## 65-0718E — Spiritual Food In Due Season

4 And I want you to get built up now in the...this Holy Oracles of God, in the Faith, the Faith of this hour.

# The Faith! It's going to take more faith than ever was in any age, for this has to be rapturing faith, be taken up.

And so we want you to believe tonight in all that you have seen, heard, the Word that you have heard preached,

the—the signs and wonders that you have seen done. We want you to accumulate all that together in your heart, and consider it, whether if that be God or not.

#### 65-0801M — The God Of This

#### Evil Age

37 We find now, this evil age is to prove, to Satan, She is not like Eve, that She is not that type of a woman.

And She will be tried by His Word, the Bride, as Adam's bride was tried by the Word. And Adam's bride believed every bit of the Word, all,

but confused on one promise, that, "He's the same yesterday, today, and forever," today, see; but failed on one promise, under the temptation of the enemy, face to face.

And now, the people that's called for His Name, of course, is His Bride. She is to come in contact again by the same thing; not by just denominational truth or something, but every Word!

#### <u>CAB-08 — 8 - The Philadelphian</u> <u>Church Age</u>

"I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation, which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth."

This verse is not a declaration that the true church will go into and through the tribulation. If it meant that it would have said that. But it said, "I will keep thee from the hour of temptation."

This temptation is exactly like the temptation in Eden. It will be a very inviting proposition held up in direct opposition to God's commanded Word,

and yet from the standpoint of human reasoning it will be so very right, so enlightening and life-giving as to fool the world. Only the very elect will not be fooled.

#### EPHESIANS 6:10-18

Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might.

11 Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

13 Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

#### Overcome?

44 We see this age that we're living in. It's one of the grandest ages of all ages.

This Laodicea Church Age is the grandest of all the church ages, because it's the ending of time and the blending of Eternity.

And, then, it's the greatest sinful age. It's more sin in this age than there's ever been. And the powers of Satan is—is many times harder to fight against than it was in any age. See?

45 Here, back there in early ages, a Christian could, for his profession of being a church...of belonging to Christ, could be beheaded for it. He could be killed, and put out of his misery, and go to meet God, quickly.

But now the enemy has come in, in the name of the church, and it's so deceiving. This is the great age of deception.

When, Christ said so, "The two spirits would be so close in the last days till it would deceive the very Elected if it was possible."

See? See? Remember, Christ spoke of an elected people for the last day. See? "It would deceive the very Elected if it were possible."

So close! The people so live, people can live a clean, holy life; not be sinful, adulterers, and drinkers, and liars, gamblers. They can live above that, and still not with It.

46 This is the—the age of Life, personal Life of Christ, where, the—the chemical of His Body, what was in Him.

## The Thing To Overcome Is Myself

#### ROMANS 7:18-21

18 For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh,) dwelleth no good thing: for to will is present with me; but how to perform that which is good I find not.

For the good that I would I do not: but the evil which I would not, that I do.

20 Now if I do that I would not, it is no more I that do it, but sin that dwelleth in me. 21 I find then a law, that, when I would do good, evil is present with me.

63-0825M — How Can I Overcome? 72 The thing you have to overcome is yourself, your idea, your thing, and surrender yourself to Him. He overcome for you. He knows the way; we don't.

61-1119 — Perfect Strength By Perfect Weakness 99 l've often said, "The greatest enemy I got is William Branham." He's the one that gets in God's way. He's the one that gets lazy.

He's the one that gets to a place sometimes where he thinks he can do something about it, and, when he does, that shoves God right out of the picture.

But when I can get rid of that guy, when I can get to a place that he is out of the way, then God can come over and do things that William Branham knows nothing about.

### 63-0825M — How Can I

### Overcome?

41 I was crossing an old log the other day, down a—a wash, or what is called a hollow. And I jumped up on this log.

On the outside, it looked good, looked like a big old beech log. But when I jumped on it, oh, a great chunk of it fell off. It was real rotten and doty.

I said, "That's the way the Christians are becoming." They been dead in sin and trespasses, so long, till become doty.

They can hold no weight, at all. They—they don't know what the overcoming means. And I begin to think of this text, then. Overcome, keep Life in

When life went out, that's what brought that log to that condition. See? And it made it worse than ever when it laid in the branch where the water was.

42 And then, there, you take a Christian, that's supposed to be a Christian, let the Life of God go from him,

and the experience, the joy of serving Christ; and, living in a church where such is going on, he rottens twice as quick, right, living right under.

43 So, if we are trying to follow the Message of the hour, or at least this part of the Message, we should live constantly in the Life of Christ. See? Cause, if it don't, you lay around,

and know that these things that you're supposed to do, and don't do it, the Bible said, "He that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it's sin."

Then you become doty, rotten, when you're separated from the Life of God. So, strive with all that's in you, to stay in the Life of Christ, that you would be fruit-bearing.

### 63-0825M — How Can I

### Overcome?

51 Now, we see these hours that we're in, this stage, and we see what it was. And the Holy Chost is rebuking the age that put Him out.

But, in all that, did you notice, "To him that overcometh"? Even in that worldly, wicked church age, "Him that overcometh."

# 52 We find here that God has always had overcomers. He's had overcomers in every age.

There's always, every time, in every age that there's been on the earth, God has always had somebody He could put His hands on, as a witness in the earth.

He's never been without a witness, though sometimes just one. But somebody overcome, now, like the saints of old.

### 56-0415 — The Deep Calling To The Deep 16 .....And now, I want you to see it. God, always at all times, ever since there's been an earth, He's had someone He could put His hand on and call, "This is My servant."

17 Sometimes it comes to just one person, like in the days of Noah, or the time of Elijah, and so forth. Sometime it's just one person. But He's never been without a witness, as long as there has been an earth.

And He never will be without a witness, as long as there is an earth. There's always someone that He can put His hands on, and put His trust in, and say, "This is My servant that'll do My will."

Wouldn't it be nice today if He say about us? "This is My servants, who I can put my trust in, and they'll do My will."

63-0728 — Christ Is The Mystery Of God Revealed 594 Justified in His sight! Why are we justified? We are His victory. The Church is His victory.

We come forth in this last days with this glorious Gospel, showing His victory. He died for this purpose, and we are proof of His victory.

Amen! When we see Him coming down and living among the Church, that's His victory. Shows that he couldn't keep Him in the grave, neither can they keep us. That's right.

We're bound right. And we're already, potentially, arised, because we've raised from dead, unbelief in His Word, from denomination creeds, to an Eternal Word of the Eternal God;

which is Him, Hisself, working through us, manifesting Himself that He is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

You may have to seal your testimony with your blood. Thousands, yea millions, have died during all the ages.

They died in the faith. Like Antipas, the faithful martyr, they held not their lives dear unto death. Often we think that it would be almost impossible to be a martyr.

But dare to recall that the faith we daily use to triumph in Christ Jesus is the same faith that upholds the Polycarps and all martyrs.

## 61-0723M — The Ever-Present Water From The Rock 149 And when we die, our souls will go under the altar of God; where I was privileged to see, a few mornings ago,

as you know, in the vision, where the Bible speaks of, "Our spirits will go to God Who give it, and our bodies shall return to the dust of the earth."

But someday, when the Scripture is fulfilled, our spirits will be released from God, will pick up the soul, and the soul to the body.

And if you can believe it, whatever God will lead your soul to believe, that is yours. Every place the soles of your foot can set upon, by faith, God gives it to you.

Amen! It's yours, you possess it, if you can find the key to this law of faith that opens it to you. You see what I mean? That Power is controlled by...

If you are a son of God, you are a daughter of God, that never leaves you. It's with you all the time. But, your faith gets away from It, but It's still there. Hallelujah!

152 When you are saved, God gives you faith to rise from the muck of the earth. Your faith overcomes the things of the world. What is your faith?

Your faith in that act that God has did in you, to make you a son of God. You quit your lying, you quit your stealing, you quit your drinking, because your faith rises you up above it.

Amen. If you don't do it, you don't have any faith. "And by faith are you saved, and that through grace."

153 As much as your faith will be released, that's how much Power you can have, because in you dwells the Power to make Heavens and earth.

God dwells in you, and you are sons and daughters of God. Amen! There you are. But, it's your faith. Jesus said, "According to your faith, be it unto you.

You ever have faith, it's give to you by the grace of God. And God reveals it to you, therefore faith is a revelation. And the whole Church of God is built upon the revelation.

159 Let me straighten a little Scripture here for you. I think we're off of the phone, but we are still here. Saint John 5:24, Jesus said, "He that heareth My Word,

65 ..... "He that heareth My

Word," the word there is,

He that this great mystery of the God made known, understands, how that God was in Christ reconciling Himself to the world,

### Names

140 And here's, now, get this lesson. Here is what's wrong with the—with the…I turn on for this. Here is what's wrong with the Branham Tabernacle.

You see, there is two different kinds of faith. There is two different kinds of virtue, as l had it the other day. Two different kinds of knowledge. Two different kinds of temperance.

141 One thinks it's prohibition, they got. That ain't the kind of temperance that God is talking about. It's that ungodly, uncontrollable temper you got, and things of that side, sass back, fuss.

142 Patience, and so forth, there's a mockery of it, a pretending to be; a nature-given faith; a nature-given virtue. There's a nature-given temperance. All these things are nature given.

143 And the biggest part of our faith is mental faith. By hearing the Word, it brings us to a mental recognition of God.

144 But if This, coming from Above, oh, brother, if It ever strikes this, there is a godly spiritual faith. Then what does that faith do? That faith recognizes only the Word.

No matter what anything else says, it only recognizes the Word, because, "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God." And the Word is still God.

"And the Word was made flesh and dwelt among us." And when the Word Itself is pouring into our faith, our mental faith becomes a spiritual revelation.

145 "And upon this foundation I'll build My Church." See? Not upon a mental conception of church joining, a mental conception of That;

but upon the revelation, when them streams of grace has poured into that mental faith that you've got. Then, upon this, a spiritual revelation, "I'll build My Church,

and the gates of hell can't prevail against It." See? That shows they would be against It, but it'll never prevail. Oh, what a glorious thing!

## CAB-09 — 9 - The Laodicean Church Age

Revelation 3:21, "To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with Me in My throne, even as I also overcame,

and am set down with My Father in His throne." Now what are we to overcome? That is the normal question to ask here. But that is not the actual thought of this verse for it is not so much WHAT we are to overcome but HOW we are to overcome.

Now this is logical, for <u>does it</u> matter much WHAT we are to overcome as long as we know HOW we can overcome?

A quick look at those Scriptures which involve the Lord Jesus overcoming will bring out the truth of this proposition.

In Matthew 4, wherein Jesus is tempted of the devil, He overcame the personal temptations of Satan by the Word, and by the Word only.

In each of the three major trials that corresponded exactly to the temptation of the Garden of Eden, the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eye, and the pride of life, Jesus overcame by the Word.

Eve fell to the personal temptation of Satan by failing to use the Word. Adam fell in direct disobedience to the Word. But Jesus overcame by the Word.

And right now, let me say that this is the only way to be an overcomer, also it is the only way that you can know if you are overcoming, because that Word CAN'T fail.

## In his own personal life, contending with Himself, He overcame by obedience to the Word of God.

In Hebrews 5:7 it says, "Who in the days of His flesh, when He had offered up prayers and supplications with strong crying and tears unto Him That was able to save Him from death,

and was heard in that He feared; though He were a Son, yet learned He obedience by the things which He suffered; and being made perfect, He became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey Him." What was He obedient to? The Word of God.
