96 Now, she must rot, of course, as I have said, in order to bring new birth. Look what she has rotted into. Notice, my brethren! She's totally rotten.

Her politics and systems is just as rotten as they can be. There isn't a sound bone in her, in her world systems, her politics and her religious politics, and whatever it is.

One says, "I'm a Democrat. I'm a Republican. I'm Methodist. I'm Baptist." Why, the whole thing is rotten to the core. There's got to be something give way. She can't stand.

If you put a George Washington or an Abraham Lincoln in every county in this United States, it still couldn't come back. It's beyond redemption.

97 There's only one thing can help her, that's the Coming of the Creator. Amen.

98 She knows she must give way. She's in pain and distress. One don't know what to do. One is looking this way, and one that way, and everything.

Until, now they got it in the hands of sinful men, who could destroy the whole world in a five minutes time.

See? So she knows she can't stand it. The people knows she can't stand it. And the world knows that they're going to, it's going to happen.

99 For, God said it was. "The whole heavens and earth is going to be on fire." It's going to be a renovation of the whole thing, so a new world can be born. God has prophesied it.

100 She's rotten, in all of her systems, and she's got to do that, to rot away.

101 That's why she, I said, she is so nervous and red in the face, and flusterated. And earthquakes, everywhere, and up-and-down the coast.

And tidal waves in Alaska, and shaking up-and-down the coast, of earthquakes and things.

And people writing, "Shall we leave it? Shall we leave it?" See? They don't know what to do. There's no safety zone but One,

102 Now let's look at the Doctor's Book, if she is in this kind of a condition, and see if this is supposed to happen when the new earth is to be born.

Matthew 24, in the Doctor's Book, which is the Bible, and let's see what's prophesied, what her symptoms would be.

103 Now, if a doctor knows the symptoms of birth of a child...And just about time the child is to come, he gets everything ready,

because he knows that that is the—the time the child is to be born. Because, all symptoms shows;

the—the water is broke, the blood. And now the...It's time. The child is dropped, and it's time for the child to be born. And so he gets everything ready for it.

24 I had a dream, the other morning. I don't dream very often, I'm not a dreamer. But I—I dreamed that I seen a man,

a young fellow in shackels, and he was trying to get out, and—and I said...Somebody told me, said, "Those are horrible people, don't have nothing to do with them."

25 And I seen this young fellow getting out of his shackel so I just let him alone. I thought, "I'll just see what he does." So when he got out, he was a nice fellow. And I seen others trying to get out.

26 Now, this is only a dream. And I walked over this way and I seen a—a brother, Roy Borders, a very good friend of mine, lives in California.

Looked like there's something wrong, his eyes was half closed, and great big...maybe cancer or something over his eyes.

And I...someone was trying to pull me away from him. I screamed, "Brother Borders! In the Name of the Lord Jesus, snap out of that!"

27 And he just barely could speak, saying, "Brother Branham, it'll have to take something more than this. I just can't grasp it, Brother Branham. I just can't grasp

28 I said, "O Brother Borders." I love him.

29 And someone pulled me away, and I looked, and it was a lady standing over here that I, when I was a little boy,

I—I used to haul groceries from the grocery store to the peoples. And her name was Mrs. Fenton, she lives in Jeffersonville yet, a personal friend to the wife and I.

Said, "These are fine people, but..." And I looked over there, and like a great big cellar, or—or big walls, down beneath a great big cave; and great iron bars, eight or ten inches thick.

And people, out of their mind, twisted arms and legs, beating their head like that. And she was crying, saying, "Deliver the people, Brother Branham."

Said-said, "Help us, we're in trouble." She herself, I know her, she belongs to the...l believe the church of Christ, or the Christian church, called Church of the Brethren. So she...

31 I looked around, and I said, "I wished I could." And go on, looking around; and I...my little, bitty body and—and them great, big iron bars; and those poor people in there.

And you couldn't get to them, them iron bars was setting close together. And I looked, and they were beating their head like they were out of their mind.

32 And I seen some lights flickering around in there. And I looked up, and there stood the Lord Jesus with a—a—a lights of rainbow around Him.

He was looking right straight to me, said, "Deliver those people." And He went away. 33 And I thought, "Well, how could I deliver them? I—I haven't got strength enough in my arms to break those bars."

34 So I said, "House of hell, give way to the Name of Jesus Christ."

35 And all the creaking and popping, and—and rocks rolling, and—and bars falling; and people running, screaming, "Delivered!" and screaming at the top of their voice, and was all delivered.

36 And I was screaming then, "Brother Roy Borders, where are you? Where are you? God is delivering His people! Where are you, Brother Borders?" I've wondered about that.

37 You know, Brother Borders is very scared. You know the prophecy, all...many of you do, you take the tapes and so forth, about the West Coast.

38 There's men setting right here, tonight, that was there when that happened, when we were standing there, on a hunting trip.

And a minister who was listening in last night, with a blinded eye, he just come up there and he said...introduced himself. He had on colored glasses, up in the mountain.

He said, "Brother Branham," said, "I'm Brother McHughes." He said, "I—I helped sponsor one of your meetings once, in California."

59-0813 — Why?

54 So is it today. We don't need so many UN's. If we are a Christian nation, let's call God on the scene. The reason there is no Balm in Gilead:

Sure there is Balm, there is a God in America, there's a God here, it's because of the stubbornness of the people that they don't want to consult Him.

They would rather take the advice of some intellectual student, than to come to the blessed Holy Spirit that God sent to the earth.

It's the reason that we are in such a condition today. It's not because there isn't a God, it's not because the Holy Spirit isn't still real,

it's because the stubbornness of the people, it's because they want to sin, it's because they desire to do those things, that's what's in their heart.

55 It's like a man dying on a doctor's steps, if a doctor has a remedy for the disease that the man has, and the man sets on his steps, but refuses to take the remedy, he'll die there.

And it isn't the doctor's fault, he's got the remedy, and he's willing to give it, but the man is too stubborn to take it.

56 And so is it today. There's no need of any man dying in sin, there's no need of all of this stuff that's going on, God has got the Remedy,

and the people set on the church steps and die because they won't receive It. They die in sin setting in the church in the pew, because they won't receive lt.

57 There's a Balm in Gilead, there's a physician there, but the people won't take his medicine. The local church member, lukewarm,

thinks he's too good to take the Medicine of the Holy Ghost. The Holy Ghost is God's Medicine, It's the Cure. But the local church member won't do it.

They'll go to church, they'll put their name on books, they're willing to pay their tithings, they're willing to do anything like that, but when it comes to taking the Medicine, they won't do it.

God's Deliverance Comes In Simplicit, y And The Word In His Season Is The Deliverer

63-0317M - God Hiding Himself In Simplicity, Then Revealing Himself In The Same 162 So, see, it's the simplicity of It, just simple, that's where God lays.

163 Now, they were—they were too smart, in that day, to catch the meaning of God's simple way of doing things. It wasn't polished for them. It's got to be polished,

It's got to be highly chromed, or they miss it. Now, but, the great Jehovah was hid in His Word. And He made Himself known to the people that believed in His Word,

by saving them, and bringing to pass the simple message. The simple message of Noah, God brought it to pass. Now notice that.

164 Now, then, again in Moses' day, notice another time of deliverance.

165 When God is just about to do something to deliver His people, God sends a Message to the people.

And, It's so simple, as we'll catch in the breaking of these Seals. That was my purpose of bringing this first. That, we find out that the breaking of those Seals is so simple, the—the—the smart miss It, a million miles. See? I hope that God anoints me for It. See? See? It just goes over the top.

And that's the reason I thought this Message, this morning, would be appropriate, to lay a foundation, on the simplicity of God, see, how God hides Himself in simplicity.

166 Just think, they can break atoms and do everything else; but when it comes to touching life, they can't even tell where it come from.

A simple blade of grass, and God is hid in it. They can fire a rocket to the moon, and—and shoot a radar over there, or whatever more,

and yet can't explain the life in a blade of grass. That's right. See? It's because it can't be explained. It's so simple, they overlook that.

167 Now notice Moses, in the day that God was going to deliver the children of Israel, according to His Word.

He, what did He do? He chose a simple family. We have no record of them. See, just "a son of Levi," is all we know.

See? And so we...and his wife. Just a ordinary, probably a—a mud dauber, as the world would think, out there making brick for the enemy. He was just an ordinary slave in Israel,

but God chose that family to bring forth the deliverer; just an ordinary Jewish family. He never went and got royalty and celebrity, or something, or even got some priest.

He took a common, ordinary family. See? Simplicity! Notice what He done, then, He brought forth a child, a simple human being. He never...

168 He could have—He could have ordained the sun, if He wanted to, to deliver them. He could have ordained the wind to deliver them.

He could have ordained an Angel to deliver them. Oh, hallelujah! God can do whatever He wants to do. "Well, how do you know then, Brother Branham?"

169 God won't leave His program. That's the reason we know that, this day, It's got to be simple. See?

Now, He always works in simplicity. But God, in the beginning, that could have made the sun preach the Gospel, or the winds preach the Gospel, or an Angel preach the Gospel,

but He ordained men for that purpose, and He never changes it. He never ordained indi-...He never ordained denominations,

He never ordained groups of men, He ordained men to preach the Gospel, not machinery, mechanical devices, or any Angelic Being, it was men.

170 And when He brought deliverance to the people down there, He sent a simple human being, born of a simple family in a bunch of slaves.

Oh, my! What a God He is, unfolding Himself in simplicity!

171 Now notice. And He had him trained in worldly wisdom, so that he could fail, and show that it isn't wisdom that we'll ever be delivered by. It's by faith that we are delivered.

He let him go in and get such an education until he could teach the Egyptians wisdom; he was so smart. God was with that simple family who could, perhaps, maybe not write their name.

And Moses was took into the highest of schooling, with such a great education, till he could teach the wisdom to the teachers.

He could teach the genius. Yes. And God let him get that way so He could display Himself in humility, to show that wisdom has nothing to do with it.

And Moses miserably failed in his genius. He let him get that way for His purpose, so that he would fail. And he did fail, and he fell.

172 So, to show, "Not by power, not by might," but not by the wisdom of Egypt, not by the wisdom of our schools, not by the power of our seminaries,

but not by the amounts of our organization, not by the power of our scholarly teaching, "but by My Spirit, saith God."

His wisdom was vanished and at its end, when he met God in the burning bush there. He took off his shoes and humbled himself to humility, and forgot all about his wisdom.

173 God, bringing deliverance, had to train him in wisdom, to let him fall, to show that you cannot lean upon the arm of your own understanding, or anybody else's understanding.

Let him fall, to show His hand. Can you see it? [Congregation says, "Amen."—Ed.]

God's purpose in doing so, was to display Himself in humility. And He let Moses become the highest, until he would—he would be the next pharaoh. He was a mighty general.

According to history, he conquered, Moses himself, the countries around. And then when he turned to the work of the Lord, with all of his talent, God let him take a headlong topple,

so that He could put him out there on the desert and beat all that out of him; and then appear to him, in humility, and send him down with a stick in his hand, to deliver the people.

174 When, he couldn't do it by a military training, by an education, by a scientific education. And by a military force he could not do it. And He give him an old crooked stick off the desert,

and He did it with him. God in humility, simplicity! God was in the stick and in Moses. And as long as Moses had the stick, then God had it, because God was in Moses. Sure.

175 Notice, "Not by power, nor by—by might, but by My Spirit." But by the simple faith!

176 Moses had an understanding that he was to be the deliverer, from the teaching of his mother.

And he trained himself in military might, to do so, but it failed. See? He had the understanding, he had the education, but that didn't work.

So he had to forget it all, and come to the simple thing of taking God at His Word, and then he delivered the people. Yes, sir.

Pressure

73 Coming to a hospital, thought, I was coming down one night, and—and there was sent me...

It was Brother Neville, the pastor's call, and I—I—I took it, 'cause I was coming from Louisville. And it said the lady was very serious.

And I went out to the hospital there at Jeffersonville, and there was a lady there. And I... They told me, "Go to room 322. The lady was there."

74 I walked in. I said, "Is there a 'four' bed, ward?" I said, "Is there a lady, So-and-so, here?"

"No, sir. She isn't here." I said, "I probably made a mistake. Excuse me."

75 And I walked back out. And the nurse was coming down the hall, and she was kind of in a hurry.

I said, "Lady, could you tell me if a certain lady is up here on this ward, or where she's at?" 76 She said, "I have no time for to do things like that. And can't you see I'm in a hurry?" I said, "Pardon me."

77 I walked up to the desk, and—and the lady was setting there at the desk, a nurse. And I said...She was writing out something.

I kept waiting. She looked up at me; just kept on writing. Well, I waited around a few minutes.

I said, "Good evening." She never said a thing. And I thought, "Well?" I said, "Could you tell me where a certain lady is? lt...l'm a minister.

I been sent here to a certain place, to room 322, they told me."

And she said, "Well, then go to room 322."

And I said, "Lady, I have been to room three-..." She said, "Why ask me, then? Go to the desk downstairs." I said, "Well, thank you."

78 I started downstairs, and I got down there. And I asked the nurse on the floor. She knowed nothing about it.

79 Here come a little doctor, down through the floor, with his stereoscopes in his hand, whirling them around and around, like this.

Little...I never seen such a fat man! He was—he was...Honestly, I believe he was broader than he was long.

He was walking...or, he was high, rather. So he was walking down, whirling these stereoscopes in his hands. And I said, "Excuse me, doctor.

Could you tell me where..." He said, "Yes, yes, it's on back, that way," he said. "Thank you, sir."

80 I went on down the other way. I thought, "Well, now, what am I going to do?"

81 And he went down, set down behind the desk. And I didn't see anybody else. I thought I might as well walk up and ask him again.

I said, "Pardon me, sir." He just kept looking at something else, you know. And I said, "Did the...I am wanting to know where the room..."

Said, "It's back that way." I said, "Room 222, I can't find which way to go." He said, "Just go this way, and that way. You'll find it." 82 What is it? Pressure, see, pressure built up. He might have come from surgery. He might have thought that he had...

that I oughtn't to be asking him that. It was out of the visiting hours, truly. Then he thought, "Just some preacher. Let him go." See?

83 The world is just built upon pressure. It's going to blow up, one of these days. The world, built full of pressure, and the doctors don't know what to do about it.

The psychiatrists has got psychiatrists doctoring them. That's right. They don't have the answer, but God does. God has the answer to all of this.

84 In the Old Testament, when a man had did something wrong, now, it was tooth for a tooth, and eye for eye.

And if this man did something wrong, he had a place of escape. I believe Joshua had built houses of refuge.

And if the people did something wrong, and they were subject to be killed, but they had a place of refuge where this man could run to, this city of refuge.

And he was safe if his pursuers didn't overtake him before he got there. He...But if the pursuers overtook him, they—they killed him, in the way.

We Have God's Template...For A Complete Total Deliverance

59-0712 — A Total Deliverance 48 Now, Moses, when he was called by God, he was a total, complete prophet.

When God sends a man to do anything, He completely equips him with everything that he has need of.

If God calls a man to be a preacher, He puts something in him to preach with. If He calls him to be a teacher, He puts something in him to teach with.

If He calls for him to be a prophet, He puts something in him, to see visions and to be a prophet. God always completely equips His man.

And that's just what He done when He sent Moses into Egypt. He raised him up in a certain way. And He schooled him in a certain way,

and He molded him, and made him, and fashioned him. After He had promised Abraham, hundreds of years before, that He would deliver the people,

then He—He had in mind that He would make Moses just the way Moses was made. Moses was a complete prophet. And then, being a complete prophet, then...

49 Just like you, if you are a Christian, God don't make any halfway Christians. God makes complete Christians.

God don't make halfway preachers, but the preacher can be halfway. And God makes His children Christians, but sometimes they're halfway Christian.

But it's not God's intention for them to be that way. It's their own ways got mixed up with the plan of God for their life, and that's what makes them the way they are.

59-0712 — A Total Deliverance 77 If our hearts condemn us, we want complete

deliverance. We don't want to be halfway, church.

We want to be a real church or no church at all. We want to be real Christians or no Christians at all. We want total deliverance from our habits, from our sins,

from our evil thinking, from our evil doing, from our negligence, whatever we've done. We want total deliverance, so that when people come into this church,

to be prayed for, there will be just this little group (maybe not over a hundred, or two) sitting here, but they'll be completely in the hands of God.

And when we pray, then God will hear from Heaven. God wants somebody that He can hold in His hands, somebody that He can say,

"I got confidence in. I can send this, My sick servant, to the Branham Tabernacle at Jeffersonville, and that group of people are one accord." Something will happen.

78 Well, look what He does for us in the condition that we're in. What would He do if we were one heart and one accord?

The only way we can do that, is unify our hearts together with brotherly love,

obey the officers of the church, and the pastor, and the pastor obey God. Then God works through the pastor, through the board, down into the church,

and all together are one unit to the Kingdom of God. Then God will hear, when we have a unified group. Let nothing bother you. Don't be dismayed at anything.

The Trumpet Of Jubilee Was Beneficial When The Slave Accepted To Go Free

61-0618 - Revelation, Chapter Five #2 169 Now, remember, in the Old Testament, if a—a man lost his inheritance and a squatter come on his land,

he could not hold it any longer for annihilation from the owner until fifty years. After fifty years, the year—year of Jubilee came by.

And the year of Jubilee, when the year of Jubilee come along, then everything went back to its original beginning again. All slaves, they went back to the original beginning.

If a man was hoeing in the field and the trumpet sounded and he heard it, he'd throw down the hoe and say, "I'm no more a slave, I go back home to my family." Everything was given back.

If a squatter was on the ground, he had to get off the ground. That's all. He got off the ground because why? The legal owner was coming back. He had to give way.

65-0219 - This Day This Scripture Is Fulfilled

46 "The acceptable year," as we all know, as Bible readers, was "the year of jubilee."

That, when all slaves and prisoners, as they were, been taken, prison; and had to give a son, to pay a debt;

or a daughter, to pay a debt, [Blank spot on tape—Ed.] and they were in bondage. No matter how long they had been in bondage, or how long they was supposed to stay there;

when the year come, of the jubilee, when the trumpet sounded, every man could go free if he wanted to go free. [Blank spot on tape.] You're free. You was no more slave.

47 But if you desired to remain a slave, then you had to be taken down to the temple, stood by the temple post,

and they took an awl and bored a hole in your ear, and then you had to serve that slave master the rest of your days.

48 What a perfect example it is of the Gospel of Jesus Christ!

When It's preached, the acceptable time, and the time of Jubilee; anybody, no matter who you are, what color you are, what denomination you belong

how it's far you've stooped in sin, or what's wrong with you; you can go free when you hear the Gospel trumpet sound out. You are free!

That means, to say, that you have crossed the line between grace and judgment, and you will never hear the Gospel again.

You'll never get any further. You must be a slave to the system you're in, the rest of your days, if you refuse to hear the acceptable year.

you would open the door, say, "Come in. I am honored to have you. Take anything that's in my house. I'll give you anything that you desire as a souvenir.

Or anything that I might do to show my respect of you coming to my home, I'd gladly do it." The German soldier would've likewise, no doubt, fallen prostrate on his face and said,

"Great Fuehrer, enter into my house, and anything that I have in my possession is yours, because you are the Fuehrer of Germany." Or you are the Queen of England...

Or you are the President of the United States, one of the highest honored men in the nation... President Dwight Eisenhower,

you would give him anything that he desired in your house. And if you would not open up your house completely, he would not feel welcome.

57-1212 - The Door Of The

Door

10 But Jesus can stand and knock, there's no one as important as the King of kings, to humble Himself to come to a low,

degraded, sinful heart and knock at that heart to try to gain entrance into that heart. And we in return, turn Him away.

Oh, you say, "But Brother Branham, I opened my heart to the Lord Jesus long ago. He came into my heart years ago." But I'm speaking now to the Church.

But when He comes into your heart, is He welcome? You know, in the heart there's many little doors, like there is in your house.

If the President come to your house, and you said, "Now, Mr. President, you may set here at the door. But don't you go in that room or this room.

I don't want you in there." He would not be welcome. And if any man that I think enough of to open the door of my house to let him in,

he's my guest, and he's welcome to anything there is in my house. If I come to your house and didn't feel that welcome, I would not feel like I was welcome at all.

11 But Jesus comes inside the door of the Christian's heart, but we've got little apartments in our heart that He cannot come in. Oh, you say, "I'm willing for Him to be my Saviour.

I don't want to go to hell, but I want to be saved. Jesus, You can be my Saviour." But He wants to be more than your Saviour, He wants to be your Lord. Lord is ownership, ruler.

That's why the Church gets in its lukewarm condition. It accepts Christ as Saviour, but not as Lord. Christ wants to be the Lord of your being, to rule and to guide you.

That's why He knocks at the heart, to come in for that purpose, is to be your spiritual Guide, and to be the ruler of your welfare.

But in our hearts we have many little apartments. I wish to speak now on some of these little apartments.

One of them is a little closet over on one side that many people who call themselves Christian, yet they would not dare to let Jesus in that little compartment,

because it's the apartment of selfishness. Now, you notice among so-called Christians, you're right, selfish motives.

"Oh, it's all right, if it's for me and my denomination, it's all right. But if my denomination has nothing to do with it, then I don't want anything to do with it."

That's a little apartment of selfishness that all Christians ought to open the door and say, "Come in, Lord Jesus, and be Lord of my heart."

12 Then there is the little compartment in the heart called indifferent. Oh, what a condition that thing gets into.

A little indifferent. You love to be just a little indifferent towards others. You want your own way.

You'd be willing to let Jesus in, but you want to continue to live in the same place that you always lived. You don't want to get away from your old associates. You just won't give them up.

You think they're nice people, and you just don't want to give them up. So you want to be a little different. That's another bad apartment in the heart.

Then there's another little door called jealousy. I don't know whether you yankees know anything about it or not, but down south you have a lot of that.

Oh, just a little inferior to the other man. Just a little better than the other church. If the Joneses paint their steps red, you got to have yours red.

Oh, what a horrible spirit to be in a Christian. Why don't you let Christ come in and make Him Lord over that little spirit room of selfishness and indifference.

Let Him gain the entrance to your heart and to everything that's in your heart. Just surrender your whole being to Him. Let Him be God and ruler of your entire being.

13 There's another little apartment that I'd like to speak on. And that is the apartment in there that's called faith.

So many people wants to accept Christ as their Saviour, but they say, "The days of miracles is past."

So they don't want to believe that the days of miracles are now. Christ can't get into that heart. If Christ could gain entrance to the heart tonight, of every person here,

there would not be a feeble person among us in ten minutes. The faith is in you, but you're afraid to open up the door and let Him be Lord of that faith.

You try to sympathize with a part of the Bible, say, "Some of it is right, but the other is not inspired." What causes that, is perhaps maybe,

some person not knowing any different, taught you that. All of God's Word is inspired. And if we'll open up our heart, and open up our door in our little room of faith,

Christ come in and be Lord, He will show great and mighty works and signs, if He could only gain entrance to that heart of faith.

14 "Oh," you say, "I believe it to be that all these things passed with the apostles." See, you keep the door closed.

Christ will come into the midst of the people and do signs and wonders on people. And they let that little compartment stay shut.

"Oh, it might be all right for her, but for me, my case is different." There is no difference with Christ. He's no respect of person, none at all.

Cancer or a toothache, it matters not with Him, if He can be Lord over the matter. You just don't open up that heart to let Him in that faith door, so He can be Ruler.

Now, they cast down reason. When you let Christ into the compartment of your heart as faith, then reasons die out.

65-0206 - Doors In Door

202 Yeah, there is a door there. I want to call another door. I get too wound up.

There is another door there, just next to that door, going around the right-hand side, and that door is the door to your private life.

Oh! Oh, you don't want Him messing with that. "Now, if I want to go out to a little cocktail party, what is it to You?

What church is going to tell me what I'm going to do?" Uh-huh, there you are, see. "A tenth of my wages? Who is going to tell me what to do?

That's my own private life! I make this money. I have my own life. I'll wear shorts if I want to. That's my own American privilege." That is true. Sure. Right.

203 But if you're a lamb, and not a goat, see, lambs is what He is after. They'll be separated someday.

204 A sheep has wool. That's the only thing it has. And it can't manufacture that wool. We're not asked to manufacture the fruit of the Spirit,

but to bear the fruit of the Spirit. And as long as it's a sheep, it'll bear. It don't have to manufacture.

The glands and everything in it is sheep, it'll make wool because the inside of him has the glands and the adrenalin and stuff it takes to make wool.

205 And when you are a Christian, you'll cope with the Word. I don't care what anybody else says. You don't have to work up nothing, and bring down nothing, pull, pump up.

You're a Christian. You just automatically bear the fruit of the Spirit. See? See, and that's the way it is. See?

206 But, people today, they don't want you fooling with their private life.

207 Only thing you do, just open up every door around, now say, "Come on in, Jesus." Watch what happens.

When you see in the Book, you're supposed to do this, you'll do it. Why? You're a sheep, to begin with, then.

208 But if you just want to set, keep Him at the door, just say, "I've joined church. I'm as good as you. See, I accepted Christ." Maybe that's just what you done. But did you make Him Lord? See?

209 Now, the Lord cannot sit down a Book of rules and say a Word, and then come around and deny It. And if you say you got the Holy Ghost, and the Bible says a certain thing to do,

and you say, "Oh, I don't believe That." You just remember, that spirit in you is not the Holy Spirit, 'cause He can't deny

Himself.

That's right. He can't deny Himself. He wrote the Word, and He watches over It, to perform It. See? So it's not the Holy...

210 It's a spirit, all right. It might be a—a spirit of the church. It might be the spirit of the pastor. It might be the spirit of the world. It might be.

I don't know what it is, but, whatever it is, it might be a denominational spirit, "I'm Methodist. I'm Baptist. I'm Presbyterian. I'm Pentecostal. I'm this." That's Pentecost.

211 Now remember, let me straighten it; pentecost is not an organization, pentecost is an experience that you receive.

You Methodists, Baptists, Catholics, and all, can experience pentecost. You can't join pentecost, 'cause there is no way to join it.

212 I've been in the Branham family for fifty-five years. You know, they never did ask me to become a Branham. I was born, a Branham.

213 And that's how you're a Christian, you are born a Christian. That's right, now.

214 Oh, that private life! "Oh, I tell you, my pastor goes to these dances, and we do the twist. They have it." All right. See?

"Don't you come telling me what I can do and what I can't do." All right, see, you won't let Him in.

215 Just let Him in one time, and then go back to the twist or the rock-and-roll, or whatever you're going to do, see what you can do.

You can't do it. Let Him in one time, and then start to put on a pair of shorts, some of you women.

216 I know I'm taking you a long time, but I want to say one more thing, if it's all right, in this regard.

58 You're living in a house, soul, body, and spirit. That's the way God lived in Jesus Christ, both soul, body, and spirit.

Now, a lot of people, even you Pentecostal people, lot of times get mistaken in that. You get a new spirit; that's not God's Spirit; that's you.

That isn't God. You get a little happy, because you got a new spirit and you jump up-and-down, run around over the floor, maybe,

and shout a little bit, and speak with tongues, and run around a little bit and think you got the Holy Ghost. That's not it.

That's a new spirit, God gave you. That's you. Then after He give you your spirit, then He said, "I'll put My Spirit..."

That's what's the matter with the miss-meal cramps you got today. That's right. That's the reason you can't get nowhere with God.

60 Notice, you put a new spirit. God has to give you a new spirit, or you couldn't even get along with Him. You can't get along with yourself, that old devil spirit you had in you.

So He's got to put a new spirit in you so you can get along with His Spirit. Amen. "I will put a new spirit in them.

And I will put My Spirit in them," He said, after He's give you a new spirit; that's you. Don't get it confused with God's Spirit; it's not. It's your new spirit, so you can get along with the Holy Spirit,

if He ever gives it to you. Amen. Cause you in your condition never get along. You can't get along with your wife.

You can't get along with your husband, can't get along with your neighbor. How are you ever going to get along with God?

So He has to give you a new spirit, 'fore you can get along with Him. So He puts a new spirit in you, and then He puts His Spirit in you,

gives you a new spirit, a new outlook, a new faith, then He puts His Holy Spirit in you. Notice, back there in the beginning when that same manna that fell out here on the ground,

every day the people eat it; but notice, those people who eat that manna would get hungry before nine o'clock.

61 I've seen a lot of camp meetings. And people go, and they'd shout the victory for a little while, while the camp meeting was going on. And then before the day was over, with the night coming close, they'll worry along and say, "Well, you know, I wished I could keep the victory. Hallelujah."

Oh, my. My. "I wished I just had the victory. I tell you, this—this—this is so-and-so, and this is so-and-so." Oh, my, it's because you're not in the right place to eat the manna. That's right.

64-0411 — Spiritual Amnesia 81 I must never forget this. If I want to remain a true American citizen,

I must remember that I am what my nation is, for I'm identified with my nation. To forget her, or—or...

To fight for her, or to die for her, or to stand for all she stands for, I must stand for it. What my nation is, I am. What it stands for, I stand for it.

To be a loyal American, I'll be ready to die for it, fight for it, stand for it, do anything there is. I'm part of it. You can't pick on it without picking on me.

When you say something against it, you say it against me, for I am an American. To say it against you, as American,

and what they say against this nation, they say against you, for you are a part of it. Don't you never forget it; when you do, then you've got amnesia, sure enough.

64-0411 — Spiritual Amnesia 87 All she is, I am. All her glory is my glory. All her shame is my shame.

If she has done shameful things, then I'll have to stare her...stand her reproach. If she receives glory, I receive glory with her, because I'm identified with her.

Now, to be identified, American has to stand for all America's shame, all America's glory, all she ever was. All she is, or what she will be, you are identified with it.

88 Now, to be a true Christian, you have to be the same. We don't want to forget that. All that He was, I'm identified with Him. I'm identified with Him.

89 Notice, and He is in me, and I in Him. Notice, then, every Christian that's a real genuine Christian—Christian, was with Him,

"When the morning stars sang together and the sons of God shouted for joy, before there was a foundation of the world."

We were identified in the immortal realms with God, ten million years before the world was ever formed. I was back there with Him.

If I got Eternal Life, I was there with Him. I was identified with Him, "When the morning stars sang together and the sons of God shouted for joy."

64-0411 — Spiritual Amnesia 90 I was with Him when He called Abraham at the age of—of seventy-five years old,

and his wife being sixty-five, and told him they were going to have a baby. I was with him when he took his stand upon THUS SAITH THE LORD,

"I'm going to have the baby." I stood with him. Every other Christian stood with him. I was with him when his temptations come.

I was with him when he went up on top the mountain, to offer up Isaac. I was with him when the ram appeared.

91 I was with Joseph when he was rejected of his brothers, because he was spiritual and the rest of them was carnal.

I was with him when he knowed the reproach he had to stand by his own brothers. What he was, I am. What I am, he was. "For we are all one in Christ Jesus."

I was with Joseph in his cave, grave. I was with him when he went to the right hand of Pharaoh. You had to be identified with him.

92 I was with Jacob that night when he wrestled all night with the Angel. I've wrestled, myself. I know what he went through with. So I wrestled with Jacob the same time he did, for I am his brother.

93 I was with Moses when he went down into Egypt. I was with Moses at the burning bush. If you're a Christian, you are identified with them Bible characters.

Don't forget it! I was with Moses when all the people turned against him. I was with Moses when he crossed the Red Sea.

When he raised his hand and walked forward, and the Red Sea opened, I was identified in Christ right then, and I was with Moses at that hour.

94 Whatever Christians has been, whatever believers has been, every believer now is identified with that same person.

Whatever it is, you must be identified. Don't forget that. When you do, you've got spiritual amnesia; you've forgotten who you are.

95 Now identified with him, with Moses, when he crossed the sea.

64-0411 — Spiritual Amnesia 96 I was with Elijah in the days of Ahab, when they had to make a choice who they would serve, God or Balaam.

We was with him on Mount Carmel, when he had to make this choice,

for we are identified in the Body of the same God that he was identified in. So if we're identified in that Body, then we must remember we were there with him. That's right.

97 Now, I was with David, when he was rejected by his own brethren. I was with David; you were, too, if you're a Christian. You have to be identified in his rejection.

98 I was with the Hebrew children, in the fiery furnace, when the—the fire couldn't burn them because of the Presence of the fourth Man.

99 I was with Daniel, in the lions' den. I was identified in there, when the Angel of the Lord identified him in there.

100 I was most surely with Him at Calvary. I must be identified with Him at Calvary. I must be there to a place,

that, where not also was I identified with Him at Calvary, I died with Him at Calvary. Every Christian must die with Him at Calvary.

If you don't die with Him at Calvary, you can't be none of His. I was there when He died. I died with Him. And then I was with Him when He raised up from the dead.

I come up on Easter morning with Him, in the resurrection. Whatever He did, I was right there with Him; every believer was the same.

101 And now I am seated with Him in Heavenly Places in Christ Jesus, with all the powers of hell conquered, through Him.

Every Christian believer was seated the same way, 'cause you have to be identified.
