- 21 A woman when she is in travail hath sorrow, because her hour is come: but as soon as she is delivered of the child, she remembereth no more the anguish, for joy that a man is born into the world.
- 22 And ye now therefore have sorrow: but I will see you again, and your heart shall rejoice, and your joy no man taketh from you.

47 So, Ephesus here sets us like Joshua, positionally. You notice, Joshua, after crossing over the land, and taking the land, then he divided the land.

"Ephraim here, Manasses here, and this one here, Gad here, Benjamin here." He divided the land.

48 And notice! Oh, this just burns our hearts! Each one of those Hebrew mothers, giving birth to those children, she spoke the very place, in her labor pains, where they would be positioned in the promised land. Oh, it's a great study!

If we could only go into it in details, which would take hours after hours. Someday when we get our church fixed, I'd just like to come and take a solid month or two, just stay right in it.

Watch when they, each one of those mothers, when she called out, "Ephraim," when she was in labor, positionally placed him where his feet was setting in oil. Just exactly every one of them wherever they were at!

49 And Joshua, not knowing this, but by inspiration, led of the Holy Spirit, after being into the promised land, give each man his promise, exactly what the Holy Spirit promised through the birth back there.

50 How that God has set some in the church, through the labor pains! Oh, they get tremendous sometime. When a church is groaning under the persecution of the outside world,

believing on the Lord Jesus, that the promise of the Holy Ghost is just as real to us as it was to Pentecost, how they groan and cry under labor pains!

But when they are born, and positionally born into the Kingdom of God, then the Holy Ghost has set in the church, some apostles, some prophets, some teachers, some pastors, some evangelists.

Then He's give into there, speaking with tongues, interpretation of tongues, knowledge, wisdom, gifts of healing, all kinds of miracles. 1. Birth Pains Because The Word of The Hour Has To Bring Forth Children of The Age=Children of the WORD

63-0323 - The Sixth Seal

352 And the world, the nature, (God have mercy!) the whole world's in—in birth pains. The world is trying, she is "travailing," Isaiah said. What's the matter? She is in...trying to bring forth a new world, for the Millennium, where all the...?...

Trying to birth a new world, for a new people that won't sin and pollute her. That's right. She is in travail. That's the reason the—the...We're in travail, Christ, to bring forth the Bride. Everything is travailing and groaning. See, there is something fixing to happen.

353 And this Sixth Plague lets her go. Brother, the earthquake bursts open, and the stars shake, volcanics will come forth, and the earth will renew itself. New lava will break forth from the center of the earth. And she'll crumble, all around and around, when she spins out in yonder.

65-0219 - This Day This Scripture Is Fulfilled

24 And on this Scripture, what caused me to fall my eyes upon this, was something that happened just recently in Phoenix, Arizona. It was the last day, of the service that I was to speak at the International Convention of the Full Gospel Business Men.

27 So on Sunday afternoon, when I got up to speak, I was going to take my text on Birth Pains, where Jesus said, that, "As a woman in travail with a child," she is travailing in birth. And so I was going to speak from there, as, Birth Pains, the subject, saying that the world is in birth pains now.

The old has to be done away with, so the new can be born; just like a—a seed has to rot away, in order to give new life.

28 And how the pains, birth pains struck the world! In World War One, she had a terrific pain, because they had poison gas, and so forth, that almost could destroy the world. And in World War Two, she struck another, harder pain; they had blockbusters, and also an atomic bomb.

She cannot stand another labor pain. With these missiles and things today, one more war will throw her out into space, for she will now be delivered. And there will be a new earth. The Bible said there will be.

29 Under every prophet's Message, Israel got a birth pain, because that these prophets would come on the scene after the theologians and clergymen would have the church all in a organization form.

And when them prophets come on the scene with THUS SAITH THE LORD, they shook them churches, and she had a birth pain. Finally, she had birth pains plumb on up until she delivered a Son of the Gospel, which was the Word Itself made flesh.

30 So the church really is in birth pains tonight, again, for the deliverance of the Son, Son of God to come again. All of our theologians, all of our systems, all of our denominations, has rotted right out from under us.

So we are in birth pain, and a Message from God always throws the church in heavier pain, but after a while she is going to be delivered of a Bride. That'll bring forth Jesus Christ to His Bride.

43 I believe that Jesus here was speaking of, as He said, "You will have sorrow, but your sorrow shall be turned to joy," speaking to His disciples here, knowing that the birth of—of Christianity was coming into existence. And now the old has to die, in order that the new is born.

To have anything that gives birth, has to have pains of distress. And they certainly was going to go through the pain of distress and anguish, to get from the law unto grace.

44 Normal, natural birth types the spiritual Birth. All things of the natural is types of the spiritual. And we find out, if we look out here on—on the ground,

and see a tree in the earth, growing, is struggling for life. That goes to show that there is a tree, somewhere, that doesn't die, because it's—it's crying out for something.

45 We find people, no matter how old, how sick, what condition, they're crying out, to live, because it shows there is a life somewhere where we live, live forever. Notice how perfect.

63-1113 - The Sign of This Time 112 Now the church has come up through the—the score of the church ages, after the first, Ephesian Church Age, in the Bible.

And if the Lord willing, before I leave here, I want to preach on a little subject called The Countdown, and see how we have come, how we've progressed.

113 And now we've left the Pentecostal age. Now we are coming to where like in the pyramid, not pyramid doctrines now, but I mean like as the pyramid. The Headstone when it comes to fit, it's got to be honed.

There's got to be a ministry in the Church, the true Church of the living God, to where when the Headstone comes, Christ, or the ministry of Christ,

It certainly will come. God will send It. It'll fit all the Building together upon it. See? Now we see these signs, as we see the ministry from Christ beginning to narrow up now, to the complete ministry of Christ, in the fulness of the Holy Spirit.

114 Under Luther it was same Holy Spirit, justification; then sanctification under Wesley; the messages; then the baptism of the Holy Spirit, making three. Three, not three steps of grace, but three stations, I might call it. 115 Notice like this. When a baby is born, there is three things that constitutes its birth. The first thing in normal birth...

You adults listen close now; the young children will never catch it. But, let's see, the first thing in a normal birth is water, then blood, then life. See?

116 Now that's the same thing that constitutes the new birth; water, Blood, Spirit. The elements that came from His body is what makes His Body. See?

It come from His body, is the material that takes to—to make His Bride. Because, Adam had his bride taken from his body. Christ has His Bride taken from the body.

And when Christ died, there was three elements that came from His body; water, Blood, Spirit; justification through believing, water; sanctification through the Blood; the baptism of the Holy Spirit.

117 Now this last great step must come into the perfection, that the Holy Spirit has to live in that Church so perfectly, it'll make the Head and the Body unite together. See? See?

That's The Body. He Is The Head In The Body. Now We Find That He Promised, In These Last Days, That That Would Be Done. We Find It.

65-1206 - Modern Events Are Made Clear By Prophecy 117 Pentecost, that's why Luther lost his message. That's how Wesley lost his message.

See, if the Wesleyan church would have went on, they'd been Pentecostals. If the Lutherans went on, they'd been Methodists. See?

Now if the Pentecostals go on, it'll be the Bride. If you hang back and keep going back in the world like you're going now, you'll be lost! It'll only be the shuck, and the stalk is to be burned.

We know that. He will gather His Wheat into the garner. But the husks He'll burn with unquenchable fire, although it was a carrier.

It certainly carried It. But the Life left it as soon as it become a leaf, it went on out to make something else until it come to its full stature.

118 And so will the Church come through Justification, Sanctification, Baptism of the Holy Ghost (restoration of gifts), right on into the formed image of Christ.

Christ is the Bridegroom, the Church is the Bride, and the Bride is a part of the Bridegroom.

It'll have to be a Word Church, not a denominational church. It'll be the Word Church, the Word that's made known, and, with the vindicated Word of God.

65-0221m - Marriage And Divorce

256 Notice, He can put her away, but she cannot put Him away. He did it, has proved it, in the days when Luther, Wesley,

and Pentecost, when they refused to become the further part of Him by having spiritual sexual affair to become pregnated with further part of the Word.

You understand? She refused. The Lutheran church refused for Christ to have any more desire with her; Luther refused it.

And let me say this, going to call me something anyhow; so is it today with every one of them, they fail to take that Word, they refuse Christ!

257 And any woman that refuses a man his child, has no right to be a wife to him. Amen. You remember, in the Bible, when the king married Esther? Because the queen refused, he just got him another one.

And when the...What happened when she refused to come out with the king and obey him? The same thing it is with a woman that refuses to be wife to her husband.

258 And so is it with the church that refuses to become pregnated in the age that we now live in, to bring forth children of this age.

We are not Lutherans, we're not Wesleys, neither are we Pentecostals! We've got to be the children of this age, through the pregnancy of the Word of God, to bring forth a Child of this age, the Seed Child.

Amen. I hope you understand. Couldn't be pregnated, no, so what did He do? Put her away, in divorcement. That's right. But she daresn't put Him away. He put her away.

259 He went right on revealing His Word to the Body, and vindicating Him, same, by Himself. His children begin to kind of look more like Him, because It's fully maturing,

or, they become children of the Word, not children of the church. Children of the Word! And the Bride will be a lovely little Lady of the Word, unadulterated,

not touched by any man's organization, any man-made theory. She'll be purely unadulterated, Bride of the Word! Amen and amen! I hope you get that, out on the air. She will be the pregnated daughter of God.

260 See what a great honor a woman can be? See what a great thing the church can be, but you see where filth has got her to?

Then trying to compare that church out there with the Church here, you can't do it. And try to compare the street harlot with the Church of the living God; or the woman, the correct woman, with a harlot?

2. By Accepting the WORD which Eve Turned Down, The Bride Becomes the "Further Part" of Her Husband-Pregnated By the Word

64-0719m - The Feast Of The

Trumpets

112 Go into the prophet's chamber and watch them seven steps. Where did the-where did the guard meet the challenge to bring the comer into the presence of the king?

At the top of the steps; was in the seventh step. There shows that we've got to come again with that same Spirit that was on John; he introduced the Messiah.

He was greater than all the prophets; he introduced It. And we've got to come to a place, again, to something that's going to introduce the Messiah.

113 And how will the Messiah...the people that's believing Him know it unless they're constantly in the Word, to know what He is! Daniel said, "The wise shall know; but the foolish, the unwise, wouldn't know. They shall know their God."

Now, now, how He shall appear in the last days, is to bring the people back to the Word, so that the Bride will know Her Husband, know Her Mate, the revealed Word. That's why this has to happen.

114 It wasn't in the reformers; wasn't in Luther, Wesley, and—and the Pentecostals, and them. Scripture says it wasn't.

115 But it will come. That is His promise for this age. We're living in the age that His Coming will be in. She must be identified in Him. Any woman must be identified with her husband, for the two are one.

And Christ's Bride has to be identified with Him, for the two are One; and He is the Word, not the denomination. The Word!

We are to be the children of the Light, and the Light is the Word which is made Light for this age. How do we know Light except It comes from the Word?

All right. The Word made flesh is the Light of the age; when you see It, and the Bible said so.

63-0728 - Christ Is The Mystery Of God Revealed 465 And remember, we are now, as His Bride, pregnated with His Spirit. Oh, my! The Church, bearing children, see, pregnated by His Spirit with His Name;

bearing His Name, bearing His Life; bringing forth the signs of His Life, evident with the preeminences, evidence of His resurrection;

showing that He is not dead, but alive for evermore. This is Eternal Life, and vindicated, vindicates to the world that we are alive in Him. Whew!

466 How do you know, 'cause you're a church member? Because, Christ is living through you, so pregnated with His Spirit that you—you're a prisoner to anything else.

You're confined, oh, my, to the Gospel, confined to the Word, and all the children that you can bring forth is that, 'cause you're a prisoner.

467 You can't commit adultery; you're already pregnated. Glory! He can't take a hold. The womb of life is closed to anything else. You're already His, by predestination.

That Seed has come to Life; no world can get in. Oh! Oh, how we'd like to stay on this for about an hour! I'm sure you understand. See?

Christ, and His alone, already finished. The Seed was there. The Seed was, already. When was It put there? "Before the foundation of the world, has predestinated us unto Eternal Life."

And as soon as the Life-giving flow, that Seed laying there...Other seeds that just would come in, wouldn't take hold, just couldn't do it, like.

But when that Seed come in, quickly it stopped up the womb; all the rest of the seed was drove out, see, like that.

468 And you become a prisoner, surrounded, in Christ. Christ in you, His Life bringing forth His evidence, His signs. Oh, my, my, my!

Look, bringing His signs of Life as a evident of His resurrection, proving to the world that Eternal Life, vindicates to the world that we're alive in Him.

And think of it, alive with God, our Redeemer, Who created us for the very same purpose, the Church, and His creative Life in us.

515 "He is the first fruits of the resurrection." Is that right? Congregation says, "Amen."—Ed.] Watch. Then, what is He? "He is the Head of the Body, which is His Church, Bride." Uh-huh.

516 Then, the Bride-Body must follow the Head, for it is part of His resurrection and part of the mystery. It's impossible for it not to go. Oh, my!

It's part of God's mystery, how God revealed Himself here and raised It up by the Word, so He reveals His Church and raising It up by the same Word. It's a part of His threefold mystery.

517 As the Head was took from the grave, so must the Body follow Him back to Eden. Where, the Head of the family, the Man, the Bridegroom;

the Bride being the Body of the Bridegroom, must follow, the Bride, because that's the Head. And the Head is revealed, and come back with Eternal Life; and the Body must follow that, because it is Husband and Wife again. Amen!

And as long as you're pregnated with the same Word, which is His Body; you've took His Body, become in Him, when you took the Word. Not the creed; the Word! Oh, my!

518 Wouldn't that make a text for this afternoon, to go on? Huh? My, wouldn't that be wonderful? See? Just think of it now, what it is.

519 Therefore, the Body cannot recognize...Don't you fail this. The Body, therefore, cannot recognize any other headship but the Word.

Cause, the—the Head is connected with the Body, and the Head is the Word, and it's the same Word, one Headship!

Therefore, denominations, and holy fathers, and everything else, is dead dung. There is one Headship, that's Christ. The Body only recognizes one thing, the Word!

Mystery Of God Revealed

376 See, Jesus so seen it so, was so perfectly born for the day, until God expressed every move that He made. He was God's revelation; God, revealed.

377 Now He sanctified, with His Spirit and Blood, a Church, that He might make every promise in this last day be revealed. Now, see, He could go back and pick up what these other fellows has left off here,

in the last days, and by His Holy Spirit reveal all the mystery of the Seven Seals. See, He is expressing Himself. That's His purpose. That's why He died. That's the second fold of His threefold manifestation.

First, to express Hisself in Christ, then express Hisself through the Church. And the same thing, Christ was the Word, and the Church becomes the Word when it lets the Word go through them.

378 But when they accept a hybrid denomination, how can the Word go through it? It's grounded, then it causes a short and blows a fuse. See?

379 But when the current is flowing freely, the Word of God, It expresses Itself. "The works that I do shall ye be, also."

And in the last days it shall come to pass: "Behold I send to you Elijah the prophet, and he shall turn the hearts of the—of the children back to the Faith of the fathers."

380 And in there, there would be a time come forth when He could express Himself in fullness of His Godhead, Deity, through His Church, have the preeminences in this Church. Oh, my! What?

The anointed Man; now the anointed people; oh, my, to bring back the anointed Bride and the Bridegroom. Anointed by (why?) accepting what Eve turned down, and Adam;

coming back with the anointing of the Word, because He said, "My Word is Spirit." See, anointed with the Word. What Eve turned down, He comes back and we accept.

268 Oh, that spiritual union of Christ and His Church now, when the flesh is becoming Word, and the Word is becoming flesh, manifested, vindicated. Just what the Bible said would happen in this day, it's happening, day by day.

Why, it's cumulating so fast out there, in those deserts, and things taking place, that I couldn't even keep up with it. We're near the Coming of Jesus, to be united with His Church, where the Word becomes the Word. Call of the Holy Spirit, searching the hearts!

65-1125 - The Invisible Union Of The Bride Of Christ

121 Speaking of the day that when women wouldn't no more want children. They want a dog or a cat, or something like that, but she don't want children anymore.

Why? She is "Old Mother Hubbard" if she has a child. See? She don't want. That's the—that's the remarks of Hollywood.

It don't want his woman to be an "Old Mother Hubbard." So she'll, he'll have some operation performed to himself or her, one, that'll keep them from having children. They don't want no children.

122 Jesus spoke of it. And what did He say? "At that time they'll begin to cry for the rocks and the mountains to 'Fall on us."

123 She'll practice birth control, so she can go to parties. She can't be bothered with a baby nursing her. "It'll disform her. When she's pregnated, it'll be, it disform her.

She won't look like she used to." And her husband, ignorant enough to let her go that way. She won't give him a child.

3. Christ Has Longed for This Hour-To Finally Truly Fall in Love and Have a Wife of His Own Choosing-(You Only Love Your Own Nature).

63-0728 — Christ Is The Mystery Of God Revealed

374 What was Jesus manifested for? To show God. He was God.

He had to be; no man could die, no prophet could die. He was God. He was the God of the prophets. He was the prophets. He was the kings.

He was the history. He was He that was to come. He that was, He that is, and He that's to be in this day; the same yesterday, today, and forever. He was manifested for that purpose.

375 And through that purpose He achieved a Church, that He, the fullness of God, might bring to pass every promised Word of God in these last days; when He gets the preeminences, preeminence in the Church,

the position, His place in the Church. Jesus said, "He that believeth on Me, the works that I do shall he also; even more than this shall he do, for I go to My Father."

See, that was His purpose. There was the manifestation. And now, today, He wants to get somebody that can so see it, that they can let the Word...

56-0805 - The Church And Its

Condition

36 And I thought of how God, (the dove is such a loving bird) and the Dove, God, wanting to make love with His human beings.

God wants to be loved. God wants to love you. "God so loved the world, He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but to have everlasting Life."

Blessed be the Lord! Then God, wanting to make love, He had to some...make something loveable.

He had to make something gentle like Himself. He had to make something that could be loved. He had to make something of His Own Nature.

37 You couldn't love nothing that wasn't of your own nature. Loving has to unite with love. A husband and wife have to love one another, if they ever make the grade.

Family has to love one another, if they ever make the grade. Something to be loved! You search everywhere, finding a girl to be your wife that you love. She searches, finding a husband that she could love.

38 God searches, trying to find a soul that He can love. So, He represented Himself here on earth as a gentle Dove and a gentle Lamb.

If that Lamb would at one minute ever taken on the nature of a snarling wolf, that Dove would have took Her flight immediately, she'd have got away.

62-0121e - The Marriage Of The

<u>Lamb</u>

81 Now, marriage, in one sense, is a type. The earthly marriage here is a type of the heavenly marriage. Now let's go over it, just for a few moments, to rehearse it a moment.

82 The first thing there is, there must be a decision made. The first thing, takes, in natural marriage, is a decision has to be made.

The young lady has to make her decision, whether she wants this young man; and the young man, whether he wants the young woman.

There has to be a decision made, and you have to make it. She must be the only woman in the world that you love, and he must be the only man. If it isn't, then you made a wrong decision.

83 And that's the same way it is by making the decision for Christ. The first thing you have to do, is make up your mind whether you're going to serve God and take Him as your Saviour,

or you're not going to do it. Are you going to serve the world? Are you going to serve Christ? You have to make up your mind. There has to be a decision made.

When you make up your mind, that you're either going to serve God or mammon, then you take your choice. But the decision has to be made.

84 And then, after the decision is made, that you are, then comes the engagement. That, you find that at the altar. You've got to make an engagement before this union can be.

And that's the way it is with Christ's Church. It has to be an engagement with Christ, a-a pledge, an engagement, a love affair.

85 And then, the next thing, is—is promises made. There has to be promises made to one another, like that you make promise.

"Sweetheart, if you'll marry me, I promise that I'll be loyal and true. I will look upon no other woman." Or, "I'll look upon no other man.

And I'll do all that as a duty, as a wife. We have children, it'll do all as a duty as a—as a mother. I, I'll be a housekeeper." All these promises has got to be made, or should be, in a correct wedding.

86 And that's the same thing when you come to Christ. "Lord, if You will receive me into Your Kingdom, I promise." There you are. "I'll love You. I'll be true to You. I'll serve You, day and night."

It's too bad we forget that. "I'll serve You, day and night. I'll fast. I'll pray. I'll be loyal to You. I'll bring my tithings into the storehouse. I, I'll—I'll pray, many times a day. I'll—I'll do anything.

And I'll pledge all my love to You." That's what you should do. That's exactly right, where you promise that, and it should come from your heart.

87 If you promise your husband that, and not from your heart, you mean it, you are absolutely not living correctly with him. It's kind of a crystallized affair.

88 Look here. If—if you haven't got teeth, and you use false teeth, now, that's all right. It's substituting for the teeth that you once had. But, actually, those teeth are not connected with you.

It's not part of you. If you had an—an arm amputated, and you put a false arm on, well, that arm is actually not connected with you. It's just stuck on you. See? It's not connected with you.

89 And when we take our pledge to Christ, if we don't become part of Him, like a woman ought to become part of a man and a man part of the woman, then we're artificial Christians.

We're not, really. You're really not married to that woman. You might be loyal.

If you don't love your husband, and him sixty or seventy years old, and you don't love him as good as you did at the beginning, then you're really just raising his children.

90 That's the way the churches are, too many today. We're just taking the name of the "Christian Church," pretending to be the Bride. When, it's artificially. We're not connected with Christ in any way.

We're like an artificial tooth, artificial arm, artificial eye. See? It's something that's artificial if we're just putting it on. Well, you can't put on Christianity. You've got to be connected with it.

91 And then a church that's just artificial, called the church of Christ, well, them children then are not in There, that's born of that same organization.

Is only...They're not Christ's children. They are denominational children, and not children of Christ.

92 If the woman isn't connected with the man in trueness, then it isn't her husband. It's just a man she's taken a vow to live with, and she took a wrong vow.

She pledged to love him, and she said she loved him, and she didn't do it. All the time, the man is deceived.

- 93 But there's one thing sure, friends, we're not going to deceive Christ. He knows His own.
- 94 But, you see, first, decisions made. Next, engagement. Then, promise.

95 And, then, the ceremony. And that's when the bride—bride takes the bridegroom's name. She is no more then of her own name. She takes the bridegroom's name.

96 And then when the Church has the ceremony, makes their promises, then she takes the Bridegroom's Name. Then she is no longer a church of the world. She is the Church of the Lord Jesus Christ. Amen. Not...I don't mean, that, by Name. I mean, that, by Birth, by nature, by power of God.

By the revealed Truth of God, in the heart, she becomes a Christian Church, the great universal apostolic Christian Church. She becomes a part of Christ.

When she does that, she...Christ injects into her His own Spirit, His own Life. And the Bible said, to Adam and Eve, there, "You are no longer twain, but one."

And when the woman, Church, is married to Christ, they are no longer two. They are One. Christ in you! Amen. That's it. His Life has been brought into you, then you become the Bride.

97 Then, another thing, after she has taken all these vows, and so forth, and the ceremony has been said:

98 Like, my wife's name was Broy before she was married. Now, she is no longer a Broy. She is Branham. Now, she isn't no more Broy. She is Branham.

99 And when you come into Christ, you're no more of the world. You are of Christ. See? You care not then for the things of the world.

They are dead to you. "For he that loves the world, or the things of the world, the love of God is not even in him."

100 So, you see, you can't be an artificial Christian. You can be an artificial, professed Christian.

101 But you can't be a Christian, become, until Christ injects Himself, by the baptism of the Holy Ghost, into you.

Then you're connected with Him. You're no longer twain. You are One. Christ promised to be in us, as the Father was in Christ.

"I and My Father are One. You and I are One." See? Christ in us! All that God was, He poured into Christ. And all that Christ was, He poured into the Church, to continue the work of the Gospel.

102 Then we become, not by artificial name, but by a reality of the Holy Spirit of Life connecting us into Christ.

Then, through the power of His resurrection, we are raised from the dead things of the world, and setting with Him in Heavenly places.

Amen. I like that. Tonight, we're setting in Heavenly places in Christ Jesus, see, resurrected with Him; died to the things of the world, and took on Christ.

And when we take on Christ, then the world is dead, then we no more care for the world. The world is dead to us. And we're...And it's dead to us, and we're dead to it.

105 And the Church is no more of the world, but it's in the Name of Christ, she is. She's connected with Him, by His own Life.

It's got to grow, as we grow in the grace and knowledge of God. You are baptized into the Holy Spirit. Now, as the pentecostal Church, baptized into the Holy Spirit, It's begin growing.

Limbs has died. They was pruning them off. But the Tree is still growing, is still going on, because It's got to come to the resurrection.

99 They're led by the Spirit, to quicken the Word to you who is believers.

The Word keeps quickening, as you come to first limb, second limb, third limb, on up. It just keeps quickening. The Spirit of God keeps quickening to you.

100 Notice that, Pentecost, their bodies were quickened by the new Life they received. That makes me feel religious. Think.

Now, here was men, fishermen, tax collectors, the humble little women of...and just ordinary housewives, little virgin girls. They were believers. They were believing that this was the Truth.

They believed that, when Jesus died (They believed on Him.) and rose up again, from the dead, they believed that to be the absolutely testimony of God, that He had quickened Him to life.
