“These signs shall follow them
that believe!” He had faith in
what He was. And if you are a
believer, you have faith in what
you are:

you are a believer! And if
you've got faith in God, the
Bible says over here in... "If
our—if our hearts condemn us,
then we can't have faith;

but if our hearts don't
condemn us, then we have
faith, we have confidence
towards God.” If you want to
read that, found in Saint John
3:21. I got the Scripture
written down there.

66 Now notice, Saint John...I
mean First John 3:21. Notice.
*...if our hearts condemn us not,
then we
have confidence towards God.*

67 But as long as you're doing things that's wrong, you can't have confidence towards God. So, you see, you can...you'll automatically know that you're wrong.

You automatically put yourself back there a sinner, by knowing that you're wrong. But when your heart don't condemn you, and you know you are a believer,

and there's nothing between
you and God, you can ask what
you will and know that it'll be
given, because it's the Word
that's given to you just like it
was to those disciples.

Uh! Oh, my! I like that.

449 Jesus said, “At that day,”⁶⁸
that’s this day. “At that day,”
when this revelation is made
known, “you will know that I am
in the Father, and the Father in
Me; I in you, and you in
Me.” When the revelation is
made manifest,

“At that day ye shall know that I and the Father are One; I am in the Father, and the Father is in Me.” Then when the revelation comes forth, then it’s, “I in you, and you in Me.”

There you are. See the manifold,
threefold mani-...What for? To
bring it back. We've got to be...
As Jesus was the Word of God,
He vindicated the same.

have to do then, is have faith in
what you are. Have faith in
what the Word says you are!

And Jesus had faith in the
Word of God, that said what
He was, “It is written of
Me.” Didn’t David, in the
Psalms; and the prophets, and
all of them speak of Him?

“I am the Bread of Life that
come from God out of
Heaven.” Amen! “I am that
Tree of Life from the garden of
Eden. I am all these things, I
AM THAT I AM.”

And He knew with that Perfect Faith, that He was the anointed Messiah, that the Spirit of God was upon Him. He said, “Now, I, in Myself, do nothing; but it’s My faith in God.”

And God was in Him, the Word
made manifest. And when the
Word of God comes in you, It's
made manifest, for you are a
believer. See? And a believer is
“the faith of God that moves in
you.”

70 Knowing Who He was,
without a shadow of doubt, He

The Word of God identified

then don’t believe Me; but if—if I
don’t do them works,

don't believe Me. But if I do, then believe the works, for they are the manifested Word promised." Oh, if you could just wake up to that, a minute! You see, the Word Itself identified Him, Who He was.

And He said, “Who can
condemn Me of sin?” In other
words, “Who can show Me
that My life and My works
don’t fulfill exactly what
Messiah should do?”

Nobody could say nothing; for He was. Then He had faith to believe, then; of whatever He said, it would happen.

71 Then He turned around and said, “The works that I do, shall you also. A little while, and the world seeth no more; yet you shall, because I’ll be with you, even in you.”

Take no thought what ye shall say, for it's not you that speak, it's thy Father that dwelleth in you;

He's the One Who does the speaking. And It's not Me, It's the Father That dwelleth in Me, He doeth the works." See what I mean?

72 Now, the identification of a
Scripture Christian, these
Words said Jesus: “These signs
shall follow them that
believe.”

Now, how can you call yourself
a believer, a people, and deny
those Words? How can you call
yourself a believer and deny
any of this Word?

See? You can't do it. You're not
a believer, therefore signs
can't follow, because you just
accept what you want to
believe and let the rest of
It...you won't—don't believe
It.

But you got to take the whole
thing, and believe it. And when
you truly believe (not make
believe, but really believe),
then these signs follow them
that believe.

73 Oh, could you compare a
Christian today with them
Christians of long ago? How
them disciples walked in the
power of the Spirit, moved by
the Holy Ghost, do it.

Just a prisoner, as I preached
on the other night, a prisoner
to the Word and will of
God; he couldn't even move
until God moved him.

Wouldn't you like to see a
Church rise like that? It's going
to; going back. It's—it's got to
come. That's right. It's
go-...It's on its road now, I
believe.

11 Now we do have...and I think it's a good thing for us, as ministers, to follow our order, when we see such things in the world as we see today.

And we have an order from
God, is for the discerning of
spirits, trying the spirit.

I believe that that is a very
great lesson for the church
today, is to try the spirit of
anything, have discernment of
the spirit. I do not think that we
should ever, by any means,

ever try to judge a person by the denomination they belong to, or by the group that they are assembled with, whether they be Methodist, Baptist, Presbyterian, Pentecostal, or—or whatever they are.

We should never judge the
man by the denomination that
he belongs to. We should
always judge him by the spirit
he has, see, the spirit.

Whether he's latter rain or
former rain or inner, outer rain,
or no rain, or whatever it might
be, we should never judge him
by that, but, by his spirit.

We are to discern spirits.
Watch what the man has in
mind, what he has...what he's
trying to achieve. If the man,
by a gift, no matter how great
the gift is...

16 But if he has a gift of God
and he's trying to edify the
Body of Christ, then I don't
care what he belongs to.

You're not discerning the man,
you're discerning the spirit,
the life that's in the man. And
that's what God told us to do.
Not one time was we ever
commissioned to discern
the—the man's group.

But we was constrained and ¹⁴²
commanded by God to discern
the spirit in the man, what he's
trying to do, what the spirit in
his life is trying to lead him to.
And then if we can find out
that he's trying to lead the
people

(not to break them up, but to
bring them together) and to
bring the Church of the living
God, not all to one
denomination, but to an
understanding, a fellowship, a
unity of spirit.

Then if he is former rain or
latter rain, or whatever it is, his
spirit and his purpose is right.
And the spirit that's in him, no
matter what move he belongs
to, the Spirit that's in him is
trying to point the people to
Calvary,

away from himself or away
from anything else, but his
only achievement he has is to
point them to Calvary. He
doesn't care whether he's even
knowed or not.

He doesn't care whether even his own movement...which is fine, see, it's good, if he is a Methodist, or a Presbyterian, or a Roman Catholic, or whatever he wants to be by denomination.

36 And when a man is so
anointed with the Spirit...Now
let this go real deep under the
fifth rib on the left side.

When a man is anointed of the Spirit of God, his habits, his actions, and everything, is God moving in him. Sometimes he's misjudged.

57 Discern that spirit, see
whether it is of God or not. See
whether it acts like Him. See if
your emotions...

If somebody kicks up
something against you and
throws dirt upon your life,
when you know you're as
innocent as you can be, and
you know that you've got the
Spirit of God, don't try to
separate yourself.

Don't try to act mean towards
them. Don't curse them. Just
walk on, knowing that God did
that to give you a test to see
how you'd take it. He'll have to
come to it anyhow.
