# 64-0401 — The Identified Christ Of All Ages 26 And then, usually, man gets It so twisted up, and the world gets in such a shape,

until He has to send some man, anointed. All ages has been the same. He identifies Himself upon the earth, in man.

God does nothing without man. The Bible said so, you know. See? He always takes man, 'cause it was man He had to use,

and let the man...Put him on free moral agency, knowing that he would fall, in order to display His attributes as a Saviour,

for there was nothing lost. And, therefore, He chose man. He could have chose stars, He could have chose trees, but He chose man.

I thought, "Just, 'Pentecost," means one thing." I still believe it. We can't organize Pentecost. It's not an organization, it's an experience. You see? That's right.

Why ain't we got a revival? Why haven't we got these things going on? What's the matter with Pentecost? It organized itself. That's it. You can't organize Pentecost.

You can make an organization. But the Pentecost is a blessing, it's the Power of God. And if it's a genuine pentecost, it'll never bypass the Word for a creed.

It'll take the Word. Right, because it's circumcised from the world and the things of the world.

It sits only on the Word of God, and believes It. We're in Bethlehem, candidates for the Kingdom of God.

We're eating God's Eternal Life Bread. Born, God Bread, born in Bethlehem, to become the spiritual Bread of Life, of Eternal Life, in the house of God. Oh, my!

# 60-0925 — That Day On Calvary 118 Now, this is hard, but it's Truth.

You got to come to that fact, recognize what Calvary did for you. We look at it, and say, "Oh, yes, that's fine." That ain't it.

If that Son of God had to go to Calvary, for crucifixion, every son that comes must go to a Calvary. He must also have a Calvary. You must have that day of Calvary.

I've got to have that day of Calvary. That settles the sin question. Not shake hands with the preacher; not be shook into the church;

not come in by letter; not come in by profession. But come in by a Birth. He never gave a letter. He never gave a profession.

He gave a Birth. That's how we come in. Then, from that, automatically we're living Christian lives.

### 60-0925 — That Day On Calvary 120 Now, if you're just doing good things,

and think you can get in, by that, then there wouldn't had to be a day of Calvary. The law provided that.

But, being it taken a day of Calvary, was to bring that in, that we could not be just church members, but be sons and daughters of God.

That's what the day of Calvary was. That's what it meant to you, that you might do, and follow, and act like Jesus.

121 Now, the river doesn't run up and down, at the same time. The river only runs one way.

### And the Spirit of God just runs one way. It doesn't mix things with It. Runs the same way.

### 60-0925 — That Day On Calvary 122 Watch Jesus, in closing.

Jesus said, "The works that I do shall you do also, and greater than this shall you do, for I go to My Father."

123 I'm not saying this so-much to the church here. You understand. But these Messages are taped. Tens of thousands hear them, around the world.

124 I'm going to answer that question for the critic, right now. I've often been said...told. They say, "Why, you believe the Bible?

Jesus said, 'These works that I do shall you do also, and greater than this shall you do, for I go to My Father."

## 60-0925 — That Day On Calvary 127 Now watch. Jesus said. Watch how He stated it. "The works that I do," He's doing them right now.

"The works that I'm doing now, healing the sick, raising the dead, opening the eyes of the blind, these works shall you do also.

You'll do these if you believe in Me. You do these works. And then a greater than this shall you do, for I go to My Father."

60-0925 — That Day On Calvary 129 Now notice. The "greater" works, was to have the Power in the Church, not only to heal the sick by prayer, cast out devils by prayer,

but to impart Eternal Life to believers. The Holy Ghost was coming, and given into the hands of the Church, to impart Life. Oh! That's what Calvary meant.

It took stooped, degraded men and women, and lifted them into a place, to be sons and daughters of God, to heal the sick and to impart Eternal Life;

by giving the Holy Ghost to obedient believers, men who were once unbelievers, be made believers, and impart spiritual, Eternal Life.

130 How much greater is it: To say, "This sick woman laying here, I can pray a prayer of faith and she'll be healed,"

that's a great thing, that's what He was doing then; "but," said, "greater than this shall you do;

l'm going to give you Power, not only to raise him up for a while, but to give him Eternal Life, which will be Eternal, forever."

131 Poor, blind, wretched people, how do you miss that? Don't you see what the "greater" thing is?

That's the greatest thing could ever happen, was to impart Eternal Life to people.

What is Eternal Life? The Life that He lived, the Life that was in Him, impart That to others. Can a man do that? A son of God can.

132 Jesus said, "Whose soever sins you remit, to them they are remitted; whose soever sin you retain, to them they are retained."

65-0410 — The Easter Seal 86 Now, the Holy Spirit is here on earth, looking out those individuals that God has ordained to Life in this age.

# And as soon as It finds it, It does just like It did on Jesus Christ,

the great super Son of God Who redeemed us all. It comes down and takes Its place of abode into the human life, now, notice, brought the quickening power.

if it's not a mockery holy spirit, if it's not the devil mocking the Holy Spirit, but is the real, true Holy Spirit. It'll manifest the promise of this hour.

87 When It fell upon Luther, It manifested that promise of that hour. When It fell upon Wesley, It manifested the promise of that hour.

When It falls in this day, It manifests the promise of this hour. When It fell upon Moses, It manifested the promise of that hour.

Fell upon Noah, It manifest the promise of that hour. When It fell upon Jesus, It manifest the promise of that hour. See?

88 It's the Holy Spirit coming down, to quicken, make alive those people that's foreordained of God to be in the Rapture. Notice. That is, if he is a true eagle,

he will understand the Message of the hour if he's a true eagle. Now, the little eagle probably, in the barnyard, was eating all right,

but he—he knowed it wasn't just exactly right. But then when he heard the Truth, then he received this Truth. Now, in John 14...

### <u>60-0925 — That Day On</u>

#### Calvary

85 Now, the first thing I want to say, is, Jesus never lived for Himself. His life was spent for others.

That's, perfectly, Eternal Life. When you say you go to church, and you do good things, that's fine. But when you live your life to yourself, you haven't Eternal Life.

Eternal Life, is living for others. It proved it when It come in the Lamb of God. He lived, and had Eternal Life, because He did not live for Himself.

He lived for others. And you receive Eternal Life, by receiving that day, and you don't live for yourself no more. You live for others.

## 60-0925 — That Day On Calvary 86 Someone said, "How can you stand, let anybody call

you such bad names?"

You don't live for yourself. You live for others, that you might redeem that man. You become sons.

And the trouble of it is, the church has forgot they were sons. You're a son. You're taking Christ's place. You're a son, so don't live for yourself. Live for others.

87 "Well, Brother Branham, I can live for this brother, because he sure is a nice man." That's not it.

88 Live for that man who hates you. Live for that person who would kill you if they could. That's what they done to Him.

### They killed Him, and He died, that He might save them. That's Eternal Life. When, you, that's in your bosom, you're facing Heaven then.

But you sacrifice your own things, give them up, like the sheep gives its wool. You look on, towards Calvary.

### 60-0925 — That Day On Calvary 89 I hope this helps you to get in a place.

That's what the tabernacle, that's what all people, has got to do, is find out what you are, and what's the purpose.

Church, isn't going to church just to play music, sing songs. Church is a place where correction. "Judgment begins at the house of God."

90 "We must reckon ourselves dead, and alive to Christ." Then, He made the way that we could sacrifice ourselves to His service,

# to follow Him. If we follow Him, we lead the life that He lived. That's wonderful.

### 60-0308 — Discernment Of Spirit 11 Now we do have...and I think it's a good thing for us, as ministers,

to follow our order, when we see such things in the world as we see today. And we have an order from God, is for the discerning of spirits, trying the spirit.

I believe that that is a very great lesson for the church today, is to try the spirit of anything, have discernment of the spirit.

I do not think that we should ever, by any means, ever try to judge a person by the denomination they belong to, or by the group that they are assembled with,

whether they be Methodist, Baptist, Presbyterian, Pentecostal, or—or whatever they are. We should never judge the man by the denomination that he belongs to.

We should always judge him by the spirit he has, see, the spirit. Whether he's latter rain or former rain or inner,

outer rain, or no rain, or whatever it might be, we should never judge him by that, but, by his spirit. We are to discern spirits.

Watch what the man has in mind, what he has...what he's trying to achieve. If the man, by a gift, no matter how great the gift is...

### 60-0308 — Discernment Of

### <u>Spirit</u>

12 Now I want to get this to the Church this morning, which, in the different denominations you are still the Church of the living God, together.

And this is the thing I want to get to you, see, that we are really not divided. We are the stones that's cut in different forms, all to the glory of God.

# 60-0308 — Discernment Of Spirit

13 Now, there is so much in the day that we live in, pertaining to "gifts." So many people judge people by gifts that they have.

Well, I believe that these things are gifts. I believe that what we see take place is gifts, and they are God-given gifts.

But, we, if we do not use them in the right way that God intended them to be used, then we can do more harm with the gifts than we could if we did not have the gifts.

The other night I made a statement at the pulpit, saying this, that I would rather see brotherly love existing among the church, if we didn't have one case of healing or anything else. See, we must know what these things are for.

# 60-0308 — Discernment Of Spirit

14 Now, if a man comes and he has a great gift, no matter if he belongs to our denomination or another denomination,

don't judge him by what denomination he come from, how he dresses, but what you want to see is what he's trying to do with that gift. What purpose he has.

If he's trying to take his influence and build himself a great name out of it, I'd have discernment of spirit enough to know that's wrong.

No matter how great a teacher he is, how powerful he is, how intellectual he is, or how his gift operates,

if he isn't trying to achieve something for the benefit of the Body of Christ, your own spiritual discernment would tell you that that's wrong.

### No matter how accurate, how perfect, how it is, it's wrong if it isn't used for the Body of Jesus Christ.

#### <u>60-0308 — Discernment Of</u>

#### <u>Spirit</u>

15 To achieve something, maybe he's got a great gift that he could draw people together with a great intellectual or a spiritual power,

that he could draw people together, and maybe he's trying to take that gift and make hisself famous so that he'll have a big name,

so that other brethren will look up to him as some big person. Then that's wrong. Maybe he's trying to—

to edify a certain thing here that he wants everybody else to get out of the picture and let him and his group be the picture. That's still wrong, see.

## 60-0308 — Discernment Of

### <u>Spirit</u>

16 But if he has a gift of God and he's trying to edify the Body of Christ, then I don't care what he belongs to. You're not discerning the man, you're discerning the spirit, the life that's in the man. And that's what God told us to do. Not one time was we ever commissioned to discern the—the man's group.

But we was constrained and commanded by God to discern the spirit in the man, what he's trying to do,

what the spirit in his life is trying to lead him to. And then if we can find out that he's trying to lead the people (not to break them up, but to bring them together)

and to bring the Church of the living God, not all to one denomination, but to an understanding, a fellowship,

a unity of spirit. Then if he is former rain or latter rain, or whatever it is, his spirit and his purpose is right. And the spirit that's in him,

no matter what move he belongs to, the Spirit that's in him is trying to point the people to Calvary, away from himself or away from anything else,

but his only achievement he has is to point them to Calvary. He doesn't care whether he's even knowed or not. He doesn't care whether even his own movement...

which is fine, see, it's good, if he is a Methodist, or a Presbyterian, or a Roman Catholic, or whatever he wants to be by denomination.

17 But what is he trying to do, the purpose of his heart that he's trying to get? Then you can see what's in the man's life, whether his motives is for his—his denomination,

whether it's for hisself, whether it's for worldly fame, whether it's for big names, to say, "I predicted that, come just exactly to pass."

Now, you see that's wrong right there, to begin with. But if he's trying to use what God's give him, as a teacher, as a prophet, as a seer...

# 60-0308 — Discernment Of Spirit

18 A New Testament prophet is a preacher. We all know that. Just any minister that's a preacher is a prophet,

a New Testament prophet, if he's prophesying, preaching, not to try to edify himself to make a big name, or to edify his organization.

Which, he should be in an organization. Here I am without one, but yet preaching you should be. That's right. Every man ought to have a church home. You ought to have a place, not just to float about from pillar to post,

but have somewhere that you go to church and you call it your church, somewhere you pay your tithes, and somewhere that you help support the Cause. Take your choice,

but then don't never disfellowship the other man because he don't belong with your group. See? Discern his spirit and see if he's got the same purpose in heart,

#### then you got fellowship one with another. You're working for one great Cause. That's the cause of Christ. I think that that is absolutely true.

#### 61-0428 — Getting In The Spirit 119 And that's what we've tried to do for two thousand years.

And Pentecostal people, you're doing the same thing, trying to pick Him up by organization.

You'll never do it, separate yourself from other brothers, you got to come back, and we got to be one, I don't care if the man's wrong.

If he's wrong and sincere in his heart, and you're right in your belief and—and you're wrong in acting the way you're acting,

l'd rather be in his place than be in yours. That's right. I'd rather be wrong in my doctrine, and right in my heart, God will respect it more.

61-0428 — Getting In The Spirit 120 So if a man is wrong. what of it? Help him, he needs help, love him. If you can't love your enemy the same as you love those who love you,

you're no better off than the publicans. Right. That's what the church has failed to get. I hope you get it tonight,

I hope you see what I'm talking about. It's back to love, redeeming love, all the other things are fine, but we got to come back to fellowship with one another.

#### 60-0925 — That Day On Calvary 141 Have your day at Calvary, God will have His way with you.

Let me quote that again. Have your day at Calvary, God will have His way with you.

#### 60-0925 — That Day On Calvary 156 What is "crucified with Christ"? Is to live for others. What kind of others?

Those who hate you, those who wouldn't like you, those who'd make fun of you: live for them; be with them; love them;

"pray for those who despitefully use you, say all manner of evil falsely, for My Name's sake. They persecuted the prophets which was before you."

157 I thought the message would probably help the church this morning, that you would see that we need a Calvary, we need a crucifixion.

But, oh, you can't be blowed off the target when you're zeroed in. That's all. There's nothing going to stop it. God carries it to its...

111 So will your prayers go straight to its destination, 'cause it's offered in the Blood of Jesus Christ which cleanses you. There's not a sin or a spot on you nowhere.

"Now here, you either come join our ranks or don't you do that no more." And the man let them know that he didn't have to join their denomination, their ranks.

He went up there, and he heard Jesus saying, "Whosoever will...," so he just received it and went on. And he was getting the job done. Well, the disciples said, "We forbid you." In other words, "We'll boycott you; we'll do all of this if you don't do it."
