It was perfect, and that's why he cried out, "Speak!" Because, he had seen before him that he (was) had been able to achieve, to bring to pass the vision that was in his mind.

And therefore, under inspiration, he done something out of the reason, out of the ordinary. He struck it, and hollered, "Speak!" See, he wouldn't have done that if he had thought.

But he didn't think. It was inspiration of seeing what he had in his mind setting there perfectly before him.

When He made a man in His Own image, so perfect that It reflected Him, God spoke through the image of man, showing what He would do.

He spoke through the prophets as they were in their potential image, as He was bringing it up to the Head. But when He come in the Head, He was all the image of God;

He was portraying Himself. Then, smitten for us, now He is the Masterpiece to us, the Gift of God, Jesus Christ, Eternal Life. I hope we never forget that.

and we was declared an independence, as a nation. According to history, there has never been a democracy at any time last over two hundred years.

And that was 1776, July the fourth. And we're just eleven years left. Will it make it? No, can't, see. Eleven years. And, if it does, it'll break all history.

77 And we see the condition of time. We see the condition of the people. We see the condition of politics.

We see the condition of the world. It can't stand. It's got to sink, like the Titanic. It must go down, for theirs give room.

One nation gives room to another, as it falls. And this kingdom must fall, and every other kingdom, to give room to that Kingdom that's coming, which cannot fall.

"For we receive a Kingdom that cannot be moved," through this perfect image of God, the Masterpiece.

78 God, when He looked upon Him, He was so inspired! He was so...to see Him the way He looked, and to see the—the form of Him,

He was so inspired that it would be the perfect Masterpiece of a Redeemer, Jesus the Redeemer. So, God, in order to be smitten, Himself; because, to pay His Own penalty,

God and Christ became One, so God could be smote in the Image, He could be scarred. And that's why Isaiah said, "We did esteem Him smitten and afflicted of God.

Yet He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquity; the chastisement of our peace was upon Him, and with His stripes we were healed."

79 The perfect Image, the God-Man! God, in en morphe, had changed from Supernatural to the vision, and the vision was projected into the Image.

And the Image was smitten so that the Supernatural could taste the feeling of death, God's perfect Masterpiece. He could not do it in Moses. He could not do it in the prophets; Isaiah, who was sawed with saws till he was sawed to pieces. He could not do it in the prophets that were stoned.

He could not do it, because He couldn't feel it; there was just a portion of Him. But in this perfect Masterpiece, He was the fullness of the

Godhead bodily.

He could not only project Moses; He could project His entire Being into this Person, and taste death for the whole human race.

God's perfect Masterpiece! God, so inspired by seeing It, He become the Redeemer of all ages; to speak for those in the backgrounds, who had been before, and now.

81 God, down through the age, hewing away, by the patriarchs, and made His platform, and brought them up from the different things that He would lay this foundation upon.

Upon this He begin to build His Word, the prophets. And then, finally, come out to the perfect Prophet, the perfect Foundation, the perfect vision God had.

82 And now, in order for this to speak, He is the Word. And for the Word to speak, He must come into the Image.

And then for the Image to speak, it's got to be smitten. He comes into the Image, and then in order to speak, the perfect Redeemer.

And She does it in His Name. She has THUS SAITH THE LORD. Then It is germitized, so the Holy Spirit waters It until It is grown and serves Its purpose.

58 In the Church of the living God, this morning, lays the power to heal all sickness. In the Church of the living God lays power to overcome all temptation.

In the possession of the Church of the living God, this morning, lays the power to chain sin and throw it away, and receive the baptism of the Holy Ghost, in the Church of Jesus Christ.

"Whatsoever you desire, ask in My Name, and it shall be given to you. A little while, and the world (the not-Seed, the unregenerated seed) will see Me no more.

Yet you'll see Me, for I'll be with you, even in you, to the end of the world." What? The Royal Seed. "The works that I do, shall you do also.

I'll verify Myself that I'm with you, for these signs shall follow them that believe." He shall possess the seed of his enemy. He shall possess.

His Seed shall possess the gate of his enemy, no matter what the gate is. If it's sickness,

temptations, sin, whatever gate it is, it's conquered. And the Seed of Abraham possess it.

59 Aren't you happy, this morning, to know that we stand now more than a conqueror? More than a conqueror! Oh, there's nothing to fight about. The fight is over. The whistle has blowed.

The flag has rose. And in the midst of every sin pile, every midst of every sick room, is the old rugged cross, planted by the Blood of Jesus Christ, a Conqueror.

Only thing we do is believe, look and live. "I'll be with you. I'll prove. People come in the last days, and say, 'Oh, well, that was.' But I'll be with you.

And the very things I did, here on earth, I'll be in you, doing the very same thing. Then they'll know. They'll see Me. The...My people will see Me. The Seed of Abraham will see Me.

They'll know Me. They'll recognize Me. The others will call Me, 'Beelzebub,' just like they have done. But you shall know Me, for I'll be with you. You'll see Me, see with your eye.

You'll see Me, for I'll be with you, even to the end of the world, the very same things that I do. He that believeth on Me, the works that I do shall he do also, same kind of work."

60 And, today, the Church of the living God has the privilege of standing and seeing the conquering,

resurrected Jesus Christ, the Son of the living God, standing present, living in His Church, doing the same thing He did then. Then we possess the gate of every enemy.

61 If you've got an enemy this morning, then, my brother, there's only, if you are a Seed of Abraham, after hearing this, there's not enough devils in hell can keep that gate before you.

It'll open. I don't care what it is. You walk up there, as a promised Seed, say, "I claim this for mine.

This is mine, because God swore that He'd raise up Jesus, and, through Jesus, I'd conquer it. I come in the Name of that Conqueror, Jesus Christ. Step back. I'm passing through." Amen.

"He shall possess the gate of the enemy." Then stand up there, with your shoulders back and your shield a shining, covered by the Blood of the Lord Jesus. The enemy will recognize it.

62 If you have need, talk to Him now while we pray, you in here, this morning, while you have your heads bowed. And if you have a need, will you just raise your hand towards Jesus? And just speak it in your heart, in your heart, and say, "Lord, You know my need.

Now, I have heard, this morning, and that's the Bible, 'He shall possess the gate of the enemy." I'm coming to possess the gate. Maybe I have a temper. Maybe I need the Holy Spirit.

Sin has bound me down. I have need. But I'm coming to the gate now. I'm going to take it, this morning, my gate. So, give way, I'm coming through."

<u>63-0714M — Why Cry? Speak!</u> 202 Here we see Moses expressingly, fully human nature, always wants God to get behind you and push you into something.

Now, that's us today. You want God, after we've seen all we've seen, yet you want God to push you to do something. See?

203 Moses had just laxed around, said, "God, I'll go ask You, see what You say. Yeah, yeah, You say it. Well, all right, I'll say it, too." See?

204 But here God had ordained him for the job, proved that He was with him. And here he is, the circumstance comes up, and then he begins to cry, "What can I do? Lord, what can I do?"

205 Now you remember, he had already prophesied here, for he said, "These Egyptians that you see today, you'll see no more." And then immediately begin to cry out, "God, what can we do?"

See? After he done done a pretty good job in prophesying there. You see, he done told them what would happen. If the Word of God was in him, It was in him.

And when he was telling that, it actually come to pass. What he said was already going to come to pass, and here he was crying out, "What am I going to do?"

206 Oh, if that isn't human beings! If that isn't me! If that isn't me! See?

207 He had already proved, "What you say will happen. I'm with you."

208 And here a circumstance rose in a moment. "What must l do? What must I do, Lord? Hey, Lord, where are You at? Hey, do You hear me? What must I do?"

And He had already ordained him, and a vindicated him, and proved and worked everything through him. And here, "God?" Oh, my! Fully expressing, man wants to rest and let God do the pushing.

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209 And, yet, he knew that God had anointed him for this job, to do this, and God had clearly a vindicated his claims.

It was time for the people to be delivered. God, through his miracles and wonders, had drawed them all together in one group. You follow me?

Brought them all together in one group, vindicated his claims. Scripture said so; here was the sign, here was the evidence here, everything that he said. Then he come among them as a prophet.

Ever, whatever he said, God honored it, even to create and bring up flies, and brought things in existence. And everything that He had promised him, here He done it.

210 But he wanted to wait on THUS SAITH THE LORD. See? He should have known that the very vindication of his call was THUS SAITH THE LORD.

His job that he was ordained to was THUS SAITH THE LORD. Can you get it? Hmm! Why did he wait on THUS SAITH THE LORD?

211 He wanted, "Lord, what can I do? Here I've brought these children out here, this far. Here is the circumstance, Pharaoh is coming. They're all going to die. What must I do? What must I do?" Hum! Hum!

212 He had already predicted what they was going to do. He had already told just exactly what, to do it.

He predicted the end of the very nation he was brought up in. I hope you understand. Huh? Moses had already said, "You'll not see them anymore.

God is going to destroy them. They've made fun of you long enough. God will destroy them." He had already predicted what would happen to them.

213 Then, "Lord, what must l do?" See the human nature there? See? "What must I do? I'm going to wait for THUS SAITH THE LORD." Yes, sir. "I'll see what the Lord says, then I'll do it." Huh!

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
