Blasphemer. Persecutor. Injurious.

And These Things Lived Before Him Regardless Of The Power Of The Blood And The Testimony Of Election.

These Things Stick In The Memory And The Devil Keeps Scooping Them Back Thinking That By Reciting Them Back, He Will Hinder The Manifestation Of Christ.

CAB 07 — Sardisean

"He that hath the seven Spirits of God, and the seven stars," Revelation 3:1. As this same Lord identified Himself with man in the incarnation,

He is again identifying Himself with man by His Spirit within man. "These are mine," saith the Lord. The seven Spirit-filled messengers are the Lord's.

By Looking At Grace, We See That It Does Not Originate From Purity. The Roots Of Grace Are Rooted In God's Loving Kindness That Picks Us Up From Filth.

But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

Grace Did Not Come Our Way Because We Were Perfect. It Came Our Way Because We Were In Sin.

So, Brother Branham Clarifies Grace As Unmerited Mercy – Nobody Was Found Worthy.

But God Through Election Extends This Grace To You And This Grace Initiates God's Goodness In Our Lives, Sustains It And Accomplishes

We Don't Leave Grace At The Altar; It Goes All The Way With Us To The Body Change.

Sovereign can do whatever it w ants to. Listen to this now. Sovereign grace can only be given by One that's Sovereign. And God is Sovereign, so He can give sovereign grace.

Therefore being Sovereign, grace don't have to ask anybody, it don't have to. It does what it wants to. Isn't that wonderful? It don't have to ask, "Can I do this? Or, shall I do this? Can I? Must I? Will I?" Doesn't do it.

The Root Of Grace Is God's Love Descending Towards A Man In Sin Who Cannot Save Himself And Yet He Has His Name On The Lamb's Book Of Life.

Jehovah Comes Down And He Raises A Prostitute To Sin No More. He Comes Down To The Drunkard With Flyblows On His Face As He Lay Unconscious In The Gutter.

That Is Grace.

Let Us Look At The Wave Sheave Here:

When Israel Waved Her Sheaves Of The First Fruit, They Were Prophesying Of The Resurrection Of Christ Who Is The First Fruit From Among The Dead.

The Bible Then Says, That Wave Sheave Was Christ Being Accepted On Behalf Of The Rest Of The Body — That Is Grace.

Because He Was Accepted, I Am Accepted In The Beloved.

Our Spiritual Man Operates From The Heavenly Places In Christ Jesus.

Leviticus 23:10-11

¹⁰ Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye be come into the land which I give unto you, and shall reap the harvest thereof, then ye shall bring a sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest unto the priest:

11 And he shall wave the sheaf before the LORD, to be accepted for you: on the morrow after the sabbath the priest shall wave it.

Because He Was Accepted, I Am Accepted With Him.

I Died With Him And Rose Again With Him.

I Am Baptized Into The Power Of His Resurrection.

Leviticus 23:15-17

15 And ye shall count unto you from the morrow after the sabbath, from the day that ye brought the sheaf of the wave offering; seven sabbaths shall be complete:

¹⁶ Even unto the morrow after the seventh sabbath shall ye number fifty days; and ye shall offer a new meat offering unto the LORD.

17 Ye shall bring out of your habitations two wave loaves of two tenth deals; they shall be of fine flour; they shall be baken with leaven; they are the firstfruits unto the LORD.

The Wheat That Comes From The Wave Sheave Had To Be Ground Into Fine Flour To Bake Loaves That Would Be Accepted As The First Fruits Unto The Lord.

The Loaves Were The New Testament Body That Comprised Both Hebrews And The Gentiles.

These Two Loaves Were Baked With Leaven.

Leaven There Is God Receiving You At The Strength Of Grace.

He knows your weakness but while we were yet in the mess of sin, He chose us so that the Holy Spirit in your life could do a cleansing job.

That Is Grace.

Leviticus 23:18-20

¹⁸ And ye shall offer with the bread seven lambs without blemish of the first year, and one young bullock, and two rams: they shall be for a burnt offering unto the LORD, with their meat offering, and their drink offerings, even an offering made by fire, of sweet savour unto the LORD.

¹⁹ Then ye shall sacrifice one kid of the goats for a sin offering, and two lambs of the first year for a sacrifice of peace offerings.

²⁰ And the priest shall wave them with the bread of the firstfruits for a wave offering before the LORD, with the two lambs: they shall be holy to the LORD for the priest.

They Shall Be Holy — When I See The Blood Of Sacrifice, I Will Receive You Into The Potter's House Which Is Full Of The Power Of Transformation.

Job 14:4

⁴ Who can bring a clean thing out of an unclean? not one.

No One Can Bring Something Clean Out Of The Unclean – Man Cannot Save Himself Therefore, Grace Must Root Out Through That

By The Feast Of Pentecost, God Was Pointing Out The Supreme Grace He Was Going To Reveal In Christ.

Who Can Bring A Clean Thing Out Of An Unclean? Not One.

The Answer Is Sovereign Grace From A Sovereign One That Can Make Israel Out Of A Filthy Jacob.

(For The Children Being Not Yet Born, Neither Having Done Any Good Or Evil, That The Purpose Of God According To Election Might Stand, Not Of Works, But Of Him That Calleth;)

And They Have Come To Church And Sometimes Lived In Here, But They Have Never Rested From Their Past.

They Carry The Burden Of Guilt Each Time A Minister Stands Here And Because Of That, They Skip Services.

But By Looking At The Roots Of Grace And Remembering The Words Of Job That -Who Can Bring A Clean Thing Out Of An Unclean? Not One.

We Can Have The Confidence In The God Who Is Rich In Mercy.

Let Us Bring In Moab Here:

The Bible In Genesis 19 Speaks
Of The Fall Of Lot Fleeing The
Fire Of Sodom And Settling In
The Caves Near Zoar.

There, His Daughters Make Him Drunk And Then Make Him Lie With Them Because Where They Went, There Was No Men To Give Them Children.

And The Firstborn Bare A Son, And Called His Name Moab: The Same Is The Father Of The Moabites Unto This Day.

And The Younger, She Also Bare A Son, And Called His Name Benammi: The Same Is The Father Of The Children Of Ammon Unto This Day.

Those Are Filthy Stories, But I Want You To Store Them Because We Are Talking About The Roots Of Grace.

I Want You To Know That The Old Testament Was A Drama That Portrayed The Coming Christ And His Grace.

1 Peter 1:10-12

¹⁰ Of which salvation the prophets have enquired and searched diligently, who prophesied of the grace that should come unto you:

¹¹ Searching what, or what manner of time the Spirit of Christ which was in them did signify, when it testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ, and the glory that should follow.

These Prophets Sometimes:

Saw Vision.

Heard Voices.

And Sometimes Lived Prophetic Lives.

1 Peter 1:12

¹² Unto whom it was revealed, that not unto themselves, but unto us they did minister the things, which are now reported unto you by them that have preached the gospel unto you with the Holy Ghost sent down from heaven; which things the angels desire to look into.

Their Lives Spoke To Us About The Coming Christ And That Is Why We Can Understand Grace Through The Unclean Shadows Of The Bible.

And On The Other Hand, These Prophets Spoke Of The Coming Christ The Author Of Eternal Grace.

The Grace Of God Came Through Dirty Channels In Order To Bring The Purity That The Bride Must Be.

Perfect.

Robed In Garments Of Righteousness.

Without Spot Or Wrinkle.

Looking At It In That Form, We Need To Allow Christ To Begin With Our Filth And Out Of Us, God Will Bring A Perfect Bride Without Spot Of Wrinkle.

² Abraham begat Isaac; and Isaac begat Jacob; and Jacob begat Judas and his brethren;

And Judas begat Phares and Zara of Thamar; and Phares begat Esrom; and Esrom begat Aram;

⁴ And Aram begat Aminadab; and Aminadab begat Naasson; and Naasson begat Salmon; ⁵ And Salmon begat Booz of Rachab; and Booz begat Obed of Ruth; and Obed begat Jesse;

Rahab there is a dirty channel, she was a prostitute.

Ruth there was also a dirty channel, she was a Moabite woman.

Matthew 1:6

⁶ And Jesse begat David the king; and David the king begat Solomon of her that had been the wife of Urias;

Solomon's Mother Was A Dirty Channel; She Was Uria's Wife. All The Men Were Okay But Some Of These Women Were Not.

These Women Represent You The Church Of Jesus Christ. The Dirty Channel That Christ Wants To Marry So That He Can Be Born In You.

Washed By A Marriage:

All These Women Were Washed By A Relationship With The Root And Offspring Of David And So Will This Bride Be.

We Are Washed By A Marriage And By The Marriage To Christ, We Share With Him His Character And All That He Is.

But Now We See Him In The Church, Sharing His Own Holiness With Us, Until In Him We Have Become The Very Righteousness Of God.

Yes, And There He Stands, "Jesus, Perfect Everything,"--lily Of The Valley, The Bright And Morning Star, The Fairest Of Ten Thousand, Alpha And Omega, Root And Offspring Of David, Father, Son And Holy Ghost--the All And In All.

- Rahab was washed by a marriage.
 Ruth was washed by a marriage.
- Bathsheba was washed by a marriage.

That Is Sovereign Grace From A Sovereign One.

Ruth 2:2-3

² And Ruth the Moabitess said unto Naomi, Let me now go to the field, and glean ears of corn after him in whose sight I shall find grace. And she said unto her, Go, my daughter.

³ And she went, and came, and gleaned in the field after the reapers: and her hap was to light on a part of the field belonging unto Boaz, who was of the kindred of Elimelech.

This Is The Message Of Grace Bringing You Into A Marriage Relationship With God.

And Remember That This Was A Moabitic Woman – She Come Through The Sin Of Lot And His Daughter.

The Marriage Of Grace Washed Them.

Ephesians 5:25-27

Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it;

That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word,

²⁷ That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.

Christ Calls You Saying, "Come Unto Me All Ye Who Are Messed Up By Sin" – I Will Get To Wash You In A Marriage Relationship Thou Filthy Gentile Woman.

Grace Will Pick You And Place You Into A Washing Relationship.

The Woman Caught In Adultery Was Brought Into A Washing Relationship – Go And Sin No More.

Those Are The Roots Of Grace.

Matthew Chapter 9, They Brought A Man Sick Of Palsy And When He Saw Their Faith, He Said, "Son, Be Of Good Cheer; Thy Sins Be Forgiven Thee".

He Was Brought Into A Washing Relationship And When The People Mummered, He Said, "For Whether Is Easier, To Say, Thy Sins Be Forgiven Thee; Or To Say, Arise, And Walk?

Grace Washed And Healed.

Luke 7:39

39 Now when the Pharisee which had bidden him saw it, he spake within himself, saying, This man, if he were a prophet, would have known who and what manner of woman this is that toucheth him: for she is a sinner.

The pharisees did not understand the roots of grace. Grace roots from evil in order to dress us with His own righteousness.

When Paul Teaches Grace, He Calls Him The "God Who Is Rich In Mercy".

What Is Your Condition? — We Have A God Who Is Rich In Mercy.

Luke 7:40-48

⁴⁰ And Jesus answering said unto him, Simon, I have somewhat to say unto thee. And he saith, Master, say on.

⁴¹ There was a certain creditor which had two debtors: the one owed five hundred pence, and the other fifty.

42 And when they had nothing to pay, he frankly forgave them both. Tell me therefore, which of them will love him most?

Simon answered and said, I suppose that he, to whom he forgave most. And he said unto him, Thou hast rightly judged.

44 And he turned to the woman, and said unto Simon, Seest thou this woman? I entered into thine house, thou gavest me no water for my feet: but she hath washed my feet with tears, and wiped them with the hairs of her head.

⁴⁵ Thou gavest me no kiss: but this woman since the time I came in hath not ceased to kiss my feet.

⁴⁶ My head with oil thou didst not anoint: but this woman hath anointed my feet with ointment.

47 Wherefore I say unto thee, Her sins, which are many, are forgiven; for she loved much: but to whom little is forgiven, the same loveth little.

⁴⁸ And he said unto her, Thy sins are forgiven.

Grace Picks You Up And Brings You Into A Washing Relationship By Marriage.

Grace Does Not Look At How Good You Are But Rather Goes Back Into The Lamb's Book Of Life To See Whether Your Name Is In There.

Once He Sees Your Name, He Pronounces That The Marriage Of The Lamb Is Come.

In Grace, God Takes The Initiative To Reach You.
