Joshua 6:1-5,15-21

6 Now Jericho was straitly shut up because of the children of Israel: none went out, and none came in.

² And the LORD said unto Joshua, See, I have given into thine hand Jericho, and the king thereof, and the mighty men of valour.

And ye shall compass the city, all ye men of war, and go round about the city once. Thus shalt thou do six days.

⁴ And seven priests shall bear before the ark seven trumpets of rams' horns: and the seventh day ye shall compass the city seven times, and the priests shall blow with the trumpets.

⁵ And it shall come to pass, that when they make a long blast with the ram's horn, and when ye hear the sound of the trumpet, all the people shall shout with a great shout; and the wall of the city shall fall down flat, and the people shall ascend up every man straight before him.

¹⁵ And it came to pass on the seventh day, that they rose early about the dawning of the day, and compassed the city after the same manner seven times: only on that day they compassed the city seven times. ¹⁶ And it came to pass at the seventh time, when the priests blew with the trumpets, Joshua said unto the people, Shout; for the LORD hath given you the city.

¹⁷ And the city shall be accursed, even it, and all that are therein, to the LORD: only Rahab the harlot shall live, she and all that are with her in the house, because she hid the messengers that we sent.

¹⁸ And ye, in any wise keep yourselves from the accursed thing, lest ye make yourselves accursed, when ye take of the accursed thing, and make the camp of Israel a curse, and trouble it.

¹⁹ But all the silver, and gold, and vessels of brass and iron, are consecrated unto the LORD: they shall come into the treasury of the LORD.

²⁰ So the people shouted when the priests blew with the trumpets: and it came to pass, when the people heard the sound of the trumpet, and the people shouted with a great shout, that the wall fell down flat, so that the people went up into the city, every man straight before him, and they took the city.

²¹ And they utterly destroyed all that was in the city, both man and woman, young and old, and ox, and sheep, and ass, with the edge of the sword.

⁶ Then the children of Judah came unto Joshua in Gilgal: and Caleb the son of Jephunneh the Kenezite said unto him, Thou knowest the thing that the LORD said unto Moses the man of God concerning me and thee in Kadeshbarnea.

⁷ Forty years old was I when Moses the servant of the LORD sent me from Kadeshbarnea to espy out the land; and I brought him word again as it was in mine heart.

⁸ Nevertheless my brethren that went up with me made the heart of the people melt: but I wholly followed the LORD my God.

⁹ And Moses sware on that day, saying, Surely the land whereon thy feet have trodden shall be thine inheritance, and thy children's for ever, because thou hast wholly followed the LORD my God.

¹⁰ And now, behold, the LORD hath kept me alive, as he said, these forty and five years, even since the LORD spake this word unto Moses, while the children of Israel wandered in the wilderness: and now, lo, I am this day fourscore and five years old.

¹¹ As yet I am as strong this day as I was in the day that Moses sent me: as my strength was then, even so is my strength now, for war, both to go out, and to come in.

¹² Now therefore give me this mountain, whereof the LORD spake in that day; for thou heardest in that day how the Anakims were there, and that the cities were great and fenced: if so be the LORD will be with me, then I shall be able to drive them out, as the LORD said.

And Joshua blessed him, and gave unto Caleb the son of Jephunneh Hebron for an inheritance.

1. This Is The Age Of The Overcomer-The Dispensation Of Overcoming...lts An Ongoing Work Of Grace!

62-0121E — The Marriage Of The Lamb 53 And, that, we know that there is going to be a Bride, and there's going to be a wedding supper served in the skies. That's just as sure to be, as God is, because it's His Word.

And we know that those that are going to make up that Bride is going to be His Church, and they're going to appear before Him without spot or wrinkle.

And they have the material on earth now to make themselves ready. If you notice, It said, "She has made herself ready."

54 So many says, "If the Lord will take this evil spirit from me, from drinking, or from gambling, or from lying, or stealing, I'll serve Him."

55 But that's up to you. See, you got to do something, too. "They that overcome shall inherit all things." They that overcome.

You have power to do it, but you must be willing to lay it down.
See? "She has made Herself ready." I like that Word.

56 You see, God could not push us through a little pipe, pull us out on the other end, and then saying, "Blessed is he that overcometh." You had nothing to overcome; He just pushed you through.

But you've got to make decisions for yourself. I have to make decisions for myself. In doing that, we show our faith and respects to God.

57 Abraham was promised a child, but he must maintain this promise for twenty-five years, the ups-and-downs that he had, and temptations, in those twenty-five years. But he held to the word of the promise.

58 And Israel was promised a promised land, but they had to fight for every inch of it. "Wherever the soles of your foot treads upon,

that have I given you," God said to Joshua. It was all there. The land was there, and God gave it to them, but they must fight for it.

59 The same way it is about Divine healing. God has got the power to heal you, if you've got the courage to accept it, but you'll fight every inch of the way.

60 God has got amazing grace to save you, and He will do it, but you'll fight every inch of your way.

61 I been behind the pulpit, going on thirty-one years, and every inch of that has been a fight, constantly. It certainly has.

62 "But we must fight if we must reign." So we find out that the Bride has to make Herself ready. "Be willing to lay aside every weight that does so easily beset us,

that we might run with patience the race that's set before us." We must lay them aside, ourself. We can't say, "God, You come, lay them aside for us." We got to do that, ourselves.

60-0515E — Adoption #1 34 Now, the Book of Ephesians, as I was just saying, I...to my opinion, is one of the greatest Books of the New Testament.

It leaves us, on where Calvinism runs out on one limb, and Arminianism runs out on the other limb, but the Book of Ephesian draws it together and positionally places the Church.

35 Now, I've typed it with Joshua. If you noticed, Israel was brought up out of Egypt, and there's three stages of their journey. One stage, was leaving Egypt. The next stage, was the wilderness. And the next stage, was Canaan.

36 Now, Canaan does not represent the age of the Millennium. It only represents the age of the overcomer, the dispensation of overcoming, because in Canaan they killed and burned and took cities. And there'll be no death in the Millennium.

37 But another thing that it does, it brings up justification by faith, after they believed in Moses and left Egypt.

Sanctification, to following under the Pillar of Fire and the atonement of the sacrificial lamb in the wilderness. And then entering into a land that had been promised.

38 Now, what is the land promised to the New Testament believer? The promise is the Holy Spirit. "For it shall come to pass in the last days," Joel 2:28, "that I will pour out My Spirit upon all flesh.

Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy. And upon My handmaids and My maidservants will I pour out of My Spirit, and they shall prophesy.

I'll show wonders in the heavens above. And in the earth, pillars of fire, and smoke, and vapour." And Peter said, on the Day of Pentecost, after taking his text and preaching,

"Repent, every one of you, and be baptized in the Name of Jesus Christ for the remission," to remit, to forgive, to take away all back trespasses.

39 Did you notice, Joshua, before they crossed Jordan, Joshua said, "Go through the midst of the camp and clean your clothes and sanctify every one of you,

and let no man come at his wife, for within three days you'll see the glory of God." See? It is a—it is a process of getting ready to inherit the promise.

Now, the promise to Israel, was, God gave Abraham the promise of the land, of Palestine, and it was to be their possession forever. And they was to always remain in this land.

40 Now, they come three stages, coming to this promised land. Now watch, it's perfectly typed in the New Testament.

41 Now this, as I have said, disagrees with some of the thinking of yours. Some of you precious Nazarene people, Church of God,

and so forth, don't let it hurt, but just watch it close and watch the types. Watch and see if every place don't hit just perfect.

42 There was three stages of the journey, and there's three stages of this journey. For, we are justified by faith, believing on the Lord Jesus Christ, forsaking the land of Egypt, come out.

And then are sanctified through the offering of His Blood, washed from our sins, and become pilgrims and sojourners, claiming that we are seeking a land, a city that's coming, or a promise.

43 So did Israel in the wilderness, sojourners, no place to rest, traveling night after night, following the Pillar of Fire, but finally come to the promised land where they settled down.

44 That's where the believer comes. He comes first to a recognition that he's a sinner;

then he is separated by the waters, the washing of the water, by the Blood, and...or the washing of the water by the Word, rather, believing on the Lord Jesus Christ.

Then, being justified by faith, he becomes a partaker, and a peace with God, through Christ, baptized into the Name of Jesus Christ, to omit him into the journey.

You get it? Into the journey! Then he becomes a sojourner and a pilgrim. He's on his journey to what? A promise that God made.

45 Israel had not yet received the promise, but they were on their journey. And without raising...Please do understand.

That's where you, the Nazarene and Pilgrim Holiness, and so forth, fell. Because, Israel, when they come to the spot, of Kadesh-Barnea,

when the spies went over and said, "The land is great," but some of them come back and said, "We can't take it, because the cities are walled up, and so forth." But Joshua and Caleb stood out,

and said, "We're more than able to take it!" Because of their already signed-up documated statements, they believed in two works of grace, justification and sanctification, and could not move any farther.

And, listen, that whole generation perished in the wilderness. But two that went over into the promised land and brought back the evidence that it was a goodly land,

"and we were more than able to take it, because it was God's promise." Then instead of the people going on, receiving the Holy Spirit, speaking with tongues, receiving the power of God,

the baptism of the Holy Ghost, signs, wonders, miracles, they felt that it would break down their tradition of doctrine. And what happened to it? Perished in the land! That's right.

46 But the believers, the Caleb and Joshua outfit, that was going on to the promise, they moved on over into the land, and took the land, and settled down in the land, as a possession.

And we never stop at justification, sanctification. Let's go on to the baptism of the Holy Spirit. Let's not stop at believing on the Lord Jesus, being baptized.

Let's not stop because He cleaned us up from a life of sin. But now we pressed on into a position, to a promise of the baptism of the Holy Ghost.

For Peter said, on the Day of Pentecost, "For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to them that's far off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call."

47 So, Ephesus here sets us like Joshua, positionally. You notice, Joshua, after crossing over the land, and taking the land, then he divided the land.

"Ephraim here, Manasses here, and this one here, Gad here, Benjamin here." He divided the land.

55-0119 — This Great Warrior, Joshua

15 Joshua, being the leader with Moses...The first time we hear of him about, he was holding up Moses' hands.

Now they journeyed, beautiful picture coming up out of the chaos of Egypt, out of the garlic pots, out of the world, crossing the Red Sea,

leaving the things behind, cutting loose every shoreline, as we call it today, coming out to walk in a strange land, among strange people, serving the Lord.

What a type of conversion, leaving Egypt, sandy, barren lands, to sojourn in a wilderness among strange people, but a promise that God would take you through.

God's promised tonight...When you come up out of the world, you separate yourself from all your earthly associates,

all the old parties you used to go to, the worldly amusements, drinking, smoking, gambling, all those things are separated. And you're walking among a strange people that you haven't known before, that say "Amen," and Spirit filled, believing in all things,

hoping all things, waiting for the coming of the Lord, professing to be pilgrims and strangers, nothing of this world, don't desire it, falling away from the things of the world. See what I mean?

Egypt, the children of Israel left the boasting physicians of Egypt to be with the great Physician. They left the garlic pots of Egypt to eat Angel's food.

They left the mudder—muddy waters of Egypt to drink from the spiritual Rock. Amen. You get it? On the journey, cut loose from Egypt, let them go.

16 And as they came through the water they were baptized unto Moses and to God. When they crossed over the Red Sea, they had a little spell of rejoicing.

Miriam got so excited that she grabbed the tambourine and begin to beat it and dance. And the daughters of Israel got excited too, speaking in terms today. And they begin to beat the tambourines and dance.

What was they dancing about? What was the excitement about? Because they looked and see all the Egyptians that once drove them to things, was dead in the Red Sea to bother them no more.

I tell you, Miriam, no wonder you have a little funny feeling tonight when them old things that used to drive you out to card parties and the social affairs of this world, when you see they are dead. You don't want them no more.

And you passed through the Red Sea, the blood cell's sprayed all over you, vaccinated you (Amen.), dehydrated you too, at the same time. Amen. That's right. Taken all the world out, sprayed you, DT, DDT, I believe they call it.

That takes all the bugs out. And when you come through God's DDT, it takes all the world out, kills all those parasites back behind.

That's what's the matter with the church today: they don't want to come through that spray. You want to pull a few things along with you.

Cut loose; let them go. Go through the spray the hard way. Separate yourself, it'll smother everything that's around you. Amen.

17 Here they come through the Red Sea. Then when they found out they was really through it, coming through that DDT back there, coming out, we found out the parasites.

I hope it burns deep. But the parasites, trying to do so, drown.

And these people who are trying to impersonate Christianity, living like the world, running around to every kind place they oughtn't to be, belonging to church and call themselves Christians,

God's spraying on his DDT today, separating His people, calling out, filling with the Holy Spirit, segregating them. You know the world wants separ—the world wants mixers.

God said, "Separate Me Paul and Barnabas." God wants separators. Separate yourself from the things of the world, then Christ will receive you.

18 Notice. Here they come out, and they were on their journey. Moses got to feeling real good, and the Spirit come on him,

and he raised up and sang a song in the Spirit, how God had overthrowed Pharaoh and his horsemen and his chariots. Then they were ready for the journey.

That's the way the Church is, when you've once come through the Blood of Jesus Christ, cleansed from all unrighteousness, then you're ready for the journey.

- You're on your road then; keep traveling.
- On and on they went, type of the Church.

But then, comparing that with the Lutheran age, they come up to a place then, they didn't have the full Gospel yet, and they come up to the place of Kadesh-Barnea.

Now, Kadesh-Barnea was where there was a great spring and lots of little springs around it, once the judgment seat of the world, a beautiful type of judgment. Judgment begins at the house of God truly. And there they camped.

19 And now, God told Joshua—or told Moses, rather, "Go out now and look around, and get a man out of every tribe, and send them over into the promised land,"

just a few days after he'd left Egypt. "Send them over now and spy out the land. And then come back and give me the report."

And when they went over across the little river Jordan, went over into the promised land, and begin to look around to see whether it was lean or whether it was good,

or whether it was of grapes or whether it was of fruits. When they come back, they climbed up and cut down a bunch of grapes that taken two men to pack them.

What a bunch of grapes. I think if a land with a curse on it will grow something like that, what will it grow when the curse is off of it?

20 Here they come back, but when they looked over into the land and seen all the Philistines, and the Amorites,

and the Hivites, and the Perizzites, and all of those fellows all walled up and setting in their big kingdoms and so forth, they quivered in their boots. They come back and said, "Oh."

When they called a counsel, brought all the children of Israel out, beautiful type now. And they stood up and said, "The land is beautiful. It's wonderful.

It would be good if we could have a revival like that. But we just can't do it. That's all." Said, "Oh, we're just prey to them." Said, "My," said, "well, they're way bigger. Why, they're giants and so forth.

And they're walled in. And it's impossible for us to take them. Oh, why did you bring us out of our churches out into this kind of a land?"

21 I want you to notice...This come in my mind just then. When Moses sent those ten spies over, it was in harvest of grape time: perfect type of Pentecost, first fruits. Pentecost was the—the in-gathering, the first harvest.

And when they was at Kadesh -Barnea, at judgment, then it was be determined on whether they could go on over and get the Holy Spirit or not, into the land of promise, where they'd promise.

You say, "Is that a promise?" Yes, Peter said, "Repent, be baptized every one of you in the Name of Jesus Christ for the remission of your sins, you shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

For the promise is unto you, and to your children, to them that's far off, even Chicago, as many as the Lord our God shall call."

We got too many people today saying, "It's too hard, we can't do it." We can. Harvest time... That's the reason they got this big bunch of grapes and brought it back, for a evidence.

I can see Caleb and Joshua, with that on their shoulders, marching down through there, just singing the jubilee song. Sure, they had the evidence.

They could prove that it was a good land. They brought it back and give all the children a grape if they wanted one off of one cluster. Just look what a bunch of grapes they had.

22 Now, Joshua and Caleb, when they heard all these murmuring, the people saying, "Oh, it can't be done, it can't be done,"

Caleb run out in the midst of the people and quieten them, said, "Yes, it can be." Joshua stood by him, said, "Certainly, it can be. God's given it to us." Amen.

I like that. Yes, sir. What was it? They were positionally born in Christ. They had a knowledge of the Word, and the Word become manifested.

Remember, every one of those Israelites had the Word of God preached to them. But it only taken effect upon Caleb and Joshua to realize what it was all about.

They said, "Oh, we can't do it." And the people begin to weep and begin to complain then, "Oh, why'd you bring us out?

We ought to have died. Now, our little ones are going to be killed and so forth. And we'll go over there, and only thing, we'll be butchered up over there with them. That's all it'll be."

That's the way they say today, "Oh, we can't accept this here Full Gospel message; we can't accept Divine healing."

Great big institutions and so forth, let one of their members believe in Divine healing and get healed, they'll turn them out. Don't tell me, I-I know.

62-1231 — The Contest

8For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against...rulers of...darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

9 "Spiritual wickedness in high places." And I'd like to draw from that a little ten or fifteen minutes context, or text, rather, I want to call it: The Contest. A contest is a test of strength. And we, where we have the...test strength. We used to have...

The Indian used to put a fire, and they would put so many man on this end of the rope, and so many on this end, and the—the tug-of-war, the contest of strength, would pull the losing party across the fire.

And now we know there's many things, and we could base this upon for a few minutes, of—of contest, but I want to speak for these minutes quickly upon the greatest contest there is,

that's, between the Church and Satan. That great strength of Satan. And we want to speak of the great strength of God in His Church.

10 Now, this great contest has been going on for many years. It started in Heaven, and Satan was kicked out into the earth, and then he become an enemy to God's people.

And, since then, he's used all of his strength and his strategy to try to pull God's people across the fires, or, into his fires.

11 And we know that Who has the most power, God does. And God, when He gave His people the best Thing that He could to combat Satan with, was His Word.

Now, because the Word is God, and who's stronger than God? So, the Word is God, and the Word becomes our strength.

God in the Church, becomes its Strength to pull Satan to his own fires that he has made. And the tug goes on. Now, Jesus said, in Mark 16, "In My Name they shall cast out devils."

61-0402 — The True Easter Seal 70 The Christian doesn't ask for easy things. We are not...

There's so much promises today made amongst Christian people, so many ministers promise the people a false thing, "If you'll just come to Christ, all your troubles is settled."

I tell you, when you come to Christ they then begin. That's when you put on a uniform and take a gun, and enter the battlefield. This Christian road is not a flower bed of ease.

It is a battle from the very hour you start, until your spirit is set free by death. You are not at no picnic. You are on a battlegrounds. And so we are promised things.

62-0701 - To Take On The Whole Armor Of God 58 Now, we're longing for somewhere there's no death, no sorrow, no heartaches, no old age, that Land is somewhere.

And we'll never be able to achieve it by guns, and fighting, and so forth, of the natural carnal weapons, but there is a Land that we can go to, and it's a battle to get there.

59 When God gave Israel Palestine when he was in Egypt, but they had to fight for every inch of it, and He told Joshua, in Joshua 1,

He said, "Wherever the soles of your foot treads upon, that I have given you." So footprints means possession. See, just keep walking, walking, pressing on.

And every time you make a step into the Kingdom of God, that's yours, just on...And all things are possible that's given, and all things are given is possible. But it's a battle.

66 And we are a army, the Christian Church is an army of God. We are soldiers, soldiers of the cross. And it is the business of every nation to see that their soldiers has the best that there is. Nothing...

67 And I was preaching the other night about achievement at another meeting somewhere, and I talked about our American soldiers.

When Washington was at Valley Forge, about half of them had on shoes, they were bare-footed, but they had a general that prayed all night, he swept across the Delaware the next day.

That's why we got America. It's men, gallant men who had something to fight for, we should never let them down.

68 Now, they had muskets in them days, knives, that's the best they had. Any nation...They had the best we could give them. And today, look at the difference in our army today than there was then.

69 But you know, when God...Being infinite, infinite He cannot change. There's where my faith rests, is on God's Word, because It is God. And Himself...

70 See, a Word is a thought expressed. And when God thinks anything is in His mind, and then when He expresses it, it's Eternal.

Because no man is any better than his word, and God is Eternal, and His Word is Eternal with Him, because It is part of Him. And you are part of your own word, and God is part of His Own Word.

71 Now, I can say anything, or the nation can say anything, in a year or two they have to keep improving it. But God is perfect, and His first decision is...

He cannot change it anymore, because it's perfect, 'cause God would not do anything unless it was perfect. So when God...

72 The first battle that was ever fought was not fought on the earth, it was fought in Heaven, Michael and his Angels against Lucifer.

And they were kicked out of Heaven, and then that great army of the devil and all of his imps fell upon the earth. And God knowed there was going to be a battle.

73 And I believe He knowed from the very beginning everything that would ever be. If God is infinite, He knowed every flea that would be on the earth, every gnat, how many times it would bat its eye, and how much tallow they'd all make together. He is infinite.

74 So, the infinite God, going to choose for His army the best Weapon that could be given, and He chose It, and It was His Word. God gave His army the best Equipment that it could ever use,

and ever could use, and would never have to be changed, and He has never changed It since. You don't improve It, It remains the same all the time. It is God's Word that He fortified His people with.

75 No matter how many things Satan ever gets, how many things any other army ever gets, or anything, it can never take the place of God's first choice, His Word.

He gave them His Word, His promise, and said, "Stay with It," the best that could be known.

76 Now, the enemy knowed as long as the human race stayed with that Word, he would never be able to touch them, (Now, I'm beginning to feel religious right now.), as long as the human race stayed with the Word.

God fortified His family on the earth, His army, in the Fort of His Word, that is our Fortress. "The Name of the Lord is a mighty Tower, the righteous run into It and are safe," they are fortified.

77 The Lord is the Word. They are in There fortified and safe for evermore, as long as the human race stays in the Word. Long as the Church stays in the Word, It is fortified, there's nothing going to bother It.

63-0114 - A Trumpet Gives An Uncertain Sound 102 Now, Paul said, in the Scriptures, like training a soldier, a soldier to a sound.

Now, a soldier has got to learn the sounds of his...of the bugle or the trumpet. He doesn't know if the trumpet go, blows, whether to—to charge or whether to retreat.

If he doesn't know the difference, what kind of a mixed-up army would you have? The enemy would certainly triumph over a bunch of soldiers that were no better trained than that. Amen.

103 That's what's the matter with our churches today. We're trained them on creeds, differenting one to the other.

104 We got to be united. We've got to know a trumpet. "Then which is the trumpet?" they say. The Gospel trumpet, that's lt. The Word of the living God is the Trumpet. Don't mix nothing with It.

105 Don't have somebody play a French harp, and the other one blow a bugle. Nobody knows what to do. It brings a confusion.

106 And Paul was talking about training a man to a sound. And just as that sound is, he knows exactly what to do, because the bugler has got orders, and from the chief captain.

And when he sounds this trumpet, the army knows just exactly the place to—to advance, and where to withdraw, and whether to turn right or left, or what to do, by the sounding of the trumpet.

107 Now, army, war, it's always been war. We never joined the Church, or come into the Church, to come to a picnic. We must realize we are coming to a battleground.

108 I never come for people to pat me on the back and say, "Brother Branham, you're a wonderful person."

No, sir. I come there with a shield on. I don't need a shield for that. I come with a helmet and the armor. I come to fight, fight every inch of the ground.

109 God told Joshua, "Every place the soles of your foot treads upon, that I give you." So, footsteps meant possession.

110 And when the church gets to a place, it compromises with creeds, and compromises with the Word, and compromises with the world, I mean, then it's losing ground. It's taking back.

111 What we need tonight is soldiers to possess every Divine promise of this Bible, that God promised to the Church, whole armor of God, and to stand.

It's what we need, soldiers; not get a uniform for a dress parade, it's always different. When a man...

61-0618 - Revelation, Chapter Five #2

37 Now, Satan will constantly punch at you until you're finished here on earth. Just remember that.

You'll never have a time but what there's a punching going on all the time, 'cause you're in a battle. Did you ask to come to Christ, to going to a picnic?

Well, you're sure going to be surprised, because it's a constant battle. I've been on the field for thirty-one years, and I've fought every inch of the way.

That's right. Israel had to fight every inch of the way. They—they...Palestine was given to them, but they had to fight every inch of the way to get it.

67 There has to be a place selected. And in this, there's a—a mutual ground, no-man's-land, and they fight here at this place. They just don't, one fight over here, and one down here, and one run over here.

There's a battle front where they meet and test their powers, where each army tests its strength against the other army, a mutual meeting place. Now, don't (get) miss this.

68 When this great battle started on earth, there had to be a mutual meeting place. There had to be a place selected for the battle to begin, and for the battle to rage.

And that battlegrounds begin in the human mind. There is where the battle starts. The human mind was chosen for the place of the battle, where it was begin,

and that is because that decisions are made from the mind, the head. Now, they never started it from some organization. They never started it from some mechanical affair. The grounds never started there.

291 Charlie, Rodney, It was He down there in Kentucky; and Nellie, Margie, and the rest of you. It was He, that same God that was back there and spoke to Moses, said, "Why do you cry to Me?

Speak the word!" It was He that brought them into existence. It's He. It's Him. Oh, my!

292 It was He that give the vision about a year ago, that said we would go over there, and these Seven Seals, and how there would be a—a—a great thunder that would start it off,

before thirty thousand people that night, in the Sam Houston Coliseum, when that Angel of the Lord had His picture taken, standing there. It was He, the same yesterday, today, and forever.

300 It was He that foretold where these things to be. It was He that said this. It was He that done these things. He's the same yesterday, today, and forever. He's done everything just exactly like He said He would do it. Amen.

301 Why should I wait? God has a vindicated the Word. It's the Truth. Let's journey. Let's walk. Let's go on the walk of the Lord, laying aside all doubts, all sins. Clean up the house, scrub it up.

And that night he was drinking. And I woke up with a great burden on my heart for him. And just with my pajamas on, slipped on my trousers, my pajama shirt left on;

I wandered out through this broom sedge field, to just about where this stands now, and I knelt down to pray for my father.

15 And while I was praying and asking God to save him and not to—to let him die a sinner, that I loved him;

and while I was in prayer, I raised up to look up towards the east from here, and there was a vision. And standing just above me, many of you knows the vision, was the Lord Jesus.

16 Now, I'm not allergic to illusions, as I know of. But visions are real. And there stood the Lord Jesus, the first time I had ever saw Him in a vision of that type.

He was just about, oh, probably ten feet above my head, standing in mid-air, with one foot just making a step. He had on a white garment, a fringe around the side of it. He had hair down to His shoulders.

Somewhere, it was right in this vicinity, within, with a radius of where I'm standing, the best I could measure off, within forty or fifty yards of somewhere around in this district here, this circle.

19 And I looked up, and He was standing there. And I bit my finger, to see if I was asleep. You know how you...Just seems like it couldn't be so. And I was just young in the Lord then, about six months I had been preaching.

I bit my finger. I took the broom sedge and broke it off. And many of you people who live in the country, know what that little toothpick, like, is in the broom sedge.

I begin to chew on that. And I said, "It—it can't be. I'm dreaming. There is my home. There is father, mother, and the children there.

There is the old brick house pond that used to stand down here, where I used to hunt ducks, just about two hundred yards beyond this. And here I am standing in the field; it's got to be so."

I'm more or less inclined to believe that it was a vision. That, I had my hands out, saying, "Lord, what does this blast mean?

And what does these seven Angels in a constellation of—of the pyramid, picking me up from off the ground and turning eastward, what does it mean?"

11 I was standing there, in prayer, and something happened. And, now, something fell in my hand. And I know, if you don't understand spiritual things, it may seem very strange.

But something struck in my hand. And, when I looked, it was a sword. And the handle was made of pearl, the prettiest pearl I ever seen. And the—the guard, you know, where...

15 Even though the sword be the Word, it takes the hand of strong faith to hold It there, to bring It to the heart of the enemy. Now, not knowing these things, but just...

All that I have received of Him, that I can tell, I have told you. So, that, you know, I believe it was...Wasn't it our Lord said, all that He had received of the Father, that He had told, and withheld nothing?

And—and so we want to do those things just as they come. Now, if you'll be real wise, and pray, I'm sure you'll understand something pretty soon, now, something that I hope is revealed.
