An Exposition Of The Seven Church Ages (7 - The Sardisean Church Age) "For they are worthy." Do you realize Who is saying this? It is Jesus, the Worthy One, <u>Himself</u>.

This is the only One Who is accounted worthy to take the book out of the hand of Him Who sits upon the throne. And now this Worthy One is saying to His saints, "You are worthy."

These words are as astounding as are the words in Romans 8:33b, "God says I am righteous." (Way translation.) There in the white light of God's righteousness,
