Thirst Is God-Given, For Himself

65-0919 — Thirst

98 There is another nature, natural, just a natural thirst, in that thirst of the soul. You might say, "Brother Branham, is that soul thirst, is that natural?" Yes, that's natural for a soul to thirst.

And it's, for God made you this way, that so that you would thirst for Him. He wants you to thirst after Him. Now, God made you like that. He didn't have to make you like that, but He did do it.

And if He hadn't have made you like that, so that you would thirst, there would be an excuse at the Judgment Bar, say, "I—I—I never did thirst for God." But, there is no excuse, you do.

You will make it somewhat; you might make it your wife, you might make it your car, you might make it something else, you might go to church and try to satisfy it.

And I have nothing against going to church, but that isn't the satisfaction. It's to find God, the living God, the God of Heaven, into your soul, that satisfies that longing and thirsting that you long for.

57-0614 — The Queen Of The South 20 And as I said, that thirsting,

20 And as I said, that thirsting, that thirst feeling in you, God made you with that thirst.

That's part of God's make-up for you. He made you and give you a thirst—a thirst for Him. But you try to satisfy it with the worldly amusements:

dancing, drinking, smoking, gambling, lust, trying to satisfy that blessed holy thirst with the things of the world. You have no right to do it, and you're cheating and robbing God by doing so.

57-0811A — The Greatest Gift In The Bible 40 Jesus said, "Blessed are they that do hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be filled."

It's a blessing to even thirst. But the devil has tried to make you think of something else. But the thirst was given you by God.

Listen. How dare you take that blessed holy thirst that God gave you to thirst after Him and try to satisfy it with the things of the world, with television programs, with drinking, with big sprees.

The devil has perverted instruments of his own and taken that thirst that God give you to thirst for Him,

and making you thirst after the things of the world. And every thirst that you have should be for Him. Certainly. That's life.

Deep Calls Unto The Deep

50-0405 — Expectation 25 My mother used to have a superstition. The little children that I...had ten of us. And when the little fellows would be...

They'd get a habit of licking their lips. And she's say they were tasting for something. And she'd put, maybe preserves on. That didn't work. Maybe put a little honey, that didn't work.

Maybe some watermelon, that didn't work. But after a while, when she found something that they were tasting for, why, they were...lt would stop licking its lips.

Well, that might have been a superstition. But this, when there's a hunger in the heart of the human being for something, there's bound to be Something creating that hunger in there.

In other words, David said, "When the deep calls to the deep..." And when there's a deep calling, there's bound to be a deep to respond somewhere.

¹¹ Behold, the days come, saith the Lord GOD, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the words of the LORD:

12 And they shall wander from sea to sea, and from the north even to the east, they shall run to and fro to seek the word of the LORD, and shall not find it. ¹³ In that day shall the fair virgins and young men faint for thirst.

56-1206 — A Secondhanded Robe 37 Now, Elisha wanted to find one thing in his mind, in his heart; there was a deep desire. And when the deep goes to coming to the deep, there's bound to be a deep to respond to that call.

Before there's a fin on a fish's back, there had to be a water for him to swim in first. Before there's a tree to grow in the earth, there had to be a earth first for the tree to grow in.

Before there's a desire in your heart for more of God, there's got to be more of God somewhere to respond to that desire.

38 I seen here some time ago, where a little kid eat the erasers off of pencils, eat the pedal off of a bicycle. And they taken him down to the laboratory to examine him.

And find out, at the clinic rather, they found out that his little body needed sulfur. For if there's something in here calling for sulfur, there had to be a sulfur to respond to that call.

Here it is, like this. Before there can be a creation, there had to be a Creator to create that creation. And if you're desiring tonight to be healed of the Lord, there's got to be a fountain open somewhere. That's right.

If you desire the baptism of the Holy Ghost in your heart, there's got to be something out there creating that desire. When the deep calleth to the deep, there's got to be a deep to respond to it.

63-0728 — Christ Is The Mystery Of God Revealed 504 Why do you hunger, Church, why do you thirst? It's the Father trying to reveal this hidden secret to you.

But you let so many things get it out of you. You let your job, you let your wife, you let your husband, you let your children, you let the cares of the world, you let some pastor,

you let somebody else get that out of you, when you know that way down in your heart you're thirsting, hungry. It's God trying to reveal it to you, see, the revelation. The last day is here. Notice now.

This Being The Age Of Counterfeits, Satan Has Many Counterfeits For True Satisfaction

65-0919 — Thirst 85 Now it's a perverted age. And Satan is perverting these thirsts that God put in you, to thirst. Satan is perverting them. Now if you want to know the right, perversion...

87 He perverts the true nature of God, and the true thirst of God, of the body and soul, by lust for sin. Sin, a perversion! Now we find out, a person today, the way they've took that perversion;

thirst for God, the thirst for to be pretty, and all these thirsts. For, for water, they've turned that into satisfying that with drinking.

The thirst for joy, everybody wants to have joy; thirst for fellowship; all these great thirsts that God put into us, that we might thirst after Him.

God made you to thirst after Him, and we try to satisfy it with some other kind of a thirst, with some other kind of a perversion of the correct thirst.

See how it's in the natural? See how it's in the spiritual? We think, as long as we join church, that—that settles, that's all we have to do. Well, that is absolutely wrong. No.

88 God wants you to thirst for Him! "As the hart panteth for the water brook, my soul thirsts after Thee, O God." See? See?

90 And there is nothing can satisfy that thirst that's in the human being, until God comes in. He must have It, or die. And no persons has a right to try to hush or satisfy that holy thirst, that's in him, by the things of the world.

No, sir. It's ungodly to do so. And if you thirst for God, don't shake hands with the preacher and put your name on the book.

If you're thirsting for God, there is only one thing to satisfy it, that's, meet God. If you're thirsting for God, that's the only way you can meet Him, is to do that.

91 And then there is a great danger, also, if you don't watch what you're doing in that time. If you're thirsting for God, be sure it's God you find. See, be sure that it's your thirst is satisfied.

But if Satan has been able to pervert you, from these natural appetites, and that he'll do if he can, he'll—he'll simply make you try to be satisfied.

Remember, It Is A Soul Thirst

Psalm 42:2

² My soul thirsteth for God, for the living God: when shall I come and appear before God?

Psalm 63:1

1 O God, thou art my God; early will I seek thee: my soul thirsteth for thee, my flesh longeth for thee in a dry and thirsty land, where no water is;

⁶ I stretch forth my hands unto thee: my soul thirsteth after thee, as a thirsty land. Selah.

65-0815 — And Knoweth It Not 122 Now, this outside man is the flesh. That's what we look at; what we see. And it has five inlets to that body.

And any grammar school child, as myself, would know there is five senses control the body; see, taste, feel, smell, and hear.

Without that, you can't touch the body. That's the only way you have to the body; see, taste, feel, smell, hear; you see it, taste it, feel it...Now, that is the evil one, on the outside.

123 Now, inside of that is a spirit, which you become when you're born in the earth and the breath of life is breathed into him.

That spirit is of a worldly nature because it was not given from God, but it was (given) permitted by God. Now you got that?

For, every child that's born in the world, "is born in sin, shaped in iniquity; come to the world speaking lies." That right? So, that person, inside there, is a sinner, to begin with. Now, but...

124 Now, it's got five inlets. And them five inlets...I don't know whether I can call them right off now. When the...First, I know, is thought, conscience, and love, choice...No.

Conscience, love, reason...There is five inlets to the spirit. You can't think with your body; you have to think with your spirit. You can't have conscience in your body.

It has no mental faculties at all; your body doesn't, so you have to think with your spirit. You have to reason. You can't reason with your physical being, 'cause reason doesn't see, taste, feel, smell, or hear.

Reason is what you can make in your mind. If you're asleep or you're out, your body is laying there dead, but your spirit can still reason. There is five senses that controls that inside man. And that...

125 Now, to the last man, which is the soul, there is only one sense that controls that, and that is free...moral agency's free will to choose or to reject.

126 And now the reason that people today...Now, don't forget this now, and you'll—you'll see what the Holy...what the initial evidence of the Holy Ghost is. See?

127 Now, people can live in this spirit, and they dance in the spirit. They shout in the spirit. They go to church in the spirit,

and they can absolutely have the real Spirit of God anointed on that spirit, but still be lost and just as devil-possessed as they can be, with that spirit.

The Only Way To Truly Satisfy The Soul Thirst Is For The Person Of The Holy Ghost

65-0919 — Thirst

137 And let me tell you, friend, I don't care how many churches you join, how many names you put on, which a way you go,

and whether you are sprinkled, baptized, or whatever you are; until you meet that Person, Jesus Christ! That, that's the only thing that will really satisfy.

138 Emotion won't do it; you might jump up-and-down and shout as long as you want to, or you might run up-and-down the floor, and you might speak in tongues as much as you want to. And them things are holy and good.

I don't say—I don't say nothing against that. But until you meet that Person, that satisfying Portion, that Something that takes every fiber in your body; not by emotion, but by a satisfaction!

65-0919 — Thirst 122 "To know Him is Life," the Person, Christ Himself! Not comparing. It's a revelation that God built His Church upon. And if we don't build upon that same Church...

The Bible said, "Abel, by faith!" And faith is a Divine revelation. See, faith is a Divine revelation. All right. This whole Thing is built upon the revelation then, and unless this is revealed to you!

Jesus said, "I thank Thee, Father, that Thou has hid these things from the wise of this world, and revealed it to babes such as will learn." See, now, the whole thing is built there, you've got to know the Person!

123 And you cannot satisfy that by joining church. You've got to find the Person, God Himself, which is the Word and—and interpretation of Hisself today, the promises that He made today.

The people that He was going to have in this day, "the Church without spot or wrinkle," don't mean a denomination; it means the persons, the individuals without spot or wrinkle.

Deception Today Is So High, That Both Sides Are Anointed With The Holy Ghost But One Is Falsely Anointed

65-1127B — Trying To Do God A Service Without It Being God's Will 250 And you say, "Glory to God! The Holy Ghost fell on me, hallelujah, just like It did on the Day of Pentecost." But that might be different today. It fell on David, too, didn't it?

Sure, It did. Fell on Uzziah, but it was wrong! See, you got to go deeper than that now. See? You got to go deeper than that. Now, don't feel hurt, just—just be reverent.

65-1205 — Things That Are To Be 100 Remember, the Bible said, "In the last days there shall come false Christs," not false Jesuses. They wouldn't stand still for that.

But, "false Christs," false anointed-ones. They're absolutely anointed with the Spirit, with the Holy Spirit, and still false. See? There's two...

101 There's three people of you. The outside is the body. You got five senses, that you contact your earthly home with that.

The inside is a spirit. There's five senses there, love and conscience, and so forth, you contact. But the inside of that is the soul.

102 Remember, "The rain falls on the just and the unjust." The same rain that'll make a grain of wheat grow makes a cocklebur grow too. See? What is it?

At the inside of that seed is a nature, and that nature display, displays itself. It can stand in the same field, right there with the weed. The weed and the wheat stand together, rejoice just as much.

Its head is down. It's starving for a drink. When a rain comes, the cocklebur can shout just as loud as the wheat can. "But by their fruits you shall know them." See?

65-1206 — Modern Events Are Made Clear By Prophecy 100 Notice, we find today that people...There's many people just can't believe It, even Spirit-filled people.

I'm going to give you one that'll choke you. The baptism of the Holy Ghost don't mean you're going in, not at all, not on that, don't have anything to do with your soul.

That's the baptism, see. Here's the inside soul, in here, that has to come from God. But then on the outside you have five senses, and five out...inlets to your...contact your earthly home.

The inside, you have a spirit, and in there you have five outlets: your conscience, and love, and so forth, five outlets to that spirit.

Remember, in that spirit you can be baptized with the genuine Spirit of God and still be lost. It's the soul that lives, that was ordained of God.

65-1205 — Things That Are To Be 112 "I got the baptism, the Holy Spirit." That still has nothing to do with it. That's just only a temporal gift for you.

The real gift is your soul down in there, see, that was born of God, and that controls the whole thing to the Word of God and the will of God.

And there you grow up, see, then you're a son and daughter of God. You're a child of God. And these things, as you come up...Like

the mother, now you're in the bowels of the earth, trying to come forth. You're a son of God, coming forth, and you see the Word says, "I should do this.

I should be born-again." "Well, I belong to church." That don't mean one thing. See? "I'm Methodist; my mother." That's good for your mother.

113 "Well, my, I'm Pentecostal, I belong to that." If you don't line with that Word, there is something wrong. See? Then, you see, your real father ain't God. See?

Because, that real start in your soul, before there even was a spirit, it was your soul. That soul didn't come from God, then it wasn't a germ of God, to begin. You're deceived.

You're in a patch of weeds and bearing the world's record of the weeds coming forth. Acting like the world, loving the world, is because the love of God is not in you.

114 And now there'll be false anointed-ones in the last days, not false Jesus. They wouldn't stand for that. But, "false," anointed.

They are anointed, yes, sir, but they're anti-Christ. They're anointed with the Spirit, to do the signs and wonders that Christ did, but won't line up with His Word. See?

63-0901E — Desperations 86 Jacob cried like never before. Desperately he called until he got a hold of God. And when he did, he wrestled; not for fifteen minutes.

He wrestled to keep Him, in his soul, all night long; and still he knew he didn't have the blessing, and he was able to hold on until the blessing come. He wrestled desperately until the blessing come.

Then, and when he seen...until God came on the scene. And then, in despair, "I'll not let You go," when he begin to feel the blessing coming down on him.

A lot of people say, "Glory to God, I got it now." There you're deceived. Yeah! Somebody say, "Oh, I just feel so good, Brother Branham, I went down there and prayed.

Oh, shivers run over me." And that might have been God. "I saw a great light before me." That still might have been God, but that ain't what I'm talking about.

87 The Bible said, in Hebrews the 6th chapter, "The rain falleth on the just and the unjust, just the same." Now, you take wheat, and take weeds, and put them in the field.

And the rain is actually sent for the wheat, but the rain falls on the weeds the same as it does the wheat. And, the rain, and the weeds is just as happy about the rain as the wheat is, and it's the very same rain.

The very Holy Ghost can fall upon an unbeliever and make him act just exactly the same way a believer acts. But by their fruits they are known; that's what I'm speaking, that's the Token. And Da-...

88 And Jacob, rather, in desperation, he said, "I know I feeled You, You're here with me, but I'm not going to let You go."

Somebody sees it fine, the first little sensation, they get up and jump up-and-down, run up the aisle, say, "I got It, I got It, I got It." Oh, no. Huh-uh. No.

Jacob stayed there until something happened, that made him walk different, made him a different person, because that he stayed until that happened.

And he was able...The Bible said, "He held until he prevailed." How can a man prevail over God? But you can do it. You can do it. A man can prevail over God.

When God Created The Soul To Thirst After Him, He Also Provided A Channel Through Which His Spirit Can Get To The Soul

65-0822E — A Thinking Man's

<u>Filter</u>

121 When you come in this world, you were born in sin. You didn't even come with a fighting chance.

You were "born in sin, shaped in iniquity, come to the world speaking lies," within your own spirit, the desire of sin, a lover of sin because you were born in sin.

You didn't have a chance. But down inside of you, somewhere, here you come, there was something in there that begin to draw.

If you knowed, it was something that told you there was a God somewhere; and you read His Word. Then you took the church, you took their ideas when you was told better, then you never used a thinking man's Filter. But when you use God's Filter, which is a thinking man's Filter, because, "All other filters will pass away, but Mine shall not."

And when you take God's Filter and draw your life, your desires; if you draw your desires through God's Filter, a thinking man's Filter, there is nothing left but the Holy Ghost.

122 Now, if you want the evidence of the Holy Ghost, there it is. When that soul of yours will line with the Word of God, in every respect, it shows you've drawed your life through the thinking man's Filter, God's Filter.

114 What's that? Well, what's drawing it? It's something down on the inside drawing. The soul is drawing your resource through the outside, down through the spirit, into the soul.

And if the soul loves the world, it's dead. I don't care how it's anointed, it is out here, and how righteous it is out here; down in here it's dead.

"For he that loves the world or the things of the world, the love of God is not even in him," no matter how religious. 115 The true Filter, that way, will—will set all those things out and bring nothing but the trueness of God, the Word, into the real true soul.

65-0919 — Thirst

25 Then I was looking and thinking about that word "thirst," so I looked up in the dictionary, to see what it means.

And here is what Webster says, "It's a painful desire," a painful, when you want something so bad until it becomes painful to you.

65-0919 — Thirst

29 Now we find, God gives the control tower to you, to give to you the things that you need. Now, the control tower in you is what directs you.

And this thirst runs in on this co-...tower, control tower, and tells you what you have need of, spiritually speaking.

The control tower in the body, and in the soul, also. There is a control tower in the body, that tells you the need that's needed in your body, and it's brought to you by thirst.

Also, there is a control tower in your soul, that tells you the spiritual things that you have need of, something in your spirit, and, and you by this can tell what kind of a life is controlling you.

30 When you—when you can see what your desires are, then you can tell, by that, what kind of something that's in you, that's creating this desire that you have.

See, there is a certain thing that you thirst for, and it—and it can tell you in your soul what this desire is, by the nature of the thirst that you have. I hope that you can understand that.

You Can't Help Thirsting After The World

Romans 7:14-25

¹⁴ For we know that the law is spiritual: but I am carnal, sold under sin.

15 For that which I do I allow not: for what I would, that do I not; but what I hate, that do I. 16 If then I do that which I would not, I consent unto the law that it is good.

Now then it is no more I that do it, but sin that dwelleth in me.

18 For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh,) dwelleth no good thing: for to will is present with me; but how to perform that which is good I find not.

¹⁹ For the good that I would I do not: but the evil which I would not, that I do.

20 Now if I do that I would not, it is no more I that do it, but sin that dwelleth in me. ²¹ I find then a law, that, when I would do good, evil is present with me.

For I delight in the law of God after the inward man:

²³ But I see another law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members.

²⁴ O wretched man that I am! who shall deliver me from the body of this death?

25 I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. So then with the mind I myself serve the law of God; but with the flesh the law of sin.

65-1125 — The Invisible Union Of The Bride Of Christ 229 How did you come to do this? You were deceived into it by your first marriage, to your adulterous parent, Eve.

It's no fault of your own. By your natural birth, you come after Eve, who committed adultery.

That's the reason you was born an adulteress. You're a sinner, to begin with. That's right. You was deceived into it. You had no...No, you, it ain't your fault.

230 You never did it. Because, that little germ that was in you, was to be you, before the foundation of the world. God put your name in the Lamb's Book of Life.

59-0802 — Without Money Or Without Price 29 There is so many entertaining things of our days. There is so much to entice people to what we would call "pleasures," and it's for all peoples, all ages.

30 There are the enticements for the young people, the modern dances and the rock-and-roll parties, and the music that they have that goes with it. And it's all enticing, for entertainment.

31 I don't care how good a home a child has been brought up in, and how it's been taught to do right; if that child hasn't accepted the experience of the new Birth, rock-and-roll music catches his attention just as quick as he hears it.

Because, in him, is born in him, by nature, a carnal spirit. And the power of the devil is so great, today, till it catches that spirit of that little one.

You could worship and be religious, but still that will have some kind of a drawing power to you, because this old man of sin and his desires is not dead in you yet.

33 But once let Christ take the throne in your heart, those things don't bother. It is so much greater.

59-1001 — What Went Ye Out To See?

61 You can't help being what you are. Even if you're a sinner, you're not responsible for being a sinner.

You're responsible for remaining a sinner. There is a way prepared for you. But to be a sinner, you was born that way.

God doesn't send you to hell for being a sinner. God sends you to hell because you won't repent and take Christ as your Saviour. You refuse to take the right road.

You send yourself to torment. You send your own soul to its Eternal destination, upon the free moral agency of your own convictions. God does not send anyone to hell.

He never did and He never will. Men send themselves to hell because they refuse to—to accept the way of salvation. God isn't...He is longsuffering. He doesn't want any to perish; never wanted it.

62 <u>But men rather walk in</u> darkness than to walk in Light. The reason of it is, they've...

They are born in that condition, and have no desire to take the Light. And messengers come, from east and west, and north and south, and throw barricades.

Song service, testimonies, preaching, across the path of the sinner, and he deliberately walks right through them and then say that God is responsible or guilty.

God is good and full of mercy. And He wouldn't want no one lost. But man wants to be lost because it's his desire. He refuses to walk in Light, that's what makes him be lost. All right.

65-1212 — Communion

44 Like in the Book here, and the spot there we was talking about the—the two Books being One, the Book of Life.

The first Book of life coming up, was when you were born, that was your natural birth. See? But then one time, way back down in there, there was a little grain of Life as I was explaining to some of the young sisters at the house this afternoon.

See, there's a little grain of Life laying there, that you wonder, "Where did It come from? What—what these strange things?"

45 I was saying this, taking for myself, like you was going to say, "William Branham, well, forty years ago, the William Branham, it isn't the same one tonight." If somebody back there would say,

"William Branham, he was a rank rascal," see, because I was born of Charles and Ella Branham. In their nature I was a sinner, I came to the world, a liar, and all the habits of the world laid right in me.

But down in there, too, was another Nature present, see, predestinated, was in there by God. In this same body, see, two natures in there.
