157 He was all showed in types, but God knew exactly when He would come. He knowed exactly when He come.

No matter how many they had before that, He had His Messiah. He showed them in types, what was coming.

158 Just exactly like He showed us the Seven Church Ages, what would come. Just exactly what He showed us what would come when He set that Light up there, in revelation to it, to show the world.

When He sent the seven Angels  
to reveal the seven messengers  
that had been down through  
there,



and show the loose ends, each Angel coming each day and revealing the loose ends that Luther left, and Wesley left, and Pentecost left, is all represented in there.

And in the very type and shadow  
of the great Shalom, Jehovah,  
Yahweh. See? Exactly. Threw  
It in the skies, and there is the  
mechanical eye taking a picture  
of It. See? Thank the Lord!

159 Shalom! Peace! Don't be weary, Jesus is here. His great Light has come to us, and we're thankful for It, yes, His Word, the great mystery.

Here He is today manifesting Himself, doing the same as He did then, just the same. Doing the very same thing.

# 63-0728 - Christ Is The Mystery Of God Revealed

105 Now, God had a purpose and a hidden mystery. And that's what I want to speak on to the Church this morning, the hidden mystery of God that He had in His mind before the world ever began,

and how that it's unfolded itself right down to this present hour that we're living. See? Then you will understand clearly then, you see, on, I believe, what is being done.

106 God's great mystery, of  
how, it's a secret. He kept it a  
secret. Nobody knowed nothing  
about it.

Even the Angels didn't  
understand it. See, He didn't  
reveal it. That's the reason,  
under our seventh mystery,  
when the Seventh Seal was  
opened, there was silence.



Jesus, when He was on earth,  
they wanted to know when He  
would come. He said, “It’s  
not...Even the Son Himself don’t  
know when it’s going to  
happen.” See, God has this all to  
Himself. It’s a secret.

And that's the reason there was  
silence in Heaven for a space of  
a half hour, and seven thunders  
utter their voices, and John was  
even forbidden to write it, see,  
the Coming of the Lord.

That's one thing He hasn't  
revealed yet, of how He will  
come, and when He will come.  
It's a good thing that He  
doesn't. No.

107 He has showed or revealed  
it in every type that's in the  
Bible. Therefore, the entire Bible  
is the revelation of God's  
mystery in Christ. Hum!

The entire Bible is an expression of one goal that God had, one purpose He wanted to achieve in the entire Bible.

And all the acts of the—of the  
believers in the Bible has been in  
type, an expressing what God's  
great goal is,

and now in this last day He has  
revealed it and shows it. And  
God's help, we'll see it right here  
this morning, what the Lord has  
had in His mind all along, and  
has expressed it.

108 Therefore, you can see the  
great meaning of what it's been  
to know this, and then try to  
bring it to the people. See? And  
then you don't...I haven't went  
into details to try to explain It as  
God has revealed it to me.



109 Now, if you want to mark this  
down. I got so many places I want  
to read from. And now in—in the  
Book of Saint Luke, the 24th  
chapter of Saint Luke, we find out  
it's...It is the two of the apostles  
on the road to Emmaus.

And Jesus stepped out, after His  
resurrection, and they were on  
their—their road to over to  
Emmaus, going along the road,  
thinking and talking, and  
weeping, on account of His—His  
death,

and how they seen Him suffer  
for what they had thought was  
of no value at all; they took their  
Lord and crucified Him.  
And—and they were going along  
there, weeping.

110 And He stepped out from  
the roadside and begin to talk  
to them about Christ. He said,  
“Oh, fools and slow to  
understand. Don’t you know  
that all the prophets and the  
Psalms...”

See, what was He doing?  
Identifying Himself to these  
apostles, that all of the  
prophets, and all of the Psalms,  
and everything, was Him,  
expressed. See?

111 And now the reason I never  
took to preach this morning,  
was because, I thought, in  
teaching, we would understand  
it better than just to take a text  
and skip over it. We would just  
teach it.

112 Now, He was saying that all  
the Psalms and all the prophets  
spoke of Him. Well, there,  
therefore, that shows that all of  
the Old Testament, all of the New  
Testament, and all of the Psalms,  
the singing, the songs that were  
sung, were sung of Him.

113 Take the 22nd Psalm, and  
sing it, and compare it with the  
morning of the crucifixion. See,  
“My God, My God, why has Thou  
forsaken Me? All My bones, they  
stare at Me. They pierced My feet  
and My hands.”



Yet, all those things there, them  
singing that Psalm down there  
in the temple, and crucifying the  
very One. See? See, those great  
religious leaders, those great  
men, those great teachers,

and yet so blinded, that was reading the prophets and was singing the songs, and doing the crime that they said they would do.

The same thing is taking place this morning!

114 Now listen close,  
'cause...Now I ain't going to  
even pay any attention to what  
that clock says. I want you to  
get this. See? I want you, get it.  
See? [Congregation rejoices and  
says, "Amen."—Ed.]

115 So you can see here, basically, in the beginning, the very thought that God had in His mind, He hid it from all of those scholars.

And the...Just a number, a selected predestinated number, a predestinated people, was the only ones that heard it.

And now search back the  
Scripture down through the age  
of the prophets, and see if it  
wasn't the same thing. See?

116 Now, and Jesus here referring them to the prophets and the Psalms, He said they all spoke of Him. See?

And here these Jewish teachers, rabbis, doctors of the law, professors, had did exactly like they had done before.



117 Now notice, again, He said,<sup>41</sup>  
“Search the Scriptures, for They  
are They that testify of Me.”  
Search the Scriptures, the  
Scriptures, the entire Scriptures.  
What am I trying to do? To show  
you that this Bible is the thing  
that’s right.

that He spoke of it here and  
showed those Seven Thunders.  
And Look and Life ma-...

207 Life magazine then packed that Circle of a Cloud and Light there that they could not understand, and don't know it yet.

But here telling, “Go there and wait for these mysteries to be revealed,” and here months before it happened, and then it happened at exactly the way He said it would do.

Did you notice in that picture?  
Even that Angel on the right,  
when he was being materialized,  
coming down, with his wings  
back and his head setting  
sideways,

there it is right there in the  
picture, just exactly. Months  
before it happened, told here,  
that, “He’s going to bring the  
Body of believers together; to  
reveal, take up them lost ends.”

208 Here come Luther through,  
he only preached justification,  
just pounded away in that age.  
He didn't know what the age  
was.

Here come Wesley through, and  
he pounded his age through.  
See? A lot of outfalls come from  
it, the other churches raising up.



Then here come Pentecost,  
pounding away, and they  
organized and went right back  
into death again; as we'll get to  
it in a few minutes, right back  
into "death."

209 And then comes the  
revelation of the mystery, to  
reveal what it's all been about.

Where, these little doctrines,  
like Luther brought out  
catechism and everything else;  
and Wesley brought this, that,  
and the other, and these other  
things;

and then Pentecost brought  
organization just the same, and  
“Father, Son, Holy Ghost”  
baptism, and things; not  
knowing any different, 'cause...

Then come back in the last days  
and pick up all these mysteries  
and clearly explain it, reveal it.  
Why? It's all the last days when  
this great mystery that God had  
in His heart is being revealed.

210 Do you get it?

[Congregation says,

“Amen.”—Ed.] If you fail, come

back to this tape again. I don't

know how much longer I'll be

with you.

Remember, this is the Truth, of  
THUS SAITH THE LORD. It's the  
Truth. It's the Scripture.

211 Like the seven mysteries of  
the seven last Seals, the  
mysteries of them. The Seals  
had done been broke, and every  
age had come down, and there  
they had left a lot of scattering.



And God, not willing that it  
should be scattered, He comes  
back and picks up those things,  
those doctrines they started,  
and brought it on out and  
revealed the whole thing.

Same thing He's doing now in revealing the mystery of Christ, how He was God's threefold purpose for the Church! Oh, my! Letting Him out. Reveal!

2. To Reveal 'The  
Mystery' Calls For The  
"Word For Today- The  
Word Comes To A  
Prophet.

65-0219 - This Day This  
Scripture Is Fulfilled

127 Luther was right on time.

Wesley was right on time.

Pentecost was right on time.

Nothing out of the order.

128 Now I ask you to consider  
the age and time we now live in,  
with the promised Word for  
today.

If back in other ages, men could  
say, “this day this Scripture,”  
“this day this Scripture,” then  
what about the Scripture for  
this day? What’s promised for  
this day? Where are we  
standing?

What hour are we living, when  
the clock is beating, the  
scientific clock, three minutes  
before midnight? World has got  
the jitters. The church is in a bed  
of corruption.

There nobody knows where they're standing. What time of day is it? What about the Scripture for this day? The conditions of the church, or, the conditions of the church today!



129 In the world, politics, our world system, is just as rotten as it can be. I'm not a politician. I'm a Christian. But, I ain't got no business talking about politics, but I just want to say they're rotten on both sides.

130 I voted once, that was for Christ; I got to win. The devil voted against me, and Christ voted for me; depends on which way I cast my vote. I'm glad I cast it on Him; let the world say what they want to.

I still believe that He's the same  
yesterday, today, and forever.  
He'll prove it. He certainly will.  
Certainly.  
The increase in crime, juvenile  
delinquency!

131 Look at our nation, once  
the flower of the earth, our  
great democracy was formed  
back there in—in the...at the  
declaration of independence,

and declaration of independence was signed, and we had a democracy, and our great forefathers, and the things that they done, we had a great nation.

132 But she is now rotting,  
and crumbling, and shaking, and  
giving away. And trying to tax  
people, to get money to send  
over yonder, to buy friendship  
with their enemies;

they're throwing it back in our face. One world war, two world war, and still moving on to a third one. Certainly. Politics is rotten, corrupted, rotten to the bottom.

Just exactly what Matthew 24 said it would be, “Nation would be against nation, kingdom against kingdom.” All these things would take place. Let’s consider this now. All right.



133 Notice another, the increase in scientific research. Now, one time, just a...My grandfather went to see my grandmother, in an ox cart.

Now it's a jet plane, or even an orbit into the air, into outer space. Its great...

How, who said this? Daniel 12:4, said, “Knowledge shall increase in the last days.” We see the hour we’re living. Notice now the—the conditions of the world, the condition of science.

134 And notice again, today, in our educational system. Now don't try to deny this. I've got the newspaper clippings,

teaching sex in our chur-...in our schools, of young students to have sexual affairs with one another, to see if they can mate in the world. Yes, sir.

135 How about in our priesthood?  
Tonight I got a piece out of the  
paper. Over in Los Angeles,  
California, of where a bunch of  
clergymen, Baptist and  
Presbyterians, ministers, brought a  
bunch of homosexuals in and  
practiced homosexual,

saying they was trying to win  
them to God. When, that's one  
of the curses of the hour, a  
Sodomite! And the law even  
arrested them.

136 Now where we at? Our whole system has rotted out from under us. I seen the increase in homosexual across the United States has increased twenty or thirty percent over last year.



Think of that, man living with  
man, just exactly like they did in  
Sodom.

137 Increase in crime, juvenile delinquency! What hour are we living? This day this Word of prophecy is fulfilled.

138 The religious world, the church itself, the church, the called-out church, that we call the called-out church, the last church age, the Pentecostal church age, where is it? It's in Laodicea, as the Scripture said.

139 Today they've let down the bars. Their women are half dressed. Their man are...It's a horrible thing. Some of them married three or four times, on deacon boards, and everything else.

They've let down, and brought in corruption, because they've set in councils and took the place with the world.

64-0112 — Shalom

168 Now to you adults, the  
Scripture is God's Symphony.

Yes. Hallelujah! Only the  
Composer knows what it really  
means and He reveals it to  
those who are listening,

who are interested in knowing  
what the drama is. But you'd  
have to know about a symphony  
first, see. It's not just something  
you see,

it's the—the changing, the  
junctions of the Word, of the  
music. It throws; sometime it's  
going this way for a while, a  
certain beat, after a while it  
changes all around. What is it?



To you who wouldn't understand It or don't know nothing about It, not interested in It, it's just a racket, it's a fuss. But to those who know about It, they're watching for It, they know It's coming. Hallelujah!

169 So we have these times of Symphonies, of the Symphony of God's Word, that the whole drama changes. You who are interested, listen for that change. You know it's getting close. You hear the way the drums are beating,

amen, want something to happen. You know this is a change, see, it's going to break out into a burst in a few minutes. See? And you're watching for it, you can tell the way the drums are timing. O God!

If you can hear the drums of the<sup>92</sup>  
finish now, if you can hear the  
echo of the music of the  
Heavenly Word singing Itself  
out, “And it shall come to pass  
in the last days!” The Symphony  
of God’s great drama that He’s  
playing,

It changes Him, His Symphony at the junction. The composer and those who are interested, listen for the change. That's what all this stuff is to us, we're listening, we're watching.

Every time He appears,  
something happens, we see the  
time getting close. We see back  
yonder not long ago when that  
Church Ages was being drawed  
out, we were listening.

We seen it was right with the Word, beating with the Word. After a while, what happened? Here He come, Himself, and vindicated it.

170 We heard the Word say, that, “In the days of the seventh angel.” In the Church Age, He just said, “The seventh angel’s Message would be the last Message.”



And then, oh, we find out over here in Revelation 10, “In the days of the Message of the seventh angel, the mysteries of God should be finished,” the Seventh Seal would be pulled back. It should be there.

Then all at once, when it's happening, a vision broke, said, "Go to Tucson, a great noise will take place at this time so you'll be thoroughly understanding and know that it's sent. It'll just shake the earth, nearly."

All of you know about it. It's on  
tape, months before it  
happened. Then it happened!  
Then appeared in the sky.  
"Shalom!" What is it? It's  
a-changing beats, the  
Symphony.

171 Then one time He said about the Third Pull, how it would come by this one way, then by knowing the heart, and then the spoken Word.

1 Kings 22:1-8

1 And they continued three  
years without war between Syria  
and Israel.

2-And it came to pass in the  
third year, that Jehoshaphat the  
king of Judah came down to the  
king of Israel.

<sup>3</sup> And the king of Israel said unto his servants, Know ye that Ramoth in Gilead is ours, and we be still, and take it not out of the hand of the king of Syria?

<sup>4</sup> And he said unto Jehoshaphat,  
Wilt thou go with me to battle  
to Ramothgilead? And  
Jehoshaphat said to the king of  
Israel, I am as thou art, my  
people as thy people, my horses  
as thy horses.



5 And Jehoshaphat said unto the  
king of Israel, Enquire, I pray  
thee, at the word of  
the LORD to day.

<sup>6</sup> Then the king of Israel gathered the prophets together, about four hundred men, and said unto them, Shall I go against Ramothgilead to battle, or shall I forbear? And they said, Go up; for the LORD shall deliver it into the hand of the king.

<sup>7</sup> And Jehoshaphat said, Is there  
not here a prophet of  
the LORD besides, that we  
might enquire of him?

3. God's Messengers Left  
Loose Ends- ONLY A  
Foreordained Vindicated  
Prophet Could Pick Them,  
Tie Them Together Before  
The Sealing By The  
INSPECTOR.

62-1230E - Is This The Sign Of  
The End, Sir?

289 Now watch. There is a lot of  
Truth lost out there, (why?)  
where others compromised on  
Truth.

But this seventh angel don't  
compromise on nothing. He  
gathers up all the loose ends,  
gathers them all up.

And at his sounding, “All the  
mystery of God should be  
finished.” Oh! God, send him. All  
of the hidden mysteries was  
finished when, he, It was  
revealed to him.



By what? If these are hidden  
mysteries, the man will have to  
be a prophet. And didn't we just  
get through and see that the  
prophet,

that would come in the last age,  
would be that great Elijah that  
we been looking for? Because,  
these mysteries that's hid,  
through the theologians, will  
have to be revealed; to God.

And the Word comes only to the prophet. And we know it. He will be the second Elijah, as promised. Oh, my! The Message he—he'll bring will be the mysteries, all, all these things.

290 We have water baptism. It's all mixed up. That's right. One sprinkles; one pours. One takes "Father, Son, Holy Ghost."

One takes this. One baptizes  
three times, face forward; for,  
one for a God named “Father,”

another one for a God named “Son,” another one for a God named “Holy Ghost.” Other one said, “You’re wrong. He has to baptize backwards, three times, that way.” And, oh, what a mess!

291 But the whole thing has been wound up, for there's only one God, and His Name is Jesus Christ.

“And there’s not another Name under Heaven whereby men must be saved.” There’s not one text of Scripture, nowhere in the Bible,



where anybody was ever baptized in any other way but in the Name of Jesus Christ. Not one time was any of the new Church, or the Church of Jesus Christ, ever sprinkled, poured, or anything else.

Not one time was ever a ceremony used, “I baptize thee in the name of the Father, Son, Holy Ghost.” It’s creeds and things.

292 And in the battle for Truth,  
them ends has been lost, but  
God said they would be restored  
again in the last day.

“I will restore,” saith the Lord.  
We went through that, not long ago, The Bride Tree. It’ll take a prophet. The Bible says that he would be here. That’s right.

Malachi 4, speaks that he'll be here, and we believe that he will. We're looking for him. And we're looking for his manifestation, and we'll see the vindicated Word of God.

293 There will just be a few  
understand it. “As it was in the  
days of Noah, so will it be in the  
coming of the Son of man.”  
What was saved?

Five souls...In the days of Lot,  
there was actually three saved.  
The wife started out, and lost.  
“So shall it be in the coming of  
the Son of man.”

There will be very few saved,  
translated in that time; one of  
the mysteries, of that Church  
being taken up. Like Lot was  
taken, like Lot was taken out,  
away;



Noah was taken up; and the Church will be taken up, also. One went in; and one went out; and the other One goes up. See? It's exactly, perfectly.

294 The Word comes. “The Book that is written within,” is then completed when this, all these mysteries have finished to be sounded. Now let me read it again, now, so you’ll be sure. Now look:

But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel (the last angel), when he shall begin to sound, the mystery of God should be finished,...

295 Now, what is “the mystery of God,” one of them? Paul said, in First Timothy 3, I believe it was, said, “Without controversy great is the mystery of godliness:

for God was manifested in the flesh (we handled Him, seen Him), received up into Glory, witnessed by Angels, vindicated here on earth.” God was! Sure, it’s a great mystery, but it’s all solved.

Not “Father, Son, and Holy Ghost,” three Gods; but, one God in three offices. The Fatherhood, under Moses; the Sonship, under Christ; the Holy Ghost, under this dispensation.

Three dispensations of the same God; not three Gods. The mystery is finished now. The Bible said it should be. When the...

342 Now, look, when it is time for the seven voices. Then it's time for the seven voices, when the Book is completed, of Revelation 10 to be revealed. Now notice. Listen.



343 Now, I won't keep you too much longer. I know I'm wearing you out, here. It's twenty minutes till ten. [Congregation says, "No. Go ahead!"—Ed.]  
Listen close now.

I know, standing up, and you all changing positions and things. I'll be glad when the church gets fixed so we won't have to be cramped up. We can take all day to preach it.

344 Now notice. Now note. The  
seven voices was thunders,  
blasts.

God, help us. If I'm wrong, Lord,  
forgive me.

345 I'm asking you the question. It  
blasted with thunder, when this  
voice rung out. Did you notice,  
that, when the Seven Seals that  
follow the seven church ages,  
when the First Seal was opened,  
that there was a thunder?

The First Seals in the Book was opened, there was a thunder; would not this First Seal of the outside Book open the same way? God doesn't change His program. Let's turn over to Revelation 6.

And I saw when the Lamb had opened one of the seals, and I heard, as it was the noise of a thunder, and one of the four beasts said, Come and see.

346 Now, there never was another thunder. “And the last Seal was opened, there was space in Heaven for a half hour of silence.” But, the First Seal was opened, there was a blast of thunder.

347 Oh, church, could it be? Are  
we that far? Friends, think.  
Maybe. I hope it isn't. But what  
if it is? What was that blast?  
And before God, and this open  
Bible, I lie not. Blast, that shook  
the earth!



348 And when the First Seal, of the seven that was opened in the Bible, it come forth, just One, but a blast that shook the whole thing; a thunder.

And then if the Seals that's on the backside would open, would not it be a thunder, too? I don't know. I can't say.

349 There was a thunder, the First Seal, and the Seal was a thunder. The Trumpet was opened at that time. And the Trumpet was blown at Pentecost, of course. I won't get into that.

350 Now, if the vision was Scriptural; the vision I'm speaking of, that I saw last Saturday morning. Is a week ago, now. If, now remember here, if the vision was Scriptural,

it must be interpreted by the  
Scripture, or a continuation of  
the same Scripture. [Brother  
Branham pauses—Ed.] I just  
waited, so that soaks in. If...

351 This that I have seen, what  
it was, I do not know, but I am  
scared to death. Are we wasted  
away? Are we at the end?

Remember, this Angel said, when this taken place, He swore, “There would be time no more.” I wonder if we really get this one.

352 You say, “Well, look like It’d be blasting acro-...” Brother, He comes in a minute when you think not. You will hear It your last time.



353 Now is It plain? When the First Seal was opened, the Seals that was inside the Book, these mysteries that was sounded forth: justification, sanctification, Roman Catholic church, Protestants!

And when all their little battles and things left these loose ends in the Word of God, the seventh angel comes on and gathers them all up and explains them. See? And then, he finishes, Seven Thunders utter out.

354 When John started to write,  
said, “Don’t write it. But, seal  
it.”

355 “And the First Seal was opened,” of the Seals on the inside of the Book, It opened with a thunder. Uh!

356 If this is Scripture, it can only be...If any Scripture is...Anything that's supposed to be of the Bible...

357 It's just like, you can't tell me there's such a thing as a "purgatory" and things like that. There's no Scripture in the Bible to back it up.

You can't tell me of these things, like the book of the Maccabees, which they might be all right..." And that fourth Book of Daniel, where an Angel grabbed him by the hair of the head, and said...set him down."

There's no such stuff as that ever took place in the Bible, where, "Jesus of Nazareth made a little clay bird, and put legs on it, said, 'Whew! Fly away, little birdie,'" it's nonsense.



There's nothing in the Bible to back that up. So it don't fool...The—the translators, God seen that the translators wouldn't even add that dogmas and nonsense.

Might been good people, the Maccabee brothers. They were that. I don't say they wasn't good people. But it wasn't Scriptural.

358 This is the complete  
revelation of Jesus Christ.  
“Nothing can be added to It or  
taken from It.”

And if we put that in There, it don't act with the rest of the Scripture. There is sixty-six Books of this Bible, and not one Word will contradict the other One.

359 And then, if this is the continuation, for the sounding of these last trumpets, or these last Seven Thunders that's coming forth, the mysteries, the last Seals, It'll have to compete,

or compare, with the rest the  
Scripture. And if them first Ones  
in there opened with a blast of  
thunder, the second Ones will,  
too, that's on the backside.

Watch what happens. If the vision was Scripture, then it must be interpreted by the Scripture, or a continuation of the same Scripture.

360 Notice, Revelation, 3 and 4,  
“Seven Thunders.” Seven  
Thunders, and then notice, 3  
and 4,



and then (what?) an oath from that mighty Angel, that, “Time was finished.” When these Thunders, you see, brought forth their voices, then the Angel...

361 Just think of it! “An Angel, clothed in a cloud, and a rainbow covenant over His head.” Why, you know Who that is.

“Put one foot on the land, and on the sea, and lift up His hand and swore, that, ‘When them Seven Thunders uttered their voices,’ that, ‘time would be no more.’”

362 And if the ministry of the  
mysteries of God is finished,  
what if that is them seven  
mysteries coming forth? And a  
humble, little church like ours,  
that the Almighty has come and  
regarded the low estate of His  
people!

You say, “What? I don’t think so.” It might not be. But what if it is? Then time has run out. Did you think it? Be serious. It may be later than we think.

363 These stars falling into their constellation back yonder! That Angel coming, and said, “As John was sent to wind up the Old Testament and to bring forth the introduction of Christ,

a Message will wind up the loose ends and will introduce the Messiah just before His Coming, the Message of the last days.”

## 65-0117 — A Paradox

87 Now we're taught, in Revelation the 6th chapter, I believe, yeah, 6th chapter, of the Seven Seals. That's supposed...



The Book to be sealed up with seven mysteries, or Seven Seals, Revelation 6. And in the last day, Revelation 10, in Revelation 10, we find out that the Laodicea, last messenger of the last age,

and during the time of his prophecy, that the Seven Seals would be opened, the seven mysteries, sevenfold mysteries that had been left off.

88 In every age there had been some of It left off. The reformer didn't have time to take care of It. In the days of Luther, he only preached justification by faith.

He was gone, they made a church. After that come Wesley, he preached sanctification. There it was. And along come the Pentecostals.

89 But we're promised,  
according to Revelation 10, and  
according to Malachi 4, and  
Saint Luke 22:17, and so forth,  
that there is got to come a—  
an Ephesians to this.

There is promised it, friends.  
There must come an Ephesians,  
that these sevenfold mysteries of  
the Word of God must be  
unfolded. And it's in the  
Laodicean age that this takes  
place. I believe that we're—we're  
there.

90 I believe we're right in the shadows of the Coming of the Son of God. And as Joshua, just before the Ephesians raised up, so did John the Baptist raise up just before the next Ephesian. And we're promised another, another Ephesians.

It's predicted here in the Scripture, therefore I think that we are living in the Ephesians again. Back again to...We are promised that what was left off during those seven ages.



91 Now you cannot add nothing to the Book, or take nothing from It. Revelation 22:18 says so, “Who will ever, will add one word, or take one Word, his part will be taken from the Book of Life.” Now we cannot add or take.

92 So therefore we know that Luther could not get to It; Wesley, and so forth, the reformers, Knox, Finney, Calvin, on down, so forth, they didn't get It all, but what they had was the Gospel Truth.

93 But now in the last days, we are given the understanding, by the Word, that we are going to understand It, because it'll come an Ephesian age to it.

And we're here! Now, paradox!  
I'll leave that hang, because I  
just got about ten more  
minutes and then we'll have the  
prayer line. Paradox!

# 63-0317E - The Breach Between The<sup>189</sup> Seven Church Ages And The Seven Seals

37 Now, see, the mystery of this Seven-Seal Book will be revealed at the sounding of the seventh church angel's Message. See? "The seventh angel begins to sound,"

and there is the Messages wrote out there, and we got it in tape and book form. Now, “At the beginning of the sounding of the Message, the mystery of God should be finished, see, at that time.”

Now we will notice. The Book, of the mystery of God, is not revealed until the seventh angel's Message is sounded.

38 Now, these points will be important in the Seals, I'm sure, 'cause it must, every bit, tie together.



39 Now, it's wrote mysterious, because no man, nowhere, knows it. God alone, Jesus Christ, see. Now, but is...It is a Book, a mysterious Book. It's the Book of Redemption. We'll get into that, in a little while.

And now we know that this Book of Redemption will not be thoroughly understood; It's probed at, through six church ages.

But at the end, when the seventh angel begins to sound his mystery, he winds up all of the loose ends that these fellows probed at. And the mysteries comes down from God, as the Word of God,

and reveals the entire revelation of God, then the Godhead and everything else is settled. All the mysteries, serpent's seed, and whatever more, is to be revealed.

40 Now, you see, I'm just not making that up. That's what...It's THUS SAITH THE LORD. I'll read it to you out of the Book,

“The sounding of the seventh angel’s Message, the mystery of God should be finished, that’s been declared by His holy prophets,” that’s the prophets who has wrote the Word.

At the sounding, of the seventh church age, the last church age, all the loose ends, that through these church ages has been probed at, will be wound up together.

41 And when the Seals are  
broke, and the mystery is  
revealed, down comes the  
Angel, the Messenger,



Christ, setting His foot upon the land and upon the sea, with a rainbow over His head. Now, remember, this seventh angel is on earth at the time of this Coming.

42 Just as John was giving his message, the same time that Messiah come in the days. John knew he would see Him, because he was going to introduce Him.

43 And we realize that, in the Scriptures, over in Malachi 4, there is to be a one like John, an—an Elijah to whom the Word of God can come to. And he is to reveal, by the Holy Spirit, all the mysteries of God,

and restore the Faith of the children back to the faith of the apostolic fathers, restore back all these mysteries that's been probed at, through these denominational years.

Now, that's what the Word said.  
I'm just responsible for what It  
said. See? It's—It's written, is  
right. That's what It is.

60 It's little, loose ends  
that...These great warriors has  
come on the scene, such as  
Irenaeus, and Martin, Saint

and revealed to the Church, and then time is no more. See? How wonderful! Then, the Book, then, is a Book of Redemption. For, then It goes ahead...

62 And we'll bring in, later on, how the hundred and forty-four thousand is brought in, and so forth. All right. That's Jew.

63 Now, now, Paul. Let's read a little bit. I get some of these Scriptures, and I think we ought to—to read Them. Now let's all of us turn; Paul, in Ephesians 1.

64 Many of them I see are writing. They got their books and writing the Scriptures down, marking them in their Bible, for a chain. So, that's—that's fine. I like for you to do that, and then go home and study it.

See? And—and if you study It, yourself, then you'll—you'll understand It better. See? Just study It, and ask God to help you to understand.

65 Now let's read a—a Scripture  
I got written down here.  
Ephesians 1:13 and 14, now.



In whom we also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, and the gospel of your salvation: in whom...after that ye believed, ye were sealed with the holy Spirit of promise,

Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory. See?

66 Now, while we got the  
Scriptures open, let us...See, the  
Holy Spirit here, Itself, is a Seal.  
The Holy Spirit is a Seal.

And a Seal signifies (what?) a finished work, the Holy Spirit being a Seal to the individual. And to that individual, when he receives the Holy Spirit, then his time of groaning is over, see, because it is a finished work.

67 Like, I used to work for the  
railroad company, and we'd load  
box cars with cans and different  
things from the canning factory.  
And, but, then, before that car  
could be sealed,

the inspector come around, to  
see if that car was properly  
loaded.

If not, [Brother Branham claps  
his hands—Ed.] the first time it  
rammed together with  
something, it'd scatter the stuff  
and break it,

and—and the railroad company was responsible. And that inspector would test everything, to see if it was properly in place.

If it wasn't, he condemned the car. Then we had to do it all over again, until the inspector was satisfied. And then when the inspector is satisfied, he shuts the door.



The inspector shuts the door.  
And the inspector places a seal  
upon it, and then no one can  
break this seal until it reaches its  
destination.

68 That's what the Holy Spirit has been doing. See? He goes and He inspects. That's the reason you can't have these things and...You say, "I spoke in tongues, and I shouted, and I danced in the Spirit."

That don't have nothing to do with It. See? The Holy Spirit inspects that person until He's thoroughly satisfied and knows that they are.

69 Then, they are sealed unto their Eternal destination. There is not nothing can ever break that Seal.

The Bible...You're putting your Scripture down. Ephesians 4:30, said, "Grieve not the Holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed until the Day of your Redemption."

Hold that word, “redemption,”  
see. Until the day that the Book  
of Redemption has been  
revealed, and the Redeemer  
comes to claim His possession!

Nothing can do it. See? “Don’t grieve It.” Stay...Do things that pleases God, for the Book is sealed, now, and you are sealed. The Holy Spirit, Itself, is the Seal.

70 Seal signifies...Now, this is  
words I got from the dictionary.  
Seal signifies a “finished work.”



And when the Seventh Seal is broken, the mystery of God that's sealed in these mysterious Seals is finished. Until the day that Seal is broke, and then it's revealed what's on the inside of It.

71 If the man is wondering what's in that box car, say, "There is supposed to be such-and-such. There is supposed to be." He is presuming.

But when the seal is broken, and the door is open, we see into it then and see exactly what's in there.

You see it? And that'll only be done at the end time.

72 Another thing a Seal signifies, is “ownership.” See, the Seal has a mark on It, shows ownership.

When you are bought by the Blood of Jesus Christ, and sealed by the Holy Ghost, you no longer belong to the world or anything pertaining to the world. You are owned by God.

73 Another thing, is, a Seal is a “security.” Seal means you are secured. Now, you that don’t believe in Eternal security, I don’t know, see.

But now, but, a Seal signifies security to its destination. Woe unto that guy that would try to break that Seal! And the Holy Spirit Seal cannot be broken.

There was three witnesses of the earth, three witnesses of heaven as a witness, both in heaven and in earth. God always vindicates. He never does nothing before first He sends forth a witness. And here it is.

My beloved friends here in this lovely city, this great move that you see moving in the earth today is a warning. Something's fixing to happen. Take it from the Bible.

35 Every junction of time God sends forth prophets, then angels, and gives a warning. Like in the—before the antediluvian destruction before every—every other time, God always sends warnings first.

He could not put punishment on the earth without (and be just), without first sending warning. So remember, the handwriting's on the wall.

These things...God doesn't just play around and—and dally around like we do. But when you see the hand of God moving, it's a milestone. It's pointing to something.



And we're at the end of the six thousand years. Everything in history, everything in the Scripture, everything in the heavens, everything on the earth is pointing to a change right now.

Prophets, angels, signs,  
wonders, and the church cold  
and formal, to be spued from  
God's mouth just like He  
said...Take courage and be  
ready. Something's fixing to  
happen.

36 Notice something fixing to happen here. And God was going to, at this time, settle it before the earth, once forever. Now, back in the Old Testament...

And many of the ministers will know this, and many of you Sunday school teachers and Bible readers. In the Old Testament...And I think here's where our churches has made a great mistake.

And the reason I thought on this, that it might be profitable for tonight...The Old Testament is a shadow of the New. And myself, I have no education;

so, I have to be a typologist to know where I'm standing. And if I look at a shadow of something, I can pretty well judge what the positive will be. So in the Old Testament all those things were shadows and types.

210 Now, anyone knows that Amos  
3:7 said that God promised that He  
would never do nothing until first  
He revealed it to His prophet.  
Through the church ages we've had  
reformers;

but promised by Malachi 4 that there would be a prophet in the land in the last days (because it has to fit that pattern, see) before the end time come.

211 Before Jesus come the first,  
Elijah come, Elijah of Malachi 3.  
Matthew 11 says so, “If you can  
understand it, this is who was  
spoken of, ‘Behold, I send  
My—My messenger before Me.’”

Now, He's prophesied, all theologians believe that: that in the last day, the Spirit of Elijah is to come, too. It has to come five times, God uses that Spirit: Elisha, Elijah, John the Baptist,

and for the Gentile church, and then for the Jews in Revelation the 11th chapter. That's, God's g-r-a-c-e, f-a-i-t-h, J-e-s-u-s, Jesus, the—the letter five. Can't stop at four, it has to go to five. See? Notice!

212 Now, He promised that, so that sets the Bible just exactly to this day, and the Sodom and Gomorrah. And Elijah was not...



That wasn't Elijah; That was the Spirit of God on Elijah; Elijah was just a man. Now, we've had Elijahs, and Elijahs' coats, and Elijahs' mantles, and Elijahs' everything.

But the Elijah of this day is the Lord Jesus Christ. He is to come according to Matthew the seventeen-...Luke 17:30, is, the Son of man is to reveal Himself among His people.

Not a man, God! But it'll come through a prophet. Now, He never had two major prophets at the same time, never, in the world. See? No matter how much there's...two—two heads can't...

It has to be one head. God has to get one man under His control. See? There's one God; there was Father, Son, and Holy Ghost, but one God over it all, notice, and just used them offices.

108 Now we know that He is with us. We believe that. You see His Word made manifest, by photographs, by Scriptures, by declarations in the Heaven, on earth, everything else that He said. Not one time has it failed.

I ask any person to show me, from the different parts of the country, or over the world, you're—you're obligated to write me and tell me, where one time it ever failed. Perfect, word by word, now, that's a promise.

109 Why was He to appear in this last days? If you go back, and you tape listeners, to The Bride Tree,

and bring up where Christ was,  
that Tree that was in the garden  
of Eden. The first Adam that fell;  
and this Second Adam was cut  
down by sin.

They hung Him on a Roman tree, and out of that drew the...come out the Bride Tree that He promised, that we see in the Scriptures, now, in order to get the Bride.

110 Like the pyramid, how it comes in the minority all the time, from the great wide; from Luther, Wesley, Pentecost, and then the capstone in the top of it is so honed,

and each one of those stones  
are so perfectly put together.  
And we don't know yet how  
they did it, but it's so perfectly  
put together in that pyramid!  
And we're not pyramid teaching  
now, we're just...



111 Enoch and them built it,  
years ago, and it stands for a  
symbol. Just the same as the sun

112 Go into the prophet's chamber and watch them seven steps. Where did the—where did the guard meet the challenge to bring the comer into the presence of the king?

At the top of the steps; was in the seventh step. There shows that we've got to come again with that same Spirit that was on John;

he introduced the Messiah. He was greater than all the prophets; he introduced It. And we've got to come to a place, again, to something that's going to introduce the Messiah.

Oh, what a glorious lesson! By the quickening Power, the first One! Although, He had—He had been typed; and many times, as we'll see later, that He was typed.

But this was really the Firstfruit of them that slept. He was waved over the promised Seed that had promise of Life.

91 He was waved at the Day of Pentecost, “when there came a sound from Heaven like a waving, mighty rushing wind,”

92 And to be waved again, we realize, in the last day, according to Luke 17:30, in the Son day again, “in the day that the S-o-n of man will be revealed,” or waved again over the people.

93 Now, Who is the Son of man? “In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

And the Word was made flesh,  
and dwelt among us.” And if all  
the teaching that we have, and  
confirmation of the Word of  
God; by Word of God, by signs,  
by wonders, we see today,

that in the Book of—of Luke  
here, that as we just quoted  
from, or the—the Luke the 17th  
chapter and the 30th verse; and  
Malachi 4, and the different  
Scriptures that we are  
acquainted with,

that that Word again is waved over the people, that the dead traditions of man is dead, and the Son of God is alive again with the baptism of the Holy Spirit right among us, and is giving us Life.

94 As Christ was the first One to raise, from all the prophets, and so forth; although typed in many places, He was the Firstfruits of those that slept.

In the Bride, coming of Christ,  
coming out of the church,  
there'll have to be a Sheaf  
waved again in the last days.  
Oh, my!



95 Waving of the sheaf! What was the sheaf? The first one that come to mature, the first one that proved it was a wheat, that proved it was a sheaf.

96 Hallelujah! I'm sure you see what I'm talking about. It was waved over the people. And the first time there will come forth, for the Bride age, for a resurrection out of dark denominationalism,

will be a Message, that the full maturity of the Word has turned back again in Its full Power, and being waved over the people, by the same signs and wonders that He did back there.

97 “Because I live, ye live also,”  
speaking to His Wife. “Because I  
live, ye live also.” What a  
resurrection that that was!

And what a resurrection this is,  
to be quickened from the dead,  
“to be made alive in Christ  
Jesus,” by God’s quickening  
Power!
