# 65-1125 — The Invisible Union Of The Bride Of Christ 58 If you're married to Christ, Christ is the Word of God.

In Saint John, the 1st chapter, said, "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. And the same was made flesh and dwelt among us."

Christ was the living Word. He always was the Word. He is still the Word. He always will be the Word. He was only the manifestation of the attributes of God, for He was the Son of God.

59 And any son is the attributes of his father, and just as you were in the genes of your father, in the body of your father when he was a young boy, you were in him.

Yet, he could not have fellowship with you, because he didn't know you.

But then, through the bedding grounds of a mother, you were brought forth into the earth and become in the image of your father, then he could fellowship with you.

60 And so were you, sons of God and daughters of God, before there even was a moon, stars, or a molecule.

You were sons and daughters of God, for you are only the physical manifestation of the attributes that was in God at the beginning.

For, there's only one form of Eternal Life, and that was you, before. You don't know nothing about it. Neither did you know when you was in your earthly father,

but you are manifested to...in his image. In the image of God you are made, and you were manifested for the glory and the fellowship of God.

61 And, therefore, as sure as your gene had to be in your father, before your natural birth, your spiritual gene had to be in God, because you're an expression of the attributes of His thoughts,

before the foundation of the world. Right. No way around it. That's right. Now, now we notice, then, that Life being in you, God's Life being in you, from the foundation of the world.

96 It's either daytime or it's nighttime. Is that right? Now, I can't say, "just this much of this is—is—is nighttime.

Just what I see through that window, that's what's nighttime." No, no. The whole thing is nighttime. That's right.

97 Now, smok...as I've often said. Smoking cigarettes, chewing tobacco, and drinking whiskey, that isn't sin. That's the attributes of sin. You do that because you're an unbeliever.

99 You'll go through trials, and troubles, and ups and downs, and misunderstood. That doesn't have one thing to do with It.

100 When Israel backslid and went down into Egypt, they was backslid. They never lost their covenant. They lost their joy of their salvation.

# 54-1231 — Everlasting Life And How To Receive It 101 David didn't say, "Restore to me my salvation."

He said, "Restore to me the joy of my salvation." His salvation had to remain the same. But he went off the wrong end and lost the joy of his salvation. See what I mean?

102 When did you get saved? When did you get sanctified? When did you get filled with the Holy Ghost? When you believed on the Lord Jesus Christ! For, you received, there, everlasting Life.

103 But then, from then on, you started growing. You started growing. You growed through sanctification, through the Holy Ghost, and through speaking with tongues, and through all these things here.

104 But you received Life when you believed. See what I mean? And now that doesn't...Some people has already got Life, and you're trying to get them to do something here,

when they haven't even reached that place yet. And Pentecostal people has never...has come to the place where the Church is getting now, to the adoption, or the placing of sons.

105 Now, in the Old Testament, when a son was born into a home, it was a son because it was born in a home. My son is my son when he was born to me.

And there he found a certain man named Aeneas, which had kept his bed eight years, and was sick of the palsy.

And Peter said unto him, Aeneas, Jesus Christ maketh thee whole: arise, and make thy bed. And he arose immediately. And all that dwelt at Lydda and Saron saw him, and turned to the Lord.

<sup>36</sup> Now there was at Joppa a certain disciple named Tabitha, which by interpretation is called Dorcas: this woman was full of good works and almsdeeds which she did.

<sup>37</sup> And it came to pass in those days, that she was sick, and died: whom when they had washed, they laid her in an upper chamber.

<sup>38</sup> And forasmuch as Lydda was nigh to Joppa, and the disciples had heard that Peter was there, they sent unto him two men, desiring him that he would not delay to come to them.



## 58-0126 — Hear Ye Him 24 Now, if this child was obedient, there was a ceremony to be made, when the child become matured. They taken him out in a public place...Listen close; don't miss

Watch the Scripture. They taken the child out into a public place, placed a robe upon him, a royal robe, and they had a ceremony. And it was the ceremony of adoption. The child that had been borned into the family, become placed by adoption in the family. And after that, that boy's name was just as good on a check as his daddy's was. He was heir of all things. He could take out;

he could put up; he could fire; he could hire. He could do whatever he pleased to do, because the ceremony of adoption had been made upon his son, and he was clothed and was set in order.

Now, there's where the Church ought to be today. Jesus said, "These things that I do, shall you do also.

Ask anything in My Name, I'll do it." Why we scared of that? What's the matter? If Christ has clothed us with the Holy Spirit, and been adopted into the family after being borned again,

and been baptized into the body by the Holy Spirit, if it's a true witness of God, ask what you will and it'll be done for you. Then we set like, say, "Oh, well, that was something else."

#### Position In Christ

51 O God, our Father. We are grateful to Thee this afternoon for Jesus, how that You took Him up there on Mount Transfiguration and was transfigured before them;

You changed Him. And Your Voice said as the adoption, "This is My beloved Son; hear ye Him."

And, God, we're trying our best to Him and follow Him in everything that we do or say. Send Him into the building just now, Lord, put a fresh anointing on every minister here and every laity here,

# When Placed As A Son You Have The Right To Exercise The Power Of Heavenly Kingdom

### 54-1231 — Everlasting Life And How To Receive It 108 And a man, in the Old Testament, when he had a son born into his house, he was a son when he was born.

But there was a tutor raise that child until they come to a certain age. Then if this tutor was...brought word to the father, that the child was worthy and all right,

and everything, now, it had...He was—he was then adopted into that family. Many of you Old Testament readers know the Scripture on that. He was adopted into the family.

But if he wasn't, he still remained a son, but he wasn't adopted. And then if he was adopted, he was brought out in the street, put on a robe, and then a ceremony was made.

And then this boy's signature, on the check, meant just the same as his daddy's. Just the same, for he was adopted into full fellowship of the family.

109 God adopted His Own Son, when He took Him up; took Peter, James, and John, as a witness. "In the mouth of two or three witnesses, let every word be established."

And went up there, and God overshadowed Christ. The Holy Spirit overshadowed Christ, and His raiment shined like the sun.

Is that right? And God Himself said, "This is My beloved Son. Hear ye Him." In other words, "There It is. What He says is all of It."

And then He was given equal...And, of course, It was God, but God in the flesh of Jesus Christ, manifesting Himself to the people. And, there, God adopted His Own

110 And now when the Pentecostal church and these people in the last days here has begin to find the new Birth, being born again, they thought that settled it.

No, sir. Your ups and downs, and ins and outs, and things like that, God can't place you as a son.

111 But when you stay in the Kingdom, stay in the Gospel, stay right, one of these days God will call you out and set you aside, adopt you as His son, before the people,

and give you something that will shake the nations, with it.

See what I mean? It's the adoption into the family.

## 55-0116A — The Believer's Position In Christ 42 There's where Pentecost failed to see this. See? If the Holy Spirit, maybe, not willing to give it then.

Look, when you were borned again of the Holy Ghost, you said, "This is It, brother." It was; you was a child.

You was just as much child as you ever could be; you were born in the family. But yet, the Tutor, which is the Holy Spirit, has watched over the church as it's been maturing.

43 Now, if this tutor in the natural went to the father and said, "Now, here, that boy is not going to be very good. I try to teach him; he—he just won't listen.

He's got his own headstrong way and he just won't listen. He's going to be this, or he's going to be that."

The father realizes right then, that that boy cannot take over his domain. That's right. Because what would he do? He'd run it through...

The return of the prodigal son gives a very beautiful picture of it. See? He could not. What he would do would be mortgage the farm, or sell it off, and drink it up, and run around.

44 Now, in the spiritual sense after we were born into Christ, we become children of God. But then see, God knows best.

Now, here's where I say, reverently, disagree with my latter-rain brethren. You think I'm persecuting church? No, my dear brother, no. See?

Now, this boy, after he got a certain age, he had to be adopted into that same family he was borned into. Any minister knows that's the placing of a son.

He had to be adopted into the family that he was borned into. Could you imagine that? But that's the Old Testament teaching; it's...Paul's referring to it here in Ephesians, the church of Ephesus.

45 Now, the thing of it is, brethren, we have tried to make each one here, and each one this, and each one that by laying on of hands and separating or setting apart. But God has to do that, the only One can do it.

Now, when the father became aware that this boy was not worthy, he never disowned him. He was still his boy.

But he couldn't put confidence in him. He was too carried about with all kinds of winds of doctrine. That's what the Scripture says,

"Be not carried about by every winds of doctrine, be stabled, always abounding in the works of the Lord, for so much as you know your works is not in vain." Quickly, wish we could stay on that awhile.

46 But notice. This father then...The day come when this boy maybe, had been all right and was a worthy man. He listened to the father; he took instructions; he was a good boy. Then the father taken him out into the public street, and then he put a special clothes on him. And then the father had a ceremony and adopted this his son into his family.

Paul saying here, "Having predestinated us unto the adoption (See?), unto the adoption." Moses a prefigure of it...

And then this son after he came out there, was given no longer—no longer was he just like the servant under a tutor. He was the boss. Amen. I hope this soaks real deep. Going to leave you in a minute.

47 Let's get way down deep. This son was no more under a tutor but he was like his father. And his father give him certain things to do.

The father might've told him, "You take care of this field over here, or you do this over here. You take care of the slaves; you take care of whatever it was."

He was in full possession (Amen.), for he was adopted into that family. And his name on a check was just as good as his daddy's.

Now, what God has done, the reason we see these things, and know that there's something wrong, friend. We see the promises of God; we see it in the Word of God. But God has just begin,

to my humble opinion, to adopting His son, positionally calling him out to one side, giving him a certain ministry, anointing them for that purpose, and sending them out. Watch what happens when He does.

48 Everything that he give him possession over will take place. God adopted His own Son like that. Jesus, walking as an ordinary man,

but one day upon Mount Transfiguration, He taken three as a witness Peter, James, John: hope, faith, and charity. Called them out, and He separated Jesus from them,

and He over-shadowed Him. And the Bible said, "His raiment shined like the sun in its strength." What was it? That special robe, God adopting His own Son.

Then It brings you right back again unto the place of where you should have been at the beginning. See? That's the reason of Christ's death, brings us right back again to (where?) sons of God.

Your adoption is not your birth. Your adoption is your placing. When you were born again, John 1:17, I believe, when we are born of the Spirit of God, we are sons of God.

But we were predestinated. Now here's what I'm trying to get you to, for this sons of the last day, you see, to...See? We were predestinated to (unto) adoption.

115 Now, now here we are. Now, this is what hurts Pentecostal a little. They say, "I got born again! Praise the Lord, got the Holy Ghost!" Fine.

You're a child of God. That's right. But yet that ain't what I'm talking about. See, you were predestinated unto adoption. Adoption, it's placing a son.
