1. Christ Intercedes On Our Confession – WHAT ARE YOU CONFESSING?

61-0519 - Sirs, We Would See Jesus

9 Now, I might make this statement, that all healing, all salvation is—is what God has achieved for us through Christ. It's already a finished work.

Now, bear that in mind as you are prayed for, or tell your friends, that there's nothing that we can do to improve it, nothing we can do to further it. The only thing we can do is teach it (See?), that it's already been achieved. God Himself did that for us at Calvary. And there "He was wounded for our transgressions, bruised for our iniquity; the chastisement of our peace was upon Him, and with His stripes we were healed." It's a past tense.

Now, it's up to you and I to appropriate faith, in ourselves to accept what Christ has did for us. And the moment we accept it and confess that He has done it, then He's setting at the right hand of God to make intercessions upon our confession.

10 Now, the word confess there in the...is same word (the ministers here would know it) profess it says, but profess and confess is the same word. To profess it was done confess it. It come from the same Greek word. And we know that it...

We must confess that He has done it, and He cannot do it until we confess it. And then He's the High Priest to make intercessions upon what we confess that He has done for us. That makes a faith in a finished work that Christ did for us at Calvary. Just that simple. Now, that's the unadulterated Gospel.

<u>Abraham</u>

35 What is confess? "Confess" is "to say the same thing." That's what you—what a confession is. Confess is to say the same thing, and say the same thing He said.

Say what He said; don't say what your feelings say; don't say what your neighbor says; say what God said. Confess it and believe it.

Don't look at your symptoms; the symptoms is the worst thing the enemy...God has to fight against. Symptoms. Everybody says, "Well, I was prayed for, but my hand's no better."

It'll never be like that. Never will. You're looking at your hand. Don't look at your hand; look what God said. What if Abraham said, "Now, Sarah...

The first month...Now, he had lived with her for—for years, and since she was about seventeen, eighteen years old, and here she was sixty-five now, many years past menopause. See?

If she's going to have children, she'd have had it then. They were both sterile. And he said, "Well, how could she have the baby..." What if he had said that? "Why, it's the first month past," said

"Sarah, how you feeling?" She said, "No different." "Well, I guess maybe, l—it wasn't God talked to me."Oh, My. God couldn't have—couldn't have put His confidence in Abraham. 36 But no matter what Sarah's condition was, it was not Sarah's condition he was looking at; it was the promise that God made he was looking at.

It ain't the condition of your hand, or your ear, or your cancer, or whatever it is; it's God's Word you're looking at.

God said so. Now, don't try to bluff it; it won't take bluffing; but if you have got the goods, it'll recognize it. That's right. You got to have the real goods.

65-0120 - Lean Not Unto Thy Own Understanding

202 Now, the Bible said, the New Testament, "He is the High Priest right now. He continues the High Priest after the order of Melchisedec. He is the High Priest forever.

There is no other High Priest but Him. No other mediator between God and men, but the Man Christ." That's right. He is the only One, and He is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

203 Now if He remains that same High Priest, and the Bible said, "We can touch Him by the feeling of our infirmities," like that little woman did that touched His garment, your faith can touch Him tonight and He'll act the same way,

lay hands on you, just as soon as hands is laid upon you, you've just like rising them up out of the water of being baptized. You have done something that God give you a promise what would happen. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved.

You go right out of this building testifying that you're saved. What if you go out of the building saying that, "Well, I don't know." Then you're not saved. But God will make your body obey your confession. See? And He's the High Priest of our confession.

Before you can be healed, you have to confess it first. You have to believe that you are healed. And then when you believe you're healed, God makes your body obey your confession.

So now when you come by here, just let it be settled; say, "God, this is Your command. I believe I'm healed," walked off the platform say...[Blank spot on tape—Ed.]

35 And when the inspiration of the Holy Spirit is here to inspire you, remember, God will make your body come into your confession. If you say you're a drunkard, and want a drink. Don't worry, you'll soon be one.

If you say you're a sinner, and want to sin, you'll be right into it. If you say you're a Christian and believe it all along, God will bring...Your testimony will bring you right into it. If you believe in healing, and believe that God has healed you, confess it,

and God will make your body obey your confession, for He's the High Priest of your confession; setting at the right-hand of the Father now with His own Blood to make intercessions for any confession upon anything that He died for.

And He died to rid sin. And sickness is the result of sin. "He was wounded for our transgressions, with His stripes we are healed." Remember that. Have faith. Don't waiver. Stand on it.

199 I don't care what you are. Come right up to El Shaddai. If your strength and all hopes is gone, the Alcoholics Anonymous has given you up, the doctor has given you up, there's nothing can be done for you, He's El Shaddai, the strong One.

Lean upon His bosom and just nurse and be satisfied. He will bring it to pass. Won't you love Him?

2. The Word Of God Takes Effect When You Accept It As Your Personal Property

An Exposition Of The Seven Church Ages (5 - The Pergamean Church Age) Notice the harmony of the Father and the Son. Jesus never did anything until it was first showed Him by the Father.

John 5:19. This harmony is now to exist between the Groom and His bride. He shows her His Word of life. She receives it. She never doubts it.

Therefore, nothing can harm her, not even death. For if the seed be planted, the water will raise it up again. Here is the secret of this. The Word is in the bride (as it was in Mary).

The bride has the mind of Christ for she knows what He wants done with the Word. She performs the command of the Word in His name for she has "thus saith the Lord."

Then the Word is quickened by the Spirit and it comes to pass. Like a seed that is planted and watered, it comes to full harvest, serving its purpose.

Those in the bride do only His will. No one can make them do otherwise. They have "thus saith the Lord" or they keep still.

They know that it has to be God in them doing the works, fulfilling His own Word. He did not complete all His work while in His earthly ministry so now He works in and through the bride.

She knows that, for it was not yet time for Him to do certain things that He must now do. But He will now fulfill through the bride that work which He left for this specific time.

62-0718 - Jesus Christ The Same Yesterday, Today, And Forever 12 But I'll make myself clear (This is being taped.), that I believe that every redemptive blessing that goes to the human race has already been paid for, and belongs to you. See? That He was wounded for our transgressions.

With His stripes we were healed. It's a past tense. I believe that when Jesus Christ, the Son of God died at Calvary, He purchased our salvation, and every sin in the world was paid for. Now, it will never do you no good till you accept it as your own personal property.

By His stripes we were healed. Therefore, there's no man could ever save a soul or heal a sick person. It's already been done in Calvary. I believe Calvary paid the price. Jesus Christ on Calvary paid the price.

8 By His stripes, we were: were is past tense, is that right, brethren? We were healed. When? Nineteen hundred years ago. Every sinner in the world was forgiven of every sin they ever did, nineteen hundred years ago. Is that right?

He's—He's the Lamb of God that takes away the sin of the world, is that right? Then everybody was forgiven back yonder, nineteen hundred years ago, but it'll never do you any good, until you accept it as your personal Saviour.

Then when you accept it, Jesus doesn't come and die again for someone, see. He just died once. We accept our—our salvation, that what He—His finished works at Calvary.

374 What was Jesus manifested for? To show God. He was God. He had to be; no man could die, no prophet could die. He was God. He was the God of the prophets. He was the prophets. He was the kings.

He was the history. He was He that was to come. He that was, He that is, and He that's to be in this day; the same yesterday, today, and forever. He was manifested for that purpose.

377 Now He sanctified, with His Spirit and Blood, a Church, that He might make every promise in this last day be revealed. Now, see, He could go back and pick up what these other fellows has left off here, in the last days, and by His Holy Spirit reveal all the mystery of the Seven Seals.

See, He is expressing Himself. That's His purpose. That's why He died. That's the second fold of His threefold manifestation. First, to express Hisself in Christ, then express Hisself through the Church.

And the same thing, Christ was the Word, and the Church becomes the Word when it lets the Word go through them.

378 But when they accept a hybrid denomination, how can the Word go through it? It's grounded, then it causes a short and blows a fuse. See?

379 But when the current is flowing freely, the Word of God, It expresses Itself. "The works that I do shall ye be, also." And in the last days it shall come to pass: "Behold I send to you Elijah the prophet, and he shall turn the hearts of the—of the children back to the Faith of the fathers."

380 And in there, there would be a time come forth when He could express Himself in fullness of His Godhead, Deity, through His Church, have the preeminences in this Church. Oh, my! What? The anointed Man; now the anointed people;

oh, my, to bring back the anointed Bride and the Bridegroom. Anointed by (why?) accepting what Eve turned down, and Adam; coming back with the anointing of the Word, because He said, "My Word is Spirit." See, anointed with the Word. What Eve turned down, He comes back and we accept.

64-0614M - The Unveiling Of God 66 Look at that Syrophenician woman run to Him, and said, "Thou Son of David, have mercy on me!"

He never as much as raised His head. She had no claims on Him as Son of David. She was a Gentile. No more than my daughter has claims on me as husband;

You remember it. Of all the everything, that woman said the right thing. You've got to say that right word, the right thing to God.

87 And Brother Rodney and Brother Charlie, from down in Kentucky, Sister Wood's brother and them was present when it happened down in Kentucky, which was the second time it happened.

Just simply speaking into existence, things that wasn't. See? Speaking, all time, and backing up the Scriptures, encouraging.

88 The third time it happened was Hattie Wright. Is Hattie here tonight? That's Edith's...How many knows Hattie Wright? Brother Wood and I were sitting there when it happened,

98 And she looked around, said, "What shall I say, Brother Branham?"

99 I said, "Say what your desire is. Think of your greatest desire, and say it."

100 And her boys was even snickering and laughing. And she said, "The greatest desire I have is the salvation of my two sons."

101 I said, "I give them to you, in the Name of Jesus Christ," and there they went.

102 And they been faithful in this church, with communion, them little fellows sitting there washing feet with the men, and things like that. We all are witness of that.

103 She had a real choice. Her mother has to die, so does she, all of them. But what she asked will be Eternal, and the salvation of her children. That was the third time it happened.

24 All in love, the whole thing is bundled up now. This has been tried to be taught on many times, and no doubt what great theologians has struck it lot deeper than I could. But the thing I want to try to get to you is this:

that a man that is in Christ, with the Holy Ghost, can bear with a man when he's wrong; longsuffering, gentle, patient; he's sweet, humble, faithful, filled with the Spirit; never negative; always positive; he's a different person.

If you want to put that down, Genesis 4:10. God said, "What about your brother?" Said, "His blood cries from the earth, against you." That right? His blood is speaking. Hallelujah! God said, "What about him?" He said, "Am I my brother's keeper?"

356 Said, "And his blood is crying out. His blood is a crying out." It's a token. It's a token, that he had been killed. His blood was crying out against him.

357 Now, if you get that in Genesis 4:10, then in Hebrews 12:24, start reading. In Hebrews 10, 12:24. Said, "The Blood of Jesus speaketh better things than that of Abel."

358 See, Abel, he was a righteous man. He died. He died, innocent, because he was in the Way. He was in the Way, standing for the real revelation he had. He spoke. It cried out! The justice blood of Abel cried out against Cain.

359 But the Blood of Jesus Christ, not only cried out, It redeemed. Amen! "It speaketh better things." It makes you sons and daughters. It hides you from the wrath of God. See? The blood of Abel could not hide Cain, see, but the Blood of Jesus can. Amen!

360 So, old Cain, come out today, if you've been a persecutor against the Word, and say, "Days of miracles is past. This Thing is all nonsense," and things.

361 It's crying out, you see. The Blood of Jesus Christ cries out, but there is forgiveness in It if you'll just accept It. Wish we could stay a little while on that, see, "Blood speaketh better thing."

362 Believe, for safety. Then apply, see. Believe for...Here is what you want to believe for. See, you want your own safety. You believe for your safety, and then apply the Token for the whole family. See?

You say, "How can I do that?" Claim It! If It worked on you, then you and the Word becomes one. Amen! Amen! See? See, It works for both of you. You and the Word are one, then apply It to your children, apply It to your loved ones.

363 Like Rahab did, she applied the token to her father, she applied it to her mother, she applied it to her brothers and sisters, and got them all in.

364 You apply It, say, "Lord, I'm going after my son. I'm going after my daughter. I claim her!" "Satan, you turn her loose! I'm coming after her. I apply my Token, the Holy Spirit."

"O Holy Spirit, that lives within me, catch my daughter there. I'm going to her now, with Your anointing upon me." He'll do it. Amen.

365 That's what they did in Egypt. That's what they did in Jericho.

366 You want to read another one, Acts 16:31. Paul told the centurion, "Believe! I'm the messenger of the hour. Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, thou and thy house shall be saved." That right?

Believe for your house, bring them all under. "Now you've seen the God of Heaven perform a miracle. It's before judgment. Do you believe it?" "Yes! What can I do?"

367 He said, "Rise and be baptized." Paul took him out and baptized him, said, "Now believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou and thy house shall be saved."

368 Believe what? Believe the Lord Jesus Christ, for your house, apply the Token to your house.

369 Then what do you do when you apply It to your house? Move all the trash out. Get all the short skirts, and the shorts, and the cards, and the cigarettes, and televisions, and whatever more, and kick them out the door, when you go apply the Token;

won't stand still for it. Yes, sir. Take it all out. All the dances, and parties, and rock-and-roll, and old vulgar newspapers, and the stuff that's of the world, kick it out the door, say, "We're cleaning out this place around here."

370 Like Jacob did, he said, told his wife and all of them, said, "Wash your clothes and everything. Put away them gods." Amen. Jo-...

371 You know what Joshua said before crossing over? He said, "Wash your clothes; come not at your wives, and so forth, and get ready, for within three days we'll cross Jordan." Amen. He was getting ready, was applying the token. Amen. That's it.

372 Get ready. Apply It. Believe It. Clean up. Let your children, let your family, let your loved ones, see It in you. That's right. It'll take effect. Yes, sir!

373 Then apply the Token in prayer, with—with consideration, with believing. Apply It with such love, and so forth, till you know it's going to take, it's going to take place. That's all. Apply It in confidence, believing It's going to help.

When you talk to that child, when you talk to your husband, talk to your wife, talk to this loved one, believe that It's going to help. Just stand there, and say, "Lord, I've claimed them. They're mine. I'm getting them for You, Lord."

374 Apply It, and create that atmosphere around you, that they'll just drop right into It. See? Oh, you are, you are, if you got the Token, you create a spirit around you, a power, that when you walk, people know that you're a Christian.

They love for you to say something to them. They believe your word.
What you say, they hold onto it.
See? That's it.

375 Apply the Token, then walk with It. Claim your household. You must do it now. This is evening time. Now, you've been listening a long time, now this is the evening time.

It's applying time now. The wrath will strike, one of these days, it might be too late then. See? Apply the Token, with confidence.

48 So they was wondering. But while they were thinking on Him, He appeared to them.

And that's the way He usually comes to us. When you usually find your greatest blessing; you housewives,

14 And God will never...You can never exhaust God's love and mercy to you. You say, "Well, I hate to bother You so much, Father."

15 Could you imagine, talking about exhausting God's love, and power, and beneficiaries for you. Could you imagine a little bitty fish, about that long, way out here in the middle of the ocean say,

"Now, wait a minute. I better consider this thing. I better drink of this water sparingly, 'cause I might run out someday." A little fish, about that big, in the middle of this ocean out here...

Well, that could easily be done, more easier than you could ask too much of God. He's the inexhaustible Fountain of Life. Whatever you have need of, ask Him and believe it.

He provided it in the redemptive blessings when He died at Calvary and gave a promise to you for everything you have need of while you're in the journey. And it's yours, if you'll ask and believe it. That's right.
