that cannot be broken. "Yet a little while and the world seeth Me no more; yet ye'll see Me:

for I'll be with you, even in you, to the end of the world," that Scripture cannot be broken. If the Bible said that, "Jesus Christ, the same yesterday, today, and forever," it cannot be broken.

Then He has to be the same in principle, the same in power, the same in vision, the same in might, it cannot be broken. Jesus said so. Say ye of him, who the Father has sanctified,

24 Now the prophets could not be sanctified (potentially) by the offering of a bull, or an ox, or something, or a sheep, or a heifer.

They were potentially under that blood (as the brother, most gallantly, has presented) that they could be sanctified, potentially, under the...looking forward to the atonement being made perfect.

For under the blood of bulls, when the bull died, or the heifer died, or the sheep died, the life in that blood could not come back on the prophet because it was a animal's life; and a animal's life would bring the prophet to an animal.

25 But when the Blood of the Lord Jesus was offered, the Life of Christ, which was God, comes on the believer. He said, "Then how can you, if you...

if God said, Himself, that, 'you are gods,' who the Word of God came to, how can you say I blaspheme (when He, Who the Father has sanctified, and sent here) when I say that I am the Son of God?

How can you do it?"
Now, here He gives the sealing question:

If I do not the works of God, then don't believe me.

26 That settles it; that takes all the questions out; that makes it forever right: "If I do not the works of Him that sent Me, the Father, then don't believe Me.

You have a right not to believe Me." And when the Jews questioned Him, when He saw a vision, and went down (in Saint John 5) in, to the pool of Bethesda,

and looked all through, to three or four thousand people, till He found a man laying on a pallet. And He said, Jesus said, "I knew that he had been there and he was in this condition."

Father had showed Him. And He went down and seen him and healed him; picked up his bed on Sunday, and put it on his back, and went walking on.

The Jews questioned Him. Jes-...They said, "Now," (otherwise) "why don't you go heal the rest of them? Make them all?"

He said, "Verily, verily, I say unto you, the Son can do nothing in Himself, but what the Father shows Him to do." There you are.

27 It doesn't lay in the individual: it lays in God. It didn't lay in Christ, Jesus: it laid in God, the Father, which was in the Son.

It doesn't lay within you today: it lays within God that's in you, the faith that you have in God. It doesn't lay within me today: it lays within God.

28 So if God has raised from the dead (And for twenty-six years I've tried, across the world, to proclaim that Jesus Christ lives. He is not dead, He's just as real today as He was in the days He walked in Galilee.

But the unbelieving world has condemned it because they're carnal and can't understand the spiritual things because He said they wouldn't: "

A little while, and the world sees Me no more; yet ye shall see Me: for I'll be with you."), all that God was, He poured into Christ; and all that Christ was, He poured into the church. "Aren't you...?"

29 "I'll be with you." And if He is in here and with us, then it's God, and not us; the faith that you have in Him is God;

the works that He would do here would be Him, and not us. So, you let your faith be today; and you believe Him with all your heart.

59-1129 - Let Us See God 127 Now, God in His Son. Now, God was in His Son. "God was in Christ, reconciling the world to Himself," that's what the Scripture says.

He, God will come down, and lived in a body, borned to the virgin Mary, and God manifested Himself through Christ;

to show what His—His attributes was, to show that He loved, to show that His patience, to show His power, to show and to manifest Himself. God lived in Christ, reconciling the world to Himself.

128 I spoke to a woman, here some time ago, or she called my attention. She said, "Pastor Branham," she said, "I appreciate your sermons.

I, I'm a...I attend your meetings." But she belonged to a certain denominational church that does not believe that Jesus was Divine.

And she said, "Well, He wasn't Divine." And I said...Said, "You try to make Him too Divine." I said, "He was Divine."

129 "Oh," she said, "sir, I will admit that He was a good man." And I don't want to hurt your feelings; some of them people are my precious friends. It's Christian Science.

And he said, "He, He isn't Divine." Said, "I will admit He was a prophet, but He wasn't Divine. And you try to make Him Divine."

130 I said, "He was either Divine or the greatest deceiver the world ever had." That's right. I said, "He was Divine.

He was more than a prophet. He was God over the prophets! Sure, He was." I said, "He was Divine."

131 And she said, "Now, you said you was 'fundamental,' and you believed the Scripture."
I said, "I do."

132 And she said, "If I prove to you, by your own Bible, that He wasn't Divine, will you witness that I am right?"

133 I said, "Yes, sir. If the Bible said He wasn't Divine, then I'll believe the Bible." And I said, "But I've got to see the Scripture."

134 She said, "In John, over in" St. John, It said, 'When Jesus went down to the grave of Lazarus, He wept." And said, "You know, if He was Divine, He could not weep." I said, "Sister, is that where you base your thought?"

135 She said, "Yes, sir. And that's true. He went to the grave of Lazarus, He wept; that showed that He wasn't Divine."

136 I said, "Your argument is thinner than the broth made out of a shadow of a chicken that starved to death." I said, "Well, you know better than that."

137 And she said, "Oh, He was—He was—He was a prophet, He was a good man."

138 I said, "He was more than...God was in Him. He was a man, but He was a—a dual-Person. One, He was a man; the Spirit in Him was God!" I said, "God was in Christ." She said, "Ah! No!"

139 I said, "Look, lady, I'll take your own Scripture. He was a man, but He was a God-man. When He went down to the grave of Lazarus, He did weep like a man.

That's true. But when He stood there, straightened His little stooped shoulders up, and said, 'Lazarus, come forth,'

and a dead man, that had been dead four days, come to life, that was more than a man. Man couldn't do that. That was God in His Son."

140 He was a man when He come off the mountain, hungry, looking for something to eat, looking right on a tree to find something to eat. He was a man when He was hungry.

But when He took two fishes and five biscuits and fed five thousand that was more than a man. That was God in His Son. Sure was!

141 He was a man when He was laying out there on that boat that night, virtue had gone out of Him, till He was so weak He couldn't...

the waves didn't even wake Him up, tossed about in that little old boat, like a bottle stopper out there on a mighty sea.

The ten thousand devils of the sea swore they would drown Him that night while He was asleep. He was a man when He was sleepy and tired.

But when He put His foot upon the brail of the boat, looked up and said, "Peace, be still," and the winds and the waves obeyed Him, that was more than a man. God was in His Son! Absolutely!

142 He was a man when He died there on the cross, screaming for mercy. He was a man when He died. He cried like a man, He had pain like a man.

But on Easter morning when He broke the...death, hell, and the seals of the grave, and rose again; He's more than a man, He proved He was God!

Living, He loved me; dying, He saved me;

Buried, He carried my sins far away;

Rising, He justified freely for ever:

Someday He's coming—oh, glorious day!

143 God was in His Son, reconciling the world to Himself. Do you believe that? Sure. God was in His Son. Quickly, our time gets away.

One more thing. We...Do you believe God is in His universe? God is in His Word? God was in His Son?

144 Now, God in His people. All right. We'll see whether He comes down to human beings the same as He does to nature. Human beings is part of His nature. Certainly, they are. Now notice, God was in His people.

145 Who was it the other night in our text, in Elijah, when a little baby had died of a sun stroke, and been laid for hours and hours on the prophet's bed, when a man,

called "Elijah," walked back and forth, up and down the floor, and laid his body on that dead baby, and he come to life? That was God in His people. It certainly was.

146 Who was it, that when Saint Peter, the apostle, a fisherman so ignorant...The Bible said, "He was ignorant and unlearned." Who was it, when he walked down along the streets,

and people laid the sick in the shadow of that man, and they were healed? Was it a man's shadow that healed them? It was God in His people, that did the healing.

147 Who was it in Saint Paul, when they took from his body handkerchiefs or aprons, and laid on the sick? God was in His people. They recognized God in Saint Paul. Certainly, they did.

148 Who was it when a bunch of little cowards prayed, took the Word of God and went up to Pentecost? They had the doors all barred up, and the windows barred up, and they were in there for ten days.

All of a sudden there came a sound from Heaven like a rushing, mighty wind, it filled all the building where they were sitting, cloven tongues set on them, like fire.

And out into the streets they 130 went, where they was once a-scared, went out there, preaching the Gospel and carrying on like a bunch of drunk people. What was it? God in His people. God moving among His people.

149 God is in you. God, the Holy Spirit, is in you, moving around now, reconciling the world to Himself.

150 What makes these inspired ministers preach the Gospel? What makes them? Perhaps, one time, drunkards; one time, gamblers; one time, bad men; all of a sudden, something changed!

And here they stand, preaching the Gospel and giving their lives out. And some of them, nearly, living just as poor as they can. When they were businessman and could be rich,

ride in big cars and have luxury, but they sacrificed it and give it away. Why? God is in His people, reconciling the world to Himself. God is in His people.

151 What is it strikes a little woman or a little man, and he rises, and his face lights up like a candle, and speaks with a language he knows nothing about,

and another one rise under the same kind of a inspiration and give a message to His church? God in His people. Amen.

3. Nature Has Been Groaning Waiting For This Hour — And Ourselves Also — Sons And Daughters Of God

65-0410 - The Easter Seal 236 But if that quickening power is there, you'll recognize. Like that little eagle; that's his mama. That's the Word. That's THUS SAITH THE LORD. That's what God promised.

That's what was foretold. That's exactly what happened. We're beyond any shadow of doubt, potentially in the resurrection right now, the saints getting ready to be taken up in the air.

237 So, Jesus, so full of this quickening power, said, "If you can destroy this temple, that took you forty years, you thought, to build, I'll raise it up in three days."

238 Why? Why could Jesus say that? Want to ask you. Why could Jesus say a thing like that? He knew That He was. Amen. I wish I could make that stick.

He knew Who He was. He knew that, every Word, God had wrote in there of Him, He had fulfilled it. He knew He was the One David spoke of.

239 Do you know you're the ones the Bible speaks of? Do you know your position is in Christ? If you're in Christ, you're a new creature.

Do you know this Word is just like everyday living, to you? Why, sure. It's yours. You are an eagle. That's your Food.

240 He knew that, by the power of God, He would do it, because it was prophesied He would do it. That's the reason He wasn't scared to say, "Destroy this temple.

I'll raise it up in three days, because David said, 'I'll not leave His soul in hell, neither will I suffer My Holy One to see corruption."

He knowed not one cell of His body would corrupt. And it corrupts in seventy-two hours. He said, "Destroy this temple. I'll raise it up again, in them three days." Why?

He was so full of that quickening power that quickened every Word. He looked back and seen every Word God wrote of Him, and prophet said He fulfilled it. He knowed that would be fulfilled, 241 Now, every Word that God said, has your spirit said "amen" to It, It's been fulfilled in your life, as a believer?

242 Do you hold back on something, say, "Well, my church teaches different"? Then be careful, hawk.

243 Notice. Eagles believe. There no question, to them. They believe It. Notice.

244 Now, He knew it would happen because the Word said It was. And every Word wrote of Him had to be fulfilled.

He knew that It was written by the power of God, by the holy prophets that had prophesied that He would do so. 245 And prophecy never fails. It cannot. The Word of God can't fail. And it is written in the...by the Spirit that...And now, also, the Spirit that raised up Jesus from the dead,

if It dwells in your being, your body, It will also quicken your mortal body. Then, shoot it, burn it, do anything you want to, make fun of it, tear it down, turn it down, do what you want to.

God will raise it up, for He said He would. And every saint of God has that promise in him, knows that that's the Truth. So, fear not, brother, we already in the Easter.

57-1211 - Sirs, We Would See

Jesus

21Now, we want to see Him at His work. Now, Jesus was born for one purpose, that was for God to manifest Himself through that body.

God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself. He was a body that was made physical, that men and women could see what He thought, and His expressions to the people in His gratefulness. And His attitude towards all mankind, He expressed it through Christ.

Christ seemed to be a dual personality. He would speak sometimes and they'd scratch their heads;

and—and they didn't understand Him. He'd speak one thing one time, look like, and something else another time. What it was, was Jesus speaking, and then Christ speaking.

Jesus was the man. Christ was the God that was in Him. "Not Me that doeth the works: My Father that dwelleth in Me, He doeth the work." See? God will not share His glory with no one.

22 So it all comes by the Spirit, but Jesus was a virgin born in order to tabernacle the Holy Spirit of God first to manifest Himself to the people; and He gave His life, a willing sacrifice that through His righteousness, we unrighteous people might have a right to come into the fellowship like He had with the Father before the foundation of the world. If that isn't grace and glory, what He did for us.

Then—then to think that the day that we're living in, is that so many people cut off that privilege from the people. Why you're...

We're living millions of miles below our God given privilege. Right. The Church of the living God should never be divided. We should be one and together.

23 We should never live under our privileges as we are today. The great powers of God lays within the reach of every—every member of the body of Christ.

"Whatsoever things you desire, when you pray, believe that you receive it, and you shall have it." And it shall be given to you.

I was reading in the Lexicon the other day, when it...Over there in Luke at that Scripture I was just quoting. The original give it, "When thou prayest," he said...Here's what I want to get to.

He said, "If ye should say to this mountain, 'Be thou plucked up and cast into the sea,' and believe in your heart that it's being done..." Believe that it is being done...

24 Now, lots of people, they say, "Pray for me, brother." All right, "Lord, help this dear brother." Give them a prayer card, and best you can. And he's seen others healed night after night, time after time,

but, "I didn't get it. I'll try it again tomorrow night." Oh, my, you dis—you discredit God to the...You discredit His Word.

Watch. "If you believe in your heart that it's being done..." Maybe that mountain looks just exactly like it always looked, but in your heart you believe it.

There might not be but one little grain of sand, but something's tearing loose. Something's begin to take place. See? When we believe that it's being done...

But you see, we just want something spontaneously...?...And what do we get? Left out, left out.

Because it weakens.

In a few nights I want to get onto that, on faith, the Lord of hosts in you. See?

4. They Are Amateur gods-God with skin on - The Word Of God Has Come To Them

64-0629 - The Mighty God Unveiled Before Us

134 And I told this to a man, the other day, when this piece had come out about this man being healed. This same minister said, "They make a god out of you, Brother Branham."

135 Well, he was a critic, so I thought I'd just kind of break it off, just a little bit. Not to hurt, you know, but just kind...

I said, "Is that too far from the Scripture, to be that?" See? I said, "No, it isn't," I said, "because Jesus called prophets 'gods.' See? That's right, 'God.'"

136 And they say, "Well, you people try to take the place of God." That's not too far out. That's exactly what it is. That's exactly. God manifested in flesh, just as He promised.

137 This little family, we find. I told him this little story, which come to my mind just now. That, one night it come up a storm, and mother said to Junior,

- said, "Now, you go on upstairs, son, and go to bed."
- Said, "Mama, I'm scared," he said.
- "Ain't nothing going to hurt you. Go on up and go to bed."

138 Little Junior laid up there, and the lightning flashing around the windows. And the little fellow got so nervous, he'd stick his head under the cover,

and he could still hear the—the lightning, or see the lightning flash on the windows, and—and hear the thunder roar.

So he said, "Mama!" And she said, "What do you want, Junior?" Said, "Come up here and sleep with me."

139 So she come up the steps, like any good, loyal mother would. And she came up, and she took little Junior in her arms.

And she said, "Junior, mother wishes to speak to you just a moment."
Said, "All right, mama."

140 Said, "Now you must bear this in mind. We go to church, constantly. We read the Bible. We pray.

We are a Christian family. We believe in God." And said, "We believe that, in storms and whatever goes on, God is our protection."

141 He said, "Mama, I believe every bit of that. But," said, "when that lightning is so close," he said, "I-I want a God with skin on It."

142 So, I—I think, not only Junior, but all of us feel that way. When we get together, when we pray one for the other, God with skin on It.

143 And we find out here that God has always had skin on Him. When Moses seen Him, He had skin on Him, look like a Man.

When God was behind the curtains, He had skin on Him. And God, tonight, in His Church, is veiled in His Church with skin on It. He is still the same God, tonight. We find that.

144 But now, as ever, the skin veil is what catches the traditions. They just can't believe that that is God making them people act like that.

See? It's because God is veiled in His Church, in skin, skin on It. That's right. He is hid from the unbeliever, and revealed to the believer. Yes, sir.

64-0321E - The Voice Of The Sign 82 God deals with an individual. See? Now notice this, He was trying to attract the prophet's attention, to get the prophet in his right place, see, and He gave the burning-bush sign.

84 Remember, God does nothing outside of man. You know that? That's what stumbles the people. See?
