1. Our Headship Is Christ The Fullness Of The Word (The Capstone, The Headstone...The Seal Of God...divine Love) All In The Individual

#### 63-0728 - Christ Is The Mystery Of God Revealed 480 Think! By the living Presence of the living Christ by the living Word;

oh, living Christ, living Presence, living Word! Watch! By His Own personal, personal vindication proves His Church.

481 Not members! He never done it, the days of Moses. He never done it in the days of anybody else; at the end of the world, when it come to the place where it was the destruction.

The days of Lot, it wasn't membership. It was personal vindication, God in flesh, see, personal vindication.

482 Remember! Think of it, that, people born of His Spirit, in a day like this, in this great denominational age that we live,

and the living God takes His living Word and—and vindicates It, personally, this Life that's in the Word, the germ that's in the Seed!

And the Word is a Seed that a sower went forth to sow. And the Life is Christ, in the Word, personally in you;

vindicating something that you cannot do, proving Hisself that it's not you, but it's Him. And you've become one, a—a—a love-slave to Him, to be a Bride. 483 Thanks be to the living God Who created the heavens and the earth and all that's in the midst!

No wonder, "He is Alpha and Omega, the Beginning and the Ending; He that was, which is, and shall come; the Root, and Offspring of David; the bright and the Morning Star." He is all-in-all.

484 His Presence, in the individual, with a personal vindication of Himself expressing Himself, the living Word that's promised for the day, expressing Itself through you, a vindication of the great revelation of God.

Look, only in an individual, never in a group! An individual; not in a group! His identification is with an individual.

You get that? [Congregation says, "Amen."—Ed.] Not with the Methodist, not with the Baptist, not the Presbyterian, not the Lutheran, not the Pentecostals, but as an individual!

485 "I'll take one, and leave one; I'll separate them." That's right. "There'll be two in the field; I'll take one and leave one. There'll be two in bed, and I'll take one and leave one."

486 It's not a group. It is a personal vindication of a pregnated child of God, filled with the Holy Ghost, so surrendered to God that he don't care about anything else. And the Holy Spirit living Its Life, pulsating through him, showing the personal—personal vindication of the Word, Itself, expressing Itself to the people and to the world.

#### 62-1230E - Is This The Sign Of The End, Sir? 371 Might be closer than you think it is. It's got me scared. Oh, I haven't done enough. Where are we at?

372 "Time shall be no more." He announces that time is over. What happens? What happens? Could that be so now, brethren? Seriously think. If it is, then the pyramid is capped by the Seven Thunders.

## 373 You remember the pyramid Message? It's the Capstone. What did It do?

The Holy Spirit capped off the individual and seal it, when we added to our faith; righteousness, and godliness, and faith, and so forth, and kept adding to it till we got seven things.

And the seventh one was love, which is God. That's how He makes the individual, and caps him and seals him with the Holy Spirit.

374 Then, if that be so, He's got seven church ages, that He's had seven mysteries that's been sounded away, and they fought for, to bring back.

And now the Headstone comes, to cap off the Church. Does the Thunders mean that, my brethren? Sirs, is that where we're at?

375 Junie, I want to take your dream. Look. Junior, before the pyramid was ever preached, months before it, seen this dream.

You say, "What about a dream?"

376 Nebuchadnezzar dreamed a dream that Daniel interpret, told the beginning of the Gentile age and when it would leave. And it's done just exactly that way. Not one bit has failed.

377 You notice? The writing that the...was on the rocks, I was interpret It for them. They were elated. That's "the mystery of God" that's been not understood, for years. Could that be that?

378 And then notice. In some mysterious way, we picked up, out of the air, a sharp tool that opened up the top. And in there was white granite, but It wasn't interpreted.

There was no letters. I didn't interpret That, Junior. I just looked at It, and said to the brethren, "Look on This." And that's fulfilled, tonight.

379 And while they were studying That, I slipped towards the west. What for? Maybe to understand the interpretation of what's written in the top of This. Could it be?

380 And Those, blasting, the other morning, that shook me plumb till I raised up in the air, as high as this building, that constellation of Angels, seven Angels in the form of a pyramid. Is that them Thunders that's coming forth? Could it be?

381 This is all interpreted. According to his dream, it was all finished.

According to God's Word, the seventh messenger will finish, seventh Message will be finished, and then the Seven Thunders. And he saw the capstone rolled over.

382 Which, many people don't even know there is Seven Seals to be revealed. I've read many men's books on Revelation, never did hear It talked on. They skip That. But it's been told you that It's there.

383 I don't know what it is. Could that be that? God be merciful to us! If that is, we're in a serious hour. Now, just a minute, look. If that be so, and the mystery is finished, that was wrote in these rocks.

384 I'm glad to be sitting in a church with godly people who God can give a dream to. I'm glad to introduce to these men and women that goes to Junior's church, and to this church, to Brother Neville's,

and them, that there's people sitting in this congregation, and the Bible said, "They would dream dreams in the last days." And here it is. And look at it, it's comparing with the Word.

385 Knowing nothing about it, a blast come forth, and here come seven Angels from Eternity. I said, "Lord, what would You have me do?" It wasn't told. I may have to go, first, to find out.

I don't know. Might not even be that. I don't know. I'm just saying, "What if it is?" If it's Scriptural, that sounds very close to it. Don't you think so?

386 Look. Then, look, the capstone was not interpreted. See? "Get west, and come back." Or, is it this, it's these seven Angels in this constellation that came to me? 387 And when I meet you at the Day of the resurrection, you'll see that I lie not; God, my Judge.

388 Or, is this that second climax that I talked about the other day? Is it of something coming forth for the Church? I don't know. I could stay on that a little bit, but I'll move on.

389 Could it be that, the mighty thunder, or the seventh Angel in the seven, constellation, seventh-period constellation, their pyramid made in a form (three on a side, and one on top), and they dropped from Eternity? Could it be?

390 Is this the mystery, of the Thunders, that will bring back the Headstone? You know, the pyramid never was capped. The Headstone is yet to come. It's been rejected. Could it be, brethren, sisters?

391 Or, is this that Third Pull that He told me, three or four years ago? 392 The First Pull, you remember what happened? I tried to explain It. He said, "Don't do that."

393 The Second Pull, He said, "Don't try." And I pulled, anyhow. You remember? All of you remember. It's on tape and everything.

394 And then He said, "Now there's a Third Pull coming, but don't try to explain It." You see how I approached This, tonight? I don't know. But, I feel duty bound, to my church, to say something. You draw your own conclusion.

395 Now, will this be the mystery that would open up, that would bring Christ, bring a Power to the Church? See? We've already...

396 We believe in repentance, being baptized in the Name of Jesus Christ. We believe in receiving the Holy Ghost.

We have signs, wonders, miracles, speaking in tongues, and the things that the early Church had. And, frankly, there's been more done, right here,

than is wrote in the Book of Acts, in this one little group of people, this little bitty ministry of ours here. What about the world over? See? More than is wrote in the Book of Acts, same kind!

The raising of the dead! Remember, there was only about three people raised, of dead, by Jesus Christ. And we have on record, doctors' record, five. See?

397 "Works that I do, more than this shall you do." I know the King James says "greater," but you couldn't do nothing greater.

More of it! He was in one Person then; He's in the whole Church now. See? "More than this shall you do, for I go unto My Father."

398 If this is the Third Pull, then there is a great ministry lying ahead. I don't know. I can't say. I—I don't know.

2. It's The Headship Who Opened The Seals-he Is Those Seals-the Mystery That Was Revealed...

## 65-0725E - What Is The Attraction On The Mountain? 138 And I started up the mountain, running as hard as I could on the other side.

All of a sudden, I thought somebody shot me. I never heard such a blast; it shook the whole country. And, when it did, standing before me was seven Angels in a cluster.

- 139 I met Brother Fred and them, a little after. Said, "What was it?"
- I said, "That was it."
- "What are you going to do?"

140 "Return home. For, THUS SAITH THE LORD, the seven mysteries that's been hid in the Bible all these years, these denominations and everything, God is going to open those seven mysteries to us in the Seven Seals."

141 There was that circle coming up from the earth, like a mist forming. When It did, It went plumb up into the mountain, begin to circle on westward, from the way It come.

Science found It after a while, thirty miles high and twenty-five miles across, just exactly in the circle of the pyramid.

142 And the other day, standing there, turned the picture to the right, and there is Jesus as He was in the Seven Church Ages, the white wig on, showing Supreme Deity. He's Alpha and Omega; He's the First and the Last;

He is the Supreme Judge of all Eternity, standing there to confirm the Message of this hour. And there shall be Light about the evening time! What's it all about? What was it?

143 I went westward. Upon that same mountain, passing up with Banks Wood there, said, "Throw up a rock. Say to Mr. Wood, 'THUS SAITH THE LORD, you'll see the Glory of God."

144 The very next day, standing there, a whirlwind came down and blasted the mountains out.

Rocks cut the top of the trees off, about three or four feet above my head. Made three big blasts, and the brothers come running over.

There was about fifteen men standing there, preachers and everything else. "What was it?" He said, "What was it?" I said, "Judgment is striking the West Coast."

145 About two days after that, the earthquake almost sunk Alaska. What is this Light up on Sunset Mountain in the Coronado Forest of Arizona? What is this strange thing that happened up there,

that the people has been driving east from west, picking up the rocks that laid around there where It struck? And every one of them, every one rock, has three corners on it, that It tore off.

(The three are One.) They're laying on desks, on paper weights, across the nation. What is this strange thing upon Sunset Mountain in the Coronado Forest?

146 Junior Jackson listening in, you remember the dream he had that I interpreted, "going towards the setting of the sun"? And this happened on "Sunset" Mountain. It's the evening time, sunset time.

The sunset Message through a setting of history, a setting of prophecy, rather, being fulfilled. And it shall be Light at the evening time,

upon Sunset Mountain in the Coronado Forest, forty miles north of Tucson. Get on the map and see if Sunset Peak there. That's exactly where it happened. I never know it till the other day.

147 Everything that...That shall never die. It's constantly unrolling Itself. From the very thing happening, to the picture being Jesus standing looking at us;

and now exactly on Sunset Mountain, and the sunset Light. The evening Light has come, God vindicating Himself. What is it? It is the facts that God and Christ are one. The "white," how many seen it, the white wig upon Him, as we talked in Revelation 1?

See, the Supreme Deity, Supreme Authority; no other voice, no other god, no other nothing! "In Him dwells the fullness of the Godhead bodily." The Angels Themselves was His wig. Amen.

148 What's happened upon Mount Sunset? God confirming His Word. That's what all this noise is about. Notice, it's God fulfilling His promised Word again, of Revelation 10:1 to 7,

"And in the days of the sounding of the seventh angel's Message, the mystery of God should be finished."

The hidden mystery of Revelation 10:1 to 7, the last Message to the last church age. Fulfills exactly, in this age, Saint Luke 17:30, "The day when the Son of man shall be revealed."

## 65-0418M - It Is The Rising Of The Sun 307 Look what we've seen in this day. The quickening Power has come to us, to open the Seven Seals.

What was that, the intelligence of a man? No, the quickening Power of God. See, the quickening Power of God foretold this would take place.

See, the quickening Power of God made the world testify to It, it's the Truth. The Angel of the Lord, I told you, was around, in a Pillar of Fire;

quickening Power let the world testify that It's the Truth. And, in that, they didn't know what It was; and we knew, just look this a way, and It's our Lord up there, you see.

308 He is the One Who opened those Seals. He is those Seals, for the whole Word of God is Christ, and Christ is the Seals that was opened. What is the opening of Seals then? Revealing Christ.

309 And the very seven Angels, which represented the Seven Churches all completed, and we couldn't even see It. They did, they took the picture, not us.

And there He is, standing there, Supreme Judge; showing that He is Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. What identification! Quickening Power did that to us.

## 60-0606 - To Whom Would We Go?

135 They say life begins at forty. That's a lie. Life begins at the altar.

That's where life begins, Eternal Life, when you come to that Jesus Christ. Every promise is yours; it's all yours. It's to you. Maybe you haven't searched it.

Maybe you haven't looked down to find out where the promise is for you. You can't come and receive the Holy Ghost unless you really believe you're going to get It.

Why, God's more anxious for you to get It than you are to receive It, more anxious; He wants you to have It. It's yours, It's your personal property.

136 He sent Jesus to die, that He might bring you to Himself that He—He might have something to worship Him. When He was El, Elah, Elohim, He was by Hisself. But in Him was attributes.

Them attributes was to be a Father, was to be God, was to be worshipped, was to be a Healer, was to be a Saviour, and all these things.

You, your life displays them attributes. As soon as you come to Him, you become His son; you worship Him.

It's what He really was to be, what He made you to do. Your purpose here is to worship God, and you cannot worship Him correctly till you worship Him in Spirit and in Truth:

Saint John 4. That's what Jesus told the woman, "The Father's seeking such that'll worship Him in Spirit and in Truth."

137 First, get the Truth, foundationally right. Jesus Christ is the only Way to come, not by shaking hands, joining church; that's good.

Shake hands, sure; join church, sure. But that's not it. Come to the Foundation first; lay yourself upon Him.

And then after you've received Him, then shake the pastor's hands and join the church. That's right. After you've done these things, but get started right first. Get headed right.

138 Like David with his slingshot, he had to head that rock right first. See, you got to take aim; you got to zero in.

And if you want to zero in, put it on Christ Jesus. For He's the Way, the Truth, the Light, the Foundation. All of it is for you.

139 Here some time ago a woman here in the United States, poor old thing was so poverty-stricken. They wondered what they'd do about her, and finally they sent the charity up to see what they could do for her.

And when they come to her, they investigated and found out she was real poor, and had nothing to eat, and sold all of her furniture.

And she was in a terrible shape. And they said, "Haven't you got any children?" She said, "Yes, sir, I have one son."

- Well, said, "Where's that son at?"
- Said, "He's in India." And said, "He's a businessman over in India."
- Well, said, "Why can't he take care of you."

140 "Oh," she said, "I tell you." (You know how mothers are.) Said, "He's such a darling boy." Said, "He writes me the sweetest letters that you ever read."

And said, "And he—he—he writes me such sweet letters, I can't ask him for any help." Said, "I just couldn't do it.

He tells me, 'Darling Mother, how are you getting along?' and things like that." Said, "I-I just hate to tell him. And—and so he...I know he'd do anything to help me."

- And said, "Then he sends me some of the prettiest pictures I ever seen."
- And said, "Sent you what?
- Pictures?"
- Said, "Yeah."

Said, "What kind of pictures?" Said, "Wait there a minute, I'll tell you. I've got them in my Bible. I've been saving them for two or three years."

141 And she went back in the Bible and begin to bring them out. You know what it was? She was worth tens of thousands of dollars.

Them's India money orders with pictures on them. She didn't know what it was all about. But she found them in her Bible.

She was rich and didn't know it, dying of hunger, dying of starvation, and—and up against charity, because that she didn't know what she had.

142 And sometime it may be that way with many people tonight. You don't realize the joy unspeakable and full of glory. You don't know the power, the Everlasting Life. You don't know how rich you are,

until you go to looking in here and finding out that those promises, that was give to those apostles, was give to whosoever will, let him come. That is right. It's all yours freely.

143 Would you like to receive it? Would you like to be filled with the Holy Ghost, be saved, your sins under the Blood, filled with the Holy Ghost, be baptized in the Spirit,

and a translating power in your heart, and go up to meet Him in the air, go out of this building tonight with that blessed assurance? If a car runs over you, what difference does it make?

My, just doesn't but just change this old house for a brand new one. That's all. It's moving from an old, broke-up man or woman to a young one that'll—that'll never die.

## 65-1207 — Leadership 205 Now we find that in here, that you have a right in your choice. You choose the girl you want to marry; she accepts you, all right.

206 Then another thing, you have a choice of whether you want to live or whether you don't want to live. You choose now between Life and death. You can live.

207 That boy had that choice. He was success in everything else, a religious man, but he knowed that when that...

He spoke it of hisself, "I've observed all these commandments since I was a youth," but he knowed he didn't have Eternal Life. See? And he had a choice to accept It or to refuse It,

and he turned It down. That was the most fatal mistake he could ever made. The rest of it wouldn't amounted. It don't, it doesn't amount, unless you take That choice.

208 Now let us follow him at his choosing, and see where it led him to. Now, see where he chose. Now, look, he was—he was a rich man, he was a businessman, he was a ruler, and he was a religious man. All that!

209 Today we'd say, "Boy, he's a genuine Methodist, or Baptist, or a Pentecostal. He—he's a real fellow, real nice boy. Fine!" Nothing you could say

about him; friendly, nice, sociable, and everything.

No immorals about him. He didn't probably smoke, drink, or run around to shows and dances, and whatever we'd call it today, as we would class a Christian. But that ain't Eternal Life yet!

That ain't what we're talking about. He might have been loyal to his church, in which he probably was. But, you see, and what did it lead him to? Great popularity.

Let's say, if he was a preacher, he could been...got a better church. He could been the state presbyter or a bishop. See? It leads you to popularity, and it led him to riches and to fame.

210 It might do the same thing today, you have a great talent to sing. I thought of that young man a while ago that sang that song here;

how he had give that to the devil, and now he get it back...And how different between him and Elvis Presley and some of these.

Pat Boone, and a group like that, Ernie Ford, them guys, great singers; and take their talents, that God-given talents, and use it to inspire the—the works of the devil. That's right.

Some great singer selling their God-given talents for fame in this world, to become somebody. How could you become any more of a "body" than you could, to be a somebody, than to be a son of God?

211 I don't care if you own the whole city, the whole world, and you haven't accepted the leadership of Eternal Life by the Holy Spirit (Christ), how you going to...Who are you, anyhow?

You're a dead mortal, dead in sin and trespasses! Religious as you want to be; as faithful as you want to be to the church; preacher, if you want to be in the pulpit; but to turn down, you die!

212 He was a great success. He was a great success here in this life. Certainly. We find him where we notice...Then we find this fellow, that he went...We follow him a little bit, and we see he got a great successful.

And we follow him through the Bible. We notice that he—he...We find him a rich man. He's got such great big places, he was entertaining the judge and the mayor of the city, or what-more.

He's up on top of his roof, and he has great banquets; and plenty of waitresses, and women, girls, and everything else, around him. And there's a beggar laying at the gate, named Lazarus.

He sweeps the crumbs off to him. We know the story. The next thing, he goes on successful, just like the churches today are getting.

## 65-1207 — Leadership 215 Notice this, now we find out that he was a great success. Then we find him later till he was a greater success, until he said, "I have got so much!"

Boy, he'd made a real genuine guy of this day. Wouldn't he? "Even my barns has swelled out, they're bursting. And I've got so much till I said, 'Oh, soul, take your rest."

216 But, what he done at the beginning, he rejected the leadership of Jesus Christ. His church, his intelligence, his education, and all, had lead him to a success.

All the Jews loved him. He give to them, he helped them, he might have done this, that, or the other.

But, you see, he rejected the—the—the leadership of Jesus Christ, the Eternal Life. And that...The Bible said, He said, "Thou fool, tonight your soul is required."

## 64-0719E - Going Beyond The Camp

48 You know, I was told, some time ago, that they had a jet plane now that can...makes them noises we hear around here, that shakes the windows.

It's when the plane has got so fast that it crosses its own sound, called sound barrier. And when it goes beyond its own sound barrier, it's almost unlimited to what it'll do.

And I think, in there, that we get a lesson. When we go beyond our own sound barrier, into the Word of God,

then it's unlimited what God can do with a man that's ready to go beyond the camp, the camp of man, that is. Now, we see that, going beyond the camp, going beyond this.

## 57-0714 - As The Eagle Stirreth Up Her Nest

65 Oh, that's the reason God likened His Church unto the eagle, because the eagle's nest,

which is the Church, is built far beyond the cares of this world: out of the danger lines; cross the Blood; where the modern prowling predators never get to.

He said, "You are a city that is set on a hill, a candle that's lit in the room." Oh, something, the Church of the living God is built high, on high ambitions.

66 When I hear of a church that hasn't got any ambition to grow, there's something wrong with that church. The Church of the living God has a high ambition.

67 And another thing: The Church of the living God is built high because it's got high anticipations and expectations. Say, "Well, we belong to the church.

Our father served in this church years ago." That might be fine, but the Church of the living God can't set still. Its ambitions is to go higher, farther.

## 65-1031A — Leadership 73 You know this boy called Elvis Presley? You've heard my tapes. You've heard how I don't degrade the boy, but that boy was had the opportunity that you all got.

See, and what he...He found out he could sing. And watch what he did, just the same thing Judas did, Judas Iscariot, he sold out esus.

Jesus gave that boy that good voice. And what does he do? Turn around and sell it out to the devil. See, he's got to come to the end of the road. See? He refused to walk with Jesus.

74 Now this young fellow here, this rich young ruler, he did the same thing. Let's follow and see what he done.

No doubt, with the great man that he was, probably a handsome young man, dark hair combed down on the side, nice clothes.

The young ladies thought, "Boy, that's a handsome young man!" Oh, they would...He would maybe wave at them, and they would flirt back with him, and things.

75 And he thought he was a great fellow, person, see, because he was handsome, he was young.

He wasn't looking down there at the end of the road. He was just looking here. "I'm young. I'm handsome. I'm rich. I can buy anything I want to.

I can take these girls, and, boy, they all like me. And they know I'm a great man." And, see, he had all that. He had followed the instructions of his father, and everything.

"And I'm very religious. I go to church." And now he could follow that, see; very popular, rich, and famous. And, and he...

76 Just like today, like you had the opportunity to become a movie star, see, or something like that.

Most young kids today, you talk to them, they know more about these movie stars than they know about Jesus. You see? And, see, you—you children are learning about Jesus.

Where they sit down, and some play come on on a movie, or something another, they know the actors and all there, all about it. They know all that better than That.

You tell them about the Bible, they don't know nothing about Bible. See, it's making the wrong choice. Now, some singer selling their God-given talent, for fame!

77 Then we see him at life's end. Let's follow him a little further. You know what the Bible says about this young fellow?

He become more successful. So, sometimes success don't mean that you've made the right choice. You know what he did?

He went out and had all big times, and throwed big parties, and spent lots of money and everything, on the girls and everything. And then he got married and maybe had a family.

And—and he—he just increased so much till he had to build new barns and things. And he said, "You see, I didn't follow Jesus, and look what I got!" See?

78 You may hear people say that, and I have, "Well, look, He's blessed me." That don't mean it all. See?

79 And after a while his barns swelled till even he said, why, even, "Soul, take your rest. I've got so much money and so much success! And I'm such a great man! I belong to all the clubs.

And I have the riches of the world in my hands. I own great sums of land and sums of money, and, why, my, there everybody likes me, a very fine person to be."

80 But you know, the Bible said that, that night, God said to him, "I'm going to require your soul."

## 60-0729 - What It Takes To Overcome All Unbelief: Our Faith 72 There was Moses back there, living luxuriously, walking down, one morning, and God spoke to him out of that burning bush.

That man was changed from that time on. What a radical thing that causes you to do whenever you find God. Look at Moses, run, killed one Egyptian, and run from it out into the desert.

And here he was the next morning, after he had met God in this burning bush, had his wife setting astraddle of a mule with that little Gershom on her hip like that,

whiskers hanging about that low, with a stick in his hand, going yonder, just hopping along just shouting and praising God, leading his old mule with his wife on it.

73 When God speaks to a man, he has faith, and he has ambition, and he has a purpose. When God speaks to a man, He gives him a purpose. When God speaks to a man, He gives him ambition.

When God speaks to a man, He gives him faith to do it, to accomplish, or achieve what his purpose in life is, what God called him to do. He's called us to be in the church of God. Amen.

74 Let's—let's just make it our purpose in life to see that we are the church of God. Let's have ambition,

not set around because the Jones' want it or the...?...want. What do we care about the...?...if they don't do it, let's us do it anyhow.

If the rest of the nation wants to sink, that's up to them. In Yakima we stand for God. We want God. We want to achieve. We want to have faith. We want to have ambition.

Let's believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, for He said, "All things are possible to them that believe. Verily, I say unto you (not if I,) but if you shall say to this mountain, be move,

and don't doubt in your hearts but believe, that what you said shall come to pass, you can have what you said." I believe that with all my heart. You believe that?

148 That was a horrible experience, and a great experience to find my way out, but that wasn't half of it. One day I was lost in sin. I went church after church, trying to find Something.

I went to the Seventh-day Adventists, they told me, "Keep the Sabbath, quit eating meat." I went over to the Baptist church, first Baptist church, he said,

"Just get up and tell them that you believe Jesus Christ the Son of God, and I'll baptize you, that's it." There wasn't nothing. But one day, out in a little coal shed, I held my hands up, I caught a hold of Something;

or, may I say, Something got a hold of me. It was a Lifeline, the Guide. And He's led me safe this far, I ain't going to take my hand off of that Wire. I'm holding my hands to Him.

Let creeds, the denominations do whatever they want to, I'm holding onto the Guide. For all that was ever on earth and all that's in Heaven, ever means precious to me, is at the end of this Line.

He's brought me safely this far, I'll trust Him the rest the way. "When He the Holy Ghost is come, He will guide you and lead you into all..."

## CAB 04 – Smyrnaen

Now the Lord God Almighty says, "I KNOW." There He is walking in the midst of His people. There He is, the Chief Shepherd of the flock. But does He hold back the persecution?

Does He stem the tribulation? No, He does not. He simply says, "I KNOW your tribulation — I am not at all unmindful of your suffering."

What a stumbling block this is to so many people. Like Israel they wonder if God really loves them. How can God be just and loving if He stands by and watches His people suffer?

That is what they asked in Malachi 1:1-3, "The burden of the Word of the Lord to Israel by Malachi. I have loved you, saith the Lord.

Yet ye say, Wherein hast Thou loved us? Was not Esau Jacob's brother? saith the Lord: yet I loved Jacob, and I hated Esau,

and laid his mountains and his heritage waste for the dragons of the wilderness." You see, they could not figure out God's love. They thought that love meant no suffering.

They thought that love meant a baby with parental care. But God said that His love was "elective" love. The proof of His love is ELECTION — that no matter what happened,

His love was proven truly by the fact they were chosen unto salvation (because God hath chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth).

He may commit you to death as He did Paul. He may commit you to suffering as He did Job. That is His prerogative. He is sovereign. But it is all with a purpose.

If He did not have a purpose, then He would be the author of frustration and not of peace. His purpose is that after we have suffered awhile we would be made perfect,

be established, strengthened and settled. As Job said, "He puts strength in us." (Job 23:6b.) You see He, Himself, suffered. He learned obedience by the things that He suffered.

He was actually made perfect by the things that He suffered. Hebrews 5:8-9, "Though He were a Son, yet learned He obedience by the things which He suffered;

and being made perfect, He became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey Him." In plain language, the very character of Jesus was perfected by suffering.

And according to Paul He has left His church a measure of suffering that they, too, by their faith in God while suffering for Him, would come to a place of perfection.

Why did He want this? James 1:2-4, "My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations; knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience.

But let patience have her perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing." Why does He stand by?

The reason is in Romans 8:17-18, "And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with Him, that we may be also glorified together.

For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us." Unless we suffer with Him we cannot reign with Him. You have to suffer to reign.
