The Certainty Of The Promise Of His Coming

1. The Descending Of The Lord Is Both Prophetic And Fulfilled Scripture

<u>Daniel 2:45</u>

45 Forasmuch as thou sawest that the stone was cut out of the mountain without hands, and that it brake in pieces the iron, the brass, the clay, the silver, and the gold; the great God hath made known to the king what shall come to pass hereafter: and the dream is certain, and the interpretation thereof sure.

64-0830M - Questions And Answers #3 362. Please explain the mystery of the translation of the Bride. 242 Just a change, see, our bodies. Now, let's say our. You know what I mean when I say that?

I don't mean to be sacrilegious. I don't mean to say ours; I don't mean to say this church; I mean to say every believer. 243 Abraham, he was looking for a promised son, that was promised him. Is that right? And the Church is looking for a promised Son. The Bride (is that right?), the Bride is looking for the promised Son.

244 Before the promised son could come to Sarah and Abraham, their bodies had to be changed. Is that right?

245 She was too old to have a baby. She had no milk veins in her breast; her breast was dried up. Her womb wasn't fertile; she was sterile.

She could not have the baby; her heart was too old to stand labor. So what happened? God changed her back to a young woman.

And He did Abraham the same thing, 'cause He said his body was as good as dead. See? And He had to change their body in order to receive the promised son.

246 And we cannot receive the promised Son that's promised us today in these bodies that we live in; these bodies are sin.

247 This first conscience controls this body with see, taste, feel, smell, and hear, and has just got us all scrupled up; we reason and everything else.

But that new body, that comes 16 from this borned again (not this first conscience, it'll pass away)...lt's that inside something that lives. Everybody understand it say, "Amen!" [Congregation replies, "Amen!"—Ed.]

248 It's not this outside see, taste, feel, smell, and hear. It isn't. It's subject to death and will die, but the inside part of you, down in here, inside, that is the, person that cannot die. See?

And that's the person that the new life starts from, from this new birth; and it builds another person in the image of this person you are, around that life. You get it?

249 So potentially it's in here, and what is it? The Word promised before the foundation of the world. And around there, this only reflects the negative; that will reflect the positive, the Word. See?

And the same thing is...Or, the translation of the Bride will be the same thing. The Word that's in you, the body will materialize around that Word, and the same thing did by Sarah.

250 Before...When that old body that she had, that first body, it had to be changed in order to produce a son. You get it?

That body could not do it. This body cannot do it, so it'll have to be changed the same way to receive the Son.

60-0303 - Former And Latter

Rain

18 That's the same thing that took place here. The—the tower man had warned the people all day long; he says, "I see the dust.""Why" they said, "nothing, I don't see no dust."

"Why, I know there's approaching army." And they went right on just the same. That's the way they're doing, the same thing today. Any man could read a newspaper,

if he's got any spiritual discernment about him at all, can see that we're at the end. The hour is here; there's nothing left for us but the coming of the Lord Jesus. Some people go out and say,

"Oh, that might be a thousand years from today." I don't believe that. I believe this generation will see the coming of the Lord Jesus. If this generation doesn't do it,

I want to preach to the young people that they'll be looking for it in their generation. I believe it'll be in this generation, 'cause the fig tree's putting forth its buds yonder,

and Jesus said, "That generation will not pass till all things be fulfilled." Israel's restored, herself; she's a nation. All the signs and wonders that was to take place in the last days, it's here.

We must cry out from the tower, from the high place that God places you in, and warn the people. But they—seem like they just go dumbly right on, as they did in that time.

54-0401 - God's Preparation 24 And so God prepares and sends voices of warning. And He's always made a preparation. Just before He sent Elijah up on the Mount Carmel,

there to prove that He was God and—and the nation had gone wrong, well, He sent Elijah out to give a warning and to make preparation for these things.

And He always does that: God provides a way every time for the people. And then if the people reject His mercy, there's only one thing left to do and that is for His judgment.

28.....And he looked over there and there stood Gabriel, the Archangel. And he told him not to fear, that after days of his ministration there at the building,

at the—Shiloh, that he was going up—or the temple—and he was going up and—to be with his wife; and she was going to conceive and bear a son.

Well, that man, with all the background of the Bible, yet just because he'd been associated with the ritualistic form of the church, he said, "How could these things be? Well, she's old and I am old. How could these be?"

He said, "I'm Gabriel, that stands in the Presence of God." He said, "Because you doubted My Word, they'll be fulfilled in their season, but you'll be dumb till the day the baby's born."

29 Say, you better believe God. That's right. When God speaks anything, it's going to happen anyhow. No matter if all the whole rest of the church world downs it, God's going to bring it to pass anyhow.

When He said He's going to, He's going to do it. That's the reason today, that we know that the things that Jesus said that He did, would be repeated again before He come.

And it's got to be. His ministry,
His life, His power, just as He
was here on earth then, so is
He now.

It's got to be, because Jesus said so. And Jesus said, "The things that I do, shall you also; even more than this, for I go to My Father." Is that right? So there's nothing unscriptural.

64-0802 - The Future Home Of The Heavenly Bridegroom And The Earthly Bride

175 Heavens and earth will pass away, now, this word means, "passing from one form to another."

It does not mean "annihilation," as the English word would mean, pass away, it's annihilated. But the Hebrew word, or the Greek word here, does not mean pass away;

it means, "from passing from one thing to another." Look, but, "to pass from one condition," it says, "to another."

176 Now notice, Paul used it, if you want to read it now. Put it down, you can read it later. In Titus 3:5, Paul is using this same word, means regeneration of man, that man has passed from a sinner to a saint, not completely annihilated.

When a man is changed, he isn't annihilated, but he's a changed person. He has been changed from what he was to what he is, not annihilated.

177 Jesus used the same word in Matthew 19:28; now, not 28:19. Now, 19:28, He said to them, "You'll set with Me in My Father's Kingdom, regenerated," you see, "changed," when you're changed. He used the same word.

178 And He used the same word when He said, to the colt, said, "Loose the colt and let him go."

179 Said the same thing at the resurrection of Lazarus, "Loose him! Change him! He's been tied; let him go!"

180 What does it mean? The earth will be loosed from the grip of Satan. It'll be loosed. It'll be loosed from politics, it'll be loosed from denominational religious systems; to be used for the Kingdom of God, to be establish it here on the earth.

But as long it's in the hands of Satan, politics...Satan the ruler of the earth, he owns it; it belonged to him, but now Christ has redeemed it.

181 One time, I was his property, but not now. One time, that little woman was his property, but not now.

See, He come to loose the grip of it. He loosed the grip of sin, of Satan, upon my life, upon your life, and now we're not his.

182 Have you often heard me say, in prayer, "take your hands off of God's property"? See? Amen! Have faith to claim your own. That's your rights. "Take your hands off of her!

Take your hands off of him!" See, faith will do it. Oh, my! Not annihilate it, but, just, "Take your hands off of it," to loose it, let it go, pass it away. It changes.

183 The earth will change. Politics will change. The religions will change. The denominations will pass away. Politics will pass away. The Kingdom of God shall be established.

184 We read in John, read John in Revelation 6:14, see, "it departed as a scroll." The Bible said the...that it...John said, "I saw the heaven and earth depart as a scroll." John, Revelation 6:14.

185 Jesus said, "Heavens and earth shall pass away," or, other words, "heavens and earth shall be changed." See, used that same word right there again.

186 No, not annihilated. For, later, in Revelation 21:2 to 24, he seen the New Jerusalem coming down from God out of Heaven, and sitting upon this earth. It doesn't mean it'll be annihilated. The systems will be changed.

187 Daniel saw the same thing. A Rock struck the world, was hewed out without hands; and the whole image of the systems was broke down and become like chaff on a summer threshingfloor, and the wind packed it away.

And the Rock, Itself, grew into a great Mountain that covered the earth. Watch that Mountain now, in a little bit. That Mountain covered the earth.

2. Scoffers Will Be On The Land To Reproach And Impersonate The Truth

2 Peter 3:4-18

⁴ And saying, Where is the promise of his coming? for since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of the creation.

⁵ For this they willingly are ignorant of, that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water:

⁶ Whereby the world that then was, being overflowed with water, perished:

⁷ But the heavens and the earth, which are now, by the same word are kept in store, reserved unto fire against the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men.

⁸ But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, that one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.

⁹ The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

¹⁰ But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up.

¹⁷ Ye therefore, beloved, seeing ye know these things before, beware lest ye also, being led away with the error of the wicked, fall from your own stedfastness.

¹⁸ But grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. To him be glory both now and for ever. Amen.

65-1204 — The Rapture 143 And the denominational system is dead. It's gone. It'll never rise again. It'll be burned. That's what you do with the husk on the field.

Flee from it. Get into Christ. Don't say, "I belong to Methodist. I belong to Baptist. I belong to Pentecostal." You get into Christ.

If you're in Christ, there's not a Word written in Here but what you believe It. I don't care what anybody else said. And then God makes that thing manifested.

Cause, you, when He pours the Spirit upon the Word, what happens? Just like putting water on any other seed. It'll live, and It'll bring forth of Its kind.

144 You say, "I got the baptism, the Holy Ghost." That don't mean that you're saved, not by a long ways.

145 Looky here. You are a triune being. You are. Inside this little fellow here is the soul, the next is the spirit, and next is the body. Now, you got five senses in this body, to contact your earthly home.

They don't contact the rest of it. You got five senses of the spirit, here: love and conscience, and so forth, of that. But in here is where you live. That's what you are.

146 Didn't Jesus say, "The rain" falls on the just and the unjust"? Put a cocklebur out here, and a wheat out there, and pour water on them, and keep them under fertilize and things like that, won't they both live by the same water?

Sure. Well, what is it? One of them will bear a cocklebur, 'cause that's all he is. The cocklebur will raise his hands and shout just the same as the wheat.

147 Don't the Bible say, "In the last days, there shall come false Christs"? Not "false Jesus," now. "False Christs," anointed ones, falsely anointed to the Word; denominational anointed, but not to the Word.

For, the Word will bear record of Itself. It don't need nothing else. It'll bear record to Itself. "And there will come false anointed ones."

- You got my tape on that. And that anoi...
- Oh, if you'd call one of them, say, "Oh, you, are you a Jesus?" "Oh, certainly not." They wouldn't stand for that.

148 But when it comes to an "Oh, glory! I got the anointing!" And it's the genuine anointing. Remember, Caiaphas had It, too, and prophesied. So did Balaam have It, and prophesied.

But that don't have nothing to do with this, inside. Unless that was God's seed, His gene from the beginning, predestinated, you're finished.

I don't care how much you shout, speak with tongues, run, shout. That has nothing to do with it.

A cocklebur can count just as much as any the rest of them.

I've seen heathens raise, and shout, and speak in tongues, and—and drink blood out of a human skull, and call on the devil. See? So you don't...Any of them sensations and things, forget it.

It's your heart in that Word, and that's Christ. Bring in there, and watch It make Itself known, just as It opens up like any other seed, and declares Itself for the age It's living in.

149 Luther could bring nothing but sprig. These others could bring these other things. We're in the wheat age now.

Luther's genuine Luthers had to bring forth genuine Luther. Genuine pentecost had to bring genuine pentecost. That's all. But we're past that age, and going on.

3. God Who Swore To Abraham, Has Sworn To The Promise For Abraham's Seed

Hebrews 6:9-20

⁹ But, beloved, we are persuaded better things of you, and things that accompany salvation, though we thus speak.

10 For God is not unrighteous to forget your work and labour of love, which ye have shewed toward his name, in that ye have ministered to the saints, and do minister.

¹¹ And we desire that every one of you do shew the same diligence to the full assurance of hope unto the end:

¹² That ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises.

13 For when God made promise to Abraham, because he could swear by no greater, he sware by himself,

¹⁴ Saying, Surely blessing I will bless thee, and multiplying I will multiply thee.

And so, after he had patiently endured, he obtained the promise.

¹⁶ For men verily swear by the greater: and an oath for confirmation is to them an end of all strife.

¹⁷ Wherein God, willing more abundantly to shew unto the heirs of promise the immutability of his counsel, confirmed it by an oath:

¹⁸ That by two immutable things, in which it was impossible for God to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us:

¹⁹ Which hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and stedfast, and which entereth into that within the veil;

Whither the forerunner is for us entered, even Jesus, made an high priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec.

62-0318 - The Spoken Word Is The Original Seed 213 Oh, people, God bless you! Hear me! I can't believe nothing but God's Word.

I want It to be my life, everything that I am. I want you to do the same. Let your walks, your talks, your moves, everything you do, be in the Word of God.

Let the mind of Christ come into you, and—and that'll pregnate you with the Word. If you don't, if you let the mind of the denomination come in, you'll be denominational pregnated.

If you let the mind of Christ come into you, He can't deny His Own Word, 'cause He's God. You be pregnated with the Word, and believe It.

I don't care if they put you out, kick you out, run you out, and every door is closed, you'll go just the same. Amen. Whew! I got to hurry now. Ah!

214 Christ is now taking Himself a Bride, to be pregnated with His Own Seed-Word in Her womb, spirit-womb in—in Her mind, and won't mix with any the denominational trash with it. She is a virgin to Him.

215 Oh, I remember sitting there in a room, three days in there, praying and waiting on the Lord, and fasting. When that struck me, I thought, "O God, what is it? Here I am, in a picture. Here I am.

If I bring up this much to the church, where will I be? I'll be have them on a limb. What can I do? I've done seen the church as every type and shadow, and everything else, shows she's gone. What will You do?"

216 Then I thought of that Word, "I will restore, saith the Lord. I will restore." Remember the old pine tree, when the fire hits her and burns her down; she shakes off a seed, though.

That seed brings forth a new one. That's right. The old trees are burnt up with organization and everything else, but there still remains a Seed of Word.

And it...the Wo-...God's Word, It'll just come right back, reproduce Itself, just as sure as the world. Yes. Now, now, she won't miss it. Notice. But Christ...

217 We believe we're in the end time. Do we? [Congregation says, "Amen."—Ed.] Do you believe that before you have a crop, now, you have to plant a seed? ["Amen."]

You see why I've let churches turn me out, tell me everything, call me all kinds of names, everything else, and just stay right with that Word? ["Amen."] See? There's a plant, Seed been planted.

It's already been planted, friend. It's already done. I can say it now. It's over. Right. She's done been planted. Oh, yeah. So is denominational seed, all the rest of them.

- That's Christ in the Church today, taking His Wife back. See the threefold mystery now? ["Amen."] God manifested in Christ;

Christ manifested in the Church; all together, to bring back the original Adam and Eve again, man and woman, which are one, made out of the same Blood and same Spirit, and everything else.

434 The Church is the Blood of Christ, by the Spirit, because the—the Life is in the Blood.

That's the baptism of the Holy Chost that baptizes us into His Body, that recognizes only His Body, His flesh, His Word. [Brother Branham pats his Bible—Ed.]

435 Denomination won't, never touch that. It's a revelation. She knows it. So did Eve know it, but she fell; but this one knows it, and won't fall.

She is ordained! Hallelujah! Whew! She is ordained to not fall. She won't fail. She is predestinated to it. "Blessed is the man who God will not impute sin."

You ministers know what I'm speaking of, when there's a couple dozen of you sitting here. See? "Blessed is the man who God will not impute sin," David.

436 Notice, redeeming back, with Him, going Home; back to Eternal Life in a human body, eating, drinking, living forever.

62-1230E - Is This The Sign Of The End, Sir?

241 The seventh angel of Revelation 10:7 is the seventh church-age messenger. See? Now watch. "And in the days..." Now watch here:

But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall begin to sound, the mystery of God should be finished,... 242 Now, sounding forth, this messenger, the seventh angel here is sounding forth his Message to the Laodicean church. Notice his type of Message.

Now, it wasn't to the first angel, wasn't given That; second angel, third, fourth, fifth, sixth. But it is the seventh angel that had this type of Message.

What was it? Notice his type of Message, "Finishing all the mysteries of God, that are written in the Book." The seventh angel is winding up all the mysteries that's laying loose-ended,

all out through these organizations and denominations. The seventh angel gathers them up, and finishes the entire mystery. That's what the Bible said, "Finishes the mystery of the written Book."

243 Now let's note a few of these mysteries, and if you want to write them down. First, I'll take what Scofield says here, in Matthew 13.

If you'd like to type some of them down, if you haven't got a Scofield Bible, you might read what he thinks some of the mysteries are. Now, in the 11th verse:

And he answered and said unto them, Because it's given to you (His disciples), because it is given to you to know the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven, but not to them, but to them it is not given.

244 The mysteries, here is "the mystery." A mystery is Scripture, is a previously hidden Truth now Divinely revealed, but (which is) a supernatural element still remains despite the revelation. The greater mysteries and the great mysteries are:

245 Number one, the mystery of the Kingdom of Heaven. That's the one we're talking on now. 13, Matthew 13:3 to 50.

246 Now, second mystery is the mystery of Israel's blindness during this age. Romans 11:25, with the context.

247 Third, third mystery is the mystery of the translation of the living saints at the end time of this age. First Corinthians 15, and also Thessalonians 4:14 to 17.

248 The fourth, mystery of the New Testament Church as one Body composed of both, Jews and Gentiles. Ephesians 3:1 to 11, Romans 16:25, and also Ephesians 6:19, Colossians 4:3. 249 The fifth mystery is of the Church as the Bride of Christ. Ephesians 5:28 to 32.

250 Sixth mystery is of the living Christ, same yesterday, today, and forever. Galatians 2:20, and Hebrews 13:8, and many places like that.

251 The seventh mystery is of God, even Christ as the incarnate fulness of the Godhead embodied, in Whom all Divine wisdom...

252 ...and godliness is restored to man.

253 Ninth mystery is the mystery of iniquity, found in Second Thessalonians, and so forth.

254 The tenth mystery is of the seven stars of Revelation 1:20. We just been through that, "The seven stars of the seven churches, the seven messengers," and so forth.

255 And the eleventh mystery is mystery Babylon, the prostitute. Revelation 17:5 to 7.

256 That's some of the mysteries that this angel is supposed to wind up, all "the mystery," all the mysteries of God.

And the other, and may I say this with reverence, and not referring to myself, but referring to the Angel of God: 257 The serpent's seed, that's been a hidden mystery, all through the years.

258 The grace, straightened out; not disgrace, but real, true grace.

259 No such a thing as an Eternal, burning hell. You'll burn for millions of years. But, anything that was Eternal, had never a beginning or a end; and hell was created. All these mysteries!

260 The mystery of the baptism of the Holy Ghost, without sensation, but the Person of Christ performing in you the same works that He did.

261 The mystery of water baptism. Where, the extreme trinitarianism has brought it into titles of "Father, Son, Holy Ghost."

And the mystery of the Godhead being fulfilled in the baptism of the Name of "Jesus Christ," according to the Book of the Revelation, that the Church in this time was to receive.

There is some of the mysteries.

262 The Pillar of Fire returning back. Amen! That's the thing that's supposed to take place, and we see it. Oh, how we could go on, naming the mysteries!

263 Seeing that Pillar of Fire that led the children of Israel, the same One that struck down Saul on his road down to Damascus!

And the same One coming, with the same Power, doing the same things, and revealing the same Word, staying Word-by-Word with the Bible!

264 The sounding of the trumpet, means "Gospel" trumpet. And the sounding of a trumpet, in the Bible, means, "Get ready for Scriptural war." Are you getting it down? Scriptural war!

60-0311 — Mary's Belief 52 Each night I been turning my back to the audience, that you might know and God a vindicates that the...

How many knows that Jesus said, "As it was in the days of Sodom, so shall it be in the coming of the Son of man." He said it.

Now, what happened at Sodom? Now, He said, "As it was in the days of Noah, eight souls were saved by water."

Well, you see where the minority is going to be before the Cap's put on, the Stone, comes back. Now, that Chief Cornerstone goes into the building and fits it together.

Now, He said what that would be. He said what they were doing in the days of Noah: eating, drinking, marrying, and giving in marriage. See?

53 But when He come to Sodom, He left that for the discernment of the church.

Now see, there was a believer, lukewarm church member, and a unbeliever. And Abraham was out of Sodom, which means the elected and called out, the Church.

And the one...Two Angels went down into Sodom; they done a few things, such as smiting blind, putting curse on the people.

To the church member...Had a meeting, called for mercy for them to run out, but they didn't do it. Just like the message goes forth today.

54 But there's one Angel Who stayed with the Church elect. And He said to Abraham (Now He was a Stranger.), He said, "Abraham, where is your wife, Sarah?" Your wife, Sarah? a Stranger. See?

Said, "In the tent behind You." Said, "I'm not going to keep this from you." ("I"—personal pronoun now) "I'm not going to keep this from you, but according to the time of life, Sarah's going to be a young woman again

- (You've heard me preach on it) and she's going to go back, have this baby."
- And Sarah in the tent behind the man—never seen Him, in the tent laughed within herself.

And the Angel, with His back turned, said, "Why did Sarah laugh?"

Abraham called Him "Elohim"; not the man setting there eating steak and drinking milk, eating corn bread.

But it was the Spirit that was in Him. Now, what was it a sign of? That the Spirit of God would dwell in the flesh of people again and show the same sign before the end time.

"As it was in the days of Sodom, so shall it be in the coming of the Son of man." Now, Sodom was the one that burned; fire fell out of the heavens and burned them.

And that's what's going to happen again; it ain't going to be water; it's going to be fire. So the Angel of mercy comes with the same message to warn the people, "Stay away from Sodom!"

5. He's Working On You Like He Did On Abraham And Sarah-Preparing To Receive The Son Of Promise

61-0226 - Jehovah-Jireh

57 Now, I want to go over to Genesis the 18th chapter and show what He done. "I am the breasted One." The 18th chapter, the next chapter, remember he was setting out before his tent door.

He was a hundred years old then. Sarah was ninety. Now, while he was setting out in the heat of the day about eleven o'clock, or twelve, things was going bad.

He'd taken the way with the Lord's despised few. They probably didn't even have a mission, let alone a air-cooled church.

But they were setting out under the tree, not because he had to, but because he wanted to. He was Abraham. He was God's child. He was...separated himself from the things of the world, and he was living for God.

Don't forget that, David. Notice. You might not understood that, but that who I spoke to understood it. Setting out under the tree...

58 And they seen three Men coming up with dust on Their clothes. And notice what They did. We spoke on it the other night. They were three Angels; two Angels and God Himself.

And They were on the road to Sodom, to the church, the denominational church down there at...down in chaos, lukewarm, backslidden, supposed to be, went off in the things of the world.

They went down there with the world so they was going to perish with the world. That's the way the church will do today.

The world that's in the church will perish with the world. They that live in sin will perish with sin. They that live to God shall rise with God. [Blank spot on tape—Ed.]

Now, these Angels setting there...Now, He said, "Abraham, I'm going to get you ready for something." Now, He sent the other two Men away,

and they went down in Sodom to preach the Word, just like a modern preacher would do. And...But this One that stayed behind, I want you to watch His actions.

He said to Abraham; He said, "Abraham, where is your wife, Sarah? Said, "She's in the tent behind You."

59 And said, "I'm going to visit you according to the time of life. I'm going to visit you and give you that child now."

Now, why did He call Himself, "I was the One made you the promise. I'm the One." How could you doubt it being God? "I made you the promise. I'm going to do the visiting.

I'm going to be the One that gives the child, I (Pronoun, personal pronoun), I. I was the One that said it. Now, I'm going to visit you according to the time of life."

And that's what made Sarah laugh. She said, "Me a hundred years old, and my lord old? How could it be?" Now, notice. I want to tell you what He done to them.

Oh, how He got them ready for it. He made a real preparation. So notice. Sarah laughed. And the Angel with His back turned to the tent, said, "Why did Sarah laugh?"

And Sarah come out and said she did not laugh. And the Angel told her what she said, what she never said but what she thought in her mind.

What was He doing? He was making Abraham ready to believe—to believe on Him for to receive his promised son.

60 What has God did? He called you into Pentecost by His grace. He confirmed the covenant to you by giving you the circumcision unconditionally. And now, what's He doing? He's showing Himself, the same God in you (Do you see it?),

the same One by knowing the thoughts of your heart, getting you ready for His promised Son coming, Christ our Saviour. He's getting you ready for the promised Son.

He was getting Abraham ready for the promised son. Now, He is getting Abraham's seed ready for the promised Son that we're waiting on. Oh, won't it be glorious to see Him?

61 What did He do? You remember, it was immediately after that, right immediately after that visitation that the son arrived.

Sodom was burned. Is that right, Bible readers? That's right. The son arrived that Abraham had waited on the promise.

The church now, Abraham's seed, has waiting for the Coming of the Son of God. And now, what's He done?

He has brought you through every one of those elements just like He did Abraham with a confirmation of the covenant, give you the Holy Ghost, speaking in tongues as the Spirit give utterance, all these different things like He promised,

and now brought you right up and sent His Spirit among you, giving you Divine discernment, just before, to prepare you for the coming Son. Amen. It's the last sign the church will receive.

61-0423 - Abraham And His Seed After Him 80 Well, the church has come through justification, sanctification, baptism of the Holy Ghost, gifts manifested to It. And now what?

The Spirit of God moving in the church, doing the same works that Jesus did before He left as a promise. And what's the next thing? The change.

The next thing happened to Abraham was a changed body. He had to have it or he'd never got the son. And the next thing happens to the church is the rapture.

We'll have to be changed and caught up in the air to meet Him. We can't meet Him on earth; we've got to go in the air to meet Him.

It's the coming Son, the promised Son. Amen. We've looked for Him now for hundreds of years. He will come someday. But the next thing for the church is to be changed.

We've had every sign: justification, sanctification, baptism of the Holy Spirit, placing of a son, manifestation of the Spirit. Now, what? The changing of the body for the rapture.

81 Oh, my. How the church ought to be waving its hands in glory, thanking God, thanking God, any minute the change could come.

For the Bible said it'd be universal. Jesus said, "There will be two in the mill, grinding, I'll take one and leave one;

two in the field, I'll take one and leave one; two in the bed," showed it'd be on both sides of the earth, while it's night on one side, be day on the other, "I'll take one and leave one."

The rapture will be universal, and their bodies will be changed. Our bodies will have to be changed. We just can't turn back to young men and women;

we've got to have a different kind of a body, so you can be caught in the air to receive the promised Son. That's what the church is waiting for now: the true church.

Every manifestation, what He did to Abraham, He has done to His seed after Him, leaving one thing out, that's the rapture of the church.

82 "And when you see these things begin to come to pass," Jesus said, "raise up your head." Look up! Your redemption's drawing nigh. When Jesus referred to it, He said,

"As it was in Sodom..." When you see a modern Billy Graham go down into Sodom, when you see the signs begin to appear before the elected Church,

and the rest of it fighting against It, watch, the time of the rapture is at hand. The fig tree putting forth its buds over yonder...

That generation will not pass away till all be fulfilled. And she's way into that generation, since the Jews have been returning to their homeland. We're at the end time....

62-1104m - Blasphemous <u>Names</u> 172 I believe there is a Bride that's predestinated. I believe God said He would have "a Church without spot or wrinkle."

I believe in predestination, that the Bride is predestinated. She's got to be There. I hope I'm with Her.

That, see, I'm with Her. Now it's up to me to work out my own salvation with God, until these things are approved of God, and then sealed into the Kingdom of God.

There is the Holy Spirit. There is the genuine works of God. "It's sealed until the Day of redemption." That was her dream. I thought it was beautiful.

173 Now, therefore, when She does that, when that Church comes to this place, or the individual, the Church is going to be There.

Let me say it real good so you get it. The Church is predestinated to be There. I want to be with It, but the only way I'll be with It, is to be part of It.

How do I become part of It? By being in It. How do I get in It? By a baptism, by one Spirit. First Corinthians 12, "By one Spirit we are all baptized into one Body." One Body; baptized into lt.

174 But you can't stick these little things, say, "I spoke with tongues. I got It." You go out here, and angry, and swear, and carry on. See?

That's putting peacock feathers in a—in a jay bird. See? You can't do it. Your own life proves that it's not.

175 But when these things are operating in you, by God, then you're sealed. Then there's no put-on about it. You're just yourself.

That's when visions, perfect, Holy Spirit, works of God, everything, is made manifest, because (why?) you and Christ become one. I hope that's understood. You and Christ become one.

60-0515M - The Rejected King

168 Oh, my precious friends, my beloved, my darlings of the Gospel, my begotten children unto God, listen to me, your pastor. You, l wish there was some way I could explain it to you.

83 It has nothing to do in the church age, at all. They're absolutely Israel. Now, we're going to read in a few minutes. Now, this interval, between the Sixth...the Seals,

is a calling and sealing of the hundred and forty-four thousand Jews, called in the Tribulation period, after the Church is gone. See? It has nothing to do with the church age, at all.

84 Now notice, Israel, Israel believes only her prophets, and, after they are vindicated.

85 And nowhere through the church age, since in the early apostolic Church, has the Protestant church ever had a prophet.

Tell me who it was, and show it to me. Never! They had, in the early apostolic age, one called Agabus, which was a vindicated prophet.

But in...When the Gentiles came in, into inheritance of God, and Paul turned to the Gentiles. After Peter, as we read last night,

had received from the Lord, that, "He was taking a—a people from the Gentiles, for His Name, His Bride," then they never has been, on the pages of history, a Gentile prophet.

Now you just go back through the history and find out. Why? Exactly, it would be contrary to the Word. Exactly.

- 86 When the first went forth, was a lion, that was prophets: Word.
- The next went forth, was the work, sacrifice.
- The next come forth, was the cunningness of—of man.

87 But we are promised, in the last day, that to return to the Church again, for the benefit of straightening up all that has been misled, missed, undone, left undone.

For, it's predicted here that the seventh angel's Message would finish the mysteries of God. And, then, we've went through It all. We see that It's perfectly in harmony with the Scripture. That's the reason.

58-1012 - The Sudden, Secret Going Away Of The Church 123 It was on one of those ranches, where the great packing companies buy their cattle, run them into the mountains,

and then bring them out after calves are born, in—in the fall of the year,

and brand them, and sell off some of the old herd, and the steers and so forth, and go ahead into the...accumulate their great herds of cattle.

124 And on this certain ranch, the owner, or the caretaker, what we call there, "the top," the foreman, he had about five daughters. They were all beautiful women, young, single. 125 And there was a little lady there, which was a cousin to these girls, that her father and mother had both deceased. And she was brought over there to be...to live with her—her uncle.

126 And those girls, that they was in those fancy type of frilly frocks, you know, and—and they just took this poor little girl and they just treated her like she was some animal.

All the hard work poured right on her. She washed the dishes. She cleaned up. She fixed the bunks.

She—she had to do it all. And they just stayed around with polished finger nails and manicure, the stuff on their lips, and all fixed up, you know, just prissy.

127 And especially did they do this when they heard that from Chicago, the big packing company who owned the outfit, his young, single son was coming to visit the ranch. Oh, did they dike out in good clothes! Ah!

And did they dress and make ready for his coming! And each night the conversation would be, they were going to vamp this young man and marry him.

Who would...Then they would own the ranch, themselves, for the son would fall heir to all. So they made themselves ready.

128 So, you see, there is a ready to be made. You make yourself ready, by joining church or something, that ain't all that's required. You got to have Oil in your lamp. See?

Just your dressing, say, "We'll build a big church. We'll belong to a better denomination. We'll—we'll get a little pipe organ, to the Lord. We'll make plush seats." That isn't what God requires.

129 Righteousness is what God requires, in His Son, Christ Jesus. That's the garments. For the Bible said, "The white clothes which she is adorned in, is the righteousness of the saints." So she...

130 These girls thought they would make themselves ready for the coming of this young man. Course, that poor little cousin, that reminds me of an off-cast somewhere.

You could appreciate her. She was a beautiful woman. But, oh, my! She was a nice little girl, but she was not even considered among them, not as a relative.

131 Now that's about the true picture of the real Church, today, before the denominations. [Blank spot on tape—Ed.] Not even considered; a bunch of interdenominationals, a bunch of outcasts.

132 So the poor little fellow just went ahead, working. And when the young man arrived...

133 They didn't know it, but he come looking for a wife. He was sick and tired of the city girls who just stayed all dolled up, and, oh, you know, hung around the barrooms,

and rode around in the Cadillacs, and the—the different things. They—they were just sick and tired of it. He thought,

"I'll go out West and hunt me a—a real girl that'll be a real mother to my babies. And somebody who'll not hang at all the sewing circles and the—and the societies and things,

but will just be a real mother." What did he find when he got there, but the same thing that he had condemned in Chicago?

137 So is another Son that I know of. Another Son will come to your church. He'll...Son of God, He'll come there. He'll look around.

He'll see you're fine dressed. He'll—He'll know that you're a good member. But He's looking for something different from just the regular trend of church. 138 So as he looked around, after while, he was so discouraged. He walked out the door.

139 And going back, walking in the moonlight, towards the bunk house, he heard somebody kind of humming. And he looked around. And here went this little girl with a great big pan of dish water,

way in the night, barefooted, to throw the dish water out. And as soon as he saw her, something another said, "That's her. That's the one."

So he put hisself in the way. And when she...That's when she come back along the corral fence, why, he was standing there. And she almost fainted.

140 He said, "How do you do?" And he said, "What's your name?" And she told him her name, and it was the same name of the boss of the ranch. Said, "Then I can't understand how that this...Is that your father?"

141 Said, "No. I'm just a cousin, you see. My father and he were brothers. I've got the same name. But I...That, that's the boss."

142 You might have the name of church, might have the name of Branham Tabernacle, or Methodist, or whatever church you go. That isn't it, friend. See? It's something different. It's your character.

That's what God is a looking at. You might be Methodist. You might be Baptist. You might be Presbyterian. It's not that. It's character that God looks at.

Not just earthly character, but Holy Spirit character. "These signs shall follow them that believe," said Jesus, in the 16th chapter of Saint Mark.

143 She was so gotten that—that he would speak to her, even. And she hung her little head down, and she ran into the house.

144 He was there for a week or two, and he looked all around, everywhere. And he never said no more, but he kept watching her.

And the night before he left...He was to leave the next morning.

They was throwing another big party. And he watched for her.

He couldn't find her. He knowed she'd had to do the dishes and so forth, so, the dirty work and all could be throwed off.

145 And that's the way the real Church of God has to take it sometime, the dirty work, all the scandal names, and all of the thing that's mean, to be throwed at It.

And She's a great speckled bird. All the other birds gather around and flock at Her. That's all right. Her name is on the Lamb's Book of Life.

She'll spread Her great wing some day for a flight. She's ready. Them speckles meant the Blood of Christ sprinkled on Her. See? You've read it in your Book, the Bible. 146 And this boy caught the little lady that night coming out. He said, "I've watched you. No one knows it but myself." He said, "I've come out here looking for a wife.

And all that I have ever seen, you meet the requirements." How did she feel? The big man's son asking her now if she would be his wife.

147 Just imagine how those girls must have felt when they looked out their window and saw, holding hands, with that little, despised cousin, the man that they tried to vamp,

- with all their big fine frocks and frills, and carrying on.
- And he said, "Will you marry me?"
- "Oh," she said, "sir, I'm not worthy."

148 That's the way the real Church feels about it, "I'm not worthy. I can... If I could just wash Your dishes, it'll be all right." Are you willing to take that place?

Could you wash the dishes from the Supper? Would you be willing to be called fanatic? Or, would you be willing to be take the way with the Lord's despised few? Are you willing?

149 Are you willing, at your work, to be marked, "There's a man, he's a religious fanatic, because he won't drink, he won't smoke, he doesn't dance, he doesn't run with women"?

"There's a woman that keeps her head down, she walks like...down through the town. She's not...She won't join our circles"?

150 Are you willing to take the way, make yourself ready for the Coming of the Lord? If you have...If you do, you'll be waiting for Him to come. You'll joy at His Coming.

It won't be a dreadful thing. It'll be the most gracious moment that you can think of, the Coming of the Lord. "All those that love His appearing."

151 So, when he left, he told her he would be back at a certain time. Said, "When you begin to see..." It was the winter.

Said, "When you begin to see those trees begin to bud, yonder, that mesquite and stuff begin to take on new life," said, "then I'll be back about spring time."

152 I understand, I couldn't say it was true, but the girl only got about a dollar and seventy-five cents a week for her labor.

But she saved every penny of it. Why? She was getting ready for the wedding that was to be. She was saving her money for her wedding gown.

For he said, "We'll be married right here at the ranch when I come again." She saved her money all year. She was happy. She didn't mind washing the dishes.

She didn't mind ironing the clothes, or sweeping out the bunk house, or what-more. She was engaged to the boss of the ranch.

153 What do we care what the world says, a real Christian? What do we care if we have to be despised and rejected? "Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth."

The Boss's Son is a coming, one day, and we're going to a Wedding Supper. What difference does it make to us, if you love His appearing?

154 After it was all...The days passed. The little daughters, the little cousins, made fun of her, danced around her, and done everything else.

"Well," said, "you poor, silly kid!

Do you not know if he...Why, he

was just like all other men. He

was just teasing you."

155 But the Son of God doesn't tease. "Except a man be born again, he will in no wise..." I don't care how good you look, how much church you belong to, what your status is in the country.

You might be a politician. You might be in the federal government. You might be in the Catholic, Presbyterian, any church you want to be.

But, it's, "Except a man be born again, you will not enter. And these signs shall follow them that believe." I'm only quoting His Word.

156 Finally, when the hour come, she begin to see this, the buds begin to come on the trees.

She knew he would be there at anytime. And he said, "I'll try to make it just at sundown, so we can be married and hurry off."

And every evening, at sundown, when she—she would go and get, make herself all ready, get her little wedding garment on, and wait at the gate.

157 And these little cousins come and laugh at her, and make fun of her, and said, "You poor, silly, ignorant child.

To think that the—the man who owns...He's the President, rather, of the company, that his boy would marry a dishwasher!"

158 He was looking for virtue, not clothes. He had enough money to buy all the clothes was necessary.

159 God don't care how big your fancy things you have. He owns everything in the world. So, He wants virtue. He wants something that's real.

160 And so, finally, one evening, while she was standing there, and they were laughing and making fun of her, and telling her she was silly. All at once, they heard some hoofs a prancing. What happened?

Across the hill come a buckboard. Now, a buckboard is a little wagon, open top, very popular in the West. And the horses all jingled and everything, coming.

Across the hill, come this carriage, and it stopped in front of the gate. And she run. She said, "I knew you would come." That's to be the Church someday.

161 She threw herself in his arms, and he said, "Darling, I have had a man stationed on this ranch since I left here last year, that's brought me a report of everything that you've done." 162 God has got a Man stationed in this tabernacle, this morning, He's called the Holy Spirit. He knows the secrets of your heart.

He knows everything that you've done, or what you think. He tells the Father everything that you do. He brings the message back and forth.

163 He said, "And he has told me that you've waited, and you've worked, and you've labored patiently, waiting for me to come.

Now, you been a slave for a long time, but now your slave days are over. I have brought along the minister, right under this rose trellis, you become my wife."

He kissed her, put the wedding ring on her finger, and picked her up and set her in the buckboard, with his arm around her.

And drove off, to find this new big palace on Outer Drive in Chicago, the selected of the nation, where she could live as his bride.

164 Why? She was ready. She had lived and been the kind of a woman that he wanted. It happened just at the spare of the moment.

165 And that sudden, secret Coming of the Lord, the world don't know it's going to happen, but we do.

It's at hand. Don't be like the young lady they stripped the clothes from, in Pearl Harbor, you'll go down in disgrace.

Be like the One who made Herself ready, and kept Her virtues, and was waiting for the Coming of the Lord, 'cause it'll be secret and sudden.

2. He Does Three Things When He's, He's, He's, He's Descending

65-1204 - The Rapture

129 Now I want you to notice a great thing taking place here now. Don't miss this. See? Now notice.

The Word says here, in Second Thessalonians, that there is three things. Notice. From the 13th to the 16th verse, there is three things that has to happen before the Lord Himself appears.

Quickly now, so we can close. See? The first thing happens...Notice: a shout, a voice, a trumpet. Let's read It now and see if that's right. See? For the Lord himself (16th verse) shall descend from heaven with a shout, and with the voice of the archangel, and...the trump of God:...

130 Three things happens: A 351 voice...A shout, a voice, a trumpet, has to happen before Jesus appears. Now, a shout...Jesus does all three of them when He's-He's-He's descending.

A shout, what is the shout? It's the Message going forth, first, the living Bread of Life bringing forth the Bride.

131 Now, God has a way of doing things. And He never changes His policy. He never changes His po-...He's the unchanging God. In Amos 3:7, He said He would do nothing on the earth until first He revealed it to His servants the prophets. And just as certain as He promised it, He'll do it.

132 Now, we've come through the church ages. But we're promised in the last days, according to Malachi 4, that there would be a return again, a prophet in the land. That's right. Notice his nature, what he would be like. He's alway...

God uses that spirit five times: once in Elijah; in Elisha; in John the Baptist; call out the Church; and the remnant of the Jews. Five times, "grace," J-e-s-u-s, f-a-i-t-h, and it's the number of grace. See? All right.

133 Now, remember, the Message is promised. And when all these mysteries has been all so bundled up by a bunch of ecclesiasties,

it will take a—a direct prophet from God to reveal It. And that's exactly what He promised to do. See?

134 Now, remember, "The Word of the Lord comes to the prophet," not the theologian. The prophet, he is a reflector of God's Word. He can't say nothing;

he can't say his own thoughts. He can only speak what God reveals. Even to the prophet Balaam when he was tried to be sold, sell his right, he said,

"How can any prophet say anything but what God puts in his mouth?" It's a thing that God does, that you can't say nothing else. And you're born that way. No more than you could...

3. Enduring to the endThere is a Promise for those who endure!

65-0829 - Satan's Eden

13 I wanted to speak to you something, to bring something to enlighten to you the promise of God for this age. See? Something, not something that somebody else was in some other day,

but something...and when...Them things are all right; we all refer to those things. But I thought I would try to bring something to your mind,

with these Scriptures I got written here, that would enlighten you, to know, make you a better soldier in the field that you're fighting in now;

to learn the tactics of the enemy, so that you can block everything before it gets to you, see. That's the main thing, is to learn to keep the—the punches off of you, as much as you can.

14 Now, let us look now to this great...for a few minutes, this great, sinful day that we're now living in.

I don't believe there ever was a day that I've ever read in history...There's been greater days of persecution, when the children of God was put to death on every hand.

But to see the deceitfulness of the enemy, we've never had a day like this we're now living.

It's the most cunning, deceitful day. And when I see that, it brings this, that, the Christian has to be more on his toe today than he ever was in any age.

15 Now, back in the days of the persecution, of Rome, to the Church, a Christian make a mistake,

he went into the arena and was fed to the lions, or something like that, when they found him of being a Christian for his testimony.

But his soul was saved, because he was a purely, unadulterated believer in God, and gladly sealed his testimony with his blood.

As the veins let loose, or holes in his body, and the blood bleed out, he would scream up, with real loyal faith, and say, "Receive my spirit, Lord Jesus!"

16 But, now, the cunningness of the devil now, makes the people believe that they are a Christian when they're not. There is the thing.

You don't have to seal...lt's—it's a more cunning day than it would be, than when you had to seal your—your life away with your testimony.

The devil has set every cunning trap that he can, to...He's a deceiver. And Jesus told us, in Matthew 24, how this day would be that we're living in,

the most deceitful day that ever lived, "so close that it would deceive the very Elected of God if it were possible for him to deceive."

Matthew 24:9-13

⁹ Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you: and ye shall be hated of all nations for my name's sake.

¹⁰ And then shall many be offended, and shall betray one another, and shall hate one another.

¹¹ And many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive many.

- ¹² And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.
- ¹³ But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.

143 Now remember, now, in the first age was a lion age. That was the Lion of the tribe of Juda, Christ.

His Own influence of Life, taken that age. That's the first Beast, which means "Power," that answered by human voice. 144 The next age was the ox age, or the dark-horse rider's age. See?

145 Now, reason that this first age was a white age, was that...As—as I've always heard people say that that first rider, the white, was the power of the church, went forth to conquer.

And we found out he was given a crown, that that was it. It was the church. It was the church, but where did he go to? Went to Rome. That's where he did. He received his crown.

146 Now, the second age was a—was a red-horse rider, which was the dark age.
