#### David said, "Blessed is the man who God will not impute sin to." When you're washed in the Blood of the Lamb

(not by make-belief, but really the-the Blood of the Lamb), God does not impute to you anything that's done, because you're under the Blood and He doesn't see it.

There's a Blood sacrifice; the only thing He can see you in, is the way He saw you before the foundation of the world when He put your name in the Lamb's Book of Life.

That's all He can look at, because you are redeemed from everything that was ever done, you're washed in the Blood of the Lamb. Therefore there's no gall in you, there's no unclean habit in you,
