What Is Thirst?

Psalm 42:1-2

1 As the hart panteth after the water brooks, so panteth my soul after thee, O God.

² My soul thirsteth for God, for the living God: when shall I come and appear before God?

Matthew 5:6

⁶ Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled.

65-0919 — Thirst 25 Then I was looking and

thinking about that word "thirst," so I looked up in the dictionary, to see what it means.

And here is what Webster says, "It's a painful desire," a painful, when you want something so bad until it becomes painful to you.

26 Now, it's—it's not an unnatural thing, to thirst. Thirst is a—a natural thing. It's just simply something that God has given us, that we could, to give us a—a desire for something.

Sometimes God has, also, has given you a—a control tower, something that sets inside of you, that—that controls these different desires.

And this thirst, this control tower that sets in a man's heart, is something that God give him to—to warn him of the desires that's needful for him.

27 Now there is two different kinds of thirst. There is a thirst, physically. And there is a thirst, also, spiritually. I would like to read this, what David said, again.

65-0919 — Thirst

29 Now we find, God gives the control tower to you, to give to you the things that you need.

Now, the control tower in you is what directs you. And this thirst runs in on this co-...tower, control tower, and tells you what you have need of, spiritually speaking.

The control tower in the body, and in the soul, also. There is a control tower in the body, that tells you the need that's needed in your body, and it's brought to you by thirst.

Also, there is a control tower in your soul, that tells you the spiritual things that you have need of, something in your spirit, and, and you by this can tell what kind of a life is controlling you.

30 When you—when you can see what your desires are, then you can tell, by that, what kind of something that's in you, that's creating this desire that you have.

See, there is a certain thing that you thirst for, and it—and it can tell you in your soul what this desire is, by the nature of the thirst that you have. I hope that you can understand that.

31 There is a—a control tower of the soul, and one for the body, and each tower is a warning caller for the needs of the other. Each one calls to the need for what the caller is calling for, it sends out a wave of warning.

32 For instance, the—the flesh thirst to satisfy the desires that's in the body, and the spirit desires for the things that's in the soul, desire is, and many times these war one against the other.

We find there, what's a great trouble today, that too many people try to live between those two desires. For, one of them desires the things of the earth, the other desires the things of Heaven.

33 Like Paul said, describes as in Romans 7:21, "When I would do good, then evil is nigh." When you try, did you ever have that in experience, Christians?

That when you're trying to do something that's worth-while, go to make an effort to do something that's good, then you find out that there is the devil, on every hand, just to upset you, everything that you'd...

And that's one good thing, that. I'd like to say this, that the Christians might know. That when you are—when you are starting to do something,

and there is something always trying to upset you in doing it, do it anyhow. That's the devil there, trying to keep you from doing what's right.

Your Desire Shall Be To Thy Husband

Genesis 3:16

¹⁶ Unto the woman he said, I will greatly multiply thy sorrow and thy conception; in sorrow thou shalt bring forth children; and thy desire shall be to thy husband, and he shall rule over thee.

¹³ Jesus answered and said unto her, Whosoever drinketh of this water shall thirst again:

¹⁴ But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life.

19 The woman saith unto him, Sir, I perceive that thou art a prophet.

65-1125 — The Invisible Union Of The Bride Of Christ 206 Life is a sacred thing, to God, and it's recorded in a book. God is the Author of life. Do you believe that?

207 Our natural life here, we have, is just a perversion. It really should be the right life, to begin with, but it's perverted by the natural birth.

The first life, or your first union, you were joined in at birth, by nature, a natural act.

A natural human being associated, man and woman together, associated together in sexual affair, which brought your first life here, and that's associated with sin and death. How can you miss seeing the serpent's seed?

212 Now, it was nature, associated with death. Your first husband, that had rule over you, was your nature by natural birth. Natural, you love the world because you are the world, and part of the world.

That right? Your desires was, by nature, to love the world which you're a part of. You're a part of nature. You believe that? And that's your natural thing.

213 That's the reason you have to be born again. You have to separate; you have to die to that first husband. You can't live with it. You just can't say, "Well, I'll divorce him, and hang him up here till occasion."

No, sir. No writing of divorcement! He dies. The nature of the world has to die. Every speck of him has to die. You have to be reunited, again, with another Nature.

214 Your name of your first nature, was born, and put in a book of life. And all your deeds was wrote in it, too. Everything you done under that nature was put in a book, called the book of life.

216 Now, you, but when you were separated from that union, by spiritual death: Your natural desire is to cut your hair. Your natural desire is to wear shorts, paint your face.

Your natural desire is to be intellectual, smart man, know something better than the other. That's what Eve wanted. That's the very thing she wanted.

218 That's what Eve took. She was pregnated with that kind of a pregnation. That's what the church is today, by Bible schools and intellectuals.

And, look, every one disagreeing with the other, a big mess just exactly what the Bible said, "Babylon."

219 The Bride knows where She stands. She is very few. There won't be many saved; just a very, very, very few.

You say, "Well, there, said, 'thousands." Yes. But they've come up through the two thousand years, too, on every age where It come out. Ever...

222 Well, you separated from your first union, by spiritual death. Now you are born again, or remarried again, to the new spiritual union;

of not your natural life of the things of the world, but of Eternal Life. That germ that was in you at the beginning, found you.

223 Now, your old book is gone, with your old union.
Now, your name in your old, in your...has been transferred.

Now, you say, "Do you mean to tell me that my old book..." God put it in the Sea of His Forgetfulness. You stand perfectly before God.

224 Now, your name is now in the new Book; not the book of life, but the Lamb's Book of Life, what the Lamb redeemed. Not the old book of your natural union, but your new, Bride.

Hallelujah! Your new life is in the Lamb's Book of Life, your marriage certificate, hallelujah, where your true Eternal germ, from the beginning, takes hold.

Now you're not only forgiven, but you're justified. Glory! "Justified," Romans 5:1 said. Yeah. Romans 5:1 said, "Therefore being justified by faith."

230 You never did it. Because, that little germ that was in you, was to be you, before the foundation of the world. God put your name in the Lamb's Book of Life.

65-1212 — Communion 44 Like in the Book here, and the spot there we was talking about the—the two Books being

One, the Book of Life.

The first Book of life coming up, was when you were born, that was your natural birth.

See? But then one time, way back down in there, there was a little grain of Life as I was explaining to some of the young sisters at the house this afternoon.

See, there's a little grain of Life laying there, that you wonder, "Where did It come from? What—what these strange things?"

45 I was saying this, taking for myself, like you was going to say, "William Branham, well, forty years ago, the William Branham, it isn't the same one tonight."

If somebody back there would say, "William Branham, he was a rank rascal," see, because I was born of Charles and Ella Branham.

In their nature I was a sinner, I came to the world, a liar, and all the habits of the world laid right in me.

But down in there, too, was another Nature present, see, predestinated, was in there by God. In this same body, see, two natures in there.

46 Well, I only catered to one. As it growed, I gooed as a baby, "Dad-da."

First thing you know, I become a liar, become everything else that's a sinner, because I raised up that way. But down in there was a little speck of Life all the time.

49 What was it? There was another William Branham. See? A little spot of Eternal Life down there, from the—the—the genes of God, the Word of God that was placed in there.

Each one of you can think of similar things. See, It was working.

51 Now, then one day as I walked on, that Voice talking, "Don't never smoke, drink, so forth." And the young fellows and all got older. See, there was Something moving.

52 But yet all at once I looked up, and I said, "I'm not the son of Charles and Ella Branham. There's Something calling."

Like my little eagle, "I'm not a chicken. There's Something up yonder, somewhere. O Great Jehovah, Whoever You are, open up! I want to come home. There's Something in me, calling."

Then I was born again. That little Life was laying there, the life of water was poured upon It, then It begin to grow.

Now, that old life was forgiven, put in the sea of God's forgetfulness, to never be remembered against me no more. See? Now we stand justified (as though we never had sinned) in the Presence of God.

Prison Now

36 Now, the soul of man is not the body of man, it's the soul. See? And the soul is something that's the—the nature of the spirit. And then when the nature of a man...

When he said, "We are dead," the Scripture plainly tells us that, "we are dead, and our lives are hid in God through Christ, sealed there by the Holy Spirit."

Now, it wasn't that your body died; it wasn't your spirit died. It was the nature of your spirit died; see, the nature, which is the soul. The nature of your soul is—is God, if you're born again.

If it's not, it's of the world.

Anything that begin has to end, so therefore the only way that you can have Eternal Life is to have a Life that never did begin.

And then your life did begin when you were born, when God breathed the breath of life into your nostrils and you became a living soul, then you begin then. But when you...

37 That nature that was in you, by nature you was of the world, alienated from God, you were actually an animal. That's exactly right.

Anyone knows that we are mammal. How many knows that? We, we are mammal, we are warm-blooded animal, but that is what we are by our earthly creation.

But, you see, what made us different from other mammals, that—that God put a soul upon us. See? Now, the other mammals don't have to wear clothes.

No other animal has to wear clothes to hide his shame, but us. We're the only ones that does, because we have a soul. But, see, God, in the beginning, knew what a man would be like. And He created the earth, and brought up all kinds of animals, from the very lowest to the highest; and the highest animal come forth, was man.

44 But, that soul that's in there, see, that soul is what God is working on, see. If He can only get that nature, that spirit, to agree with Him, then that nature dies,

the nature and the love of the world dies, and the things of the world is dead. See? Because, "If you love the world, or the things of the world, the love of God is not in you."

See? And a man must be born again. So, this nature has to die, and the nature of God comes and lives in you. And God is the only thing there is that never did begin or never can end.

Abraham And His Children

Hebrews 11:8-10,13-16

⁸ By faith Abraham, when he was called to go out into a place which he should after receive for an inheritance, obeyed; and he went out, not knowing whither he went.

⁹ By faith he sojourned in the land of promise, as in a strange country, dwelling in tabernacles with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise:

¹⁰ For he looked for a city which hath foundations, whose builder and maker is God.

13 These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of them, and embraced them, and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth.

¹⁴ For they that say such things declare plainly that they seek a country.

15 And truly, if they had been mindful of that country from whence they came out, they might have had opportunity to have returned.

¹⁶ But now they desire a better country, that is, an heavenly: wherefore God is not ashamed to be called their God: for he hath prepared for them a city.

2 Corinthians 5:1-4

1 For we know that if our earthly house of this tabernacle were dissolved, we have a building of God, an house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens.

² For in this we groan, earnestly desiring to be clothed upon with our house which is from heaven:

³ If so be that being clothed we shall not be found naked.

4 For we that are in this tabernacle do groan, being burdened: not for that we would be unclothed, but clothed upon, that mortality might be swallowed up of life.

56-1125M — A Secondhanded Robe 37 He knew the end from the beginning. He knew he was going to choose.

He knew Elisha would take Elijah's place, before the world was ever formed. Everything has to work just exactly right.

39 Now notice, in Elijah, then, after he threw his robe on him, and tried it on him. In other words, Elijah the prophet, who had the mantle of God on his shoulders,

he came down and laid it across Elisha, the farmer, to see if it would fit him. And it taken about ten years to get altered, to fit that mantle.

40 You know, God usually puts us in the shop and trims us up. Now, He didn't alter his robe to fit Elisha; He ordered Elisha to fit the robe.

And that's what He does today. He alters us to fit the robe, not the robe to fit us. Sometimes we want to make the robe fit us, but we can't do that.

You've got to (let) be altered, yourself, for the robe. It's God's robe, and He made it perfect. And we've got...He has got to bring us into that realm, to make the robe fit us.

42 Notice, all these years, as far as we know, he just had that one baptism of the robe going over him.

But through the years, God had molded the man's character into a place to where, after his call, that he would fit into the robe and be the servant of the Lord.

43 And then when Elijah passed through and throwed it on him, and they started up towards Gilgal and many of the other places they went,

on to the school of prophets, on their road, journeying on. And, finally, Elijah was trying to get Elisha to turn back. Did you notice it?

Trying to get him to turn back. Said, "I..." Otherwise, "Maybe the road is a little too steep for you, son. Maybe it's a little too narrow for you to walk."

44 You know, where Elijah was, was straightness. And wherever God's true servant preaches the Gospel, it's a straight, unadulterated Gospel where It's preached.

54 And then Elijah told Elisha, "You better turn back, because the way may be a little hard."

But a man of God who has once faced it, or been throwed across his shoulder the robe of God's righteousness and power, it's not too easy to turn back.

55 When I heard the pastor say, this morning, that our..."Many are becoming discouraged." What we need, brother, is take courage!

What we need is to be encouraged, that's right. Trials may come. We never was promised to be immune from them,

but He'll give grace to go through them. If the mountain is too high to go over, too deep to go under, too wide to go around it, He'll give grace to go through it.

That's right. Just don't worry, but keep your eyes on Christ, for He's the only One that can take us through.

58 Stay with it, no matter how much discourage, even it comes from your mother, your papa, or from your pastor. Stay with Him.

59 On to the Jordan they went. They crossed over. And Elijah said, "Now, what will you that I do for you?"

60 He said, "A double portion of your spirit to come upon me." He knowed he had a work to do. He said, "A double portion."

Not just a good warm experience, not just a good handshake, or a good fellowship with the rest of the church. But, "What I want is a double portion of what's the best now."

61 Itell you, when God sets a man for a world task, he has got to have something better than the world has got.

He has got to have something better than the church has got.
He has got to go for a double portion.

62 And if there ever was a time that a double portion is needed, it's today, in the realms of the people; something better, something higher.

I can't...I think beans and cornbread is very good, but sometimes I have to reach up a little higher. And we do that; we've got to.

We've got to keep climbing. Israel was backsliding if it kept staying on the same ground. She has got to be moving on or moving back. And that's the way the church is.

63 So, as they went along, it wasn't but a few minutes until he said, "You've asked a great thing, but, nevertheless, if you see me when I go, you can have what you asked for."

64 Now, that has to be singleness of motive, singleness of heart, singleness of eye, keeping your eye on the promise. Hum!

If you're sick this morning, if you're afflicted, there is one great promise; not by Elijah, but by God Himself. "If thou canst believe, when you pray, believe that you get what you ask for,

and you shall receive it." No matter what the doctor says, how much this goes or that goes; keep single on the promise.

65-0418M — It Is The Rising Of The Sun

138 And one day, the story goes, this old eagle flew over the barnyard.

She was looking everywhere, and she found him. Oh, for that resurrection, to recognize that he really wasn't a chicken, after all.

He was an eagle! And he was always taught to look down, look for a bug or something in the barnyard. But he heard a scream, that said, "Look up this way!" And he looked above him, and there was a creature with fourteen-feet wings, powerful-er than all the chickens there was in the barnyard, and claimed him to be her son.

He said, "Mama, how can I get to you?"

139 Said, "Just jump, start flopping your wings, for you're an eagle."

140 See, she knew she had a son somewhere. No matter what he's been raised up in, she's got a son somewhere.

141 And God knows! Hallelujah! He's got a predestinated, foreordained Church! He knowed He's got sons and daughters, and a Bride, waiting somewhere;

when the Holy Spirit begins to fly over it, that wave Sheaf. Oh, my! He's the same yesterday, today, and forever. Not some mythical story, but a reality!

142 No matter how many tried to tell him, "a eagle," he didn't know what a eagle was. Yet, he was a eagle.

He would not understood it until he seen something that reflected him, that he reflected, rather.

143 And when we see, not a denomination, not a Ph.D., not a LL.D., not a good neighbor; but a son of God molded in the image of God,

with the dynamic Power of God to answer the request of this day, that He's the same yesterday, today, and forever, there ain't no hen going to hold you.

He hunts for his Mama. He's an eagle, to begin with. He recognizes. This real eagle recognizes the call of God's Word. Why? He's an eagle. A eagle to a eagle!

The Word before the foundation, the Word to the Word! The Word, predestinated, to the Word written for the hour. You realize your position. He hunts for lt.

144 This then, this earthly body, is quickened and brought by the quickening Spirit of God to obedience to the Word of God.

65-0221E — Who Is This

Melchisedec?

87 His grandpa and grandma were eagles. He was a eagle, all the way back. Eagle don't mix with other things. He is not a hybrid at all, he is a eagle.

88 Then, after you recognized the very Word of God was Eagle Food, then you left the other thing.

You have then been formed into the living image of the living God. You heard from your theophany. "If this earthly body be dissolved, we have one waiting."

Our Theophany Is Represented By The Name In The Lamb's Book Of Life

346 Heavenly Father, oh, I—I just, sometimes, Lord, stand here and—and I tremble. I think of that awful hour that's approaching, and I...There is no way to stop it. It's predicted it would come.

And I thought of, "Why don't the people come and—and—and listen? And won't they come and accept It?" But, of course, I know that—that You—You said they wouldn't, so they won't.

347 <u>But there is some that's</u> got their names written on the Lamb's Book of Life.

And when them Seals are throwed open there, they see their name there, and the Holy Spirit speaks to them. They come. You can't keep them away; no one can, no one.

62-1230E — Is This The Sign Of The End, Sir?

128 And he said, "I dreamed a dream." And there it was! I just sat still, and I listened and watched.

He said, "I dreamed that there was a great big hill, like out in a field, where blue grass or something was."

And said, "Up on top of this hill, where the water had washed away the soil, there was a top rock, up on top the hill, like the top of the mountain. It was rock; no grass.

And where the water had washed down, it had cut some kind of readings on these stones. And you were standing there, interpreting this reading on these stones." And said, "All of us,"

and here is the way he put it, said, "the brethren from Georgia, and from all around, we were all standing together, listening to you interpret that mysterious writing on those stone, that mountain."

221 And, brother, sister, you will never be able to...Don't never try to hush that holy calling in your heart, see, by joining a church, by reciting a creed, by belonging to a certain organization.

222 There is only one thing can satisfy it, that's the Person, Jesus Christ. "As the hart panteth for the water brook, so my soul thirsts after Thee, O God.

My soul thirsts for the living God!" See, there is something in you, that wants to see the moving of God. Your soul thirsts for It. Don't stop anything short of That.
