But when He put His foot upon the brail of the boat, looked up and said, "Peace, be still," and the winds and the waves obeyed Him, that was more than a man. God was in His Son! Absolutely!

142 He was a man when He died there on the cross, screaming for mercy. He was a man when He died. He cried like a man, He had pain like a man.

But on Easter morning when He broke the...death, hell, and the seals of the grave, and rose again; He's more than a man, He proved He was God!

Living, He loved me; dying, He saved me;

Buried, He carried my sins far away;

Rising, He justified freely for ever:

Someday He's coming—oh, glorious day!

143 God was in His Son, reconciling the world to Himself. Do you believe that? Sure. God was in His Son.

Quickly, our time gets away. One more thing. We...Do you believe God is in His universe? God is in His Word? God was in His Son?

144 Now, God in His people. All right. We'll see whether He comes down to human beings the same as He does to nature. Human beings is part of His nature. Certainly, they are. Now notice, God was in His people.

145 Who was it the other night in our text, in Elijah, when a little baby had died of a sun stroke, and been laid for hours and hours on the prophet's bed, when a man,

called "Elijah," walked back and forth, up and down the floor, and laid his body on that dead baby, and he come to life? That was God in His people. It certainly was.

146 Who was it, that when Saint Peter, the apostle, a fisherman so ignorant...The Bible said, "He was ignorant and unlearned." Who was it, when he walked down along the streets,

and people laid the sick in the shadow of that man, and they were healed? Was it a man's shadow that healed them? It was God in His people, that did the healing.

147 Who was it in Saint Paul, when they took from his body handkerchiefs or aprons, and laid on the sick? God was in His people. They recognized God in Saint Paul. Certainly, they did.

148 Who was it when a bunch of little cowards prayed, took the Word of God and went up to Pentecost? They had the doors all barred up, and the windows barred up, and they were in there for ten days.

All of a sudden there came a sound from Heaven like a rushing, mighty wind, it filled all the building where they were sitting, cloven tongues set on them, like fire.

And out into the streets they went, where they was once a-scared, went out there, preaching the Gospel and carrying on like a bunch of drunk people. What was it? God in His people. God moving among His people.

149 God is in you. God, the Holy Spirit, is in you, moving around now, reconciling the world to Himself.

57-1211 — Sirs, We Would See Jesus

21 You know the wise man didn't come to no little baby.

They come to a young child, two years old or better. You see? The Bible said they killed all the children from two years old down to get Him.

He was around two years old. But we have all these little things that just becomes a little fictions and little stories that we told. However, in it all, God is glorified.

Now, we want to see Him at His work. Now, Jesus was born for one purpose, that was for God to manifest Himself through that body.

God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself. He was a body that was made physical, that men and women could see what He thought,

and His expressions to the people in His gratefulness. And His attitude towards all mankind, He expressed it through Christ.

Christ seemed to be a dual personality. He would speak sometimes and they'd scratch their heads; and—and they didn't understand Him.

He'd speak one thing one time, look like, and something else another time. What it was, was Jesus speaking, and then Christ speaking. Jesus was the man.

Christ was the God that was in Him. "Not Me that doeth the works: My Father that dwelleth in Me, He doeth the work." See? God will not share His glory with no one.

22 So it all comes by the Spirit, but Jesus was a virgin born in order to tabernacle the Holy Spirit of God first to manifest Himself to the people; and He gave His life, a willing sacrifice that through His righteousness, we unrighteous people might have a right to come into the fellowship like He had with the Father before the foundation of the world. If that isn't grace and glory, what He did for us.

Then—then to think that the day that we're living in, is that so many people cut off that privilege from the people.

Why you're...We're living millions of miles below our God given privilege. Right. The Church of the living God should never be divided. We should be one and together.

23 We should never live under our privileges as we are today. The great powers of God lays within the reach of every—every member of the body of Christ.

"Whatsoever things you desire, when you pray, believe that you receive it, and you shall have it." And it shall be given to you.

I was reading in the Lexicon the other day, when it...Over there in Luke at that Scripture I was just quoting. The original give it, "When thou prayest," he said...Here's what I want to get to.

He said, "If ye should say to this mountain, 'Be thou plucked up and cast into the sea,' and believe in your heart that it's being done..." Believe that it is being done...

24 Now, lots of people, they say, "Pray for me, brother." All right, "Lord, help this dear brother." Give them a prayer card, and best you can.

And he's seen others healed night after night, time after time, but, "I didn't get it. I'll try it again tomorrow night." Oh, my, you dis—you discredit God to the...You discredit His Word.

Watch. "If you believe in your heart that it's being done..." Maybe that mountain looks just exactly like it always looked, but in your heart you believe it.

There might not be but one little grain of sand, but something's tearing loose. Something's begin to take place. See? When we believe that it's being done...

But you see, we just want something

spontaneously...?...And what do we get? Left out, left out.

Because it weakens.

In a few nights I want to get onto that, on faith, the Lord of hosts in you. See?

59-0712 — A Total Deliverance 87 Jesus was completely, totally man. He could cry like a man. He could eat like a man. He could be tired like a man.

He was completely, totally man, in His physical being. And in His Spirit, He was completely, totally God, so He made His flesh submissive to the Spirit that was in Him.

You see, He was tempted in all manners like we are. He was man, not an Angel. He was a man. He had desires and temptations, just like we do.

The Bible said He did. He was a man, not an Angel above temptation. Hebrews 1 said, that, "He was..." Hebrews 1:4 said, "He was made lower than the Angels." He was man, completely man;

that God took a complete man, to bring total deliverance, and He filled Him with His Spirit. The Holy Ghost was in Him, without measure. And He was tempted like we were. And He was completely God.

He proved it when He raised the dead, when He stopped nature, the roaring seas and the mighty winds. When He spoke to the trees, and so forth, they obeyed Him.

He was God, inside. And He could have been man, for He was man, but He totally and completely delivered Himself (as a man) into the hands of God, for the service of God.

88 And He is our example. We are men and women. We're also Christians.

If He's our example, let us completely deliver ourselves into the hands of the Holy Chost, that we might be subjects of the Kingdom of God. 89 He was totally man; He was totally God. But He surrendered His natural parts to His...

and His physical parts, and His Own thinking, and His Own doing, and His Own cares, and, "I do only that which pleases the Father." There you are. Totally delivered from human beings.

The priests come to Him, the great men, and said, "Rabbi, so-and-so," and tried to bribe Him into their affiliations and denominations. But He was totally delivered because He trusted in God.

63-0714M — Why Cry? Speak! 202 Here we see Moses expressingly, fully human nature, always wants God to get behind you and push you into something.

Now, that's us today. You want God, after we've seen all we've seen, yet you want God to push you to do something. See?

203 Moses had just laxed around, said, "God, I'll go ask You, see what You say. Yeah, yeah, You say it. Well, all right, I'll say it, too." See?

204 But here God had ordained him for the job, proved that He was with him. And here he is, the circumstance comes up, and then he begins to cry, "What can I do? Lord, what can I do?"

And He had already ordained him, and a vindicated him, and proved and worked everything through him. And here, "God?" Oh, my! Fully expressing, man wants to rest and let God do the pushing.

209 And, yet, he knew that God had anointed him for this job, to do this, and God had clearly a vindicated his claims.

It was time for the people to be delivered. God, through his miracles and wonders, had drawed them all together in one group. You follow me?

Brought them all together in one group, vindicated his claims. Scripture said so; here was the sign, here was the evidence here, everything that he said. Then he come among them as a prophet.

Ever, whatever he said, God honored it, even to create and bring up flies, and brought things in existence. And everything that He had promised him, here He done it. 210 But he wanted to wait on THUS SAITH THE LORD. See? He should have known that the very vindication of his call was THUS SAITH THE LORD.

212 He had already predicted what they was going to do. He had already told just exactly what, to do it.

He predicted the end of the very nation he was brought up in. I hope you understand. Huh? Moses had already said, "You'll not see them anymore.

God is going to destroy them. They've made fun of you long enough. God will destroy them." He had already predicted what would happen to them.

213 Then, "Lord, what must I do?" See the human nature there? See? "What must I do? I'm going to wait for THUS SAITH THE LORD." Yes, sir. "I'll see what the Lord says, then I'll do it." Huh!
