Revelation 3:21, "To him

that overcometh will I grant

to sit with Me in My throne,

even as I also overcame, and am set down with My Father in His throne." Now what are we to overcome?

That is the normal question to ask here. But that is not the actual thought of this verse for it is not so much WHAT we are to overcome but HOW we are to overcome.

Now this is logical, for does it matter much WHAT we are to overcome as long as we know HOW we can overcome?

A quick look at those Scriptures which involve the Lord Jesus overcoming will bring out the truth of this proposition.

In Matthew 4, wherein Jesus is tempted of the devil, He overcame the personal temptations of Satan by the Word, and by the Word <u>only.</u>

51

In each of the three major trials that corresponded exactly to the temptation of the Garden of Eden, the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eye,

and the pride of life, Jesus overcame by the Word. Eve fell to the personal temptation of Satan by failing to use the Word.

Adam fell in direct disobedience to the Word. But Jesus overcame by the Word. And right now, let me say that this is the only way to be an overcomer,

also it is the only way that you can know if you are overcoming, because that Word CAN'T fail.

Now notice again how Jesus overcame the world systems of religion. When He was repeatedly badgered by the theologians of His day, <u>He</u> constantly applied the Word.

He spake only what the Father gave Him to speak. There was not a time when the world was not utterly confused by His wisdom for it was the wisdom of God.

In his own personal life, contending with Himself, He overcame by obedience to the Word of God. In Hebrews 5:7 it says,

"Who in the days of His flesh, when He had offered up prayers and supplications with strong crying and tears unto Him That was able to save Him from death,

and was heard in that He feared; though He were a Son, yet learned He obedience by the things which He suffered;

and being made perfect, He became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey Him." <u>What was He</u> <u>obedient to? The Word of</u> God.

63-0825E — Perfect Faith 64 He had faith, with His power. How did He? He said, <u>"I can do nothing in</u> Myself." Why? He relied upon what He was;

<u>He relied in knowing that</u> He was the Word. And He had faith in God, Who made Him the Word. He was God (the Word), and they was in Him,

and that give Him faith because He understood His position. He knowed what He was, because the Scripture had said He was this.

And here every Scripture tied in, to prove that He was exactly what the Scripture said He would be, and He knew what He was.

65 Therefore, He relied upon what God had made Him. And if He did that, then can't we rely upon what God made us as believers?

"These signs shall follow them that believe!" He had faith in what He was. And if you are a believer, you have faith in what you are: you are a believer!

you.

God above us, the Pillar of Fire; God with us in Jesus Christ; God in us, the Holy Spirit. What is it? The same Word, the same God. Amen.

165 No more trusting in anything else, God come Hisself. This is a Man-size job, so He just brought it all down, and come down Himself,

"They won't have to do <u>nothing about it, just let</u> them surrender to Me and I will walk in them, talk in them, speak in them, work in them, thoroughly."

Oh, my! That's it. "I will do the, do... I will do the work, just let them just humble themselves, let them just empty up, I will defeat My enemy out there through them."

That's it. You can't do it in yourself now, you're not a match for him, but if you'll just let God do it, get the Word in you, then it'll be, all be taken care of.

57-0915E – Hebrews, Chapter Seven #1 30 Daniel said, "In that day they run to and fro, knowledge shall increase."

And he said, "The wise shall know their God, in that day, and shall do great exploits in that day. But the wicked will not know the God of Heaven."

They know Him in a form and in a ritual, like our first lesson said, but they don't know Him by the way of perfection.

He Wants To Get Somebody That Can So See It, That They Can Let The Word

<u>63-0728 — Christ Is The</u> Mystery Of God Revealed 375 And through that purpose He achieved a Church, that He, the fullness of God,

81 might bring to pass every promised Word of God in these last days; when He gets the preeminences, preeminence in the Church, the position, His place in the Church.

Jesus said, "He that believeth on Me, the works that I do shall he also; even more than this shall he do, for I go to My Father."

See, that was His purpose. There was the manifestation. And now, today, He wants to get somebody that can so see it, that they can let the Word...

That's His purpose. That's why He died. That's the second fold of His threefold manifestation. First, to express Hisself in Christ, then express Hisself through the Church.

And the same thing, Christ was the Word, and the Church becomes the Word when it lets the Word go through them.

See? That's all. <u>The Book</u> <u>holds that mystery, and the</u> <u>Book is only unfolding it</u>

Congregation says, "Amen."—Ed.] Well, then, if...He always was the Word. "In the beginning was the Word." And if the Word was God, then you were in God.

The Word, the part that you're to play, was in God before the foundation of the world. He seen you. He knew you. He predestinated you to it.

How can it be for the good?" And months later, when I seen her standing there in all the beauty of a young girl,

speaking to me, standing by the side of that old wagon, broken down, there, I knowed, if she would have lived she might have turned out wrong,
